


Lies Christians Peddle

For 2000 years, getting worse with time, the body of Christ has peddled lies that contradict the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) when Jesus warned us that hypocrisy *blinds* us (Matt. 7:5 in the graphic). And some of these lies are whoppers! I'm covering more than 30 of them on this article and playlist.

1 Christians CAN'T All Agree

Christians have historically agreed to be united on the main points (whatever we decide those are, besides Jesus is Lord) and agree to disagree on everything else as if it's impossible to come to actual unity in Christ. What we've been doing is calling God a liar! Because, Jesus didn't pray for something that's impossible for us to do! And agreeing on all points of sound doctrine was the crux of His High Priestly prayer, "That they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (John 17:21, ESV). Jesus and the Father aren't one by being in agreement on just the main points but wishy washy on the rest, like the current body of Christ! They were—and are—ONE in mind and Spirit. And that's what Jesus prayed for the body of Christ so that the lost would "ask [us] for a reason for the hope that is in [us] (1 Pet. 3:15, ESV).

He also made it very clear that we are responsible to Him and to one another. These are the two greatest commandments "Love the Lord your God with all...[and] love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these" (Mark 12:30-31, ESV). We also know that born again Christians have been called as "the church, his body" (Eph. 5:23, ESV) about which we're told "the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." (1 Cor. 12:21, ESV). Yet that's exactly what we've been doing for the last 2000 years—choosing our opinions over what Jesus clearly taught us—so that we're now divided by tens of thousands of unbiblical denominations, practices, and beliefs. And, while it's clear as can be that I'm a member of the body, for 26 years others obvious members of the body have chased me away or otherwise rejected me being just as dishonest and unloving as the lost!



And Christians know we're in the wrong so that, for example, the group For Him has a song called *Runaway Train* which says *Blessed ties we're breakin'...Will we ever realize we're not on the right track*. As the Lord has me proving throughout my ministry and on this playlist, we've been running on our own track for the last 2000 years! But the answer to the question about whether we'll ever realize it or not is Yes because God has foretold of a great awakening He calls "the latter rain" (Joel 2:23, ESV) a "downpour" in the Concordant literal translation (CLT). But, again, we've been in rebellion for 200 years. I know without a doubt that it's been 2000 years and not just since the so-called Reformation of the so-called Church because Peter did it, as revealed in the New Testament. I cover it on this text and playlist because it's led to another lie Christians have consistently peddled. The way he handle Ananias and Sapphira's lies was totally unbiblical! It *didn't* honor Christ. He did what we've done ever since, chose to go with his wicked heart (Jer. 17:9 below) rather than take every thought captive to Christ and obey Him (2 Cor. 10:5 below).

Jeremiah 17:9, KJV The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked.

2 Corinthians 10:5, ESV We destroy arguments and (△) every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ.

So let's say you were willing to admit that I'm obviously a born again member of the body of Christ. But you don't agree with 80 percent of what I'm saying on this playlist! If we were both willing to express genuine reverence for Christ (Eph. 5:21 below), we could list all the points on which we differ and tackle them one by one. *Taking our thoughts captive to Christ* (2 Cor. 10:5), and being honest since Jesus is "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV) and all lies come from Satan "the father of lies" (John 8:44, ESV)—both of whom should highly *motivate* us to be honest—we could work through the list and likely both have to let go of some of our current points of view having been further enlightened by the other one's understanding and interpretation of Scripture. **Humbly** working through it together, we *would* arrive at unity in Christ.

Ephesians 5:21, ESV Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

But, again, it's not what we've been doing. Instead, we've fulfilled "the rebellion" God said would take place before the Lords return (2 Thess. 2:2-3 below). It's been a snowball effect taking place for the last 2000 years . And I discern the Father will answer Jesus' High Priestly prayer just as soon as we start doing what I just described.

2 Thessalonians 2:2-3, ESV To the effect that the day of the Lord has come. Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first.

And if you're honest about, taking your thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5) you'd have to agree that the body of Christ is responsible for the "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, ESV) coming on the world since WE were both informed and empowered to "submit...to God. Resist the devil, and he w[ould have had to] flee" (James 4:7, ESV). The lost know nothing about that! They think all religions are the same. By not walking as humbly before the Lord as we should have, the body of Christ has historically laid out the red carpet for Satan to deceive and brutalize humanity. If we want to be part of the solution, we need to be teachable and admit when we've been wrong. We need to *genuinely* love the truth. And since Jesus says "I am...the truth" (John 14:6, ESV), if we genuinely love Him, we'll admit our errors and help others see those errors as called by God. We "take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them" (Eph. 5:11, ESV).

