



God's 7000 Year Plan, Part 6 of the Playlist Prophecy Unsealed


We're in the Last of the Last Days. Christians talk about the last days coming or recently having started when according to the Bible we've been in the "last days" for the last 2000 years. I know that without a doubt because 2000 years ago the apostle wrote "in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son" (Heb. 1:2, NIV). We're now in the very *last* of the last days. And you can clearly see why looking at the graphic.




Father Time. Because God stands outside of time, "one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day" (2 Pet. 3:8, KJV). As "the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending" (Rev. 1:8, KJV), it's as if He is Father Time. But, actually, He's the Father of it since "all things were created by him, and for him" (Col. 1:16, KJV).



Authors of Confusion. Not having obeyed the Lord, historically, and done so in increasing measure, "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has fulfilled "the falling away" and "rebellion" prophesied of in 2 Thessalonians 2:3 (KJV & NIV respectively) which He said would take place/be fulfilled before His return, His second coming. So while "God is not the author of confusion" (1 Cor. 14:33, KJV) humans are. More specifically, professing Christians. Even more specifically, the "born again" (John 3:7, KJV) "body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV). We've made a royal made out of the Gospel message!



A God of Parables and Parallels. Anyone who knows the Bible knows He loves parallels. Through this ministry He's revealing that **EVERYTHING** parallels what He has said and is doing and what we've said and done—and will do. Because, God "works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will" (Eph. 1:11, NIV)—has worked it all out that way.



The Good News About Our Rebellion. While commissioned to make disciples teaching them to obey everything He's taught us (Matt. 28:19-20 below), born again Christians have instead rebelled against Him in increasing measure so that "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV), the Lord's Church, is in horrible shape today—the worst ever. We're at the YOU ARE HERE mark. The good part about it is that He said this is exactly what would happen before His second coming "for that day will not come until the rebellion occurs" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV). This presentation *has* made it clear that we've fulfilled it. So it's one more confirmation that His return is just around the corner.

Matthew 28:19-20, NIV Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.



Day 1 of Creation and It's Parallel. Having created light (Gen. 1:3-5 below) God separated it from the darkness. This parallels humanity's separation from God which took place because the first humans disobeyed Him. Except I discern the first humans disobeyed the one they *thought* was God, the one who "was a murderer from the beginning...and a liar and the father of lies" (John 8:44, NIV)—Satan *masquerading* as the most High (2 Cor. 11:14 below) having set out to "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) so that he "deceive[s] the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV). As explained on the video, all three Father, Son, and "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV) can technically be called Lord God. In any case, this is the account of what happened:

The LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die" (Gen. 2:16-17, NIV). But "when the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it" (Gen. 3:6, NIV). In turn, "God saith, 'Lo, the man was as one of Us, as to the knowledge of good and evil; and now, lest he send forth his hand, and have taken also of the tree of life, and eaten, and lived to the age,' [and]...he casteth out the man" (Gen. 3:22-24, YLT).

In the latter part of this presentation (lightly covered on the video for this part) I go over my understanding of what I discern actually took place—why Christians have continued to believe the lie.

Genesis 1:3-5, NIV God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.

2 Corinthians 11:14, NIV Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light.



Day 2 of Creation and It's Parallel. Having separated the waters with a "firmament" (Gen. 1:6), with the flood you see a separation being made between His chosen and those not chosen—during "the present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). 
We can either acknowledge that we've been deceived and become an earnest seeker of truth, or keep on believing Satan's lies—which is what most people will do just like a mother who discovers her husband has been sexually abusing their child. Just pretend all is well. Sooner or later everyone who does that will find out how well that worked. It didn't. While seeking truth, you have to remember there is a brutal spiritual war taking place with the fallen angels (Eph. 6:12 below) who use humans (2 Cor. 11:14-15 below). The only way to get past the layers and layer and layers of lies—hundreds of layers!—is to "take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, NIV). You can't just go by your own opinion because your heart just like everyone else's is "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV).

Ephesians 6:12, NIV For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.


2 Corinthians 11:14-15, NIV And no wonder, for Satan himself masquerades as an angel of light. ¹⁵ It is not surprising, then, if his servants also masquerade as servants of righteousness. Their end will be what their actions deserve.



Day 3 of Creation and It's Parallel. In the same way that God gathered the waters together during Creation (Gen. 1:9), He gathered them when He helped Moses flee the Egyptians—just as He'd done at the end of the flood. It was either God who was helping Moses or Satan "masquerad[ing] (2 Cor. 11:14, NIV) as "the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) in order to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV). Satan has the power—along with the rest of the fallen angels—since God has given him "all...authority" (Luke 4:6, NIV) and we've been informed that "the working of the Adversary [is] in all power, and signs, and lying wonders" (2 Thess. 2:9, YLT). Just think about all the killing "God" had Moses and the Israelites do considering that "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) and says "I change not" (Mal. 3:6, KJV)—would Jesus have killed or tortured anyone?! Besides "him that had the power of death, that is, the devil" (Heb. 2:14, KJV).



