Long Introduction

It's all about how long it's taken us, the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 1:27, KJV), to get to this point: two *thousand* years! And we're not even there yet! (As of this edit in March of 2021.)

On a dark desert highway cool wind in my hair


God's way is a *high* way "For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones" (Isa. 57:15, KJV). Therefore, along the way (John 14:6 below), in the dark (Rev. 13:3 below), dry and weary land of apostate Christianity (Ps. 63:1 below), God still refreshes the soul (Ps. 84:5-6 below)—more specifically, my soul. That's what He was doing when He gave me the interpretation for this song in 2009.

John 14:6, KJV Jesus saith...I am the way.

Revelation 13:3, KJV All the world [has] wondered after the beast.

Ps. 63:1, KJV My flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is.

Ps. 84:5-6, KJV Blessed is the man whose strength is in thee; in whose heart are the ways of them. Who passing through the valley of Baca make it a well; the rain also filleth the pools.



cool wind in my hair

The "cool wind" is the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:2 below). He's revealing how cool He is through this ministry. And He's *in my hair* (as the expression goes) since He won't leave me alone! (Jer. 20:9 below). But the wind is also in my hair because I most often rode my motorcycle without a helmet (and this song seems to be about someone on a bike).

Acts 2:2, KJV A violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house. [That was at Pentecost when the Spirit was first poured out on the believers. However, we're now talking about *my* temple since we're talking about "my hair" being that He was refreshing my soul and the born again *are* "the temple" (1 Cor. 3:16, KJV). So technically it's all the born again whose souls He's refreshing—all who'll finally take Him seriously.]

Jeremiah 20:9, KJV His word [i]s in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones.

So while I most often didn't wear my helmet, it turns out God predestined me, along with all of His elect "vessels of mercy" (Rom. 9:23, KJV) to have an *invisible* helmet, "the helmet of salvation" (Eph. 6:17, KJV) which I didn't know about when I had my bike. In other words, the Lord had me *covered* since He "prepared [me] in advance for glory" (Rom. 9:23, NIV). God's elect have been *covered* since before we were born. However, we can reject His "helmet of salvation" (Eph. 6:17, KJV) just like I often rejected my motorcycle helmet. It's a pretty dumb thing to do, so dumb it's now illegal. It's like how "the Pharisees and the experts in the law rejected God's purpose for themselves" (Luke 7:30, KJV) and suffered the brutal consequences with the fall of Jerusalem at the hands of the Romans in 70 A.D.

The wind is also in your hair if you're born again and willing to be honest, because He's blessing you, delivering you, through this ministry as you Ride through this Valley of chaos we've created for ourselves with the "falling away" (2 Thess. 2:3, KJV) He prophesied would take place before His return. While you probably think that's a very proud thing for me to write, the fact is that NO ONE else is interpreting secular resources biblically as they should be since "all things were created by him, and for him" (Col. 1:16, KJV) and He's using them to further build us up in Christ.

Warm smell of colitas

This ties in to some food related biblical interpretations the Lord gave me, the movies *Ratatouille (2007)* and *Babette's Feast (1987)*, the book *Maya Makes a Mess* by Rutu Modan, as well as a culinary parable He gave me beginning in the late 1990s which I summed up with the timeline. Christ says "My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink" (John 6:55, NIV). Therefore, the Old Testament says "taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him" (Ps. 34:8, KJV).



And "Colitas" means *tails* in Spanish, little tails, like a child's *little booty*. It's the word my mom used once as she chased my brother around the living room with a broom yelling something like "I'm gonna beat your booty! You bad BAD little boy!"



In other words, Chef Jesus' cooking is permeating the air—a few *derrieres* He's *whipping together* since there's nothing like a good ol' fashioned spanking when it's deserved (Gal. 6:7; Heb. 12:10; Prov. 3:12 below).

Galatians 6:7, KJV God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Hebrews 12:10, KJV For they [our parents] verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

Proverbs 3:12, KJV For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

There's also the expression "You're getting warm" meaning you're getting close. Therefore, God is revealing that we're getting *close* to the Day when He is going to be *whipping those booties* so that the born again will "shall lothe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that ye have committed" (Ezek. 20:43, KJV). Because, God has prophesied that in the last of the last days His "witnesses...shall prophesy...clothed in sackcloth" (Rev. 11:3, KJV), meaning repentant.

rising up through the air

After more than two decades of being treated like *I'm* the moron by the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) as well as by the lost, what God is doing sure smells good to me! He says "Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan...to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee" (Rev. 3:9, KJV). I discern God means that those who've hurt me and my family the most, Eagle Church leadership—which I talk about in the *Welcome!* book and video—will finally repent and ask God's forgiveness acknowledging that they did wrong and that I am being used by God.

God let me *smell* it "rising up through the air" by giving me the interpretation for this song. Having followed Him against the grain of everyone on my path for over a decade, something that was about to get harder in 2009, the Lord was encouraging me since it would be yet another decade before anyone would treat me biblically—which hasn't even happened yet. And since 2012 the few who did somewhat listen to me, my immediate family members, stopped. Giving me this interpretation, the first of many, is like when the smell of a pie rises up through the air. The smell, equivalent to hearing God's voice, lets you know that thing is almost ready to eat. Spiritually speaking, God is referring to the end of this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT), His return, and the "marriage supper of the Lamb" (Rev. 19:19, KJV). He was encouraging me, and through me, through this ministry, He's encouraging the body of Christ, all who'll take Him more seriously.

God used the T-Shirt from my favorite radio station when I was in college to help me connect the dots. It says *Feast Your Ears*.

Poor Colitas: When the Lord opened up this song to me, He also tuned me in to some boys coloring way outside the lines (since my daughters play piano). I'm thinking they had to be very bad little boys growing up. Poor Moms. Poor colitas! But they took the heat and persevered while obviously doing their homework. Now look at 'em! One Direction - What Makes You Beautiful (5 Piano Guys, 1 piano) - The Piano Guys - YouTube. In other words, getting disciplined—especially by God—is a good thing!



Up ahead in the distance I saw a shimmering light

The light up ahead in the distance—at the End of the Tunnel—is Jesus since He says "I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life" (John 8:12, KJV). And putting my website together some time between 2012 and 2015 I found a cave from the Maya ruins in Guatemala. So it's like this graphic for my website homepage. Because Christianity is so apostate, my life and walk with the Lord has been, not only like a dark desert highway but as if that highway has been inside this very dark cave heading towards the light, towards Christ. And the road behind me reveals a trail of ruins, many ruined lives because of Christianity's apostasy. And He's using me, Maya, to fully expose the ruins, the mess we—the body of Christ—have historically made. Christ is the Light up ahead in the distance as we come out of this dark 'cave' of apostasy, which He said we would walk through before His return. Scripture says "the day of Christ…shall not come, except there come a falling away first" (2 Thess. 2:2-3, KJV). We've fulfilled it.



God also says "I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches" (Rev. 22:16, KJV). He's revealing His angel, having done that, through these biblical interpretations. However, "the churches" are not those buildings everyone calls church. They're the born again who have the Spirit within for having initially obeyed Him for a season (Acts 5:32 below). We "are God's building" (1 Cor. 3:9, KJV). "Like living stones, [we] are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood" (2 Pet. 2:5, NIV).

Acts 5:32, NIV The Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him.