The fact is that we were all born into—and born again into—a version of Christianity that is extremely unbiblical in many ways so that we've believed many lies about God and what He's revealed to us—what He's actually like and what He's actually doing.

But the *faithful* **follower** of Christ will constantly be getting corrected by God either directly through His Spirit and His Word or indirectly through others using His Word and working through His Spirit. If we *don't harden our hearts to the truth when we hear His voice* (Heb. 4:7) not getting offended by Him (Matt. 11:6), we'll "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 3:18, ESV).

Hebrews 4:7, ESV Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.

Matthew 11:6, ESV Blessed is the one who (A) is not offended by me.

Every born again Christian knows the body of Christ is off target in many ways so that we need to repent. Yet we've historically refused to repent so that we've gotten worse with time. It's partly because the human heart is "deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) but also because God is holding those beams in place as a judgment against us for having been so unfaithful, as we've been informed "It is time for judgment to begin at the household of God" (1 Pet. 4:17, ESV). Peter was speaking as a born again Christian to born again Christians—judgment begins with us. We are the ones who have beams in our eyes that we need to remove in order to help the lost remove the motes out of theirs. Beams are bigger than motes. The ESV says we have a log in our eye, we they hypocrites, and the lost have a speck in theirs. They're less guilty before God than we are since they don't have the holy Spirit inside of them giving them the power to obey God whereas we "received power when the Holy Spirit [came] upon [us]" (Acts 1:8, ESV) "the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, ESV). We initially obeyed the Lord so that He placed His Spirit inside of us. But then, as a group, we walked away from Him to one degree or another, picking and choosing what to believe and obey. Yet Christians—as a whole—act as if we're fine and the lost have beams in their eyes. No. We were entrusted with the truth, empowered by the Spirit to walk in it, and haven't. We need to remove the beams from our eyes being honest about what the Bible says in relation to the new covenant so that we can enable the Father to answer Jesus' High Priestly prayer of making us one. Then the lost elect will clearly see the motes in their eyes and come to the knowledge of the truth so that we'll experience the latter rain downpour (Joel 2:23). In the same way that Jesus says "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him" (John 6:44, ESV) no one can come back to the Lord—draw closer to Him—unless the Father draws them, which He's doing through this playlist. And in both cases, whether lost or born again, the only thing needed is for us to be honest. As "ambassadors for Christ" (2 Cor. 4:20, ESV) we're supposed to be representing "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV).

To sum it up, it's not that Christians *can't* all agree on sound doctrine but that we've refused to even try. Paul spoke it back then saying "You no longer try to understand" (Heb. 5:11, NIV). But we'd better start trying—and fast—because our time is just about up as clearly revealed by 54 prophecies in the Bible pointing to 2030 as the Lord's return. But if you have tons of hypocritical beams in your eyes blinding you probably won't see what God has clearly revealed. You'll just scoff thinking "No one can know the day or hour!" not even *trying* to understand.

2 There are Good People in the World

Unlike everyone else, born again Christians *know* that "there is none righteous, not even one" (Rom. 3:10, YLT). We also know that "the heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) and that "No one is good except God alone" (Mark 10:18, ESV). Yet, just like the lost, the body of Christ loves to promote the lie that people are good! I can make the generalization since the Lord has had me trying to get through to Christians for 26 years and instead of being honest they defend themselves, their pastor, their family, or their friends saying that they're believers and/or good people. But "the devils also believe" (James 2:19, KJV), and the whole point of why Jesus went to the Cross was because we're NOT good people! What's worse is that even born again Christians aren't good people UNLESS we "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV) which we've historically NOT done so that we're now divided by tens of thousands of unbiblical denominations, doctrines, beliefs, and practices rather than being "one" in Christ as we were called to be (Phil. 1:27, ESV). Two thousand years ago Paul said "It is hard to make it clear to you because you no