Day 4 of Creation and It's Parallel. The two great lights God made, a greater one for the day and lesser one for the night (Gen. 1:16) parallel the ministries of Christ—THE "light of the world" (John 8:12, NIV)—and John the Baptist who prepared the way for the Lord's first coming (Matt. 3:3). It also parallels the work of Christ and of the leading antichrist, Lord Satan, since Jesus' work is "for the day" whereas Satan's work is "for the night" being that "everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed" (John 3:20, NIV).



Day 5 of Creation and It's Parallel. God created life on the fifth day which parallels the outpouring of His Spirit beginning at Pentecost (Acts 2:17-18 below) since it wasn't until that point that all elect have been enabled to enter God's kingdom by becoming born again (John 3:3 below). When faithful, God's Spirit within—which He calls "living water" (John 7:38 below)—enables us to bring life and healing both physical and spiritual, most clearly revealed in the book of Acts.


Acts 2:17-18, NIV In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy.

John 3:3, NIV Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again.

John 7:38, NIV Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.




Day 6 of Creation and It's Parallel. Having created the first humans "God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it" (Gen. 1:28, NIV). And because we are "desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) we've done it in the most cruel and abusive manner possible lacking respect for God, for self, for others, for animals, and for the environment. Historically we've done exactly what He prophesied we would do. And because "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) has fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, NIV), the world today is in the worst shape morally we've ever been in—speaking of the whole world (to one degree or another) and not just a segment of it. Scripture foretold what we would do. "People worshiped the dragon because he had given authority to the beast, and they also worshiped the beast" (Rev. 13:4, NIV). In fact, "all inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life" (Rev. 13:8, NIV). But God didn't guarantee that those people—the elect—would not worship the beast just because their names were written in the book, Scripture also says "the one who is victorious will...be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life" (Rev. 3:5, NIV, my emphasis). And to be "victorious" the first step is to become born again, as I've been trying to get across. Don't take God seriously enough to become born again and even though your name was written in the book God will blot it out.



Day 7 of Creation and It's Parallel. Having finished His work of Creation, God rested on the seventh day which parallels His millennial reign. The following passage speaks of it. It's written a bit oddly so I spliced and edited it to get at the gist of it:

[About] entering into his rest...unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them [speaking of the unbelieving Jews]: but the word preached [to them] did not profit them [as it did us], not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. [But] we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said...God did rest the seventh day from all his works...and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief...[Therefore] To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts (Heb. 4:1-7, KJV).

Don't harden your heart against God if you want to experience the millennial reign of Christ, a very unique and blessed time period in all of God's plan when both human and resurrected humans will inhabit the earth. It will be a time of "rest" for resurrected humans/called saints because our bodies and minds will no longer experience fatigue. In a way it will also be a time of rest for the humans who haven't been transformed yet since they'll be living in a world where there are no fallen angels as we've had during this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) while also having the Lord and all of the resurrected saints physically there to help them.




No Life vs Life. Those who become "born again" get to enjoy being part of the Lord's reign during the next age which He calls "the life that is truly life" (1 Tim. 6:19, NIV). But there's an aspect of it that we can enjoy immediately because we are given God's Spirit (Acts 5:32 below) which, combined with God's Word/the Bible gives us "the mind of Christ" (1 Cor. 2:15, KJV). And since Christ is "the way, the truth, and **the life**" (John 14:6, NIV, my emphasis) having His mind is about as alive as anyone could possibly be during this age. We have the mind of Christ in that we have access to it through His Word and Spirit—so **when** "we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, NIV). In the same way that He is one with the Father (John 10:30 below) we can be one with God—our heavenly Father—through Christ, through God's Spirit and His Word. And if a group of born again followers of Christ were actually fully engaging their brains (2 Cor. 10:5 below), we'd really be living the life! Except that's not how it is, but it will be for a short period at the end of this age.


Acts 5:32, NIV The Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him.

John 10:30, KJV I and my Father are one.


2 Corinthians 10:5, NIV We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.




Days of Work vs Days of Rest. Because of the system God set up during the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT), everyone has to work. Even if you're rich you should be working, doing the "good works, which God prepared in advance for [you] to do" (Eph. 2:10, KJV)—speaking of the elect—so that you can enter God's day of rest and begin enjoying the "life that is truly life" (1 Tim. 6:19, NIV) right now while you're alive on this earth. God's kingdom is entered by becoming born again (John 3:3). Doing so we see what others can't see, not only that Jesus is God but His hand in the world around us which He has me thoroughly revealing through this ministry and which I touch on in this presentation. He says "Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand" (Matt. 13:13, NIV). That's why (partly why) no one can make many of the connections I've made—even though they're obvious. They're spiritually blind. Therefore, rather than work for Christ, they work for the leading antichrist, Satan, "god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). And that work will amount to absolutely NOTHING in the end. While you guys get a paycheck and I don't, I'll actually be getting a much greater paycheck than if I'd worked for pay my entire life. Or God's a liar. And He's no liar. It's Satan the god of this world who's the liar, a massive liar!



