

The Lord is speaking through everything (Col. 1:16) so that it's not just about the lyrics. It's also about the *way* in which it's being said. For one thing He's "mock[ing]" (Ps. 2:4, YLT) the "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV). For another, He's motivating the born again "to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you" (2 Tim. 1:6, NIV)—doing it so that we finally fulfill our calling.




So it starts off with the lead singer, who represents "the head of the church" (Eph. 5:23, KJV) Jesus Christ, asking if they're ready. And they're all like *Yeah*. This is exactly how it is because Jesus says "Be ready" (Matt. 24:44, NIV) and Christians are like *Yeah*, we're so ready when that's the furthest thing from the truth!




Nobody is ready for His coming because the lost are lost and the born again have been unfaithful historically so that most who think they're born again *aren't* as Jesus prophesied in the following passage:


Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (Matt. 7:22-23, KJV).



As my testimony reveals, and the testimony of others as well, born again Christians reject their brethren when that's totally unbiblical. "God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be" (1 Cor. 12:18, NIV).




At best, historically, most born again Christians have gotten "saved; yet so as by fire" (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV). They weren't ready.



And we're certainly not ready today since the body of Christ is in the worst shape we've *ever* been in! While we should be hitting the bullseye, we're not even hitting the target!



The music starts off with the door banging. It represents the Lord who has been banging on the door of our hearts all of our lives.




Once you get right with God—no longer ignoring your sins or the sins of others—asking Him to remind you of the times He was knocking, He will. Christ says "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you" (John 14:26, NIV).




The wipers are wiping even though there's no rain because we want to be able to *see* (Luke 10:23). The Lord says "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God" (Matt. 5:8, KJV). To be "pure in heart" we "must be born again" (John 3:7, KJV) AND walk in the Spirit (Gal. 5:16, KJV). In other words, don't walk in the Spirit and you *will* fulfil the lust of the flesh as the body of Christ has historically done and is currently doing.



At the only so-called home church the Lord every gave me, Eagle Church in Indianapolis, Indiana—they loved to say "God is in the details!" even though they couldn't even discern the most obvious ways in which He was speaking and revealing Himself. Still, God *is* in the details so that He's mocking us with those monstrous microphones, speaking through the guys banging, as well as through those chimes (1 Kings 19:12), for example. It's as Jesus said "I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out" (Luke 19:10, KJV). And every Christian knows Christians hold their peace; they do NOT evangelize. So the stones, chimes, and songs are all crying out as He has me revealing.




The Lord led me to Eagle in the late 1990s when I'd been born again for a decade, leading me there to teach me through them and to also begin this prophetic ministry, using them as an example of how unrighteously the body of Christ behaves. Because, before and after that there's never been any better. They represent the norm. While the born again do sometimes behave better, hardly any *ever* do when held accountable to repent concerning the state of the Church. But one day more will.



The wiping wipers are also 'acting' prophetically, as if preparing for rain, "the latter rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV)—the greatest outpouring of God's Spirit during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). It's like how I've been praising the Lord for over two decades for what He's done when He hasn't actually done it yet—speaking of giving the born again eyes that see that He's using me to begin this rain and not actually nuts as everyone seems to think I am.




That sudden revving up is what's going to happen with the body of Christ, His Church, when the Lord finally opens up this ministry (Hab. 2:2-3).




The old pianos on their side represent the state of the Lord's Church. It's in total disarray when a big part of the reason Christ suffered brutally on the Cross was to make Her holy (Eph. 5:25-27, KJV). Yet the last 2000 years along with the last two decades of my personal experience as He's called me to hold Christians accountable is that Christians adamantly "refuse to blush with shame" (Jer. 3:3, NIV).




The Lord is mocking the body of Christ in a couple of different ways. For one, Christians talk about Him as if they're the one's in control as with how they go on and on about having "accepted Christ" when He very clearly says "You did not choose me, but I chose you" (John 15:16, NIV). If anyone has been "accepted" it's us by Him! So it's not as if He's been waiting on us—and not just months and years, but centuries. What He's done is stood back letting both professing Christians who aren't born again along with those who are born again waste *their* lives away (Ps. 18:26). It's a judgment for not having taken Him seriously.