longer try to understand" (Heb. 5:11, ESV). Likewise, I've yet to be able to get through to even one born again Christian because they also don't try to understand. While pastors preach that we need to repent Christians don't repent. We've historically refused to repent when we've been walking away from the Lord for 2000 years. While born again Christians initially obeyed the Lord so that He gave us His Spirit ((Acts 5:32 in the graphic) we've historically then NOT followed Him either at all or not very closely so that, as a group, we've fulfilled "the rebellion" the New Testament said we'd fulfill before the Lord's return. "To the effect that the day of the Lord has



come. Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first" (2 Thess. 2:2-3, ESV). And why would "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) rebel against Christ?! Because, we're not good people. It's as He says, our "heart [the heart of every human being, including the born again] is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). While we don't want to think of ourselves as being wicked, deceitful above all things, lying to ourselves about our nature doesn't help us or anyone else. What it does is help Satan further deceive us!

3 We Can't Know When Jesus Will Return

Since Jesus said "Concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father" (Mark 13:32, ESV), most of today's Christians seem to think we still can't know the timing of His return. However, Jesus was speaking to people who weren't even born again yet. And further into the future the New Testament says "You are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief" (1 Thess. 5:4, ESV). Jesus also rebuked the Jews for *not* being discerning of the signs of His first coming (Matt. 16:3), and as born again Christians with 2000 years worth of Bible study, we should be much more discerning than they were. He also told us to "Stay awake" (Mark 13:37, ESV). In any case, not only are there plenty of "signs of the times" (Matt. 16:3, ESV) revealing we're nearing the Lord's soon return, as with The Two Preachers - YouTube channel, as noted there are *at least* 54 prophecies in the Bible pointing to the same year, 2030. These aren't dreams or visions but actual Bible prophecies. And the fact that the body of Christ has thoroughly fulfilled "the rebellion" God informed we'd fulfill before the Lord's return (2 Thess. 2:2-3, ESV) is another confirmation. My testimony and ministry prove beyond a doubt that today's body of Christ is in full rebellion, as a whole. I've summed it up with all these lies we're currently walking in. Just because there's some life in the body of Christ doesn't mean we're not in rebellion. It means that "if we are faithless, he remains faithful" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). And He views us both as a group, "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, ESV), and as individuals. So it's like this graphic.

And since hypocrites blind themselves with beams (Matt. 7:5) you could be born again and **not** see what's clearly revealed about the timing of the Lord's return. So rather than being a proud scoffer, as most born again Christians are today as God has proven through my testimony, you should earnestly consider all of the lies and THEN pass judgment having admitted the truth about your own life as it relates to the new covenant, repenting as needed. "God is not mocked" (Gal. 6:7, ESV) so that if you ignore your hypocrisy against what's been clearly revealed you *will* be kept in the dark of the obvious, just like the lost who refuse to admit the truth about Christ even when it's clearly revealed with those 351 Messianic prophecies, or who argue that we can choose our gender when we obviously cannot.





4 We've Entered the Last Days

Over the past three decades there's been increasing talk among Christians that we've entered or are about to enter the last days. It's a lie—of sorts—because we've been *in* the last days for the last 2000 years. The truth is that we're now in the very *last* of the last days. This graphic put out by the Messiah 2030 - YouTube channel, which I've tweaked, sums it up. The Bible says "with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day" (2 Pet. 3:8, ESV). Unlike what the world has been deceived to believe, that the universe is billions of years old, according to God it's only 6000 years old. And the Bible reveals that He divided "the ages of ages" (Gal. 1:5, YLT) by days equivalent to 1000 years each. The Messiah 2030 channel covers it in detail on two long videos so I'm not doing that here. Paul also wrote "In these last days he has spoken to us by his Son" (Heb. 1:2, ESV). Two thousand years ago they were in the last days because, when you look at it from God's perspective, Jesus showed up in the middle of the work week, at the end of the middle of it, and we've been in the last days of the 'week' for these 2000 years, Thursday and Friday. Next comes the Lord's return, which Messiah 2030 clearly reveals through 53 Bible prophecies all pointing to 2030. But if you have hypocritical beams in your eyes you may

not see what's been clearly revealed (Matt. 7:5 in the graphic) since those beams BLIND you. Instead, you'll just scoff it off as if it ridiculous just like the lost. In any case, as soon as Jesus returns He begins His 1000 year reign of Day 7, the day of rest, ending the work week of this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). So we have been in the last days for the last 2000 years and we are now in the very last of the last days with only six and a half years left as of this writing and making of the playlist. It's the reason the Lord has been enlightening different people to the lies we've historically believed and which He's having me cover on this playlist-at least the main ones-because we're not ready! And the reason we're not ready is because we took what He did for us for granted proving His point that "the heart is deceitful above all things, and



desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). Those who admit the lies we've believed for NOT having been very good disciples of Christ will be able to get ready for the hard days ahead and help others get ready. They'll also be able to do more than what most born again Christians have historically done which is to have gotten "saved; but so as by fire" (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV).

