God's View of His Bride is NOT OK

The 'official' version is the funny one, the one to watch. Maybe you'll *get* it (Luke 10:23 below). The Lord is *seriously* mocking "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV). "He who is sitting in the heavens doth laugh, The Lord doth mock at them" (Ps. 2:4, YLT). You should definitely watch the video before tuning in to my interpretation of it. OK Go - Needing/Getting - Official Video - YouTube.

Luke 10:23, KJV Blessed are the eyes which see.

What God is doing through these biblical interpretations is teaching His people how to *walk in the Spirit* because when we "walk in the Spirit...[w]e shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh" (Gal. 5:16, KJV)—and, therefore, not get deceived (as much). We don't because having experienced how much fun the Lord is, we no longer look for 'fun' in the things of the flesh, of the world, Satan's world (John 12:31 & 2 Cor. 4:4 below). It's also easier to press on with our calling and go against the grain when we can clearly see God's hand in the world around us since "all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (2 Tim. 3:12, KJV). Rather than listen to the many people around, including professing Christians, we need to *listen* to the Spirit and *walk* in the Spirit. Jesus says "I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life" (John 8:12, KJV).

John 12:31, YLT Now shall the ruler of this world be cast forth.

2 Corinthians 4:4, KJV The god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

So here's my interpretation of this song by OK Go.

I've been waiting for months, waiting for years, waiting for you to change.

God says the following:

Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending them: Yet [you] hearkened not unto me, nor inclined [you]r ear, but hardened [you]r neck: [you] did worse than [you]r fathers (Jer. 7:25-26, KJV).

[You] have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught [you], rising up early and teaching [you], yet [you] have not hearkened to receive instruction (Jer. 32:33, KJV).

While many of His elect did pay attention to Him when He walked the earth and for a while thereafter so that they became born again, they soon fell away as Paul noted when he said "Some are already turned aside after Satan" (1 Tim. 5:15, KJV)—a move which has been snowballing ever since, summed up with the timeline. In turn, all who've become born again during the last hundred years became born again into a *very* apostate version of Christianity and, therefore, have believed a load of lies about the world, about God, about Christianity, and about what God has actually done through Christ's work on the Cross. And because they know the truth that Jesus is God, they're extremely proud spiritually, as my testimony reveals. Today's "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 1:27, KJV) has "a form of godliness, but den[ies] the power thereof" (2 Tim. 3:5, KJV).

The Great Apostasy!

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Since God "worketh all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV), in this secular song God, through His Spirit, is singing about His Girl, His soon to be Bride, His Church, the BRAT (Isa. 54:5, Jer. 3:14, 2 Cor. 11:2 below).


Jeremiah 3:14, KJV Turn, O backsliding children, saith the Lord; for I am married unto you.

Aw, but there ain't much that's dumber, there ain't much that's dumber than pinning your hopes on a change in another

Today's Christians seem to think God is so dumb that He would actually pin His hopes on a bunch of sinners. That's what they're doing by denying the doctrine of election summed up in the graphic and covered in the book *Election: One of the Biggest Blinders*. But God's not an idiot. He's a genius! He says "You thought I was exactly like you [an idiot]. But I now arraign you and set my accusations before you" (Ps. 50:21, NIV). Through this ministry God is setting His accusations before His Church, the body of Christ, the born again.



Most Christians seem to think elect means the same thing as born again. Except if that were true the following statement by Paul makes absolutely no sense. He said "I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ" (2 Tim. 2:10, KJV). Unlike the born again, the elect have to obtain salvation.

And since you probably got offended in my calling you an idiot, what I'm doing in using that terminology is following the Spirit's leading. In the book *For Such a Time as This: A Revelation* I walk you through something God walked me through revealing that we (the born again) *are* idiots. It should be *obvious* considering the state of the Church and world today because of what He said, "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7, KJV). Had we been smarter than the idiots that we've been, the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) would have submitted to the Lord, resisted the devil, and he would have had to flee. Instead, the body of Christ is overrun with demonic activity today! There are TONS of people exposing it online. And all you need to do is read the New Testament and take one look at professing Christianity to see that this is absolutely true without a doubt.

And I, yeah I still need you, but what good's that gonna do? Needing is one thing, and getting getting's another.


While we're in rebellion—and have been in rebellion for most of Christian history— Jesus still needs those of us who are filled with His Spirit (the born again), because that's how He has purposed to reach the lost as we read in the following passage, for example:

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher [preaching the truth]? (Rom. 10:14, KJV).

