We Will Rock You, Queen

You might listen to the song first to get the feel of it fresh in your system. Queen - We will rock you (Lyrics) - YouTube.

The Rock. For starters, the *Rock* is God's Christ, commonly called Jesus, since Scripture says "that Rock was Christ" (1 Cor. 10:4, KJV).

The Queen.

This is the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 1:27, KJV) since She'll soon be the Bride of Christ, more commonly referred to as the Church. And because the Church currently looks and behaves like the hooker BRAT rather than the warrior Bride She was meant to be. God, Jesus, the Rock, is getting ready to rock the house, His Church, since "judgment must begin at the house of God" (1 Pet. 4:17, KJV).



Buddy, you're a boy, make a big noise playin' in the street, gonna be a big man some day!

Buddy represents several players: Satan, the body of Christ, Jesus, the elect, my husband, and me. However, it's only Satan and the body of Christ who are 'making a big noise.'


Satan as Buddy. Satan *pretends* to be our buddy, our friend, by being "transformed into an angel of light" (2 Cor. 11:14, KJV) and by using "his servants [who] masquerade as servants of righteousness" (2 Cor. 11:15, NIV). Directly and indirectly he makes a "big noise"—big stink more like—thinking he's going to be a big deal one day. Satan "said in [his] heart, **I will** ascend into heaven, **I will** exalt my throne above the stars of God: **I will** sit also upon the mount of the congregation...**I will** ascend above the heights of the clouds; **I will** be like the most High" (Isa. 14:13-14, KJV). Except, he *fell* "as lightning falls from heaven" (Luke 10:18, KJV). So while this Scripture applied to someone else, it also applies to Satan, all the more since no one has set out to "be like the most High" as much as Satan, the leading antichrist of "many antichrists" (1 John 2:18, KJV).

However, God trumps Satan—and everyone else. He says "Surely as **I** have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as **I** have purposed, so shall it stand" (Isa. 14:24, KJV, my emphasis). In other words, God "worketh **all** things after the counsel of **his** own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV, my emphasis).

A Boy. Satan's really just a *boy* compared to God, both "the Father, and...his Son" (1 John 1:3, KJV), since he's not a man but a fallen angel who has an extremely immature attitude. While he thinks he's God's gift to the world—which, ironically, he would have been had he been faithful since "angels [were created to be] ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation" (Heb. 1:14, NIV)—he's hardly *The* Man. The best he can do is be "like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV).

In fact, those who have "the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, NIV), are greater than Satan since "greater is he that is in you [born again Christians], than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4, KJV).

The Body of Christ as Buddy. While Jesus says "I have called you friends" (John 15:15, KJV), aka my buddies, the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has been making a big noise by telling others that *they* need to repent or end up in hell when there are some serious problems with that. First of all, it's the body of Christ who needs to repent since "judgment must begin at the house of God" (1 Pet. 4:17, KJV). Secondly, hell doesn't even exist as revealed by the original languages of the Bible which I've walked through in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body* and summed it up with these graphics. In fact, no matter which translation of the Bible you look at, hell totally contradicts God's nature as revealed by Jesus who is "the exact representation" (Heb. 1:3, NIV) of God's being since He "is the image of the invisible God" (Col. 1:15, KJV).





In fact, when you compare most of what Christians have historically done and are doing with the New Testament, it *totally* doesn't line up, as I've summed up with the timeline.



Therefore, just like Satan who thinks he's going to be a "big man some day," Christians think *they're* going to go to heaven some day—be the 'big man' as compared to the lost—when most professing Christians couldn't possibly be born again according to the New Testament, and as Jesus warned when He said "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matt. 7:21, KJV). He also warned us saying "Wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat [whereas] strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it" (Matt. 7:13, KJV). "Destruction" seems to mean two things. Either that you don't enter the Lord's rest (Ps. 95:11 below), the millennial reign (Rev. 20:4 below), and/or a ruined life here on earth, as with divorce, a messed up career, and/or a less than desirable death which won't earn you rewards (2 John 1:8 below), for example.

Psalm 95:11, KJV Unto whom I sware in my wrath that they should not enter into my rest.

Revelation 20:4, KJV I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

2 John 1:8, KJV Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

You got mud on yo' face You big disgrace Kickin' your can all over the place

Satan's Mud and Big Disgrace. Satan is covered in mud/sin/filth and is a *huge* disgrace since he was the "the anointed cherub...perfect in [his] ways from the day that [he] wast created, till iniquity was found in [him]" (Ezek. 28:14-15, KJV). As an angel, he was supposed to be helping God's elect because Scripture says "the angels...Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?" (Heb. 1:13-14, KJV). But it's *not* as if Satan's rebellion came as a surprise to God since He has "worke[d] all things [out] after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV) saying "I will do all my pleasure" (Isa. 46:10, KJV).

God also says the following:

What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory (Rom. 9:22-23, KJV).

Since Satan is clearly a "vessel...of wrath" (Rom. 9:22, KJV) and God created him "perfect" (Ezek. 28:15, KJV) and the Bible was written after Satan's fall, we can see that God *did* "work...[it all out] after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV). My guess is that God knew exactly what Satan—and everyone else—would do and moved forward with it anyhow since He knew He could work it all out to benefit everyone, in the end. I've covered it in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*. And Scripture says that God "make[s] known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come" (Isa. 46:10, NIV). That's because God, unlike everyone else including the supernatural beings, stands outside of time since He is the "Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending" (Rev. 1:8, KJV). He *is* time so that "apart from [Him we] can do nothing" (John 15:5, NIV) "for in him we live, and move, and have our being" (Acts 17:28, KJV).

We're all God's tools. And that's true for Satan and all the "vessels of wrath" (Rom. 9:22, KJV). I cover it in *Election: The Biggest Blinder*. My current understanding is that God allowed Satan to fall and disgrace himself, and do all the damage he's done and is doing, because He has a higher purpose in it. Essentially, it's to reveal His grace by also revealing human depravity, since for the last 2000 years all the elect had to do was "submit...to God. Resist the devil, and he [would have had to] flee" (James 4:7, KJV). What's tripped everyone up is that we've focused on *this* life, this age. But God has a greater picture in mind, summed up with the graphic which I basically walk through in *God's Plan*.