Life is in the Blood. Everyone past grade school (even before then) knows that "the life of a creature is in the blood" (Lev. 17:11, NIV). That's why Christ gave it up, so that we can actually live. While not everyone will get to enjoy the millennial reign of Christ, they will get to enjoy eternal life in Paradise once they have also suffered "the second death" (Rev. 2:11, NIV) as I'm explaining on this presentation.



Christ is the Rock of Ages. I walk through this graphic towards the end of the playlist for *Prophecy Unsealed.* I also provide the Scripture references on that PDF file.




Come Up Hither. There are two meanings to this: one now, one later.

Now—Rise Up to the Challenge Set Before You by not taking offense (Matt. 11:6) and be informed of what's coming down because the rest of the passage (Rev. 4:1) says "and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter." "Set your affection on things above" (Col. 3:2, KJV) and God will give you a prophetic edge. And the challenge is to win the race. God says "Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize" (1 Cor. 9:24, NIV). And the prize is Christ/God, knowing Him. He says "I am thy...exceeding great reward" (Gen. 15:1, KJV).

Later—Meet the Lord at His Second Coming as we're told in the following passages:

[Speaking to the local body of Christ the apostle wrote] Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality (1 Cor. 15:51-53, NIV).

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord (1 Thess. 4:16-17, KJV).



The Very End. I walk through the last hour of this age on this playlist, *Prophecy Unsealed*. And that last hour begins with the Lord's return, calling up those who honored Him during this age, again referring to the following passage, what commonly called the rapture of the Church:

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord (1 Thess. 4:15-17, KJV).

The fist in the graphic is Lord Satan's. The wrath of God is expressed through Satan and the forces of evil since God has given them "all...authority" (Luke 4:6, NIV). "The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness" (Rom. 1:18, KJV). Right now the born again are receiving that wrath along with everyone else for holding the truth in unrighteousness. And after the rapture, the rest will receive the climax of it for the same reason since "the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen...so that they are without excuse" (Rom. 1:20, KJV).



We are at the End of the Age. There is plenty of evidence, both in the Bible and in the world, that we are at the end of the age. It's so obvious that even the lost can see it so that Damian Kulash sings a beautiful song about it. And if you are discerning you can hear God's voice in it. OK Go - Damian Kulash Covering Lavender Diamond's "Everybody's Heart's Breaking Now" – YouTube.

The following are the clearest passages on our rewards (Rev. 22:12):

Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it (Matt. 7:13-14, KJV).

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire (1 Cor. 3:11-15, KJV).

Look to yourselves [speaking to the born again], that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward (2 John 1:8, KJV).



It ALL Ties in. God has worked ALL THINGS out for His purposes (Eph. 1:11) so that I used the *Dropbox* app logo to represent our rewards because it's the same. We store our data 'in the cloud' as in "in heaven" which is what God has told us to do in the following passage:

Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also (Matt. 6:19-21, KJV).


It's not as if our data is actually up on some clouds, right? It's in another dimension we can't see, just like we can't see infrared light with the naked eye. Same thing. God, along with our heavenly treasure—for those who've stored it—are right here in a dimension we can't see, at least not yet. And no one else can store treasure in heaven for you, earn those rewards for you. This is something we must each do for ourselves, no matter what else anyone thinks or says. It's what reveals whether we actually believe in Him or not. If we believe Him, since it's so amazing, we'd appreciate it. In other words, what we do with our time reveals our level of faith in Him.



A Rebellious Body of Christ. Because we're living in the very last of the last days, even though you can walk in the truth before born again Christians who KNOW the truth, they will still turn on you—as they've done to me for the past 24 years—because it's just as God says, the human "heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV).



History is a Bunch of Reruns. What's going on today is actually a parallel, a rerun, of what happened before when the born again disciples had been praying for God to release Peter from prison. Because when God answered their prayer and Peter knocked on the door, they told Rhoda who had answered the door, what they really believed (Acts 12:15). While they thought they had faith in God, they really didn't. And it's the same today (to one degree or another)—as it has always been.



A Really Old Rerun. It actually dates much further than the book of Acts because they didn't keep their word (Josh 24:22). The Israelites were witnesses *against* themselves just as Christians have been. But since "the LORD's mercies...are new every morning" (Lam. 3:22-23, KJV), meaning you can have a fresh start every day—as long as you're still alive—"choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods [the world is serving or the One true God]. But as for me...I will serve the LORD" (Josh 24:15. NIV).
