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This tract is part of my video playlist, *Joy While Waiting*. I explain what I'm doing on the first video and tract. Basically, according to the Bible God is speaking to us all the time through everything and using it for His purposes (Col. 1:16). In order to hear His voice you have to be "born again" (John 3:7, KJV), honest, and know the Scriptures. If you're born again but not honest about what God has revealed in the Bible, you'll be just like the lost who hear a voice they think is God's when it's "the forces of evil" (Eph. 6:12, NIV) deceiving you. It would help to watch at least the first handful of videos on my playlist *Scripture in Pictures* since I'm trying to NOT be repetitive.



Knowing the voice of the Lord, working on something for Him over a decade ago in 2009, for some reason I remembered this song. Having downloaded the lyrics, in no time I'd interpreted the whole thing. I've summed it up on this tract.



This road I'm on is a "dark desert highway" because "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has fulfilled the "rebellion" which God said would take place before the Lord's return (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV below). It's a "highway" because I'm on "the way" (John 14:6, KJV) who is "high and lofty" (Isa. 57:15, KJV)—I'm "born again" (John 3:7, KJV). There's "cool wind in my hair" because the Spirit—"a rushing mighty wind" (Acts 2:2, KJV)—is exceptionally cool as He's revealing anew through this ministry, especially these interpretations. And He's "in my hair" because He won't leave me alone—and it can get annoying—that's what the expression means, You're getting in my hair. It's annoying only because no one else can yet discern what I've discerned—and it's been over two decades!

2 Thessalonians 2:3, NIV Don't let anyone deceive you in any way, for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs.



"Colitas" means little tails. It's the word my mom used when I was about 11 and she was chasing my brother through the living room to beat his bad little behind. There's a "warm smell of colitas rising up through the air" because when God's "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV) finally comes to open up this ministry loads of Christians are going to be 'getting it' from the Lord. Their colitas are "warm" because they're getting a beating (spiritually speaking) and also because that beating will change their hearts so that they'll no longer be "cold" (Matt. 24:12 below) as they have been.


Matthew 24:12, NIV Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold.




The "light" I see is "the light of the world" (John 8:12, KJV) the Lord Jesus Christ. He's "in the distance" because He's given me a prophetic ministry so that I've been waiting for over two decades for Him to fulfill the main promises He's made to me about my life on this earth. He used many to prophesy that I'd be having a Joseph Experience speaking of Joseph of the Old Testament who was hated, betrayed, set apart, imprisoned...and used "for the saving of many lives" (Gen. 50:20, NIV). The Light, the Lord, is "shimmering" because part of the definition of that word means "wink." Through my walk with Him, the Lord has revealed His fun loving nature since "He who is sitting in the heavens doth laugh, The Lord doth mock at them" (Ps. 2:4, YLT). And He's got good reason to mock "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 23:27, KJV) since we haven't taken Him seriously. Christianity is made up of the biggest hypocrites the world has ever known!



Because Christians have been so cold and unbiblical—and downright mean—this graphic sums up frequent stops along the way. "My head grows heavy" with heartache and "my sight grows dim" because of the tears. But my head also grows heavy because of all the information He downloads since it carries so much responsibility. It's like a line from a poem I wrote about my mom for an English class in college, "ankle shackled to ball and chain that has your name."




My sight growing dim also refers to "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) making me struggle with my faith since we weren't supposed to have to go against the grain of the lost and of all of the born again—of everyone—including all immediate family members. While I was born again a decade before, it wasn't until the late 1990s that the Lord called me to start speaking up to professing Christians holding them accountable to His Word, about which He said, for instance, "When you tell them all this, they will not listen to you; when you call to them, they will not answer" (Jer. 7:27, NIV). So that's how it's gone, most have totally ignored me, and the few who have acknowledged me have been cold as ice—while professing to know and love the Lord.



Stopping for the night is not only the need to physically stop work and rest but much more so because of the body of Christ's extreme "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV). It's like we're living in the darkest dark ages. I have to stop because of the night/the level of darkness we're living under. It's too hard to keep going full force every day, day after day, year after year, all alone against the grain. So the more time has passed, the more 'stops' I've been taking—which is the last thing any of us should be doing! Rather than "encourag[ing] one another daily" (Heb. 3:13, NIV), today's Christians, including those who are actually born again, discourage those of us who are following Christ. Jesus says "I am the door of the sheep" (John 10:7, KJV) and "I am the way" (John 14:6, KJV). In other words, He's the "doorway." I'm standing in the doorway because I'm in Christ, not only "born again" (John 3:7, KJV) but "walk[ing] in the Spirit" (Eph. 5:16, KJV).