And the light is "shimmering" because the Lord is "the light of the world" (John 8:12, KJV) and He's got a great sense of humor which throws the faithless off track. As you can see with the graphic, shimmer can mean twinkle, sparkle, and wink. Scripture says "My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways" (Isa. 55:8, KJV), "a merry heart doeth good like a medicine" (Prov. 17:22, KJV) and "the One enthroned in heaven laughs" (Ps. 2:4, NIV). Since He's the One who created humor, He's got the best sense of humor there is! He's shimmering like when there are three people and one winks to the other while having fun at the third party's expense. But it's not a bad thing, It's like what a grandfather would do between two gran kids. The one will only get offended and bent out of shape if they're too sensitive. And Jesus says "blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me" (Matt 11:6, KJV).



My head grew heavy

My head has grown *heavy* ever since God first enlightened me because of everything He's downloaded. So in the very beginning when I became born again in 1988 I was like Daniel who "fainted, and was sick certain days; [and] afterward rose up, and did the king's business; and...was astonished at the vision, but none understood it" (Dan. 8:27, KJV). That's *exactly* my testimony summed up in *Welcome!* and detailed in the rest of the testimony books.

Because the born again have been so hard-hearted their heads are also going to grow heavy feeling the weight of conviction crashing down on them by the Hammer. God says "Is not my word...like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?" (Jer. 23:29, KJV). And Jesus's "name is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, KJV). In other words, Jesus is the Hammer. He's going to be *breaking* those rocky stone cold hearts and then totally *melting* them down as He's walked me through with *Maya Makes a Mess* along with a lesson He had for me one day at the beach concerning ice cream. He says "I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh" (Ezek. 11:19, KJV).

Basically, it's like this. When Jesus walked the earth we were under the law of Moses. While that was given "by the disposition of angels" (Acts 7:53, KJV), and it was fallen angels as I've covered in several different books, because the temple represented God's house in the eyes of the people, Jesus called it "My Father's house" (John 2:16, KJV)—God having "worketh all things [out] after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV). Therefore, Jesus harshly rebuked the Jewish leaders "making a whip of cords, [and] drove them all out of the temple" (John 2:15, ESV). Now, however, we are under the new covenant law of love and grace since "grace and truth came by Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, KJV). Therefore, God will be crushing these hardened harts with His Word and melting them down through revelation which He's had me sum up with this ministry. Then He'll be 'whipping' the body of Christ not with a whip of cords but like you do when making ice cream, with a blender. Through this ministry He's going to be whipping the body of Christ together, at least a remnant, making us a *united* body of Christ. A remnant will finally be united with Him as we worship Him as required, "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24, KJV) and united with each other as we finally "submit to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, NIV).

In short, the body of Christ is the ice cream he's serving up from that timeline. *We* are desert. Because, in the same way that the Father fed us through Christ so that they basically 'ate Him alive' as the expression goes, we, the born again who walk most closely with Him also get eaten alive. That's my 22 year testimony. As He says "The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also" (John 15:20, NIV), which they'll do at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV). And the combination of our guilt before God along with "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, KJV) coming down on us makes the head grow heavy. And since He's using me as His Sous Chef, having called me to "Feed [His] sheep" (John 21:17, KJV), it's like this graphic.



and my sight grew dim

Because of Christianity's lack of faithfulness to God and all the consequences that has caused, my sight by faith has also struggled, grown dim, at times—especially since "mine own familiar friend[s and family], in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, ha[ve] lifted up [their] heel against me" (Ps. 41:9, KJV). So while there are three others living with me in the same house—my husband and two grown daughters—we don't even eat together anymore. It's what He ultimately meant when He said "There are many rebellious people, full of meaningless talk and deception [all those institutional church leaders]... They must be silenced, because they are disrupting whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach—and that for the sake of dishonest gain" (Titus 1:10-11, NIV). By raking in the millions it's obvious they're deceivers

because Jesus taught "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15, KJV). In fact, the sight by faith for all of the body of Christ has grown dim "for the leaders of this people [have] cause[d] them to err; and they that are led of them are destroyed" (Isa. 9:16, KJV).

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I had to stop for the night

Exhausted, working for the Lord for years against the grain "for a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries" (1 Cor. 16:9, KJV), working unpaid "as [a] slave...of Christ, doing the will of God from [my] heart" (Eph. 6:6, KJV), non-stop, with trial upon trial over the years since "many are the afflictions of the righteous" (Ps. 34:19, KJV), I have to stop for the night. Then I'm back at it the next morning for another 10 to 12 hour day, day after day, year after year—unpaid and completely alone for the last decade. So lately, I stop for the night earlier and earlier.

There she stood in the doorway

Jesus is the Door having said "I am the door of the sheep" (John 10:7, KJV) and He's the way having said "I am the way" (John 14:6, KJV). In other words, He's the doorway. I'm standing with Him because it's as He says "Where I am, there shall also my servant be" (John 12:26, KJV).

I heard the mission bell

He and I are ringing the Church bell—sounding more clearly the mission of every born again Christian (Matt. 28:19-20 below)—the *warning* bell (Joel 2:1 below). Churches with bells often doubled as one room school houses as well as the town hall, places of learning and of civil order, which are a big part of what Christianity is all about.

Matthew 28:19-20, KJV Teach...them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. [Joel 2:1, KJV Sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand.

And I was thinking to myself, "This could be Heaven or this could be Hell"

The saints, the born again, who walk closely with the Lord question whether or not Jesus is rebuking us when we hear His voice, just like the disciples did back then when He said "one of you shall betray me. And they were exceeding sorrowful, and began every one of them to say unto him, Lord, is it I?" (Matt. 26:21-22, KJV). So it's like the song says, "This could be Heaven or this could be Hell." And for most—all of us at some level—it is 'hell.' At least in the sense that there's hell to pay, restitution to be made revealing genuine repentance, along with the consequences we'll be suffering, "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, KJV). But "if we [had been] more discerning with regard to ourselves, we would not [have] come under such judgment" (1 Cor. 11:39, NIV). And, again, all are guilty at some level (Matt. 26:31; Phil. 2:21; Zech. 12:10 below).

Matthew 26:31, KJV Saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me.

Philippians 2:21, KJV All seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

Zechariah 12:10, KJV They shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

And while hell is a pagan concept which doesn't actually exist, there *is* hell to pay for having taken God's Gift through Christ (2 Cor. 9:15 below) for granted (Heb. 2:3 & Gal. 6:7 below). That payment is hell on earth as well as the consequences we'll suffer after this life is over. For the born gain it means a loss of rewards and a lesser position in God's kingdom, or so I discern. And for the lost it means the "second death" (Rev. 2:11, KJV).

2 Corinthians 9:15, KJV Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift.

Hebrews 2:3, NIV Since the message spoken through angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, how shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation?

Galatians 6:7, KJV God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Then she lit up a candle

By obeying God, I'm relighting (Matt. 23:13 below) the Light (John 8:12 below), the candle having "nullif[ied] the word of God for the sake of...our tradition[s]" (Matt. 15:6, NIV).

Matthew 23:13, NIV Hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven in people's faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to.

John 8:12, KJV Spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

and she showed me the way

I'm holding up the Light (Hab. 2:2-3 below) showing God's elect how to get Home (Ps. 119:105 below) on the Honor's Program (2 Tim. 2:15 below).

Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

Psalm 119:105, KJV Thy word is a lamp unto [our] feet, and a light unto [our] path.