And, combined with the Berisheet prophecy, <u>Is the End of Days Prophesied in the First Word of the Bible?</u> (youtube.com), there are 54 prophecies in the Bible of which I'm aware which all point to 2030 as the year of the Lord's return. That's a good deal of evidence. And we've been warned to "not despise prophecies, but test everything; hold fast what is good [and] Abstain from every form of evil" (1 Thess. 5:20-22, ESV). It's evil if it contradicts the truth God has revealed in the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) because it's a lie handed to us by Satan the "liar and father of lies" (John 8:44, ,ESV) who set out to "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) in order to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV), allowed by God because He's been "testing" humanity to prove to us that our hearts *are* "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) proving it best of all through the unfaithful body of Christ. In other words, He's proving to us just how much we need a "new heart," the heart of Christ, which no one has yet received but which He has promised (Ezek. 36:26).

5 Jesus was White or Olive Tone

The Bible reveals that Jesus and, therefore, the Israelites/Jews were a people of color (Rev. 4:3 in the graphic & Dan. 7:9 below) so that I used one of those stones to make Jesus' face for my graphic of the risen Lord. He's what we call Black. This documentary, Watch Hebrews to Negroes: Wake Up Black America | Prime Video (amazon.com), reveals how humanity was deceived. (Apparently it's also a book by Ronald Dalton, Jr.) However, the modern group Hebrew Israelites don't represent the Church Jesus is building (Matt. 16:18 below) since their teachings don't line up with the Lord's.

Daniel 7:9, ESV As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool.

Matthew 16:18, YLT I will build my assembly, and gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

The true skin tone of the original Hebrew Israelites is important for several reasons.

- 1. It reveals that We've Historically Not Taken Jesus Seriously. Jesus warned us that Satan is "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) and that he's "a liar" (John 8:44, ESV)—that all he does is lie—to whom He gave "all...authority" which he could "give...to anyone [he] want[s]" (Luke 4:6, NIV). And, he's not just "a liar" but "a murderer" (John 8:44, ESV) who set out to "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) in order to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV) by "masquerad[ing] as an angel of light" (2 Cor. 11:14, NIV). It's a pretty major historical error on our part, speaking of the body of Christ.
- 2. It Reveals that We've Been Seriously Deceived. The fact that we've been deceived by the true skin tone of Israelites/Jews reveals we've been seriously deceived. So the lies I'm covering shouldn't be hard to believe. Because, by not taking Jesus or Satan seriously, we set ourselves up to get deceived. It's like all of the unfaithful members of the body of Christ historically set us up. But it's also been our own fault, and even more so, because, with the web, which they didn't have, we've been given the most opportunity to




get this thing right. And we've still refused to submit to the Lord! That's my testimony of the past 26 years as He's had me reaching out to mostly professing Christians many of whom were clearly born again.




- 3. **It Points Us Back to the Truth.** Being "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV), Jesus cares about the truth.
- 4. **We Laid Out the Red Carpet for Satan.** Seeing the Jews as being white people, we've paved the way for Satan's murderous and deceptive agenda as it comes to its climax in these last of the last days. This graphic sums up what the body of Christ has done *along with* the rest of the world.

