




Jesus warned us that the "hireling[s]...care...not for the sheep" (John 10:13, KJV). Yet for most of Christian history "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has been looking to the hirelings to learn God's ways! In turn, we've fulfilled the "falling away" and "rebellion" of which God prophesied before the Lord's return (2 Thess. 2:2-3, KJV & NIV). There's hardly anything "Christians" are saying or doing today that lines up with God's Word, more specifically the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV). And a major lie the body of Christ preaches is the pagan doctrine of hell.



This graphic sums up what the Bible teaches as I currently understand it. There was a season before time began—before the ages—since God created time for us and He stands outside of it. Therefore, there's also a period after time, after the ages.




The born again are supposed to speak the hidden truths about God and what He's done (1 Cor. 2:7, YLT). So that's what I'm doing—to the best of my ability. Before "the ages" God foreordained everything to come. That doesn't mean that He planned evil. Since Scripture says that God "worketh all things after the counsel of his own will" (Eph. 1:11, KJV), I discern He envisioned what His created beings would do, both supernatural and human, then, like any good writer—and He's "the author...of our faith" (Heb. 12:2, KJV)—He worked out all the details so as to end up with an amazing "story." The best ever. In other words, God coordinated all of our sins into His Master Plan working it all out for His glory and the good of all, in the end—speaking of the end of the ages.




"Christ is the head of the church, his body" (Eph. 5:23, NIV), and Scripture says "all things were created by him" (Col. 1:16, KJV). Therefore, I discern that, before the ages, the "Father" (John 10:30, KJV) who is "the invisible God" (Col. 1:15, KJV), begat His Son "the only-begotten God" (John 1:18, CLT & NASB). Then, like Napoleon who put out the challenge for someone to come up with a better way of preserving food for the reward of a sum of money, the Father challenged His Son to come up with the details of the Plan and put it into motion. Except rather than do it for money, Christ did it for love, love of the Father and love of all He created (Col. 1:16 below)—because "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV). Colossians 1:16, KJV For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him.



Through this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) along with the next age, God is revealing how "desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) humans are, even when we're born again as He has me covering in the free books He's had me write (Hab. 2:2-3 below) found on my website <u>www.notmocked.com</u> having had me follow Him through the so-called churches and Christian groups for over three decades.


Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV [Having asked Him what He wanted me to do with my life in the late 1990s] the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.



They're so-called churches because those institutional buildings we've called church for centuries do not represent the church Jesus is building (1 Cor. 3:9 & Acts 17:24 below). God made that clear to our generation two decades ago by having Frank Viola and George Barna publish *Pagan Christianity: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices*. Jesus did not give up His life for a pagan Church! Rather, He gave it up for one that is "holy and without blemish" (Eph. 5:27, KJV). And we're *hardly* that today! 1 Corinthians 3:9, KJV Ye [born again] are God's building.

Acts 17:24, KJV God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands.




During the next age, the Age of Christ, the millennial reign, God will be *further* revealing how "desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) humans are since *Satan will have been bound for a thousand years* (Rev. 20:2, KJV) and the mortals of that time will also have the resurrected Lord and resurrected saints helping them just like the resurrected Lord helped the disciples on this earth between the time of His resurrection and ascension (Acts 1:3). Yet, having lived in Paradise, no "forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV) to deceive anyone or lead people astray, "when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison...[and] gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea" (Rev. 20:7-8, KJV).



In other words, that group of mortals will have blown it even worse than born again Christians of this age blew it. And we blew it worse than the Jews blew it. In other words, no matter how good God makes it for us, we *still* behave "desperately wicked[ly]" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). We are all "impostors" (2 Tim. 3:13) since we give Him lip-service but our hearts are far from Him (Matt. 15:8).

*The born again at least initially obeyed the Lord so that they received His Spirit, as we're told "the Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, NIV). However, while having become born again, most have not been *followers* of Christ.



During the final age, what I've called Age of Judgment, everyone including the fallen angels—who rejected Christ and "practised the evil things [will be]...rising again [for] judgment" (John 5:29, YLT).


1 Corinthians 15:24-28, NIV Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power...then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all.

Romans 5:19, NIV For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.

Colossians 1:19-20, NIV For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

1 Corinthians 15:22-25, NIV For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him. Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.


1 Corinthians 15:28, NIV When he has done this, then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all.




Those "rising again to judgment" (John 5:29, YLT) will suffer the second death (Rev. 2:11). It's what the born again suffered during this age by dying to self since "we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may also be revealed in our mortal body" (2 Cor. 4:11, KJV). And during the millennial reign of Christ, Age of Christ, those mortals will also have to choose between good and evil, truth and lies, become born again and follow Christ. However, not all will since we're told, for example, that during that time "the one who fails to reach a hundred will be considered accursed" (Isa. 65:20, NIV). "And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea" (Rev. 20:7-8, KJV).



Because of the work Jesus did on the Cross, everyone is getting a "Get Out of Jail Free Card," so to speak. Some used it during this age by becoming "born again" (John 3:7, KJV), some will use it during the next age, and the rest during the Age of Judgment. Rather than get sent by "God [who] is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) to eternal fire burning hell as Churchianity teaches, God will punish them for their crimes.