2 Timothy 2:15, KJV Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

More than that. As Sous Chef in His Service (John 12:26 below), I'm not only *cooking* Flambé—which He's made clear through the *Culinary Parable*, *Maya Makes a Mess* book, *Babette's Feast* and *Ratatouille*, along with my testimony—I'm showing God's people how to make Flambé for yourselves (Matt. 28:20 below) so that you can serve others since He says to all born again "Feed my sheep" (John 21:17, KJV). In that way, eventually, we'll set the world ablaze for Christ (Matt. 3:11 below), and rejoice *as* we get persecuted (Acts 5:41 & Ps. 126:2 below).

John 12:26, KJV If any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

Matt. 28:20, KJV Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded.

Matthew 3:11, KJV He shall baptize you with the Holy [Spirit], and with fire.

Acts 5:41, KJV They departed...rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name [since professing Christians including the born again will ridicule and rebuke you for leaving the sacred cow of institutional church with all of her false doctrines].

Psalm 126:2, KJV Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The LORD hath done great things for them.

Right now most seem to rejoice in that they can get through trials with God's help, trials they never would have gone through had they honored the Lord in the first place. That's not what we've been called to do! Most Christians today are honoring Satan and then getting bailed out by Jesus for having been "hand[ed]...over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh" (1 Cor. 5:5, NIV), when we should be honoring Jesus so that Satan gets mad at us and we, therefore, suffer at his hand. Scripture says "how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God" (1 Pet. 2:20, NIV). According to Scripture we weren't supposed to make this world our comfortable home. So here's part of Hebrews 11, what's often called the Hall of Faith.

Through faith [they] subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions. Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection: And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment: They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented; (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth. And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise (Heb. 11:33-39, KJV)

They "received not the promise" because it's not for this life. Jesus said "My kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36, KJV). His kingdom, what we're supposed to be living for is not about making a comfortable life for ourselves here on earth. It's about honoring Him so that we "obtain a better resurrection" (Heb. 11:35, KJV).

There were voices down the corridor

The voices down the corridor are of those cheering us on, humans who've gone before us (Heb. 11 above), as well as angelic ones (Luke 1:19), all of which add up to the voice of the Lord (Isa. 42:6).

Luke 1:19, KJV The angel answering said unto him, I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God; and am sent to speak unto thee, and to shew thee these glad tidings.

Isaiah 42:6, KJV I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles.

The closer you get to the Lord, by faith, the clearer you hear the voices. God says "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded" (James 4:8, KJV). And the closer we get to "the last trump" (1 Cor. 15:52, KJV), the clearer God's elect will not only hear, but see. "Scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced" (John 19:37, KJV). The closer you walk with the Lord the more discernment you have.

I thought I heard them say

You didn't just think you heard—you did! It's like this account with Samuel:

The LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child. Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place. And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth (1 Sam. 3:8-10, KJV).

That's what the born again need to do as well, be still before God and listen for His voice through His Word and Spirit.

Not being in the habit of doing that, most born again today aren't doing what God has called them to do but things they think are good to do. And there's a huge difference. A good example is with all those leaders in the institutional churches since they do NOT represent the church Jesus is building as summed up with the pyramids. However, He still uses much of it because He's the One in ultimate control who uses all things for His purposes (Col. 1:16) and "worketh all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV). What you heard (are hearing through this ministry) is God speaking by all means necessary. He prophesied saying the following:

It shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy (Acts 2:17-18, KJV).

While that's been happening to some degree for the last 2000 years, it's *really* going to start happening when a decent core among the body of Christ repent.



The institutional church doesn't just function like a business, it mirrors the satanic New World Order!

Welcome to the Hotel California

A hotel is a stopping place. 'Hotel California' represents the rest stop between Christianity *today* and heaven on earth. It represents Christianity *tomorrow*. Basically, the Son rose in the east (Israel) and is setting in the west (the U.S.). God has also taken our sins that distance, *the* distance. "As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us" (Ps. 103:12, KJV). And California represents the most western part of the U.S. mainland—that's not only beautiful, but *warm*. It's warm in temperature but cold spiritually, and therefore needs to change, like the body of Christ, since we're supposed to be representing love being that "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV). He made it clear that this is how we're supposed to behave:

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails (1 Cor. 13:4-8, KJV).

It also ties in to this hymn. Day Is Dying in the West - YouTube.

When the Lord opened up this biblical interpretation to me in 2009, California still brought to my mind images of beautiful blue skies with powder puff clouds, gorgeous beaches with ocean cliffs where wildlife and people play together. They have fantastic weather nearly year round with beautiful and varied topography—a paradise—where the sun sets marking the end of the day. And God says "Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an holy day, a sabbath of rest to the LORD" (Ex. 35:2, KJV). And "he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his. Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief" (Heb. 4:10-11, KJV). Under the new covenant our sabbath rest isn't about worshipping God on a certain day since we're supposed to be "bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, KJV). Every thought means every day! Our sabbath rest is a life of *total reliance* on the Lord.

California is also a place where they have many wild fires (even before their use of Directed Energy Weapons), and the Lord is pretty *wild* (Isa. 55:9 below), as well as being a fire (Heb. 12:29 below). It's a warning.

Isaiah 55:9, KJV For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Hebrews 12:29, KJV God is a consuming fire.

Coronado is a place and a hotel in southern California, in San Diego. It's the Lord's hotel since He's the One who's been crowned. "He hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS" (Rev. 19:16, KJV). He is el Coronado, the Crowned One. It's only through Him and by faith in Him that anyone can experience the blessings and rest of *Hotel California*, of the Lord. Scripture says "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12, KJV). He's the One welcoming His elect there. He says the following:



Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light (Matt. 11:28-30, KJV).

Yet the body of Christ as a whole views Him as worse than a brutal dictator who's going to be sending most of the people He created to fire burning eternal hell. I walk through it in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*.

God also tied this song and hotel to the two men I considered marrying. I cover it my testimony books. Both of their names echo the name of God, one does of the Father, whose name means *God is gracious*, and the other one, the one God led me to marry echoes the Son, His title, since it means *King*. The first one, the gracious one, wanted to take care of my every need and the one I married *has* taken care of my worldly needs. But unlike most Christian women, I don't look to him as my shield or my helper or my strength...as I just heard one woman say about her husband. I look to Jesus as all those things, and so should every born again Christian. Doing what that woman is doing is idolatry. And my experience is that it's what many Christian women are doing. They've placed their husband in the Lord's place.

Such a lovely place (Such a lovely place)

Jesus is the King of everything (1 Tim. 6:15; Col. 1:16 below). Therefore, He's King of Hospitality, which makes His *hotel* a very lovely 'place.' Scripture says "Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked" (Ps. 84:10, NIV). No other place compares so that the psalmist wrote "One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple" (Ps. 27:4 below).

1 Timothy 6:15, KJV [Jesus] is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords.

Colossians 1:16, KJV All things were created by him, and for him.

The verse is repeated to stress the point, a point made through Joseph who said "The dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). God has repeatedly repeated the same message through this ministry by way of my personal testimony along with the biblical interpretations. And the point being stressed is of His soon return and, therefore, of our need to repent—speaking of the body of Christ. God says "For verily I say unto you, That many prophets and righteous men have desired to see those things which ye see [will see], and have not seen them; and to hear those things which ye hear, and have not heard them" (Matt. 13:17, KJV)—speaking today of the "latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV) and of the rapture when "the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord" (Eph. 4:16-17, KJV).

So, ultimately, the "lovely place" being sung about is the millennial reign of Christ, His kingdom on earth, when those "which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands...lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years" (Rev. 20:4, KJV).