So while Satan was created as the most beautiful and perfect being, he 'kicks his can all over the place' through his rebellion. We've been informed that "his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven [a third of the angels who rebelled with him since "stars are the angels" (Rev. 1:20, KJV)], and did cast them to the earth" (Rev. 12:4, KJV). That being the case, we, humans, are in a brutal war "wrestl[ing]...against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Eph. 6:12, KJV). We're at war against Satan and his fallen angels, the demons. Yet the body of Christ as a whole has historically *ignored* this war, for the most part, which is why we're getting creamed. Just look around at what's taking place all over the world today!

The Body's Mud and Big Disgrace. Christians have *mud all over their faces* since they honor Satan, the leading antichrist, more than Jesus, God's Christ. While told that "God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24, KJV), that's not what we've done historically with the exception of that first batch of believers. And it's clearly not what we're doing today summed up with these videos made by others. Like the lost, most of the body of Christ today is honoring Satan since all denominations bow to the pope who rejects the lordship of Christ. And a born again Christian shouldn't *need* to watch the videos to discern the truth.

Ephesians 5:23 The Catholic Church teaches that the pastoral office, the office of shepherding the Church, that was held by the apostles, as a group or "college" with Saint Peter as their head, is now held by their successors, the bishops, with the bishop of Rome (the pope) as their head.

The fact is that the whole *system* we've historically called Christianity is unbiblical since Jesus is our "high priest" (Heb. 4:14, KJV) and He says "You may not be called 'Rabbi,' for One is your Teacher, yet you all are brethren" (Matt. 23:8, CLT). The word *pastor* isn't even found in the literal translations of the Bible. The word used in Young's Literal Translation is "shepherd" (Eph. 4:11, YLT). They're supposed to be *servants* of the "good shepherd" (John 10:11, KJV) who is Christ. In contrast, they've historically been "shepherds...that do feed themselves!" (Ezek. 34:2, KJV). EVERYBODY knows *that!*

And under the new covenant which Jesus made with His blood, "they shall be all taught of God" (John 6:45, KJV). Born again Christians are supposed to be studying God's Word, the Bible, seeking the Lord and learning from Him. He says "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me" (Matt. 11:29, NIV). Shepherds who honor Christ are mere facilitators, not lords—which is how today's shepherds behave. Just try holding them accountable. (They think they're God! They're just like the popes who think everyone should bow down to them and kiss their hand.) Jesus clearly said that the "rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant" (Mark 10:42-43, NIV).

But it's not all their fault since most people who go to church idolize those men.

And Jesus said "I am the good shepherd [who gave]...his life for the sheep. But he that is an hireling [a paid professional], and not the shepherd...careth not for the sheep" (John 10:11-13, KJV). That's my 22-year testimony and the testimony of many. They really don't care for sheep and, therefore, neither do they really care for the Good Shepherd. Try holding a so-called pastor accountable to God's Word and they kick you out of "their" church and don't tell anyone what they did. Or else they tell them with a twisted version of the truth. And when you approach those church going "Christians" the first thing they do, having admitted that what you're saying sounds right, is run to their pastor to see if he's OK with it. They deserve each other. It's as if God said 'You want some carnal man to be your leader, that's what you'll get.' It's the exact same thing the Israelites did with Saul so that God told Samuel "They have rejected me as their king" (1 Sam. 8:7, KJV).

And today's Christians are so dead asleep-such extreme idolaters-that even when they're aware that a prophet approached a pastor, they still honor that hireling instead of Jesus! That's what happened in 2015 when God had the prophet approach John MacArthur during the service. The congregation even laughed about it, having no fear of God at all when "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom" (Prov. 9:10, KJV). And you can even see MacArthur laughing about it as it happened. He did because John MacArthur is a Freemason who uses occult hand signs. He openly serves Satan. Yet the people in that congregation, as well as online, honored him as the true prophet while calling the true prophet a false prophet. There's plenty of information on the web put out by former Freemasons revealing that Freemasonry is satanic, as with this blurb:

The most cohesive group of infiltrators the church has ever seen are the Freemasons. They work behind the scenes to subvert the Gospel, and in fact, meet in secret to teach salvation on the basis of another savior. We know this to be the fact, because we were...Freemasons (from *Ex-masons for Jesus* www.emfj.org).

And there's plenty of information about John MacArthur being a Freemason and about the occult hand signs so it's just as God says "They are without excuse" (Rom. 1:20, KJV). Still, He's having me help His people by having had compile the work of many together in *Satan's Reign: A Timeline* where I provide links to those who explain different points more thoroughly.


Combining parts of the first and second stanza the song says—

Buddy...You got mud on yo' face


Buddy as Jesus with Mud on His Face. Again, Jesus is our "Buddy" since He says "I have called you friends" (John 15:15, KJV). But since even the born again have taken Him for granted and NOT "casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, KJV), we've thrown—are throwing—mud on His face! In turn, the body of Christ as a group has been "put[ting] him to an open shame" (Heb. 6:6, KJV).

So in my *Welcome!* video I've summed up the impact that's had on families as God used my family and the family of former close friends as an example. It's pretty bad so that God says "They must be silenced, because they are disrupting whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach—and that for the sake of dishonest gain" (Titus 1:11, NIV). "They" are the "hireling[s who] careth not for the sheep" (John 10:13, KJV), "the shepherds...that do feed themselves!" (Ezek. 34:2, KJV). The way the literal translations put it is "whole households they overturn" (Titus 1:11, YLT) and "subverting whole households" (Titus 1:11, CLT). What these paid professionals have done with the help of their idolaters is "nullify the word of God" (Matt. 15:6, NIV). And since Jesus "is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, KJV), Christianity

has nullified Christ! The body of Christ has thrown so much mud on His face He's hardly recognizable today. It's like this graphic, all those line representing the mud of false doctrines and lies we've been historically throwing in His face.




Buddy as the Elect with Mud on their Face. Since most professing Christians reject the doctrine of election, the Lord had me sum it up in the graphic. Essentially, as I understand it, God created two types of people for this age, non-elect and elect—having a purpose in mind that goes beyond this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). And I discern He actually created very few non-elect compared to the number of elect. Since Paul said "I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ" (2 Tim. 2:10, KJV) elect cannot mean born again as most currently seem to see it.



And the only way to understand why God would "fit...[some] to destruction" (Rom. 9:22, KJV), in other words create some people for "destruction" is by understanding God's plan of universal salvation through Christ, which I cover in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*.

