







This video/tract is the first of a playlist I've called Joy While Waiting. The Man I'm with is the Lord Jesus Christ/aka Yeshua/the Messiah since He says "If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour" (John 12:26, KJV). He's a Man of color since Scripture says "He that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone" (Rev. 4:3, KJV). Those stones are the color I've made His face. And if He was of color so were the original Hebrew Israelites. There's PLENTY of proof as I share in my material and the most thorough resource is the following documentary: Watch Hebrews to Negroes: Wake Up Black America | Prime Video (amazon.com). It matters since the truth matters, and buying into the White lie has caused us some serious problems as I cover elsewhere. However, like the rest of "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) the producers of that documentary have swallowed some of Satan's lies—but on this point the evidence is extensive.




Born again in 1988, a decade later, in 1998, the Lord made my calling clear to me, detailed in the free books on my website.




So while I've been waiting for the Lord's "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV), obeying Him to speak up on His behalf and hold professing Christians accountable, I've experienced the fellowship of the Lord.



I'm not just saying that like Christians do. My life testimony *reveals* it as shared in my material.




Because of "the body's of Christ['s]" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV), this calling has been an *extremely* isolated and lonely one. Working for the Lord, I don't have a paid job, so I have no money of my own, no co-workers, no family or friends who are interested in Him...nothing.



But, the closer you walk with Him, the better you get to know Him, the more spiritual discernment you have. That's the trade off. The born again have to choose whom they will *serve*, either "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV) or the Lord Jesus Christ who says "My kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36, KJV). It's a choice we make every minute of every day!



Walking closely with the Lord for over a decade, born again for two decades, in 2009 He started giving me interpretations of non Christian songs, books, and movies, as with Edge of Tomorrow (2014), showing me how they tie in to what He's saying and doing and what we've done and need to do. The one thing I do have is "the joy of the Lord [which] is [my] strength" (Neh. 8:10, KJV). I'd already been making loads of connections for nearly two decades between my life, this world, and what God is saying, but these popular and/or readily available resources make it easier for "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) to see that I'm a true prophet and super easy for you to "fan into flame the Spirit of God, that is in you" (2 Tim. 1:6, NIV)—which is a big part of His purpose through this ministry. Having told me to "Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it" (Hab. 2:2, KJV, my emphasis), once you make some of these connections you're going to be SUPER FIRED UP for the Lord! And that's exactly what the world needs, therefore what "God [who] is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) has provided.



In 2012, having led me to yet another local institutional church in the DC metro area where I live, He had me write a book for that leadership, as He'd had me do many times before. More than a decade into it I was crushed when the Lord showed me that they also wouldn't 'get it' since they were so rebellious and it wasn't the "appointed time" yet. But He used that pastor to tell me I'd experience joy while waiting. I was thinking that joy would be at the beach since I'd decided to take a break and go out there for the day—since I do love the beach and desperately needed a break.



But that's not what God had meant. He was giving me joy through some resources, which are pretty funny. And, one of them had my name on it—and it was ALL ABOUT this calling.




Having gone to the library to get a book on tape for my road trip to the beach, I'd first stopped in the sale section asking Him if He had anything for me, since He often did. That's when I saw it, a 32 page cartoon children's book which parallels this calling and what "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) is doing.




On this video playlist and through the tracts, I'm summing up the biblical interpretations with a bit more detail than I did on the slide for *Edge of Tomorrow (2014)*. Some of them are pretty long, so to get the full scope of it you can download the PDF books from my website—if it's already up. (I'm having to rework them to incorporate additional things the Lord has revealed to me over the last few years.) And since the more I look at them, the more I see...they could *all* be pretty long. I've toned them down on this playlist/these PDF tracts to make them as "plain" (Hab. 2:2, KJV) as possible—without deleting the joy of it.




While Christians tell me I'm nuts or otherwise not right with God, it's obvious that's not the case. Rather, it's exactly as He says (Hos. 9:7). It's professing Christians who are "nuts" for not taking God seriously so that we as a group are WAY OFF target, that group being "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV).



And what I'm doing is what Christians sing about, since it's what the Bible teaches (Col. 1:16).




The reason most born again Christians are oblivious to God's hand in the world around them most of the time, is because we've fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3). We've hit the bottom of the barrel. Today's "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12: 27, KJV) is made up of the worst hypocrites the world has *ever* known! We're an EXTREMELY dysfunctional Family!



We're not even hitting the dartboard when we should be hitting the bullseye!



Most born again are like the man in this graphic, SUPER PROUD and blinded by TONS of beams in their eyes! Because, what Churchianity teaches is in MANY ways *extremely* contrary to what Jesus taught and what the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) teaches. For instance, while Christians go on and on about having "accepted Christ" He says "You did not choose me, but I chose you" (John 15:16, NIV).



For a greater example, while "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) for most of Christian history "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has been teaching that He's going to burn most of the people He created—since "broad is the road that leads to destruction" (Matt. 7:13, NIV)—and they'll feel all of that pain for the rest of eternity! Christians have this split personality view of God when He says—and they preach—"I the LORD do not change" (Mal. 3:6, NIV). It's Christians who have a split personality, like Jekyll and Hyde, as my testimony clearly reveals.