Such a lovely face

There's no lovelier face than His for "who is like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who is like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders?" (Ex. 15:11, KJV). Therefore, "Let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us" (Ps. 90:17, KJV).

Plenty of room at the Hotel California

While the "hireling[s who Jesus warned us] care...not for the sheep" (John 10:13, KJV), and roughly chase you out of those so called church buildings like Diotrephes did 2000 years ago (3 John 9:9-11 below), the Church Jesus is building is NOT those buildings. It's a *community of people* who love Him and one another. They're "like living stones, [which] are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 2:5, NIV). So, as the song says, there's "plenty of room at the Hotel California" at El Coronado. There's room for all of His children at His hotel. No one needs to feel left out. Not one. God says "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Acts 2:21, KJV).

3 John 9:9-11, NIV Diotrephes, who loves to be first, will not welcome us. So when I come, I will call attention to what he is doing, spreading malicious nonsense about us. Not satisfied with that, he even refuses to welcome other believers. He also stops those who want to do so and puts them out of the church. Dear friend, do not imitate what is evil but what is good.

Neither do we have to fight for positions of importance as professing Christians currently do, just like the rest of the world—since they're *all* important, especially the positions we dislike the most as He makes clear with the following passage:

God has put the body together, giving greater honor to the parts that lacked it, so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it (1 Cor. 12:24-26, NIV).

It's like if someone took a hammer to my little pinky toe, my entire body would overwhelmed with pain. Rejecting a member of the body of Christ, especially the apparently least important, has the same effect. It just take longer to realize it.

And unless you're 'sitting' in *your* assigned position doing *your* job (Eph. 2:10 below) and doing it *well* (Col. 3:23-24 below) you're wasting your life away (1 Cor. 3:11-15 below). It's like this graphic—speaking of the born again.

Ephesians 2:10, NIV For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Colossians 3:23-24, NIV Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.



1 Corinthians 3:11-15, KJV For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

Any time of year (Any time of year)

Any time, day, night, or season, we are welcome. Jesus is always ready and waiting for us—repeated, meaning *truly*. Again, He says "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you" (James 4:8, KJV). God is stressing the point since so many, especially the "hireling[s]" (John 10:13, KJV)—all those paid Christian leaders—are so guilty. But instead of committing suicide like Judas who "went and hanged himself" (Matt. 27:5, KJV), all that's needed is genuine *repentance*. "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9, KJV). So this song, based on the passage about the prodigal son, should encourage the broken rebels. Still Calls Me Son John Waller - YouTube.

You can find it here

In God's *hotel*, you can find love, forgiveness, mercy, fellowship—all that you need, and more—any time you need it. God says "My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore [should we] rather glory in [our] infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon [us]" (2 Cor. 12:9, KJV). The Father "hath put all things under [Jesus'] feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all" (Eph. 1:22-23, KJV). This contradicts what the hirelings say to you when you hold them accountable. They tell you that you have to be part of an institutional church and under *their* lordship in order to grow in Christ. But that's not at all what the New Testament teaches.

Her mind is Tiffany-twisted

Tiffany & Company make luxury jewelry. And Jesus—the Word—is more precious than gold as we're informed in the following passage, for example:

The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward (Ps. 19:9-11, KJV).

And because of how God has worked in my life, my mind is wound up with His Word, as you can see in my material. It's like the braids I used to do on my girls' hair, a combination of His Word, my words, and daily events, continually until the end—of this life. It's also twisted with tragic soberness, anger, frustration, and comic relief for which they've "said unto [me], Thou art mad" (Acts 12:15, KJV). It's a double twist. I did the girls' hair that way too.




While Christians are supposed to "know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose" (Rom. 8:28, KJV), they don't really believe it. If they did they wouldn't live as worldly as they do, using Him merely like hair spray or like croutons on a salad when He's supposed to be the salad. So He's revealing through my testimony and this ministry that all things do work together for them that love God. Except, in order to get the full benefit you have to work *with* Him, as in "follow" Him (Matt. 4:19, KJV).

she got the Mercedes Bends

People get the *bends* (decompression sickness) from coming up too fast. The Lord gives me *the bends*—gets me laughing or crying, or both at the same time—by constantly taking me for a Ride from my world to His back and forth. He gives me the bends because for over two decades it's been like the following passage and this hotdog/sandwiched graphic:

When Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils. And she went and told them that had been with him, as they mourned and wept. And they, when they had heard that he was alive, and had been seen of her, believed not (Mark 16:9-11, KJV).



And these 'bends' are of the *Mercedes* type because they're such high quality being that they come from God our Maker (Job 22, NIV & Ps. 99:9 below).


Job 22:12, NIV Is not God in the heights of heaven?

Psalm 99:9, KJV For the Lord our God is holy.

She got a lot of pretty, pretty boys she calls friends

There's a constant taunt from Satan, "Your Christians are sissies and they're not even your friends! You haven't got a friend in the world!" And it's true, on both counts, though twisted. There are a lot *boys* who belong to the Lord's Family who are "pretty pretty" as in super cowardly due to their lack of humility (Matt. 15:16 & Mark 6:52 below) and love of self

(Phil. 2:21 below). And it's not just boys/men but women as well. And it's not just Christian so-called leaders. Nearly all who've responded have done so in a very cowardly manner. For example, so called pastors never address you head on. Instead, they incorporate what they're saying to you in their sermon. It's super passive aggressive. Since they don't address you directly it's not as if you can dialogue with them or defend yourself. They just stand up there on their pedestal and squash you like a bug. Then if you do approach them again they weasel out of their responsibility by twisting Scripture and/or twisting your words, or send their cronies to squash you. You can't win since Christians are their idolaters. It's pretty much like this graphic someone made.



Matthew 15:16, KJV Jesus said, Are ye also yet without understanding?

Mark 6:52, NIV They [haven't] understood [because] their hearts were hardened.

Philippians 2:21, KJV For all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's.

However, as God's boys, God's children, His elect, they *are* my friends since they're Jesus' friends even though they don't currently act like it (John 15:15 below), people for whom God has had me praying (Matt. 5:44-45 below).

John 15:15, KJV I have called you friends.

Matthew 5:44-45, KJV I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

And because they're Friends, having become "born again" (John 3:7, KJV)—those who have—there are no *better looking* boys around, therefore, "pretty pretty." Lacking faith and humility, they're pretty cowardly. But as born again, they're pretty good looking. They're *pretty pretty boys*.

And since these 'boys' are God's *queens* (Isa. 54:5 below)—again speaking of the born again—they're *pretty* boys, because God is *not* politically correct. Rather, He *is* Correct (Rom. 1:27-28 below). And He's pretty funny—pretty pretty funny—as He's revealed through the ministry He's given me, especially through some of the biblical interpretations.

Isaiah 54:5, KJV For thy Maker is thine husband.

Romans 1:27-28, NIV In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed shameful acts with other men, and received in themselves the due penalty for their error. Furthermore, just as they did not think it worthwhile to retain the knowledge of God, so God gave them over to a depraved mind, so that they do what ought not to be done.

And, again, they're not just *boys*. In the same way that the word *guys* is used for male and female, the word *boys* refers to the body of Christ—males and females of all ages for whom He's had me praying and reaching out to for over two decades having said "Do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith" (Gal. 6:10, KJV). So while "Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: [the Lord has] prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren (Luke 22:31-32, KJV). Therefore, "for this cause [I] also, since the day [I] heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding: That ye might walk worthy of the Lord" (Col. 1:9-10, KJV).