No loving father would set their child on fire and God, our Father, who "is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) is much more righteous and loving than humans. He's "holy" (John 17:11, KJV).



God severely punished the pagans and Israelites for burning their children in the fire and He's no hypocrite. When King Ahaz "burnt his children in the fire, after the abominations of the heathen...the LORD his God delivered him into the hand of the king of Syria; and they smote him, and carried away a great multitude of them captives" (2 Chron. 28:3-5, KJV). This graphic reveals what they were doing, placing their children in the hands of this hot furnace while banging loud drums so as to muffle their babies' cries. Teaching and believing in the doctrine of hell Christians are saying God's ways are just like humanity's ways, as in "desperately evil" (Jer. 17:9, KJV).




God knows when exactly the doctrine of hell was invented but hell isn't in the literal Bible translations. However, it's part of the King James Version which appears to be the mother of most English Bible translations—and I'm guessing most translations worldwide. And those translators were **not** serving King Jesus but King James—whose translation appears to have had a big hand in popularizing this false doctrine.




By teaching the false doctrine of hell, the body of Christ has been *calling evil good and good evil* (Isa. 5:20). We've made God out to be more evil than humans and even Satan! Because, Satan doesn't burn people alive forever like we've been saying God is going to do. By teaching the doctrine of hell we deny what God has taught us through Christ's life! For example, we're supposed to forgive others (Matt. 5:44) but God won't do that—which would make Him a ROYAL hypocrite! But He's not a hypocrite and made it very clear that He hates hypocrisy by how Jesus rebuked the Jews for it (Matt. 6:16, 15:7, 16:3, 22:18 etc.). We know the Father also hates hypocrisy because Jesus said "My teaching is not my own. It comes from the one who sent me" (John 7:16, NIV).

There are more passages to consider, which I include in *God's Plan*, but here are three of them comparing two literal translations (the Concordant and Young's) with the King James.



While no human being or fallen angel is worthy of eternal life, we all get to live eternally with God in Paradise because of the work Jesus did on the Cross. "God did so love the world [not just the Christian hypocrites], that His Son—the only begotten—He gave, that every one who is believing in him may not perish, but may have life **age-during**" (John 3:16, YLT, my emphasis). Those who rejected Him during this life will have "life that is truly life" (1 Tim. 6:19, NIV), not during the next age, but after the judgment when they too come into subjection (Heb. 2:8). I cover my understanding of this more thoroughly in *Listen!* and *God's Plan* but that's the gist of it. And I don't cover it in great detail because the Bible doesn't give us great detail.




Also, there is plenty of other work to do during this age than focus on the next one. In order to fulfill the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19-20 below) and God's will for His Church (Eph. 5:25-27 below), the body of Christ first needs to *mature*.

Matthew 28:19-20, YLT Disciple all the nations, (baptizing them—to the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all, whatever I did command you,) and lo, I am with you all the days—till the full end of the age.

Ephesians 5:25-27, ESV Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.



The doctrine of hell is clearly NOT the Truth as revealed by God in Scripture. It's a monstrous lie we've been fed by the "hireling[s who] careth not for the sheep" (John 10:13, KJV) or for the Shepherd. "This is the message that we have heard from Him, and announce to you, that God is light, and darkness in Him is not at all" (1 John 1:5, YLT)—and the doctrine of hell is about as dark as it gets. Even hardened criminals must have viewed what Mr. Rothenberg did to his son—setting him on fire—as outrageously evil. Yet that's what Christians are saying of God who "so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son" (John 3:16, KJV). He's supposedly so evil that He's going to set most of the people He created on fire and burn them alive for the rest of eternity even though "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV). It makes absolutely no sense because no one can even come to Christ unless the Father draws them (John 6:44). So God doesn't draw people to Christ and then He's going to torture them forever for not coming to Christ! Christians are clearly not engaging their brains (2 Cor. 10:5).



The fact is that during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) God *isn't drawing* everyone to Christ (Acts 13:48). Some are "vessels of wrath fitted for destruction" (Rom. 9:23, YLT). God is using them for His purposes. If it weren't for God's intervention we'd *all* be vessels of wrath since "there is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom. 3:10, KJV). And it's not as if God has been unfair to them because they'll be able to get right with Him during the last age when "those who practised the evil things [will be] rising again of judgment" (Acts 5:29, YLT). And it's not as if God *made* them do the evil things they did. Those were choices they made, just like we all make bad choices and have to suffer the consequences.



Left to ourselves, we would ALL eventually become just like the most hardened criminals. The LOST proved that with the 1970s Stanford Prison experiment. 
What God is doing is proving how foolish "the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory" (Rom. 9:23, KJV), the elect, have been during this present evil age since we had the opportunity to become born again and close followers of Christ. Yet most didn't become born again and those who did didn't become close followers of Christ—which is why the world is in the mess that it's in today.



According to Scripture, the born again are the most responsible for the state of the world today because, unlike the lost, we have both the knowledge and the power (Acts 5:32 below) to submit to God which would have forced Satan to flee (James 4:7). And while most Christians speak of *elect* as meaning *born again*, that can't possibly be the case since Paul said "I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation" (2 Tim. 2:10, KJV).

Acts 5:32, NIV The Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him.

Acts 1:8, NIV You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you.