There's a massive group of people Jesus calls His "lost sheep" (Matt. 15:24, KJV), both among the nations and the house of Israel, a group you can visualize with my pie charts. While these charts aren't based on statistics, since there are none, they are based on common sense and, more importantly, the Spirit's leading and teaching.

So while many *have* heard about Jesus, they don't believe that Jesus is God's Christ because of Christian hypocrisy, apostasy. The body of Christ has done the same thing the Jews did so that He continues to say, but is now saying it to us, "The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you" (Rom. 2:24, KJV). We're the problem!

I walk through these pie charts in the book *Growing Pains*.



So I been sitting around, wasting my time, wondering what you've been doing.

Aw, and it ain't real forgiving, it ain't real forgiving sitting here picturing someone else living.

This was Jesus letting me know He *knows* how I feel having followed Him against the grain not only of the lost but of professing Christians for more than two decades, taking the heat from both groups summed up with the graphic.




It's like born again Christians have kept Jesus bound and gagged for most of Christian history—**not** letting Him carry out His will for making themselves more important than Him, loving *themselves* more than Him or His people, the lost elect. It's like we've bound and gagged Him while professing to love Him, something He's confirmed through the biblical interpretation of the movie *Ratatouille* and also *Avatar*, SUPER hypocritical! Because, what we do to Jesus' servants we do to Him. He clearly says "Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me [and]...Whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me" (Matt. 25:40 &45, NIV). And as revealed by my testimony, summed up on my *Welcome!* video, this is exactly what the body of Christ has done to me. Welcome! A Word for the Church - YouTube.



So while I know I haven't been "wasting my time," it does *feel* like it since I've kept at it for years on end and not one soul has been able to see the *obvious*. It's as God informed me in the late 1990s. This ministry is for His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV). Because of our rebellion—our extreme hypocrisy—God has been holding most of our hypocritical beams/those blinders in place—speaking of the born again—so that you all haven't even been able to tell that I'm actually born again! These words echo exactly what a former pastor wrote to me, who I discern is born again though obviously blinded by beams since he wrote in his book *A Church Beyond Imagination* (in the FAQ section) that only apostles are responsible for the Great Commission in which Jesus said "make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you" (Matt. 28:19-20, NIV). If that were true, then it *would* be OK for the rest of the body of Christ to kick back, but that's clearly not what the New Testament teaches! And if you can't tell that I'm a true prophet, you can't tell that I'm actually born again—when it couldn't be more obvious! It's God's judgment (1 Pet. 4:17 below). He's keeping those with more Bible knowledge, who have God's Spirit within, and who are the most connected with believers, *blind* to the obvious.

1 Peter 4:17, NIV For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?



While Jesus says "Hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly" (Matt. 7:5, KJV), He also says the following:

This people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and **they have closed their eyes**. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them (Matt. 13:15, KJV, my emphasis).

Throughout the Bible we see the same theme play out. God's people harden their hearts to Him so that He then *helps* them stick to that plan. In other words, because we refuse to repent God *helps* us along our path of self destruction—until we learn our lesson. It's what Paul said "Hand this man over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved on the day of the Lord" (1 Cor. 5:5, NIV).

And the part of the song where it says "it ain't real forgiving" ties in to what I've struggled with for these two decades because standing between God and man gets pretty frustrating. It's the reason Moses blew his top so that God didn't let him enter into the Promised Land:

The LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him. And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock? And Moses lifted


up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also. And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them (Num. 20:7-12, KJV).

By *helping* me have a sense of humor about it all, God has enabled me to *be* forgiving since you guys (born again Christians) *obviously* don't know what you're doing! Especially since I do sit here and picture *everyone* else living while I toil away by myself—while all hell breaks loose around the world! It's not only depresing, it's maddening! And I don't just *picture them*, I *see* them living. The rest of my family just went off to spend the weekend with my husband's relatives, for instance.

Yet I know they're not *really* living—having rejected Jesus. Also because it's as God says, "Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold" (Matt. 24:12, NIV). The love of most *has* grown cold. And cold love *isn't* actually love. So I know I'm not really missing anything, nothing worthwhile anyhow. But it's still hard having to live in such *extreme* isolation.

And I, yeah I still need you, but what good's that gonna do? All needing is one thing, and getting getting's another.

This is confirmation not only of how it is, but of what God is doing. Repetition in the Word of God reveals how serious it is and how determined God is, just like we put words in bold or underline and dump in a load exclamation points to stress our point. As God said through Joseph "The dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). Through this ministry, especially with the biblical interpretations of secular resources, God is repeating the same message over and over and over and over again to stress the point that what He has me saying *has* been established and He *will* shortly bringing it to pass. And what exactly has been established? Only the very end of the world! I summed it up in this graphic and walk through it in God's Plan: A Vision for the Body.