The "mission" is the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-20). And the "bell" is the alarm. The Lord says "Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for **the day of the Lord is coming**. It is close at hand—a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and blackness. Like dawn spreading across the mountains, a large and mighty army comes, such as never was in ancient times nor ever will be in ages to come" (Joel 2:1-2, NIV, emphasis). He's talking about great tribulation (Matt. 24:21). And "the day of the LORD is coming" refers to both the Lord God, the day of the Lord's return and also the Lord Satan and the day of his greatest evil against humanity. I walk through it most thoroughly in Satan Exposed: Rightly Dividing the Word. In other words, the Spirit isn't warning us about the Lord Jesus Christ but about Lord Satan "god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV).




This is essentially the definition of conviction combined with revelation, what it feels like. It feels something like "Heaven" because there's freedom in Christ (John 8:32). But it feels like Hell because we finally admit what we've known all along about ourselves—and it ain't good (Jer. 17:9). So it's really both. But, if you're honest about it—both about yourself and about the Scriptures—it's ultimately Heaven, as in heavenly. In contrast, if you're not honest with yourself about yourself and about the Scriptures, it's ultimately Hell, as in hellish. In fact, for many, especially the "hireling[s]" (John 10:13, KJV)—all of those supposedly spiritual professionals—for those who are or become born again, even their heavenly outcome will be quite hellish (Luke 12:47). Even for those who are honest it can be hellish because, typically, the closer you walk with the Lord the more Satan and the rest of "the forces of evil" (Eph. 6:12, KJV) come after you. The difference is that honest born again souls "obtain a better resurrection" because of it (Heb. 11:35, KJV).




The body of Christ's historical "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV) has left the world in spiritual darkness. By giving me this ministry, the Lord is having me *light up the candle and show people [starting with professing Christians] the way,* the way back to the Lord, "the truth" (John 14:6, KJV) and, therefore, the way to the "latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV), as well as the way to get through the "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, KJV) successfully.




While Churchianity is all over the place on this, Scripture seems to reveal that the rapture happens right before the worst part of the tribulation, around thirty minutes to be more exact according to the following passage. "When he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour" (Rev. 8:1, KJV). I walk through my understanding of it in *God's Plan: A Vision for the Body*.



Since God stands outside of time but humanity lives in it, "the corridor" refers to time—past, present, and future. When we get right with God and make up our mind to no longer turn a blind eye to our own sins or to the sins of others, the Lord starts reminding us of His hand on our lives throughout our lives, even before we were born again. He helps us see how everything we've experienced—in fact, everything and everyone—connects to His master plan and how we fit into it. He does it, not get us all proud like a puffer fish, but so we can fulfill the "good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in" (Eph. 2:10, KJV). God speaks to us directly through His Word and through people, anyone or anything. We know it's ultimately coming from Him IF it lines up with the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV). Again, if it doesn't it's "the forces of evil" (Eph. 6:12, NIV) trying to deceive you. And if you don't take your thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), you will be deceived.



Rather than being honest, today's Christians attribute being held accountable to the truth as coming from Satan, often quoting Romans 8:1, ignoring the most important part of it since many of the translations deleted it. It says, in the literal and in the King James, "There is, then, now no condemnation to those in Christ Jesus, who walk not according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit" (Rom. 8:1, YLT, my emphasis). Christians are ignoring the Lord because the New Testament makes it clear throughout.



So looking back in time, this graphic sums up the corridor of my life. It ties in to what Henry Blackaby, author of *Experiencing God*, wrote about in relation to what he called spiritual markers. Every memory we have which we can tie in to what God has said and is doing or will do—in relation to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV)—is a spiritual marker. The more connections we make, the better our understanding of what's really going on not only in our own lives but in reality—in the life of the Church and in the world at large.




So while Satan is using just about everyone to deceive us, able to do so since they **don't** "demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and...take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, NIV), God says "I am the LORD; I change not" (Mal. 3:6, KJV).