By teaching that we accept Christ it's like Christians are saying the Lord is this dumb, that He has left it up to sinners to do what only He can do! (Eph. 2:8). In other words, He's basically saying there ain't much that's dumber than His Girl, the body of Christ! And not just for this reason, but because for 2000 years, given the completed Word of God, His Spirit within (the born again), and in the United States, total freedom to worship Him as required "in Spirit and in truth" (John 4:24, KJV) for the entire history of this nation, we've still gotten it all wrong so that today's Christians can't even tell the difference between a true and false prophet, just like most Jews couldn't 2000 years ago! And they had none of these benefits.



While getting saved, most born again will have nothing or next to nothing to show for themselves, and to enjoy for the next 1000 years at least, probably much longer. Instead, they'll walk around as if "naked." He warned us (Rev. 16:15, KJV). That warning works for both the lost and the born again—just at different times, different ages. (The whole doctrine of hell is an unbiblical pagan notion which I cover elsewhere.)



Jesus, by way of His Spirit, is singing of His Girl, since "the body of Christ" (2 Cor. 12:27, KJV) will soon be the Bride of Christ. Paul said "I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ" (2 Cor. 11:2, KJV). And He says "I am married unto you" (Jer. 3:14, KJV). In His eyes it's as if we're already married since He stands outside of time. And yet we have the brazen look of a prostitute (Jer. 3:3, NIV).



The body of Christ is a spoiled BRAT (Beauty Run Amuck Today) *and* a WHORE (Woman Hiding Our Righteous Energy) since She lives for this world rather than the Lord's kingdom. And this world is Satan's world since he is "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). It's like he's Her pimp.



The Lord still needs us, however, because He has purposed to work through the born again/body of Christ to reach the lost and fulfill the Great Commission (Matt. 28:19). And He's mocking His Girl, the body of Christ, since He doesn't actually *need* us to do anything! That's kinda the point about Him being God Almighty.



He's let us go on this long in our rebellion so that we can finally understand what we're REALLY like and what exactly He's done for us. Therefore, "getting is another" *thing—not* the thing Churchianity has made of it. He'll be revealing that He'll be getting His Girl through the work **He's** doing, which He's doing by humbling the mess out of the body of Christ through the ministry He has entrusted to me.



This long segment starts with a turn and ends with them coming out of a tunnel and making another turn. It's about the *centuries* of darkness we'll be coming out of and the turns/the changes the body of Christ will be making (Jer. 26:13). While the Lord Himself does no evil, He does hand us over to Satan, His servant, as a disciplinary measure, as the following New Testament passages reveal:


Hand this man over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved on the day of the Lord (1 Cor. 5:5, NIV).

Among them are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan to be taught not to blaspheme (1 Tim. 1:20, NIV).

Being handed over to Satan is for our own good. But it would have been MUCH BETTER to have obeyed the Lord in the first place so that He wouldn't have had to hand us over to him!




Again, He mocks us (Ps. 2:4) since He knows *every* DETAIL of what we've been doing—and it's mostly bad! It's the body of Christ, the born again, who have been *sitting around wasting their time* because "unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labor in vain" (Ps. 127:1, NIV).



And actual sitting around *is* all they do in those so-called church services. He made it crystal clear to our generation that what we've called Church for centuries is **not** the Church He's building. He did it by having Frank Viola and George Barna publish *Pagan Christianity: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices,* the pagan satanic roots.



And because they don't walk closely with the Lord Christians, like the lost, do *wonder what He's been doing* mostly angry with Him for not doing what *they* want! Yet He's the One who has every right to be angry with us for not doing what He died for us to do.