And while I *don't* have **any** friends since "lover and friend hast [Satan] put far from me" (Ps. 88:18, KJV)—except for Jesus who has "called [me] friend" (John 15:15, KJV)—by faith, my Friendship Basket is overflowing since it's not about this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) but the "coming ages" (Eph. 2:7, NIV) and "He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. He also says "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over...For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again" (Luke 6:38, KJV).

How they dance in the courtyard, sweet summer sweat

Born again Christians have been partying *in* the "courtyard." While they've clearly been doing that in the buildings supposedly representing His house, all those so-called churches with pagan activities, but in their own bodies. "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?" (1 Cor. 3:16, KJV). Therefore, they'll soon be sweating from the Heat since "our God is a consuming fire" (Heb. 12:29, KJV). They'll be doing a *new* dance. God says "Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up" (James 4:9-10, KJV).

And the ones sweating the most will be the currently apostate born again in institutional church leadership, which is why He gave the following warning, "Be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation" (James 3:1, KJV).

But since all who profess to know Christ have taken on His name (Ex. 20:7 & Ps. 50:16-23 below), and those who reject Him do know the truth (Rom. 1:20 below)—*everyone* should be sweating bullets!

Exodus 20:7, KJV Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Psalm 50:16-23, KJV Unto the wicked God saith, What hast thou to do to declare my statutes, or that thou shouldest take my covenant in thy mouth? Seeing thou hatest instruction, and casteth my words behind thee...These things hast thou done, and I kept silence; thou thoughtest that I was altogether such an one as thyself: but I will reprove thee, and set them in order before thine eyes. Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver. Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God.

Romans 1:20, KJV The invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse.

It's "sweet" since it's a dance of repentance (Ps. 51 below) which takes place in the temple courtyard of the born again's own heart (Heb. 4:12 & 1 Cor. 6:19-20 below).

Psalm 51, KJV Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight...Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence...Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee... Then shalt thou be pleased.

Hebrews 4:12, KJV For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20, KJV Ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Some dance to remember

The Lord's Girl/the Brat will be trying to remember all the people and events He used to draw them back and they refused to listen (Jer. 5:3; Ps. 139:23-24 & Gen. 41:9 below) feeling guilty and scared for what they've done (Isaiah 6:5 below).

Jeremiah 5:3, KJV [I have] stricken them, but they have not grieved...they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.

Psalm 139:23-24, KJV Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Genesis 41:9, KJV I do remember my faults this day.

Isaiah 6:5, KJV Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips.

It's a prayer 'dance' since God answers sincere requests (John 14:26; Matt. 7:7; James 5:16 below).

John 14:26, KJV The Comforter, which is the Holy [Spirit], whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Matthew 7:7, KJV Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

James 5:16, NIV The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

Some dance to forget

The BRAT will also dance to forget because She'll feel so convicted finally realizing how cold-hearted and unfaithful She's been, echoing Paul's words "O wretched man that I am!" (Rom. 7:24, KJV). And as a spiritual worship dance, it's done standing over 'hot coals' (Heb. 12:29; Matt. 25:40; Isa. 6:6-7 below), and that 'burning flesh' is a pleasing aroma to the Lord because He "ha[s] no greater joy than to hear that [His] children walk in truth" (3 John 1:4, KJV).

Hebrews 12:29, KJV For our God is a consuming fire.

Matthew 25:40, KJV Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me.

Isaiah 6:6-7, KJV Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

So I called up the Captain

The Captain is Jesus, God's Christ, "captain of [ou]r salvation" (Heb. 2:10, KJV).

"Please bring me my wine"

This refers to the wine of communion (Mark 14:23 below), the blood of Christ (Mark 14:24 below).

Mark 14:23, KJV He took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them: and they all drank of it.

Mark 14:24, NIV This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many.

He said, "We haven't had that spirit here since nineteen sixty nine"

Hearing the Lord say that the Spirit hasn't been poured out since 1969, I was confused since many of us were born again after that, contrary to what the false prophet Harold Camping preached. Asking Him about it since Scripture says "The Holy Spirit will teach you" (Luke 12:12, NIV), He informed me that the Satanic Bible was written in the US in 1969. Also, alcoholic drinks are referred to as spirits because they open the door for those demons. Therefore, publishing the satanic Bible would do it all the more. So it's like God is using Satan to mock us as if he's saying "We haven't had *that* Spirit—the Spirit of the Lord—here since nineteen sixty nine" when the satanic Bible was published. And by not *taking our thoughts captive to Christ* (2 Cor. 10:5), we've allowed demonic spirits to **overrun** the land. We're also guilty on *many* counts because American history, court houses, and currency—among other things—firmly testify to God's hand over this nation. It's *obvious*, even with all the masonic lies.

On top of that, we are also guilty because God has had members of the body calling for repentance for years, including Martin Lloyd-Jones (scholar of church history) who preached at a conference for church leaders in 1969 about how guilty we were due to Christian denominational divisions (*The Puritans: Their Origins and Successors*, *p.219*, *Can We Learn from History?*)—a teaching that pretty much went in one ear and out the other of the body of Christ, the Lord's Girl, the BRAT.



If the body of Christ had actually obeyed the Lord, we would have experienced "on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10, NIV). Instead we're getting—and *have* been getting—on earth as it would be in hell if that were a real place.

While many are struggling today trying to figure out exactly what we're supposed to be doing, the body of Christ will *learn* to celebrate the Lord's Supper correctly, which was modeled for us by the Mayflower Pilgrims who worshipped Him in "spirit and in truth" (John 4:24, KJV)—initially. Better than our generation, anyhow. God says:

Whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep [many have died]. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world (1 Cor. 11:27-32, KJV).



Fake Communion

And still those voices are calling from far away

Having sinned so greatly against God, He is nevertheless drawing us back through *all* of those who've gone before us, as He's doing with this very secular song and other resources He's had hidden in plain sight (Ps. 89:30-33 & 2 Tim. 2:13 below). He's literally using everything and everyone since all things were created by him, and for him (Col. 1:16, KJV) and there's nothing more important to Him than His Church, His Girl, that She become "holy and without blemish" (Eph. 5:27, KJV).

Psalm 89:30-33, KJV If [My] children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments; If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments. Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail.

2 Timothy 2:13, KJV If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

Wake you up in the middle of the night

The more contrite your heart, the clearer you hear the voices down *the corridor* (of time) so that they wake you up in the middle of the night (Ps. 16:7; Matt. 2:19-20; Acts 16:9 below).

Psalm 16:7, NIV I will praise the LORD, who counsels me; even at night my heart instructs me.

Matthew 2:19-20, KJV An angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel.

Acts 16:9, KJV A vision appeared...saying, Come over...and help us.

Just to hear them say...Welcome to the Hotel California

God, through all of His servants, repeatedly reassures us—those who'll finally take Him seriously—of a *WELCOME!* (Matt. 11:28-30; Ps. 103:8-10 & 1 John 1:9 below).

Matthew 11:28-30, KJV Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Psalm 103:8-10, KJV The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever. He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.

1 John 1:9, KJV If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Such a lovely place (Such a lovely place)

God's *hotel* is a lovely place since it's all about love since "God is love" (1 John 4:8), joy (Ps. 67:4 below), peace (John 14:27 below), understanding the meaning of life (Ps. 111:10 below), power over evil (1 John 4:4 below), and life in Paradise (John 17:3 below).