Through this ministry the Lord is pulling out the Welcome Wagon for all who'll take Him seriously. You didn't just think you heard those voices, you did, just like the boy Samuel (1 Sam. 3:4-11 below). "Hotel California" is this legendary hotel in San Diego. Hotel Del Coronado means the hotel of the crowned one, that One is Jesus (1 Tim. 6:5, NIV). "We're being welcomed to a hotel because our lives on this earth are just a short layover. He warned us saying "Pass the time of your sojourning here in fear" (1 Pet. 1:17, KJV) because Satan is "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV) and he's "a murderer" as well as a massive "liar and the father of it" (John 8:44, KJV). But even born again Christians have ignored the Lord and lived for Satan's world. And it's called Hotel California because California means hot furnace as in "God is a consuming fire" (Heb. 12:29, KJV), His fire of truth and conviction consumes our sinful nature.

1 Samuel 3:4-11, NIV The Lord called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am." And he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." But Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." So he went and lay down. Again the Lord called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." "My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." Now Samuel did not yet know the Lord: The word of the Lord had not yet been revealed to him. A third time the Lord called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." Then Eli realized that the Lord was calling the boy. So Eli told Samuel, "Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening." So Samuel went and lay down in his place. The Lord came and stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening." And the Lord said to Samuel: "See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle.


Looking at 1 Samuel 3:4-11, it's exactly the same today. Like Eli today's "holy priesthood" (1 Pet. 2:5, KJV) —the born again—can't discern that God is calling, and He's about to do something through this ministry that will make the ears of everyone who hears about it tingle.




Hotel California, the Lord's "hotel"—biblical Christianity—is a very "lovely place" (Gen. 41:32 below) because it's not only about genuine love, "love feasts" (Jude 1:12, NIV), it's about experiencing the presence of the Lord in the greatest possible measure during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT), even though we can't see Him—for those who take Him seriously.

Genesis 41:32, KJV Doubled...twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.


In this song and throughout this ministry the 'message' has been repeatedly doubled *more* than twice. In other words, God is seriously stressing the point. In this song, through the biblical interpretation of it, He's making the point of welcoming the saints back to the Truth.




There's no lovelier face than His so that it doesn't even matter what He allows because of who He is and what He's done for us—which most of today's Christians are actually totally clueless about! Therefore, so is the rest of the world. Most Christians, including those who are actually born again, have Jesus as their Ticket Out of Hell which they keep in their back pocket—and that's it.



While Christians chase people away from the Lord and from the supposed churches and Christian groups, those people, buildings, and groups do NOT actually represent Him since the whole system is satanic, as was confirmed in 2001 when God had Frank Viola and George Barna publish *Pagan Christianity*. The Church Jesus is building is of "living stones" (1 Pet. 2:5, NIV), people who genuinely love Him and others (Mark 12:30-31), including their "enemies" (Matt. 5:44, KJV). So real Christians—"born again" (John 3:7, KJV) who are "walk[ing] in the Spirit" (Gal. 5:16, KJV)—don't chase people away who love the Lord!



Whatever you need whenever you need it, you can find it in Him since He is "The Lord our God" (Mark 12:29, KJV) "Maker of heaven and earth" (Ps. 115:15, KJV)!



While everyone likes to tell me or view me as if I'm nuts, just like they told some others "Thou art mad" (Acts 12:15, KJV) and "Much learning doth make thee mad" (Acts 26:24, KJV) since they had either very little faith in God or none at all, my mind is twisted with the Truth (John 14:6, KJV) which is like "a pearl of great price" (Matt. 13:46, KJV). My mind has been "refine[d]...as silver is refined" (Zech. 13:9, KJV) the kind of stuff Tiffany & Company sells, very costly. In fact, it's cost me everything as He said it would (Luke 14:33).




People get the *bends* (decompression sickness) from coming up too fast. The Lord gives me *the bends*—gets me laughing or crying, or both at the same time—by constantly taking me for a Ride from my world to His back and forth. Its like this graphic because the body of Christ is "dead" asleep in a coma (Rev. 3:1) *when* we're coming up on the worst period in all of human history "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world…nor ever shall be" (Matt. 24:21, KJV). He gives me *the bends* because **FOR OVER TWO DECADES** it's been like the following passage when dealing with Christians, many of whom I discern are actually born again:

When Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils. And she went and told them [that the Lord had appeared to her]...And they...believed not (Mark 16:9-11, KJV).