More mocking since He's the most forgiving of all. Not only did He forgive those who tortured Him to death *while* they were doing it having prayed "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34, KJV), He also forgave us for treating Him as we have for the last 2000 years (2 Thess. 2:2-3)!



But He's not just mocking us. He's also *picturing someone else living*, His Girl "hav[ing *finally*] put off the old man with his deeds" (Col. 3:9, KJV).



As we've been informed through Joseph, repetition of the prophetic Word means that "the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). Except this stanza is repeated three times in the song and not just doubled. Therefore, God is stressing the following:

- 1. His need for us,
- 2. The senselessness of waiting on us, and
- 3. The *other* thing He's going to do which is to do it Himself.

As Scripture says "He saw that there was no one, he was appalled that there was no one to intervene; so his own arm achieved salvation for him, and his own righteousness sustained him" (Isa. 59:16, NIV). While He's using me, the ONLY reason He's able to is because of His work in my life. If not for Him, I'd be just as far from Him as everyone else since "there is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom. 3:10, KJV).



Getting enlightened, you see the guy with a pretty big smile on his face which is what those who have ears to hear will have on their faces (Neh. 8:10).



So the antenna thing going up symbolizing the ears of the born again finally perking up.



That brings us into a long segment that first has that long tunnel and then quite a bit of discordant music. It parallels the long segment of discordant Christianity and all the heartache it's caused billions of people and animals (Rom. 8:22, KJV) when all we had to do was "submit…ourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he w[ould have had to] flee" (James 4:7, KJV). The world is in the mess that it's in ultimately because of the born again since God gave us the knowledge and the power to make Satan flee and to model for the lost what needed to be done. But we didn't.



Having *left Her first love*, the Lord models what the body of Christ, His Girl, needs to do which is to put it in reverse (Rev. 2:4) returning to those initial days when we became born again *for* having obeyed Him. Since "the Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, NIV), the "latter rain" outpouring of His Spirit (Joel 2:23, KJV) will also be given to *those who obey Him*.



The Lord is also expressing His heartache because of our intense hypocrisy. He warned us that His "kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36, KJV) and that "the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word [so that we] become...unfruitful" (Matt. 13:22, KJV). But His Girl has ignored it all for being focused on living for this world, Satan's world! Again, it's Satan's world because he is "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV).



Again with the repetition emphasizing what God is saying. So while He's calling His Girl the dumbest dummy who has ever lived, He's also emphasizing His love for Her *anyhow*. It's a Hosea Gomer thing.



While He says "What good's that gonna do?" concerning the needing aspect of it, He's got it under control because "getting is another" thing. And "with God all things are possible" (Matt. 19:26, NIV). Getting the Girl He wants is actually NO PROBLEM for Him. He's a Catch!



So as they come to the end of this third repetitive stanza, the car speeds up and *flies* down the last tunnel for a crash ending. It's exactly how we're ending this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). Having a clear vision of what God has actually done—as He's revealed bits and pieces of it to different people which He's had me pull together under 'one roof' so to speak, the Lord's Girl will finally be eager to fulfill Her calling. So as the born again finally repent confessing of a multitude of sins that dirt will go flying all over the place. And we're ending because of the onset of the "great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be" (Matt. 24:21, KJV).



Having crashed and come to the end of the ride, the one guys asks if they got it to which someone else replies "God it." However, considering that today's Christians can't even tell the difference between a true and false prophet and how hard hearted and stubborn today's Christians actually are when confronted with the truth, "Got it" is a *prophetic* statement. The Lord's Girl *will* get it—eventually. She'll 'get it' at God's "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV). Halleluyah!



There are more details, in fact, the more you look the more you see. God's Word hidden in plain sight is just like a microscope or telescope. When we *take our thoughts captive to Christ* (2 Cor. 10:5) the vision of what God has done, is doing, and saying is endless! But, I did take it a bit further than this in the booklet linked on the first page. I don't usually look at the original interpretations when I make the tracts and videos, so they're not exactly the same. So there's the video, the book, and the tract—and they're all slightly different with more or less information provided in each.