Psalm 67:4, KJV O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth.

John 14:27, KJV My peace I give unto you.

Psalm 111:10, KJV A good understanding have all they that do his commandments.

1 John 4:4, KJV Greater is he that is in you [born again], than he that is in the world.

John 17:3, YLT This is the life age-during, that they may know Thee, the only true God, and him whom Thou didst send—Jesus Christ.

Again, He gives us a double promise about it, repeated twice in the song (and in many times in this ministry) stressing the point. "Doubled...twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV).

Such a lovely face

The better you know Jesus, the more attractive He gets (Ps. 50:2). The Man is hot! (Heb. 12:29).

Psalm 50:2, KJV Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined.

Hebrews 12:29, KJV Our God is a consuming fire.

They livin' it up at the Hotel California

The born again are full of joy in the Lord at His *hotel* because our Tour of Duty is nearly over. No more infighting over unbiblical nothings or hurting one another (James 3:13-17 below). And then, no more fighting or hurting at all! (Rev. 21:4 below).

James 3:13-17, KJV Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

Revelation 21:4, KJV God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

While many think *there's no hope* since Christians have "ma[de] the word of God of none effect" (Mark 7:13, KJV) with our hypocrisy, thereby making the world a horrendous place in which to live, God is turning it around for those who take Him seriously. He let us see what we/Christians could do without Him and now He'll be showing us what we can do with Him (Rom. 9:22-23, James 4:7 & Rev. 11:3 below).

Romans 9:22-23, KV God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction...[so] that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory.

James 4:7, KJV Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Revelation 11:3, KJV I will give power unto my two witnesses [born again Jews and Gentiles].


And because He's talking about the latter rain, they're living it up at Hotel California since the first rain was given to us moderately in comparison and *that* was totally amazing, summed up with the graphic. God says "Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV).

The First Christians were Highly Empowered by God because they Obeyed Him as Individuals and as a Group

- They spoke in languages they hadn't studied (Acts 2:4-6);
- They healed the sick (Acts 3:2-7);
- They raised the dead (Acts 9:37-41);
- They drove out demons (Acts 16:16-18);
- They witnessed boldly (Acts 4:4);
- They prayed for their attackers as they killed them (Acts 7:58-60);
- They enlightened thousands at a time (Acts 7:58-60);
- Their shadows provided healing (Acts 5:14-16);
- Unbelievers admired them (Acts 2:47);
- They beamed around like in Star Trek (Acts 8:39-40);
- They were full of wisdom (Acts 6:3);
- They were full of generosity (Acts 4:34-35); and,
- They were full of joy (Acts 2:46).

What a nice surprise (What a nice surprise)

This revelation is quite the "nice surprise." Stunning Good News! (Ruth 4:14 below). So good it's repeatedly repeated, again and again throughout this ministry (Gen. 41:32 below). The best part about it is that hell is not real. No one is going to hell. I walk through it most thoroughly in God's Plan. So while it will be like this graphic when it's all been said and done, there are very serious consequences for rejecting Christ and/or living unrighteously, consequences both in this life and in the next. For one thing God says "There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Matt. 8:12, KJV). But it's not going to last forever.



Ruth 4:14, KJV Blessed be the LORD, which hath not left thee this day without a kinsman, that his name may be famous in Israel.

Genesis 41:32, KJV Doubled...twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.

Bring your alibis

While people have many 'alibis' for why they deserve to go to heaven, there's only *one* that's acceptable: *Jesus paid the price for my sin* "for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12, KJV). All the others fall miserably short.

Neither are there any good works that will make you right with God since we can only be "saved through faith...Not of works, lest any man should boast" (Eph. 2:8-9, KJV). The works a born again Christian does are done in obedience to God out of love, for which we'll receive rewards (2 John 1:8 below), but they do not earn us life for the ages. Neither do we do them because of the rewards. Works of faith (Col. 2:23 & Rom. 14:23 below), however, do earn us a closer relationship with God, which is an amazingly great reward! (Gen. 15:1 below).

2 John 1:8, KJV Look to yourselves [born again saints], that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

Colossians 3:23, NIV Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.

Romans 14:23, KJV Whatsoever is not of faith is sin.

Genesis 15:1, KJV I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

If you belong to Christ and are born again (John 3:3 below), you *will* have proof, an *alibi*, because "faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead" (James 2:17, NIV). Your entire way of life will testify to the truth like Stephen who the whole congregation knew to be "a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 6:5, NIV). It's like this graphic the Lord showed me when I became born again, though I tweaked it into a flower. Everything you do will have Christ at the center of it so that it is obvious to others that you belong to Him.

John 3:3, KJV Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

So, as far as this "present evil age" (gal. 1:4, YLT) is concerned, Satan *ain't got no alibi* since he's so ugly inside (Rev. 12:9 below), though his looks are sometimes deceiving (1 Cor. 11:14 below).

Revelation 12:9, KJV The great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceive the whole world.

1 Corinthians 11:14, KJV For Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.





Mirrors on the ceiling

The mirrors are over each of us like that cloud over Eeyore's head. *Everywhere* we go, He is there (Ps. 139 below). Except unlike Eeyore's cloud it's a *good* thing! The mirrors are *on the ceiling* because "our God is in the heavens" (Ps. 115:3 KJV). And it's a good thing because "he leadeth [us] in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake" (Ps. 23:3, KJV) and also for our own good "for the wages of the sin [is] death, and the gift of God [is] life age-during in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Rom. 6:23, YLT).

Psalm 139: 1-8, NIV You have searched me, LORD, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you, LORD, know it completely. You hem me in (H) behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed (M) in the depths, you are there.



When a decent number of born again souls wake up to themselves and repent, the Bride's fruitless deeds of darkness will be brought to light publicly so that the rest of the elect will realize there's a two-way mirror on every ceiling being that "thy Father [in heaven]...seeth in secret" (Matt. 6:4, KJV). Therefore, many of them will begin taking God seriously as with the following passage:

Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed (James 1:21-25, KJV)..

There are mirrors plural because there are many people. However, only the born again who take God seriously—acknowledging that I'm speaking on His behalf (Matt. 23:39 below)—will understand that they're there and how they work (Dan. 12:10 below).

Matthew 23:39, KJV [Jesus said] Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.


Daniel 12:10, KJV Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.

The mirrors are two-way mirrors (like law enforcement have in an interrogation room) because Jesus *is* The Law and He can see everything we do but we can't see Him. He says:

Understand, ye brutish among the people: and ye fools, when will ye be wise? He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see? He that chastiseth the heathen, shall not he correct? he that teacheth man knowledge, shall not he know? The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity (Ps. 94:8-11, KJV).



These are mirrors on one side so that we can see ourselves clearly. "The word...is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass" (James 1:23, KJV). The Bible is the glass, the mirror, because "the word of God is...a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb. 4:12, KJV). And the standard by which we are being judged is God's standard. He says "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect" (Matt. 5:48, KJV). It's like the glass in a telescope or The Christmas Carol concerning the Scrooge and the Ghost of Christmas Yet to Come. Using God's mirror, the Word, to look into the future—since it's prophetic being that "the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy"(Rev. 19:10, KJV)—we compare how we should be versus how we actually are and need to be (1 Pet. 2:5 below). Doing that we can make changes now to improve our future not only in this life but for the ages to come (1 Cor. 3:11-15 below).