Because of Christianity's "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV), I NEED the bends. And they're of the *Mercedes* type because they're such high quality being that they come from God our "Maker" who is my "husband" (Isa. 54:5, KJV) spiritually—my Hero, a *very* Hot Dog. This graphic sums up the only line I ever had in the only play I was ever in, which sums up my life testimony, "Out of the fire and into the frying pan!"

^{*}Mayi (pronounced MaGee) is what they called me growing up—not far from MaJo.



"Pretty, pretty" is pretty derogatory. Again, the Lord is mocking "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) because it's pretty as in weak and cowardly—doubled for emphasis. While today's body of Christ is made up of heavy duty haters who are just like the lost, since "the love of most [has] grow[n] cold" (Matt. 24:12, NIV), Jesus was willing to die a brutal death for them. And He calls the born again "friends" (John 15:16, NIV). Therefore, even though they've been super hateful, I still consider them my friends—even though they totally don't act like it right now. What I've gone through is what Jesus went through for ALL of us. "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8, NIV)—He just went through it in a much more extreme fashion. Much more! And the really amazing part of it is that He did it **KNOWING** this is how even the born again would treat Him for most of the past 2000 years!



The 'courtyard' under the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV)—which all of humanity is under—is the born again's own heart. Because, "we are the temple of the living God" (2 Cor. 6:16, NIV). The ministry the Lord has entrusted to each born again soul is a hot coals ministry. He says, "If thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head" (Rom. 12:20, KJV). Because God is "gracious" (Ps. 86:15, KJV) being that "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV), this particular ministry will feel like they're dancing on hot coals because they'll actually be pretty happy for having been granted such grace and forgiveness, especially considering the trials we'll soon be facing. It's "sweet" because of the impact it will have not only on those individuals (2 Cor. 7:10), but on the world—the greatest reformation of all of history, "the latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV). It's about "summer" because rather than being iceberg cold as they have been, Christians—at least a decent sized remnant—will finally be warm, even hot with a passionate love for God and, therefore, for people. And it's about "sweat" because everyone will be sweating bullets at both being exposed and as we get into the "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, KJV).




Convicted, the born again will ask the Lord to remind them of everything they've done that has offended Him, which He'll do (John 14:26). And they'll also beg Him to forgive them for what they've done, which He'll also do (1 John 1:9).




While even born again Christians treat God as if He's our servant, we are supposed to be His servants (Luke 12:37)! Christ is "the captain of [ou]r salvation [who was made] perfect through sufferings" (Heb. 2:10, KJV). Therefore, it'll be likewise, for each and everyone of us. The wine is "the new covenant in [His] blood, which [wa]s poured out for [us]" (Luke 22:20, NIV). And The Satanic Bible by Anton Lavey was published in the United States in 1969, revealing the very dark character of this nation even though God granted us the most compared to the rest of the world. And it's hard to compete against Satan's spirit when even the born again reject the Spirit of the Lord, as He's revealed through the New Testament, through the book Pagan Christianity, and through my life testimony. It's impossible! The ONLY reason I'm still "stand[ing] firm in [my] faith" (Isa. 7:9, NIV) is because of Him and His purposes (Eph. 1:11 below). And I just now realized that 1969 is the year I had a season of nightmares of being thrown into a pit while living in California, not only was that the same state where Anton Lavey was living, it's my Christian testimony since it's what the brothers (read brethren) did to Joseph (Eph. 1:11 below)—doing it for not submitting to Christ but, instead, letting Satan use them.

Ephesians 1:11, KJV [God] worketh all things after the counsel of his own will.



No matter what we do, God, who uses everything and everyone for His purposes (Col. 1:16 below), is ALWAYS reaching out to us knocking on the door of our heart (Rev. 3:20).

Colossians 1:16, KJV For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him.



The voice of the Lord and His servants, either supernatural or human, will wake you up in the middle of the night if need be, just like the angel woke Joseph out of sleep in order to keep Jesus from being killed (Matt. 1:20 & 24). Rather than roll over and blow Him off, as even born again Christians do (Eph. 4:30 below), we need to pay attention because He's trying to *help* us.