Unlike what they teach in those so-called churches, the Bible appears to teach that this is the first of three ages, summed up in the previous graphic for the ages. Yet mainstream Christianity has focused on this age cramming into it prophecies that will be fulfilled *after* this age.

In any case, focusing on the elect and the mud we have on our faces, according to Scripture, summed up with the Opportunity Line graphic, God pursues the elect all of our lives. Jesus "stand[s] at the door, and knock[s]" (Rev. 3:20, KJV), and stands there every day during the course of the life of His elect so that *every* day—whether we're lost or born again—we can either let Him into our lives, or not. In fact, elect can reject Him altogether so that Jesus says "He that overcometh...I will not blot out his name out of the book of life" (Rev. 3:5, KJV). Don't let Him into your life at all and, even though you're elect, you'll have your name blotted out of His book. In other words, you won't get to experience the millennial reign, the next age, when those of us who did become "born again" (John 3:7, KJV) will "live...and reign...with Christ a thousand years" (Rev. 20:4, KJV). God also says about His elect that "he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love" (Eph. 1:4, KJV). The elect have had their name written in the book of life from "before the foundation of the world" (Eph. 1:4, KJV). But since should is a conditional, we can totally ignore Him just like "the Pharisees and the experts in the law[who] rejected God's purpose for themselves" (Luke 7:30, NIV). And since that's what most elect have historically done, the Bible says that "all that dwell upon the earth shall worship [Satan], whose names are **not written in the book of life**" (Rev. 13:8, KJV, my emphasis). Their names were either not written in the book of life before the foundation of the world or else their names were blotted out of it.




So while Christians argue about whether or not you can lose your salvation, it's clear from Scripture that you cannot become un-born again. God will not remove His Spirit from you once He's given it to you since the born again were "sealed unto the day of redemption" with "the holy Spirit" (Eph. 4:30, KJV). Sealed unto the day of redemption the born again cannot lose their salvation. But, an elect soul *can* lose their election and have their name erased from the book of life.

On top of that the born again can build so poorly on the foundation of Christ that you can't even tell they're actually born again—as it is with the majority today. God says "Store up for yourselves treasures in heaven" (Matt. 6:20, KJV)—obviously speaking to the elect and no the "vessels of wrath fitted to destruction" (Rom. 9:22, KJV). Yet history reveals that most professing Christians have spent the bulk of their lives building up their careers on this earth. Even those who spent their lives studying God's Word didn't do a very good job of it because they believed Satan's obvious lies like about hell and the institutional church, for example.


And since everyone born during the last 100 years was born *into* a SEVERELY apostate form of Christianity, we all joined the apostasy just as soon as we became born again choosing to believe the lies that Satan and his ministers have been feeding everyone. 



My husband has mud on his face since he's lacked faith and resolve just like the rest, but in some ways not as bad, yet overall worse since "to every one to whom much was given, much shall be required from him" (Luke 12:48, YLT). I share our family's testimony in the testimony books on my website broken down by spiritual markers and the five stages of my life. Again, God has "worke[d] all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV). And to not be so repetitive, I share other aspects of our lives throughout my material revealing how God has coordinated it all for His purposes and our good.












Me as Buddy. Like everyone else I have mud on my face—all over—since "there is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom. 3:10, KJV).

So right after writing Riverdale leadership about being covered in mud "all over"—the leadership team the Lord wanted me to "share" this information with in 2012—I dreamt of our favorite getaway spot while we lived in Indianapolis. Eyes opened, I literally jumped out of bed and rushed to a forgotten bookshelf. The Lord cracks me up! I am covered in mud! After years of seeing the *Tribe of Mud People* walking along the beach at Lake Michigan, the little women and I finally converted. So, yet again, the Lord was making good on His promise to provide this prophet some joy while waiting, as the man had preached having had me give them 'the message.' This hireling had preached "prophets have to wait, but they'll experience joy while waiting." And, naturally, being undiscerning hypocrites, Christians—like the lost—have rebuked me for the joy the Lord has given me when He says "The joy of the LORD is your strength" (Neh. 8:10, KJV).

And the resource that gave me the most joy that season was the official video for the song *Needing Getting* by OK GO, for which I've also done an interpretation. God's got the best sense of humor (since He created it), rebuking and disciplining us *while* teaching us while *also* giving us a good laugh. No one else can do that like Jesus! Except you'll only find it funny if you're right with Him and/or humble enough to admit when you're wrong. If not, you'll just get offended and lie to yourself that God's not really saying what He's saying. It's like all the excuses most dieters make so that they *don't* actually lose weight. And Jesus says "Blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me" (Matt. 11:6, KJV).








Singin'

Rather than only crying my way through this very difficult calling, God has me 'singing' so to speak, "for the joy of the Lord *is* [my] strength" (Neh. 8:10, KJV, my emphasis) so that my testimony is summed up with this graphic and Psalm 126 (in the graphic).


And what God has done for me is good for the whole body because that's how He works. He says "If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; [but] if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it" (1 Cor. 12:26, NIV). Jesus modeled it for us. He's also given us the same message with the movie *Frozen (2013)*, for which I've done a short interpretation. So when Christians finally acknowledge that God is using me, and see how He's using me—as revealed in the material He's had me provide—the body will rejoice because the blessing is for all (all who take Him seriously). It's confirmation that this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) is just about over.

We will, we will rock you We will, we will rock you

God made a point about repetition through Joseph of the Old Testament. And He prophesied to me beginning around 2001 that I'd be having a Joseph Experience-which I've had and am still having. Joseph was highly blessed by God and suffered greatly for it. And he said "The dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). Through the testimony and ministry God has given me He has doubled the message multiple times, making the point that He is coming back SOON. Many born again Christians know it but they're missing key points about how to prepare. By repeatedly repeating the message through this ministry God is nailing the point,—for those who'll have eyes that see.



And it looks like He confirmed it, not only through different prophecies but through the mirror for the last week of Daniel's prophecy. However, I leave room for error since under the new covenant Jesus made with His blood we're supposed to be functioning as a body "for the body is not one member, but many" (1 Cor. 12:14, KJV) and we're not—so I could be wrong on the 2030 year of His return and on other things as well! But I sure do find this timeline interesting. And throughout my experience and throughout the Scriptures God had revealed a parallel way of doing things. However, He almost always does it with a twist—a parallel that's not exactly the same. In fact, as I summed up in the graphic for the last three and half years, I'm thinking those three and a half years that I placed back to back on the Daniel timeline may actually overlap rather than run back to back. I don't remember when I made this Daniel timeline but you see that I had a question mark at the bottom right about the temple being built. Then in the summer of 2020 He seems to have answered that question for me so I explain my current understanding in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*.