Revelation 19:10, KJV 1 Peter 2:5, KJV You [who take God seriously), like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

- 1 Peter 2:5, KJV Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 3:11-15, KJV For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

So while it sometimes seems like we can't possibly measure up, like I've been feeling lately having again fallen off the health wagon, we "can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth [us]" (Phil. 2:13, KJV). Even though we fall, in Christ, all we have to do is get back up just like little children learning to walk. And He says "Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein" (Mark 10:15, KJV).

The mirrors are also there so that we don't take revenge on others since we *know* that God sees what they've done and *will* avenge us. He says "Avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord" (Rom. 12:19, KJV).

The pink champagne on ice

This, again, is a reference to the blood of Christ and cup of communion since we've been told the following:

He took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins (Matt. 26:27-28, NIV).

And Jesus said "I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom" (Matt. 26:29, KJV). He's now got it ready and waiting for us (Rev. 19:9 below)—ON ICE! (Rev. 3:11; 22:7; 22:12; 22:20 below).

Revelation 19:9, KJV He saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.

Revelation 3:11, KJV Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

Revelation 22:7, KJV Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

Revelation 22:12, KJV Behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work.

Revelation 22:20, KJV Surely I come quickly.

To put something 'on ice' means to postpone it. In other words, God is being merciful by postponing His coming and giving us one more chance to get right with Him (Joel 2:13, KJV). However, He's obviously telling us He's on His way (Matt. 25:1-13, KJV).

Joel 2:13, KJV Rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

Matthew 25:1-13, KJV Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut. Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not. Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.

And to put *someone* 'on ice' means to leave them out in the cold since they acted up in some way. God is doing that to many professing Christians, especially in harlot church leadership. They're getting His cold shoulder since that's what they gave Him and His servants and "God is not mocked" (Gal. 6:7, KJV). They're getting left out in the cold (1 Cor. 11:29 below)—because they *didn't* love the truth, love Jesus (John 14:6 below) as they claimed (2 Thess. 2:10-11 below).

1 Corinthians 11:29, KJV For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself.

John 14:6, KJV Jesus saith...I am...the truth.

2 Thessalonians 2:10-11, KJV Because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved...for this cause God shall send them [a] strong delusion, that they should believe a lie.

And she said "We are all just prisoners here, of our own device"

When the Lord opened up this song to me, my family and I had been prisoners in our cells without walls and open doors for over a decade because of our faith in Christ (Heb. 11:1 below), love (John 14:21 below), and obedience (Eph. 5:11 below). However, I'm now the only one still a prisoner here. But the girls were great 'prisoners of their own device' while growing up, before college—that cesspool of sin we *pay* for and which *empowers* God's children to run after Satan.

Hebrews 11:1, KJV Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

John 14:21, KJV He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me.

Ephesians 5:11, NIV Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them.

In any case, all born again who want to make certain that they're in the Lord's *hotel* will repent of their hardness of heart, apathy, and unbiblicalities, becoming 'prisoners of their own device.' They'll finally choose to make all the necessary hard choices to honor Christ (Rom. 12:1-2 & 2 Tim. 1:8 below).

Romans 12:1-2, KJV I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

2 Timothy 1:8, KJV Do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God.

And in the master's chambers

Jesus is the Master since Scripture says "One is your Master, even Christ" (Matt. 23:10, KJV). And His chamber is wherever I am because the temple of God is within me being that He says to the born again "Your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you" (1 Cor. 6:19, NIV). And since there are many elect who will become born again or otherwise get right with Him, there are *many* Master's chambers, which is what Jesus said "In my Father's house are many mansions" (John 14:2, KJV). The Master is wherever the born again soul is because the temple of God is within individuals not so-called church buildings. Scripture says the following:

True worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth (John 4:23-24, KJV).

We have known that if our earthly house of the tabernacle may be thrown down, a building from God we have, an house not made with hands—age-during—in the heavens (2 Cor. 5:1, YLT).

They gathered for the feast

The more sincere born again will be feasting on God—the Bread of Life—in the days of Hotel California (Ps. 34:8 & John 6:55 below), as we finally *let* Him gather us together (Matt. 23:37 below) in preparation for the Marriage Supper, the feast (Rev. 19:9 below), no longer having "fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprov[ing] them (Eph. 5:11, KJV). We'll finally allow the Father to answer Jesus' prayer of 2000 years ago, "That all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John 17:21, NIV). However, as I walk through in *God's Plan*, only a remnant within the body of Christ will *fully* honor Him.

Psalm 34:8, KJV O taste and see that the LORD is good.

John 6:55, KJV For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

Matthew 23:37, KJV How often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!

Revelation 19:9, KJV Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.

They stab it with their steely knives

Feasting in *Hotel California*—the true Church—the Church without walls or anything fake since "every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation" (Luke 11:17 below), the more sincere born again *correctly* use "the sword of the Spirit...the word of God" (Eph. 6:17, KJV), their steely knife, to fight this war "for we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against...spiritual wickedness in high places" (Eph. 6:12, KJV). And "the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb. 4:12, KJV).

And the beast they're stabbing is our own wicked nature (Ps. 73:22 & Col 3:5, NIV below) along with all the garbage Satan and his entourage try to pass off as good (Rev. 13:1 & 18:23 below).

Psalm 73:22, KJV So foolish was I, and ignorant: I was as a beast before thee.

Colossians 3:5, NIV Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.

Revelation 13:1, KJV I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

Revelation 18:23, KJV For by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.

According to God Satan can do nothing in the body of Christ unless we help him since God says "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7, KJV). Therefore, his sorceries are actually our sorceries. If the born again were to submit to God there would be no beast *to* stab within "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV). But that's *not* how it is today. The body of Christ is *overrun* with this parasite!

But they just can't kill the beast

Ultimately, only God can kill the beast on both counts, our "desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) nature, and Satan, aka the "beast" (Rev. 11:7, KJV). Scripture says the following:

I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. For in my inner being I delight in God's law; but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord! (Rom. 7:21-25, NIV).

Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee (Jude 1:9, KJV).

The Devil, who is leading them astray, was cast [by God] into the lake of fire and brimstone (Rev. 20:10, YLT).

The born again have been given the job of *stabbing the beast*—both "forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV) as well as within our own nature. We do this with "the sword of the sprit which is the word of God" (Eph. 6:17, KJV)—repeatedly and relentlessly—to get him off our backs as Jesus modeled for us (Luke 4:13 below) and to keep him off (James 4:7 below).

Luke 4:13, KJV When the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season [departing because Jesus had repeatedly stabbed him with the Word of God. It's like they had a fencing match].

James 4:7, KJV Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.



For most of Christian history the body of Christ has been fighting the beast (Satan and his servants) with real weapons rather than getting right with God and fighting this thing the right way, spiritually. By fighting physically it's like we're playing the Game by Satan's rules, helping him, rather than by Jesus' rules, and *not* helping Him. We've been fighting *against* Him while professing to love Him!

Last thing I remember, I was running for the door

Everyone's first reaction is to want to run like "Moses [who] said, I exceedingly fear and quake" (Heb. 12:21, KJV), as I wanted to do on Labor Day weekend when He lassoed me by the neck and tied me up in knots on our camping trip in 2009, detailed below. That's when He first called me to actually write a book which He's used to make this series. It had made me feel like He was a cowboy and I was the calf He was branding, like this passage, with a twist:

Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a [wo]man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts. Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: And he laid it upon my [tuchus], and said, Lo...thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged (Isa. 6:5-7, KJV).