Ephesians 4:30, NIV Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.



While Christians have made God out to be a monster worse than Satan with our doctrine of Hell, Scripture says "I the LORD do not change" (Mal. 3:6, NIV). And He revealed through Jesus' life—through the gospel books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—what He's really like since "the Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being" (Heb. 1:3, NIV, my emphasis). Therefore, since "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) what He had the angels say to the shepherds 2000 years ago He continues to say today—even to the outrageously "rebellious" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV) body of Christ. In fact, especially to the body since we are the ones He aims to use as His "labourers" for the "harvest" (Matt. 9:38, KJV).




The Lord is *nailing* His point (Gen. 41:32) since He's "the carpenter" (Mark 6:3, NIV). He's going to smash the body of Christ's stone cold hearts with that sledge hammer—smash them to bits! So lovely.



"The body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) will finally take God seriously so that He will fulfill His purpose for His Church as we've been informed in the following passage:

Christ...loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:25-27, KJV).


While this ministry *shouldn't* be a surprise to the body of Christ, because of our historical "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV), it is—a very "nice surprise"—once the born again get past their guilt. When the saints start walking *closely* with the Lord and interpreting resources for themselves—for porking out on the Truth who is "food" (John 6:55, NIV)—they'll finally be "living it up" *loving God and one another* (Mark 12:30-31) not only feeding themselves but feeding others, as you see some doing in the graphic.




An *alibi* requires evidence which is what the Spirit is telling us to bring, proof that we're actually "born again" as He said we "must be" (John 3:7, KJV). So while born again Christians know that the only reason anyone gets to enter the kingdom of heaven is because of the work Jesus did on the Cross, since they don't obey Him it's hard to tell if they're actually born again. "Many" professing Christians will hear Him say "I never knew you" as we're told in the following passage:

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (Matt. 7:22-23, KJV).

People that aren't born again can prophesy, cast out devils, and do many wonderful works including miracles because their "coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders" (2 Thess. 2:9, KJV).




The New Testament says "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like" (James 1:22-24, NIV). So, in one way there are two mirrors on the ceiling, the Father and the Son, who are always watching us through the looking glass, the "firmament"




And because "His name is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, KJV) and every Christian professes to believe it, believe Him, there are as many mirrors on the ceiling as there are professing Christians. Yet even the born again have historically **NOT** done what God requires of us! (Matt. 17:5 & John 13:34-35).



When He was here Jesus said "I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom" (Matt. 26:29, NIV). Now He's telling us by way of His Spirit that it's already "on ice." Look into it because the evidence that He's coming back soon is over the top, as I cover in my material which is the compilation of many people's material.



What He's had me do is place everything against the Scriptures in relation to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) weeding out as much of the lies and misunderstandings as possible while working alone since no one will even discuss the Lord with me. So I know that my current understanding *isn't* 100% correct since the system God set up for this part of the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) **REQUIRES** that we work together "submitting...ourselves one to another in the fear of God" (Eph. 5:21, KJV).




To put someone on ice means to hold them back, postpone, delay. God is keeping us from the full blown "latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV) because we're so rebellious. He says "The showers have been withholden, and there hath been no latter rain [because] thou hadst a whore's forehead, thou refusedst to be ashamed" (Jer. 3:3, KJV)—which is my testimony of more than two decades.




Honoring Christ is a choice the born again make every minute of every day. And choosing to do so during the climax of the body of Christ's "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV) amounts to living in a prison of total social isolation, a prison without walls. That's what I've been doing. It's what we did for years as a family but eventually my children and husband joined the crowd of rebellion. And when God finally opens up this ministry and the born again get convicted, they'll make the choice to stand alone or mostly alone against the grain of rebellious born again, against the grain of professing Christians who aren't born again, and against the grain of the lost who reject Christ. We do that not by being hateful but by standing apart, as He says "Come out from among them, and be ye separate...touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you" (2 Cor. 6:17, KJV).