So while we can't know the day or hour of the Lord's return since "of that day and hour knoweth no man" (Matt. 24:36, KJV), Jesus rebuked the Pharisees and teachers of the law for not being more aware when He said "Hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?" (Matt. 16:3, KJV). He also warned us saying said "Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap" (Luke 21:34, NIV). "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15, KJV). Focusing on building your career and nest egg in this world rather than on building God's kingdom, falls under "the anxieties of life" and loving the world. The King James says "take heed to yourselves lest...that day come upon vou unawares" (Luke 21:34, KJV). In other words, we should be aware. We can know the general timing and, therefore, the year of the Lord's return-we just can't know the "day and hour."



And there are two key prophecies revealing that the Lord will return in 2030, or so I discern—provided on not still missing something. One is the Berisheet Prophecy and the other is the Hosea prophecy, videos created by others:

1. The Berisheet Passover Prophecy - Full Movie - YouTube.

NOTE: While most of the Berisheet prophecy appears to line up with Scripture, there are a couple of discrepancies, the main one being that this man has believed the Jesuit lie of the pre-tribulation rapture.

2. The Bible Foretold History! (Hosea Prophecy Revealed) - YouTube.

When the body of Christ, at least a core group, starts working together as we're supposed to be doing, "submit[ting] to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, NIV), acknowledging that God is using me instead of blowing me off like everyone's been doing for the past two decades, *receiving* me in the Lord and *helping* me answer some of these questions (Rom. 16:2 below), *then* we'll have more clarity.

Romans 16:2, NASB Receive her in the Lord in a manner worthy of the saints, and that you help her in whatever matter she may have need of you; for she herself has also been a helper of many, and of myself as well.

We in "we will rock you" Refers to Different Groups

The Father and the Son, Jesus and me, real Church leaders/servant leaders (as opposed to hirelings), and the awakened church.

We = **The Father and the Son:** God is One, yet plural since He manifested Himself through Jesus who "is the image of the invisible God" (Col. 1:15, KJV). Jesus also said "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father" (John 14:9, KJV). I walk through it in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*, but here's the gist of it. The Father has always existed and He begat a Son "the only-begotten God" (John 1:18, CLT). He then placed that Son in Mary by way of His Spirit like they do with in vitro fertilization:

In gestational surrogacy, the child is not biologically related to the surrogate mother, who is often referred to as a gestational carrier. Instead, the embryo is created via in vitro fertilization (IVF), using the eggs and sperm of the intended parents or donors, and is then transferred to the surrogate...Gestational surrogates...are not "blood" relatives to the babies they carry — they have no biological connection...only oxygen and nutrients are passed to the baby from the pregnant woman through the umbilical cord (from www.surrogate.com).

Mary was just a *carrier*.

If this wasn't the case then Jesus was praying to Himself when He prayed, but He clearly said He was praying to the Father as in "Father, forgiven them" (Luke 23:34, KJV). It also reveals that Mary was not more special that she was, as the Catholics have made her. If Jesus carried Mary's DNA then there would be something unique about Mary and that whole line of people. But there isn't other than God used them to first carry His message, first verbally and then physically. It's no different than how He uses any one of us.

So while the Father is "Spirit" (John 4:24, KJV) and Jesus was in the flesh, it's as Jesus said "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30, KJV). They are both God/Divine. But there is only one God in that only the Father has always existed. Therefore, "the LORD is one!" (Deut. 6:4, NASB). The Father and the Son are one in mind and Spirit.

And eventually the body of Christ will be one in mind and Spirit with Him/them, at least a remnant, as Jesus prayed for—speaking of the end of this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). He said "Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me" (John 17:20-21, KJV). I explain in *God's Plan* why I discern only a remnant will be as intimate with Father and Son as Jesus was with the Father when He walked the earth.

And when it's all been said and done at the end of "the ages to come" (Eph. 2:7, KJV), then everyone who has ever lived will be one with God, Father and Son.

We = Jesus & Me: The Lord and I will be shaking everyone's ground with this ministry—everyone's who's paying attention. It is *we*, He and me, because it's as He says, "Where I am, there shall also my servant be" (John 12:26, KJV). But because we're in the depths of apostasy and of the "increase of wickedness" (Matt. 24:12, NIV) in the world, only a remnant will even notice the rumblings. As He says "Narrow is the way which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it" (Matt. 7:14, KJV).

And yet, He *is* shaking things up *all* around the world. "He hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven" (Heb. 12:26, KJV). He's rocking the world. Most just don't realized He's the One behind it all using Satan and his "ministers" (2 Cor. 11:15, KJV)—both human and supernatural—as His tools.

We = Real Church Leaders: God has chosen certain ones among the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) to step up to the plate and lead the way walking rightly before Him. I know that because that's the system God has set in place as revealed in Ephesians 4, for example, which I summed up with God's Mission Statement. At some point God will open up this ministry to those people, and they'll "run" with it (Hab. 2:2, KJV), encouraging others to "run with patience the race that is set before us" (Heb. 12:1, KJV). While lots of people are revealing Satan's hand "hidden in plain sight" there is no one else that I'm aware of doing what He has me doing, revealing His hand hidden in plain sight through these biblical interpretations.

God's Mission Statement Ephesians 4:11-16	
God's Order	"He gave some [as] apostles [church planters], and some [as] prophet [inspired preachers/expounders], and some [as] proclaimers of good new [evangelists], and some [as] shepherds and teachers. (YLT)
God's Purpose	"His intention was the perfecting and the full equipping of the saints (His consecrated people), [that they should do] the work of ministering toward building up Christ's body (the church). (AMPC)
God's Timetable	until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. (NIV)
God's Rationale	"Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. (NIV)
God's Strategy	Speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. *From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. (NIV)

And I discern He's worked this way so that the body of Christ gets motivated to *mature* and also discern His hand hidden in plain sight in other resources, since that's the level of faith and discernment we'll need to get through the trials of the last days which are nearly on top of us.