Even hardened convicts wouldn't have called the man who set his child on fire a loving man! And yet the body of Christ says God is even worse than that! How exactly does burning people alive amount to love? What we've been saying is that God is actually worse than Satan! Because, he only has a "short time" to hurt people (Rev. 12:12, KJV). For most of Christian history the born again have NOT been engaging their brains! (2 Cor. 10:5)—not even remotely. And I'm absolutely NOT saying I'm smarter or purer than anyone else—as I get accused. I'm hardly that! (I'm heaps dumber than loads of people and just as twisted as everyone else.) The only thing different about me is that I'm the one God is using for this part of His plan. It's just like the chip I just ate out of my bag of chips. I didn't even give it a second's thought as to which one I'd eat since they're all the same. In other words, "there is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom. 3:10, KJV). Today's Christians totally don't 'get' that since they are heavy duty idolaters of the "hireling[s]" even though Jesus warned us these paid professionals "care...not for the sheep" (John 10:13, KJV), for example.




James convened the Hampton Court Conference, where a new English version was conceived in response to the problems of the earlier translations perceived by the Puritans,<sup>[6]</sup> a faction of the Church of England.<sup>[7]</sup>

James gave the translators instructions intended to ensure that the new version would conform to the ecclesiology of, and reflect the episcopal structure of, the Church of England and its belief in an ordained clergy.<sup>[8]</sup> The translation was done by 47 scholars, all of whom were members of the Church of England.<sup>[9]</sup> In common with most other translations of the period, the New Testament was translated from Greek, the Old Testament from Hebrew and Aramaic, and the Apocrypha from Greek and Latin. In the Book of Common Prayer (1662), the text of the Authorized Version replaced the text of the Great Bible for Epistle and Gospel readings (but not for the Psalter, which substantially retained Coverdale's Great Bible version), and as such was authorised by Act of Parliament.<sup>[10]</sup>


Part of it also has to do with the Bible translations. I explain it in detail in my free books, especially *God's Plan* and *Listen!* 



I've summed up my understanding of the Bible on the playlist and electronic tracts I've called *Scripture in Pictures*. In *many* ways it's quite different than Churchianity's understanding.



And my understanding is NOT perfect because the system God set up for this part of the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) **REQUIRES** that we function as a group, "the body" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV), "submit[ting] to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, NIV) and no one is willing to talk to me about the Lord **much less** work with me.



To see more than you're currently seeing in relation to the Lord, it would help you to watch my playlist *Scripture in Pictures* before this playlist since doing so will help you see the biggest "beam[s]" (Matt. 7:5, KJV) you have in your eyes so that you can *remove* them and make the same connections I've made. That's how "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) will finally answer the Lord's high priestly prayer "That all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John 17:21, KJV). Right now the lost look at Christians—those who are "born again" (John 3:7, KJV) and those who only think they're born again (Matt. 7:22-23 below)—and look at Christ, and either think the whole thing is ludicrous/not reality or that it's OK to "worship" God however we please since that's what the body of Christ has historically modeled for the world.

God is giving us a HUGE measure of grace *before* all hell breaks loose worldwide, "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be" (Matt. 24:12, KJV)—as He prophesied concerning the "latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV). The Bible reveals that the greatest revivals not only come during the greatest periods of rebellion but with the greatest trials. Therefore, during the former rain "there was a great persecution against the church" (Acts 8:1, KJV). And the latter rain is a much *greater* outpouring of God's Spirit than the former rain since God called that one *moderate*. And we're getting it because of God's grace having reached the lowest point of rebellion in history.

Matthew 13:30, KJV Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.


Joel 2:23, KJV Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain.

Matthew 13:39, KJV The enemy that sowed them [the tares and all their lies] is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Ephesians 5:25-27, KJV Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.



The Lord has had me back up every single point with Scripture in relation to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV). All you need to do is be honest—after all we're dealing with the One who is the Truth (John 14:6). Therefore, "speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ" (Eph. 4:15, NIV, my emphasis). As my life testimony reveals "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) does NEITHER. As a group we don't speak the truth and we sure don't do it in love! Today's Christians have it all backwards because while I'm speaking the truth in love—not yelling at anyone or being otherwise hateful (like them)—they rebuke me for being hateful and not speaking the truth! In other words, Christians, like the lost, are "call[ing] evil good, and good evil" about which God says "Woe unto them" (Isa. 50:20, KJV).



The following was the passage I chose for our wedding in 1989 as a newly born again Christian, and it's what the Lord is doing—will be doing at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV):

> God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause his face to shine upon us; That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations. Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us. God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear him. —Psalm 67, KJV



If you're gonna ride with Him, hang on tight because "with madness he driveth" (2 Kings 9:20, YLT)—and who can blame Him considering how we have "trampled the Son of God underfoot...[and] treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant" (Heb. 10:29 NIV).