6 Christians Have Been Transformed

Many born again Christians have been telling themselves—and others, feeding the lie—that we've been completely transformed—as in this documentary, American Gospel - Movie (youtube.com), specifically at the timestamp 3:10. But, while God said "I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you" (Ezek. 36:26, ESV), the born again have not yet received our new heart whereas "the Holy Spirit...God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, ESV), specifically speaking of obeying Jesus because "truth came through Jesus" (John 1:17, ESV). And the reason we need a new heart is because our "heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) as history reveals since it's been all about war, corruption, depravity, abuse, and deception, and that includes the history of the body of Christ as summed up thoroughly enough on these articles: The Plain Truth about the Protestant Reformation - Part 1 | Tomorrow's World (tomorrowsworld.org).) Born again Christians obeyed Jesus initially so that He placed His Spirit inside of us. He did give us a new Spirit, His, which He never removes even though we may stop obeying Him since He says, speaking to the born again, "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Heb. 13:5, ESV). Elsewhere God has revealed to us that we can get "saved; yet so as by fire" (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV) having become born again but not a follower of Christ or not a close follower which is what Jesus told us to do having said "Follow me" (Matt. 4:19, ESV). So while His "sheep hear [His] voice...and they follow [Him]" (John 10:27, ESV), we can follow Him closely or at a distance, or anything in between. And Christian history along with the current state of "the church, his body" (Eph. 5:23, ESV) reveal that most born again Christians have been following Him at a great distance! So while Jesus will never forsake us, as a group the born again have historically forsaken Him, as these lies prove since they contradict His teachings. In any case, according to Scripture the born again won't receive our new heart until the day He returns and "we shall all be changed" (1 Cor. 15:52, ESV). Then, at the rapture, we'll have the heart of Christ, One who would never disobey His Father or abuse others. Praise the Lord!





In contrast, Christian history including that of the body of Christ has been very abusive so that Protestants killed other Protestants. And my testimony of decades, especially of the last two and a half decades, proves that even born again Christians are extremely unloving and abusive. And it's because we have *not* yet been fully transformed. It's the reason the New Testament tells us to do much more than just believe in the Lord. In fact, it says "devils also believe" (James 2:19, KJV), and devils aren't Christian! We've been told to "work out...our own salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil. 2:12, ESV). I discern we've been warned to do this with fear and trembling primarily because OUR heart is "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV).




7 Christians are United in Christ

Christians talk about being united in Christ when nothing could be further from the truth! As a group we're not united with Christ and we're not united with one another as revealed by the tens of thousands of denominations that call themselves Christian, for example, which have different doctrines, practices, and beliefs. And it has to be much worse today since this data is more than a decade old!

And the body of Christ is viewed by God as a woman because the New Testament says "the church [is] his body" (Eph. 5:23, NIV) about whom we're told the following:

Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:25-27, ESV).

She needs a bath because She's the opposite of "holy and without blemish." Not having taken Jesus seriously we've repeated all the sins of the Jews so that He's saying to "the church, His body" (Eph. 5:23, ESV), "You have the forehead of a whore [and] refuse to be ashamed" (Jer. 3:3, ESV). It's like this graphic since this stadium seats 50,000. The body of Christ, His "Bride" (Rev. 19:7, ESV), has made Solomon seem faithful! And it's because our hearts *are* "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV).




8 A Rebellion Recently Started

While many preach that we've just come into "the rebellion" which God foretold we'd be in before Christ's return (2 Thess. 2:3 in the graphic), or worse that we *will* be coming into it, we *have been* in rebellion for 2000 years in increasing measure. It's been a snowball effect that began with the first disciples. The body of Christ is now in the worst shape we've ever been in as the New Testament proves, the state of "the church, his body" proves (Eph. 5:23, ESV), and my testimony proves. This rebellion started with the very first disciples.



For example, Peter asked Jesus how many times we should forgive someone and was essentially told to *always* forgive when Jesus replied "Seventy times seven" (Matt. 18:22, KJV). Jesus also said TO PETER "Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Matt. 16:19, ESV). It was also Peter who betrayed Jesus during His darkest hour—three times (John 18:15-27)—and who was immediately not only forgiven by Jesus (John 21:15-19) but given a *very* important ministry "to the circumcised" (Gal. 2:8, ESV). Yet the minute these lessons were put to the test—with Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5:1-10)—Peter



lobotomized himself about what he'd been taught, dismissing Christ and letting his wicked heart rule (Jer. 17:9). Rather than *forgive* those who had sinned against the Lord just as the Lord had forgiven him when he had sinned against Him, Peter had them killed by *loosing* demonic spirits! And the born again have continued following Peter's example as if we're *supposed* to kill when "the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil" (Heb. 2:14, ESV). All killing honors and helps the devil. Yet for the past 2000 years, even born again Christians have been going off to war to kill people asking God to "Bless our troops" as if He loves 'our' nation more than others ignoring the fact that His kingdom isn't even "of this world" (John 18:36, ESV) and says "Love your enemies" (Matt. 5:44, ESV).