We = The Awakened Church: Currently the body of Christ, the Lord's Girl, is in a coma as if "dead [asleep]" (Rev. 3:1, KJV). I know it's a coma and not RIP dead because He says "I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die" (Rev. 3:1-2, NIV). So while the Lord's Girl, the Church, the body of Christ, is dreaming about Jesus saying to Her "Well done good and faithful servant!" (Matt. 25:21, KJV) He's actually saying "Wake up!" (Rev. 3:1, NIV) I'm "a consuming fire" (Heb. 12:29, KJV). God has prophesied that this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) will end in a ball of flames. The New Testament says "By the same word [and Jesus is "the Word [that] was made flesh" (John 1:14, KJV)] the present heavens and earth are reserved for fire, being kept for

the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly" (2 Pet. 3:7, NIV). Destruction of the ungodly means both physical death and also destruction of their ungodly nature through the trials they'll have to endure both during this life as well as during the age of judgment when they'll be resurrected and get disciplined. Jesus said "There doth come an hour in which all those in the tombs shall hear his voice, and they shall come forth; those who did the good things to a rising again of life [which begins with the rapture followed by the millennial reign], and those who practised the evil things to a rising again of judgment" (John 5:28-29, YLT).



At the same time, God has prophesied of a great awakening, a greater outpouring of His Spirit than He did 2000 years ago, which I've summed up with the graphics. And "now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed" (Rom. 13:11, KJV). When the born again finally wake up to themselves, especially those in my generation, elders who are not yet elderly, we will rock you/rock the world—as a group. And while it's not just those of my generation, the Bible is clear that those who are older, elders, have a greater responsibility. Even the lost know this; *children* know it. Older women, for instance, were supposed to "urge the younger women to love their husbands and children" (Titus 2:4, KJV), not to go off and work full-time dumping their children in daycares. And the "younger [ones are supposed to], submit...to [their] elders" (1 Pet. 5:5, KJV). But that's not what we've done—*especially* these days—because the human "heart is desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). And if the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) hasn't done it, and we haven't, neither have the lost.



Rock You Means Several Things. To "rock" something would mean to stone it, which means to kill it. It also, therefore, means to put an end to it. It also means to disturb the status quo like when you *rock the boat*. It also means to do a great job surpassing expectations as with "You rock!" And, it means to have a good time as in "This rocks!"

To Rock/To Stone: All who get right with God will stone the BRAT's abominations to death something like they did in the Old Testament when the prophet said "Why hast thou troubled us? the LORD shall trouble thee...And all Israel stoned [them]" (Josh. 7:25, KJV). But since we're under the new covenant, a covenant of love and grace since "grace and truth came by Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, KJV), when the Lord finally opens up this ministry at His appointed time (Hab. 2:2-3 below) we'll be stoning the BRATs abominations with the Word, the Rock, since "that Rock [is] Christ" (1 Cor. 10:4, KJV) "and his name is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, KJV). It's what God has me demonstrating through these booklets and videos. We won't be using real rocks, weapons, or hatred of any kind because "the weapons of our warfare are NOT carnal" (2 Cor. 10:4, KJV, my emphasis). Christians will finally learn to actually be Christian, genuine "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Cor. 5:20, KJV).



Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

Rocking the Boat: As the born again start getting right with Him, because of how God will be using this ministry combined with what's going on in the world, those who are more faithful/more humble will be turning the Church right side up again, seriously rocking the boat. Christians talk about turning the world upside down when the world *is* upside down "call[ing] evil good, and good evil" (Isa. 5:20, KJV)—just like most Christians are currently doing. We need to turn

the Church right side up again which will impact the world. Paul said "What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside? God will judge those outside" (1 Cor. 5:12-13, KJV). Yet Christians have either not focused on the lost at all, or else they're standing in judgment of them as with this graphic. God didn't tell us to spread the Good News by protesting and condemning people but by preaching and teaching. He says "Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction" (2 Tim. 4:2, KJV). "For God sent **not** his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved" (John 3:17, KJV, my emphasis).




In fact, God supernaturally makes the point that the U.S. is upside down in the booklet where I walk through a revelation He gave me. For Such a Time as This. He says "Your turning of things upside down shall be esteemed as the potter's clay" (Isa. 29:16, KJV). When we took pottery classes all of the messed up and old clay was recycled. That's what God is doing starting with the more discerning members of the body of Christ—working us over—because we are also made of clay. Scripture says "the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground" (Gen. 2:7, KJV). Dust is dirt which is clay.

The Bible also says that "afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and...shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days" (Hos. 3:5, KJV). The "children of Israel" were the Hebrews but since all those tribes were scattered and there's been intermixing, they're all over the place now. And the real dividing line is between human and supernatural "forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV). In any case, Daniel also prophesied about it saying "Some of them of understanding shall fall [and so they have], to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed" (Dan. 11:35, KJV).

To Rock Means to Surpass Expectations: Having followed the Lord through some house cleaning detours for a couple of months where He had me praying for people in this important part of the world—the DC metro area—several said to me "Girl, you rock!" for having made their place so squeaky clean. They just had no idea how much I was actually *rocking* (stoning their abominations) as I prayed over them, their families, their jobs, their co-workers, their friends, and whatever else God brought to mind with Scriptures to pray as I cleaned their place. He prophesied that "on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord" (Lev. 16:30, KJV). And Jesus "hast made us [the born again] unto our God...priests" (Rev. 5:10, KJV). I am part of the "holy priesthood, [made so by God] to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ" (1 Pet. 2:5, KJV).

And considering that He had me praying for people who work on Capitol Hill and throughout the federal government, some with strong international connections, the lowly job of housecleaner *wasn't* all that lowly—especially considering the job/the calling He has given me with the rest of this ministry. And since the best way to rock—to stone abominations—is by being in right relationship with God and praying His Word and will to be done by His power, prayer has been a pretty big part of my calling and ministry.






Priestly Service—No one is so great that there's a task, no matter how lowly like cleaning toilets, that we cannot perform for Jesus. The example of foot washing from John 13 (below) is *symbolic*. Jesus meant we should be willing to do **whatever** He asks of us. That's pretty much what *love* means. And He says "love one another; as I have you" (John 13:34, KJV).

John 13:5 & 14-15, KJV He poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded...If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. [What He did was give His *life* in service for others. And that's what we're supposed to do, which He has me modeling. I'm not being conceited. God has revealed it through my life testimony as shared through the material He's had me put together.]