The point is that we need to be people who *genuinely* love the Lord and care about what He cares about. As He summed up with the following passage:

The LORD said unto [the angel], Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof. And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city, and smite: let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity: Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom is the mark; and begin at my sanctuary (Ezek. 9:4-6, KJV).

While this was originally speaking of the Hebrews, because God's Word is prophetic God uses it to speak to different generations. So, essentially, history repeats itself as summed up with this graphic.



Therefore, Ezekiel 9:4-6, KJV is also speaking to our generation, which many discern is the last generation, and it's speaking not only about Jerusalem but about the whole world. Jerusalem represents the Bride of Christ, the new Jerusalem about whom Scripture says the following:

The one who is victorious I will make a pillar in the temple of my God. Never again will they leave it. I will write on them the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from my God (Rev. 3:12, NIV).

God gave us 2000 years to take Him seriously and we're now almost out of time. And since "judgment...begin[s] with God's household" (1 Pet. 4:17, NIV) **Christians** need to repent—as they KNOW but haven't done! They know it because they preach it. However, their actions, especially in the US don't reveal it. Most of the body of Christ today is living for the world while professing to love the Lord. Because we were all born into a severely apostate version of Christianity, professing Christians—those who actually have God's Spirit within and those who only think they're Christian—have deceived themselves that all that's needed is to say you're a Christian and go to church. It's the following passage:

He also that received seed among the thorns [that's all of who heard the Gospel message since we were born into an extremely apostate version of Christianity] is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful (Matt. 13:22, KJV).

If the body of Christ was actually fruitful we'd be at least as empowered as the first Christians, summed up with the text box. But we're clearly not!

The First Christians were Highly Empowered by God because they Obeyed Him as Individuals and as a Group

- They spoke in languages they hadn't studied (Acts 2:4-6);
- They healed the sick (Acts 3:2-7);
- They raised the dead (Acts 9:37-41);
- They drove out demons (Acts 16:16-18);
- They witnessed boldly (Acts 4:4);
- . They prayed for their attackers as they killed them (Acts 7:58-60);
- . They enlightened thousands at a time (Acts 7:58-60);
- Their shadows provided healing (Acts 5:14-16);
- Unbelievers admired them (Acts 2:47);
- They beamed around like in Star Trek (Acts 8:39-40);
- They were full of wisdom (Acts 6:3);
- . They were full of generosity (Acts 4:34-35); and,
- . They were full of joy (Acts 2:46).

I've been hoping for months, hoping for years, hoping I might forget. Aw, but it don't get much dumber, it don't get much dumber than trying to forget a girl when you love her.

This is the Lord going on about His Girl, His soon to be Bride, who's currently sleeping around with *tens of thousands* of lovers represented by all of those unbiblical denominations, in a totally unbiblical system, summed up with the pyramids, which honors Satan! And it's the reason He'd like to forget her, as in *Forget YOU!* But it's impossible for Him to do since He loves Her enough to have given His life *for* Her on that Cross, an extremely painful and humiliating death. While given His Spirit and every possible advantage in the U.S., we've still played out the same old theme God summed up with the prophet Hosea. "he LORD said to Hosea, Go, take unto thee a wife of whoredoms and children of whoredoms: for the land hath committed great whoredom, departing from the LORD" (Hos 1:2, KJV). God had Hosea do that to show the people what they'd done. In contrast, the body of Christ has chosen to it for not having genuinely appreciated what He did for us on the Cross.

The repetition, "doubled...[more than] twice...[is] because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). What's He's brining to pass is the culmination of the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4 YLT).

While the whole thing is sickening—how could we have been so outrageously unfaithful to the Lord who died so brutally for us?!—at the same time, for those of us who walk with the Lord the whole thing is a riot when seen from God's perspective, not only the words but the serious looks on their faces, the costumes, the old instruments (on their *side*), the sound, the driving, the dirt, the rough ending, *all* of it, and then He says, "Did we get it?"

Yeah, did we?

While the guy in the sons says that we did get it, I doubt it! 'Cuz there *ain't* much that's dumber than the Lord's Girl, as my 22-year testimony reveals. Though according to God some *will* eventually get it. He says "None of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand" (Daniel 12:10, KJV) at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV). Therefore, may God grant *you* a measure of wisdom! You need to go from wherever it is you currently are on the spectrum and stand close to Him as His best friend, since that's who He's been to you. Because, "it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful" (1 Cor. 4:2, NIV).