It's like the born again get 'branded' by the Lord because "the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his (2 Tim. 2:19, KJV).

Our Labor Day Camping Trip: In 2009 on Labor Day weekend, out camping, I had a dream which turned out to be God calling me to write the book from which He's developed this ministry. And my first reaction had been to want to run for the hills!

In the dream I was with a tall woman and we were walking down the center aisle of the familiar blue carpet and chairs from Eagle church in Indianapolis, my first and only "home" church. We were surrounded by blue skies and wispy clouds so that it was like the view out the window of an airplane, representing the Church without walls which spans the last 2000 years until the "last trump" (1 Cor. 15:52, KJV). In my dream this woman and I were in the real Church. We were walking very briskly down the center aisle. I was trying to keep up with her while filling her in on something as she listened intently. Both of us were intense. But she was revving up whereas I was running out of steam, gasping for air. I was also afraid of something and thought she was mad at me, but she wasn't—but she was mad. She kept grumbling as I filled her in, and she held something in her hand. She was on a mission like a mom who's about to knock some sense into that crazy kid of hers. Headed straight down the aisle towards the "altar." [And Jesus is the altar since the New Testament says "We have an altar from which those who minister at the tabernacle have no right to eat" (Heb. 13:10, NIV).] Anyhow, this woman knew exactly what she had to do. I just kept filling her in. And every time I remembered something else she'd get more fired up. Gasping for breath, I stopped short having noticed a guy prostrated at the sanctuary steps pleading to God about something. Steve?

I woke up.

I eventually (years later) realized that both the woman and the man represent the soon to be Bride of Christ, the born again. Having gotten enlightened by what she held in her hand, this ministry, She was praying both for forgiveness and for others, and very focused on Her mission, the Great Commission. Jesus, the One She was determined to reach, says "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you" (Matt. 28:19-20, NIV).

Thinking about the dream, it had grabbed me by the heart and lassoed me by the throat. It slammed me down like a cowboy does a calf tying me up in knots! All wound up like that, the RV I was in felt *really* small. Stepping out for air, I built a fire, made my coffee, and asked my Shepherd about it reading where I'd left off in my Bible. I was digging my heels in fighting against it—like any calf would. Yet, at the same time, I *wanted* to surrender to what it might mean. That I'd get my rump burned? *No!* But...*yeah*, that it might be from God. Because, three other dreams I'd had were suddenly up in my face for which God had given me full confirmation *were* from Him since "the Holy [Spirit]...bring[s] all things to...our remembrance" (John 14:26, KJV). I'd been afraid of something and God does burn us like cattle. It's "his seal of ownership on us...his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come" (2 Cor. 1:22, NIV). Besides, following Jesus *always* means getting burned since "all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (2 Tim. 3:12, KJV). That dream pretty much signaled the beginning of the hardest part to

date of my life—increasing isolation to the point that I've had no one to even talk beyond chit chat for the past decade. Because, if you're going to serve the Lord during the peak of great apostasy, as we're in today, there *is* no one with whom to have fellowship. Especially if He's using you like He's using me!

Still, I had to have God's Word to go with the dream—ongoing confirmation—since that's the only way to stay on the way. As He says "Thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left" (Isa. 30:21, KJV). You can't do like most Christians do today and assume every dream you feel is actually from God. So as God would have it, in almost all my Bible intake for the next few days He was speaking to people through dreams (see Gen. 20, 28, 31 &. 37). And because God had had many prophesy to me that I was being used like Joseph from the Old Testament, which I'd already been walking in for nearly a decade by then, I surrendered and let Him burn my butt. But unlike cattle, I've been getting a very long slow burn. And it's hurt—does hurt.

Connecting all the dots, this dream was God calling me to write the initial book, *Wake Up!* which He's had me break down and rebuild over and over again over the past decade, now appearing as a series of books. While there were 61 at one point, many of them were just for me, like rough drafts for my mind as He was teaching me more.

Since Jesus is the Door (John 10:9 below), the more humble born again will finally start running to Him, running for the Door as they say in the song (1 Cor. 9:24 below).

John 10:9, KJV I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

1 Corinthians 9:24, KJV Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.



I had to find the passage back to the place I was before

At first, most would rather go back to the way things were just like they grumbled at Moses in the wilderness saying "Because there were no graves in Egypt, hast thou taken us away to die in the wilderness?" (Ex. 14:11, KJV). We grumbling against the Lord because His branding iron is so hot (Matt. 3:11 below) and we *all* like playing it safe which means going along with the crowd, just as they did 2000 years ago (John 7:13, 9:20-22, 18:25-27; Matt. 26:56 below). Except the crowd is headed for destruction (Matt. 7:13-14 below).

Matthew 3:11, KJV He shall baptize you with...fire.

John 7:13, KJV Howbeit no man spake openly of him for fear of the Jews.

John 9:20-22, KJV His parents answered them and said, We know that this is our son, and that he was born blind. But by what means he now seeth, we know not...These words spake his parents, because they feared the Jews.

John 18:25-27, KJV Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also one of his disciples? He denied it, and said, I am not. One of the servants of the high priest, being his kinsman whose ear Peter cut off, saith, Did not I see thee in the garden with him? Peter then denied again: and immediately the cock crew.

Matthew 26:56, KJV All the disciples for sook him, and fled.

Matthew 7:13-14, KJV Broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

However, since He stamps an 'R' on our rump for *Royalty* (Rom. 8:17 below), getting burned for Christ is a *good* thing (Matt. 22:14 below).

Romans 8:17, KJV If children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

Matthew 22:14, KJV Many are called, but few are chosen.

But the *R* also stands for Rat (Jer. 17:9 & Rom. 3:10 below). As revealed through my testimony, the body of Christ today is made up of rats, a point God confirmed with the biblical interpretation He gave me for the movie *Ratatouille* (2007), rats who need to get clean before they can learn to cook and feed the people, as summed up with the graphic.

Jeremiah 17:9, KJV The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked.

Romans 3:10, KJV As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one.

Matthew 11:29, KJV Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.



"Relax," said the night man, "We are programmed to receive."

The *R* also stand for Rest and Relaxation. "The angel sa[ys] unto [us], Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people" (Luke 2:10, KJV). He's saying *Chill out*. And there are many angelic friends. "The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the holy place" (Ps. 68:17, KJV). They're *programmed* by God to welcome us. "Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?" (Heb. 1:14, KJV). And Jesus says "I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you" (John 15:15, KJV).

You can check-out any time you like, But you can never leave!

The born again can go prodigal if they want to, as just about everyone has since "all seek their own, not the things which are Jesus Christ's" (Phil. 2:21, KJV). Still, none of the born again are EVER separated from His love because of what Jesus did on the Cross (Rom. 8:35-39 below). Hallelujah!

Romans 8:35-39, KJV Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The Very Long Ending

It's a long ending because God is being merciful to us. "The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with [us], not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance" (2 Pet. 3:9, KJV). However, according to Scripture only the elect have the ability to repent during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT), a point I cover in *Election: One of the Biggest Blinders*.

The Repetition

Several verses in the song are repeated whereby God is saying these sayings are trustworthy and true "doubled...twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV):

- You are being welcomed—repeated twice.
- His face, God's presence, is beautiful—repeated twice.
- You can find all you need in Him, any time—repeated twice.
- This prophecy is a wonderful surprise—repeated twice.
- Church as it was meant to be, and will be, is a wonderful place—repeated four times.

May the Lord our God give you eyes that see and ears that hear everything He's saying to our generation.