A BLOODY LITTLE DETOUR. When we rock the boat and stone abominations, there tends to be some backlash. And, combining God's sense of humor as He's "worke[d] all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV), with some teachable moments, God had me work with two cleaning firms for a few weeks—both supposedly Christian, yet anything but. So on the last day of this God-ordained Detour, I was charged by four territorial dogs. And like the "dumb dogs...[on my path who] look to their own way" (Isa. 56:10-11 below), these real dogs weren't rabid but damaging nonetheless. So I did with them what God has me doing with these spiritual dogs. I yelled, "Get DOWN! DOWN! NOW!" (Titus 1:11 below). So while it was scary and it hurt, I was laughing as I made my way to the sink without getting blood on the white carpet (important to a cleaning lady). I could laugh for being well acquainted with dogs (real and spiritual). They bit me several times, with one perfect little chomp on my butt which is EXACTLY how this Tour of Duty has felt! And that guy, the leader of the pack—just like the beast the world wonders after (Rev. 13:3 below)—was a Boxer, the type that like to fight. And that's how it is. "The devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour" (1 Pet. 5:8, KJV).



Titus 1:11, KJV They must be silenced, because they are disrupting whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach—and that for the sake of dishonest gain.

Revelation 13:3, KJV All the world wondered after the beast.



And if you follow Jesus, you *will* experience the backlash since "all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution" (2 Tim. 3:12, KJV). But "it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing" (1 Pet. 3:17, KJV).
















In any case, if these "dogs" (Isa. 56:11, KJV) want to prove to themselves that they actually belong to the Lord and won't hear Him reject them (Matt. 7:21-23 below), they need to learn from those in *Eight Below (2006)* who *bow down* to Maya. Because, Jesus says "Inasmuch as ye did it...to one of the least of these, ye did it...to me" (Matt. 25:45, KJV). The Lord gave me the following Word in the late 1990s at the beginning of this part of my walk:

Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are [Christian], and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee (Rev. 3:9, KJV).

I just hope for their sakes that they get "zealous...and repent" (Rev. 3:19, KJV).

Matthew 7:21-23, KJV Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Maya's so cute too, and endures such cold and isolation (as I've had to). She's his "best girl" (in the movie), whose name just so happens to be mine. And she rescues the idiot who wouldn't *listen*—which is exactly how it is. So while most will think I'm making connections that aren't there, that I'm delusion, God has made the connections very clear, *obvious*, throughout my life testimony. I am following the Lord's leading based on the connections He has revealed to me which I share in material as He's called me to do. So either I can believe Him and walk by faith, or be rebellious like the rest—except I'm not



willing to do that. What God has done is surpassed all of our expectations, just like He did 2000 years ago. What the Jews were expecting back then was quite a bit less that what Jesus came and did. And that's how it is again. Except this time it's with Christians. Get Down By Audio Adrenaline (With Lyrics) - YouTube.

To Rock Means to Have a Great Time. Real Church would be like celebrating Thanksgiving, every week—only better since Jesus is the guest of honor—and He's a load of fun. The best case scenario would have been of community living like the group from Denmark in this documentary, **Happy (2011)**—only **much** better since they don't know the Lord. And yet, they're all *super* happy! Denmark Co housing - Happy Documentary Clip - YouTube.

But because Christians have been so rebellious for so long, we're getting the exact opposite of what we could have had. We're coming into the worst period of all of human history "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be" (Matt. 24:21, KJV).

Still, when we get right with God as a group—as local assemblies—we will experience the "joy of the LORD" (Neh. 8:10, KJV). And local biblical assemblies are the only way we'll have some measure of protection from Satan's schemes. Moreover, since Satan is "the prince of the power of the air" (Eph. 2:2, KJV) that "great" fellowship many have today online isn't going to cut it.

Buddy you're a young man, hard man


Being Young and Hard: Buddy in this case is the immature harlot "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) who lacks faith in God. Even "though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food!" (Heb. 5:12, NIV). I discern that many born again Christians have a lot of head knowledge of the Word of God (much of which is wrong), but very few have a close *relationship* with Him—next to none! So not only is the Church super immature/young, She's *super* hard hearted. She's carnal.

It's just like in the Old Testament when "no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done?" (Jer. 8:6, KJV). And it's what God prophesied saying "Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold" (Matt. 24:12, NIV). And every Christian who's the least bit awake knows that there's no one more cold—with the exception of brutal murderers—than a professing Christian! While the lost can be extremely cold, since Christians are supposed to be *representing* love being that "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) and we've been called to be "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Cor. 5:20. KJV), they're worse. And they're worse because they're *spiritually* proud. Since they "believe" Jesus is God, they think they already know everything and are, therefore, unteachable—that's been my 22 year experience.

Therefore, because Christians are so proud, "the LORD hath poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep, and hath closed your eyes: the prophets and your rulers, the seers hath he covered" (Isa. 29:10, KJV). If this wasn't true I would have been able to get through to someone—at least one person!—in the last two decades that the Lord has had me reaching out to people. But I haven't been able to get through to anyone. Most won't even talk to me! They don't even acknowledge that I've reached out to them! That's not exactly loving. Even if was dead wrong on every point, that is not how the New Testament teaches Christians should behave.

And that's the thing about being spiritually blind, you can't *tell* that you're blind. In contrast, when you're physically blind you have no doubt about it. You KNOW you can't see! That's how it is for the lost and it's the same with the born again. Except it's even worse for the born again. If you're born again but have gotten proud, you are carnal/backslidden. You're spiritually blind while *knowing* you know the Lord. Therefore, no matter how much someone tells you, and no matter how wrongly you behave, you still think you can see clearly even when it's obvious you're way off track. In order to remove the blinders we have to HUMBLE ourselves before the Lord. It's like this movie I just watched. A Matter of Faith | Full Movie | Jordan Trovillion | Jay Pickett | Harry Anderson | Clarence Gilyard - YouTube The girl and the black man represent the body of Christ. That man wasted *years* of his life and the girl was *super* cold towards the Lord.

And near the end during the debate the movie reveals another lie Christians have bought into, that only the "experts" need to be able to "contend for the faith" (Jude 1:3, KJV) when every single born again Christian, provided you're not a new believer, should be able to decently contend for the faith and doing it as a way of life. Since "Christ Jesus...will judge the living and the dead...I give you this charge: Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction" (2 Tim. 4:1-2, KJV).