Another way to look at it is that we—humanity—are prisoners here in Satan's New World Order/"great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, KJV)—of our own device for not having taken the Lord seriously historically. Because, He clearly informed us that all we had to do was "submit...ourselves...to God. Resist the devil, and he w[ould have had to] flee" (James 4:7, KJV). So the Lord gave me a biblical interpretation for the song We are the Champions by Queen and it's like Satan is thanking us all for having given him fame and fortune and everything that goes with it. And because not all Christians are actually born again, and even not all born again will repent when called to do so, many will keep on fighting til the end, til the very day Jesus returns. God prophesied about it through an evangelist, Tommy Hicks, which I read in the following video: Tommy Hicks Vision for the Church in the Last Days — YouTube. It's exactly what I've walked in for the past two decades because it's a vision of the history of the Church. But it's also prophetic of what's yet to happen.



The "master's chambers" are the bodies of the born again since Christ is the "Master" (Matt. 23:10, KJV) and "[w]e are the temple of the living God" (2 Cor. 6:16, KJV), "God's building" (1 Cor. 3:9, KJV). Gathering for the feast refers to uniting in Christ and in biblical prayer as we should have been doing all along.



This is what scholars have called the Lord's High Priestly prayer, it was that important (John 17:21)—and yet we've TOTALLY ignored Him! And the Father won't answer the Lord's prayer until we do our part which includes acknowledging those He's using as opposed to chasing them away.



Now that it's outrageously obvious that He's coming back soon, and convicted for having been so unfaithful, the body—at least a decent sized remnant—will finally do what needs doing to prepare for "the marriage supper of the Lamb" (Rev. 19:9, KJV).




Their "steely knives" are "the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God" (Eph. 6:17, KJV). While we can overcome the enemy with this steely knife we can't kill "the beast" (Rev. 11:7, KJV). Only God can do that. But, it looks like—according to Scripture, as I cover in God's Plan—He's not actually going to do that. What He's going to do is "destroy" his evil nature—just like He's doing for all human beings, by the end of "the ages" (Eph. 2:7, KJV) so that "God may be all in all" (1 Cor. 15:28, KJV). Eventually everyone God created—supernatural (angels) and natural (humans)—will live in submission to God, 100% willingly and completely so that we have a kingdom that is better than any of us can even imagine. It's the reason He allowed all the pain and suffering, to show us how much we desperately need Him and what He's actually done for us. Rather than kill Satan and all the fallen angels He's going to change them, or so I discern. I don't see "God [who] is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) having created anything in order to destroy it. Because, He's "the Creator" (Isa. 40:28, KJV) whereas Satan is "the destroyer" (1 Cor. 10:10, KJV). Unlike those who still preach the doctrine of Hell, I no longer see God behaving like Satan.



Unlike Christians who argue about little details while totally missing the Big Picture (Matt. 23:34), I view Satan along with all of his supernatural ministers, the fallen angels, as one, "the forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV). And every human being who isn't in submission to the Lord, which includes most born again today—actually all since we're not functioning as the united body of Christ—is serving the beast! We're helping Satan hurt us all!



This is the "last thing" you'll remember because it's the most important thing you'll do with your life, especially during our day. You'll be "running for the door" constantly and in increasing measure, going "in and out" (John 10:9, KJV) like I've been doing for three decades. We go in to become "born again" (John 3:7, KJV). But then we go out because we *live* in this world, we're stuck here. But we go back in the door because we live in this world ruled by Satan "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). We go in and out and always find pasture—"food" (John 6:55, NIV) for the "sheep" (John 10:27, KJV)—because the Lord is not only with us but **IN** us since "the Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, NIV). Needing to find the passage back to where you were before is speaking about the initial shock of realizing/getting convicted of what you've done, the desperate need you'll have to not want to admit it to yourself. But ultimately it's about returning to your first love (Rev. 2:4), that "place" where you were "before" you fell away from the Truth, before your "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV).



The "night man" is a "ministering spirit...sent to serve those who will inherit salvation" (Heb. 1:14, NIV). He's of the "night" because we live and he serves during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) an age of darkness. He, and all of the Lord's angels who did not rebel, "are programmed" to, again, "serve those who will inherit salvation," in other words "receive" (Matt. 28:5). While the last two lines of the song sound ominous, they're actually a huge blessing for the born again! While we can "check out any time," as just about all have done historically by allowing ourselves to be lured away with "the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches" (Matt. 13:22, KJV), we "can never leave" because nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ (Rom. 8:37-39) including ourselves! Hallelujah!