Shouting in the street gonna take on the world some day

Shouting in the Street: Through their books, ministries, sermons, and street preaching, Christians boast loud and broad about being conquerors when they're LOADED DOWN with sin, *refusing* to repent, making the body of Christ as a whole powerless and their own salvation *highly* questionable since the New Testament says "Whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him" (1 John 3:6, KJV). If the body of Christ was actually walking in the power of the Lord today we'd be even more empowered than those first believers 2000 years ago. But that's hardly the case. If there's any doubt in your mind that we're not measuring up as a group consider what's going on worldwide with Covid. When we actually get into the peak of the latter rain there will be no way to keep it a secret. Even though Satan is "the ruler of the kingdom of the air" (Eph. 2:2, NIV) so that he controls the web, because "the one who is in [the born again] is greater than the one who is in the world [Satan]" (1 John 4:4, NIV), when "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 1:27, KJV) finally starts *maturing* in the faith and actually *walking* in the truth functioning as the body of Christ, Satan will have to flee those hot pockets. As God says "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7, KJV).

And, God says "I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not. Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds" (Rev. 2:21-22, KJV). We've had 2000 years to repent, and we haven't. But, a remnant *will* since this is a HUGE part of the reason Jesus went to the Cross:

Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:25-27, ESV).



In Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. Romans 12:5, NIV **Shouting in the Street:** Being "in the street" is akin to being Home *less*. That's what most professing Christians are because most of them are NOT actually born again. God says "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?" (2 Cor. 13:5 NIV). Jesus said:

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not **prophesied** in thy name? and in thy name have **cast out devils**? and in thy name done **many wonderful works**? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (Matt. 7:22-23, KJV).

While these so-called Christians prophesied, cast out devils, and did many wonderful works in the name of Christ, according to Him most professing Christians will miss the millennial reign of Christ, and instead get raised up for "judgment" (John 5:29, YLT). It's most of them because "narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it" (Matt. 7:14, KJV).

You got blood on yo' face

Christians Have Blood on their Faces: Christianity's abominations are mixed with the blood of Jesus along with the blood of others, so that Jesus says the following to Christians:

When you did these things and I kept silent you thought I was exactly like you. But I now arraign you and set my accusations before you (Ps. 50:21, KJV).

When ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: [because] your hands are full of blood. Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow (Isa. 1:15-17, KJV).

While Christians think they're innocent, they are *covered* in blood. For example, having watched the towers disintegrate before their eyes and thousands die in 9/11 of 2001, they *refused* to take God seriously and repent at that time so that much blood has since been shed, "running into the millions" according to Brown University's Costs of War Project.

Yet if we would have repented as a group—like the PAGAN king of Nineveh led his people to do, for example (Jonah below)—God would have "healed the land" (2 Chron. 7:14, KJV). He says:



If my people, which are called by my name [as in **Christ**ian] shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land (2 Chron. 7:14, KJV).

Jonah 3:6-10, NIV When Jonah's warning reached the king of Nineveh, he rose from his throne, took off his royal robes, covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the dust. This is the proclamation he issued in Nineveh...Let everyone call urgently on God. Let them give up their evil ways and their violence. Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish. When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he relented and did not bring on them the destruction he had threatened.

In other words, this pagan had more discernment than today's born again Christians!

You big disgrace Wavin' your banner all over the place

Christianity's Banner Waving: Christianity is a huge disgrace yet still waves the so-called Christian banner all over the place, wrongly, rudely, and hypocritically protesting in the streets—so cocky! Yet God says "What right have you to recite my laws or take my covenant on your lips? [Since] You hate my instruction and cast my words behind you" (Ps. 50:16-17, NIV). Again, God has used this ministry to reveal that's what the body of Christ is doing since I haven't been able to get through to even one person in over *two decades!*






Pagan Banner Waving: Everyone who rejects Christ and flaunts their point of view all over the place is guilty. "For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low" (Isa. 2:12, KJV). Those gay pride parades are prophetic.

We will we will rock you (Sing it) We will we will rock you

Again, certain passages are repeated to express God's passion, again referring to Joseph's proclamation that its "because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). It is "the great and dreadful day of the LORD" (Mal. 4:5, KJV). It will be a "great" day because it's the day Jesus returns to earth to begin His kingdom reign when all who "had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands...[will] reign...with Christ a thousand years" (Rev. 20:4, KJV). And it will be a "dreadful day" because all who did not become born again will "die in and [thei]r sins" (John 8:21, KJV) "be hurt of the second death" (Rev. 2:11, KJV). So, ultimately, "we" in We will rock you refers to the Father and His Son.



Buddy you're an old man poor man

The Elect are Old and Poor: The lost cry that Christians are unloving while *they're* super unloving. And Christians cry how loving they are while they're even more unloving than the lost, being spiritually proud and, therefore, blind. It's an old poor/sad story that goes way back to the Garden of Eden because "by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin...so [that] death [and sin] passed upon all men" (Rom. 5:12, KJV). In turn, "We [followers of Christ] ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another" (Titus 3:3, KJV).

Through Christ, the elect have to learn to do what God said through Paul "our old man is crucified with [Christ], that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin" (Rom. 6:6, KJV). The more we rely on Jesus, daily reading, believing, and *applying* His Word to our lives, the more successful we are—the more that old and poor man disappears. But even the born again have been super unfaithful so that Buddy is a very old man.

And while the born again who walk more closely with the Lord will give in to those old ways now and then, since we have God's Spirit within and we're constantly seeking Him, "though [w]e may stumble, [w]e will not fall, for the LORD upholds [us]" (Ps. 37:24, KJV). It works best when "We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, NIV). And since the body of Christ as a whole has not been in the habit of doing that, we've become a very *poor* man. While "jointheir[s] with Christ" (Rom. 10:17, KJV), relying on ourselves rather than on God we've been living like the prodigal son who squandered his wealthy father's inheritance relayed to us in the following passage:

A certain man had two sons: And the younger of them said to his father, Father, give me the portion of goods that falleth to me. And he divided unto them his living. And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living. And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want. And he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country; and he sent him into his fields to feed swine. And he would fain have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him. And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants. And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him (Luke 15:11-20, KJV).

Satan is Old and Poor: Satan was created before humans so that he's really old. We know he was created before Adam because Scripture says the following:

Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell me, if you understand. Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it? On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy? (Job 38:4-7, NIV).

While he's the "anointed cherub" (Ezek. 28:14, KJV) Satan's actually really poor since he fell from heaven as Jesus said, "I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven" (Luke 10:18, KJV). Therefore, when he gets "cast down to the lake of fire" (Rev. 19:20, CLT), all who are there will say to him "Art thou also become weak as we?" (Isa. 14:10, KJV). In God's Plan I go through my understanding of the "lake of fire" since it's not hell. It's a place of refinement.

Unbelievers are/will be Old and Poor: All the non-elect "vessels of wrath fitted to destruction" (Rom. 9:22, KJV) along with all the elect who will die having rejected Jesus or who gave Him nothing more than lip-service will become old and poor because everyone lives forever since Jesus has "reconciled all things unto himself" (Col. 1:20, KJV).

However, since Jesus doesn't reign forever as Christianity teaches but "he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet" (1 Cor. 15:25, NIV), it's clear to me that the rewards and treasure the born again followers of Christ earn during this life for the next is only good the ages. After than, at the end of the ages, everyone will be on equal ground. We'll all have finally matured enough to be like Christ who shared everything with everyone and said "All things that the Father hath are mine" (John 16:15, KJV). In other words, when all the ages are over everyone who has ever lived with have that mentality. We'll all finally love to share everything since we'll fully understand that it *all* actually belongs to our Father and we are *all* His children.

Concerning the ages, or at least the millennial reign of Christ, Jesus said "Whoever does not have [God's Spirit, dies without His Spirit so that], even what they have will be taken from them" (Matt. 25:29, NIV). Therefore, He says "I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear" (Rev. 3:18, KJV). Apparently, in the next life/next age (or ages), *everyone* will know how little we valued Jesus so that God refers to it as walking around "naked." That's pretty poor.

Pleadin' with your eyes

Pleading with the eyes while having self-centered motives is the same as giving lip-service, summed up by Jesus in the following passage:

Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men. Therefore, behold...the wisdom of their wise men shall perish (Isa. 29:13-14, KJV).

So while God sees right through it, He overlooks it since "He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities" (Ps. 103:10, KJV)—in part. While "the Lord is slow to anger...[He] will not leave the guilty unpunished" (Nah. 1:3 below).

In other words, today's body of Christ—especially the hirelings—are like "the Pharisee [who]...prayed: 'God, I thank you that I am not like other people...I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get" (Luke 18:11, NIV). The majority of the body of Christ today is pleading God with their eyes while keeping their hearts far from Him, justifying themselves. "They measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves [so that God says] they are not wise" (2 Cor. 10:12, NIV).

Gonna make You some peace some day You got mud on your face, Big disgrace Somebody better put you back into your place

Due to God's grace and Jesus' work on the Cross, all *will* have peace one day in spite of our wicked ways. Because "if the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed" (John 8:36, KJV). And Jesus *has* set everyone free through His work on the Cross, Scriptures I walk through in *God's Plan*.

Somebody is Jesus: *Somebody* is going to put everyone back in their place "for God resisteth the proud" (1 Pet. 5:5, KJV) and "the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son" (John 5:22, KJV).

Somebody is Me: I'm *somebody* even though I'm a *total* nobody: no friends, no one in my family to talk to, no paid job since I work for the Lord alone without pay and have done so for two decades, no extended family, *NOTHING*. What I do have is fellowship with Jesus which is actually all that really matters. He's nailing the point through the ministry He's entrusted to me. He says "God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong" (1 Cor. 1:27, NIV).

Somebody is God's Church: *Behaving* like the Queen She was created to be—since Jesus is the "king of kings" (Rev. 19:16, KJV) and our "Maker is [our] husband" (Isa. 54:5, KJV)—Christianity will finally conquer evil put Satan in his place—at least concerning the Church, a remnant thereof. Because, "greater is he that is in [the born again], than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4, KJV). And God informed us that this was His purpose:

To make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: To the intent that now **unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places [Satan and the fallen angels, to them] might be known by the church [through born again Christians] the manifold wisdom of God, According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord (Eph. 3:9-11, KJV).**

Again, a remnant within the reformed Church will put Satan and the fallen angels in their place, at last—for a season. God says:

I will give power unto my two witnesses [the faithful who were originally Jew or Gentile], and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days [3½ years], clothed in sackcloth [repentant]...These have power...to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will (Rev. 11:3-6, KJV).

As explained in *God's Plan*, these plagues are really the born again *not* actually honoring Christ. But, they will still help many lost elect souls SEE that Jesus is God. Jesus said "He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John 14:12, KJV). Jesus didn't send plagues on people.

He healed them. But in the same way that Peter lacked grace when he was born again so that he cursed Ananias and Sapphira and they died (see Acts 5), many born again in the last days will still continue to lack grace. Cursing people to death is not a work that honors God but Satan since "him that had the power of death, that is, the devil" (Heb. 2:14, KJV). Jesus is the One who will *completely* put Satan in his place. He'll "cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years...be fulfilled" (Rev. 20:3, KJV).

And, again you see the repetition—with mud on face and big disgrace—as taught throughout the Bible, means that God is stressing the point since we're such a royal mess and total disgrace. He says "Go, wash...therefore, [and when they] washed, [they] came [back] seeing" (John 9:7, KJV).

We will we will rock you, Sing it We will we will rock you, Everybody, We will we will rock you We will we will rock you, Alright

There's *loads* of repetition "doubled...[more than] twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV).

The Ending. There's a long instrumental ending, which is actually a transition since they often play this song immediately followed by *We are the Champions*, which God has also had me interpret. It's all about how long it's taken God's Church to get to this point—and we're not even there yet! "Willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, [God has] endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction...that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy [the elect], which he had afore prepared unto glory" (Rom. 9:22-23, KJV). And that will be especially true for the remnant who takes Him more seriously in these last days. So God hasn't just endured the "vessels of wrath" (Rom. 9:22, KJV), the non-elect, God has had to endure the "vessels of mercy" (Rom. 9:23, KJV), the elect, including the born again! Because, it's just as He says, "the heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) and "there is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom. 3:10, KJV).

It's also about how long this part of my calling has taken—over two decades!

And we wouldn't even be at this point if not for God's unmerited grace. Left to our own devices, we would have annihilated ourselves *long* ago!