Again, it's because "the heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). And it's what He prophesied when He said "The hour is coming when whoever kills you will think he is offering service to God" (John 16:2, ESV). Even born again Christians have historically offered this "service to God." Those who rebelled were those who were entrusted with the truth, the body of Christ. And our rebellion has been an overall steady downward slide for the last 2000 years since there never really was a reformation of the Church as already covered, summed up with the articles put out by Tomorrow's World, for example. A rebellion has started. But it started 2000 years ago! We are now deep in it.

9 Church is a Building

While pastors preach that they're in "the house of God," church is not a building or an institution but "the family of faith" (Gal. 6:10, CLT), also referred to as "his body" (Eph. 5:23, ESV), a worldwide group of people who "have the same spirit of faith" (2 Cor. 4:13, ESV). When we obeyed Jesus for a season of time, we were filled with "the Spirit whom God has given to those who obey him" (Acts 5:32, ESV). I know that we had to obey Him for a season of time since the New Testament says that people must "first be proved, then let them minister" (1 Tim. 3:10, YLT). If He requires us to prove ourselves to each other, He definitely requires us to prove ourselves to Him before placing His Spirit inside of us. He then says to the born again, "You are God's field, God's building" (1 Cor. 3:9, ESV). The New Testament also says "we [the born again] are the temple of the living God" (2 Cor. 6:16, ESV). And that's because "the God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by man" (Acts 17:24, ESV). He says to the born again body of Christ "You yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house" (1 Pet. 2:5, ESV). And Jesus warned us saying "a hired hand...cares nothing for the sheep" (John 10:13, ESV). Hold them accountable to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) and you'll find out it's true. And if they don't care for the Lord's sheep, they don't really care for Shepherd, so when you hold them

accountable, they get seriously bent out of shape! In fact, there's very little that goes on in those man-made buildings we've historically called church that lines up with sound doctrine. I summed it up on this table which I've provided at this link <u>Fake-vs-Real-Church.pdf</u> (notmocked.com) with all the references.

And not long after the Lord had me make the table, He showed me a book that had been written about a decade before in 2001 by Frank Viola and George Barna confirming what I'd discerned, *Pagan Christianity: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices*. The Church, the "assembly" Jesus is building (Matt. 16:18, YLT), is not pagan. God has delivered us from all things pagan. But in order to enjoy that deliverance we have to obey Him. He's called us out of the world and out of fake religion:

The World: Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you (2 Cor. 6:17, NIV).

Religion: Come out of her, my people, lest you take part in her sins, lest you share in her plagues (Rev. 18:4, ESV). All Denominations Bow Before the Pope (youtube.com).

Biblical Christian fellowship is between people who meet anywhere any time as revealed by Jesus. And the example following Pentecost is in houses so that many of the New Testament letters say something like "the assembly at their house" (Rom. 16:5, YLT). So while there's been a move towards that in the last few decades, those house churches are still walking in and practicing most of the lies we've historically believed and practiced. They're mostly replicas of the unbiblical institutional set up. The following two playlist sum up how it should be and I summed it up in the graphic. The problem with most of the current house churches is that they haven't been given over to "godly sorrow" (2 Cor. 7:10, KJV). And I discern it's what the Lord will be doing through the ministry He's entrusted to me, doing it at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV).

The Problem with Pay. Since our hearts are so deceitful (Jer. 17:9), getting paid to do the Lord's work—especially as a salary—will *lead* us to compromise the truth. It's inevitable, and the reason He told us to "not peddle the


word of God for profit" (2 Cor. 2:17, NIV) because "a root of all the evils is the love of money" (1 Tim. 6:10, YLT). My guess is that most of those pastors aren't actually born again, and the ones who are have totally hardened their hearts to the truth while also blinded by many beams of hypocrisy (Matt. 7:5)—same with most of their followers. The few so-called pastors I've read about who've come out of that system were enlightened by the Spirit and were willing to obey Him, giving up that salary and power along with the rest of the many perks that come with that position since those sitting under them are idolaters, idol worshippers as someone summed up with this Pastor Bob graphic I tweaked.



The Problem with Hierarchy. The institutional model for God's Church is the same as the business model and model of the New World Order over which Satan reigns since God gave him "all authority" (Luke 4:6, ESV) on earth making him "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) and "the god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). Using the Catholic/business model for God's assemblies we've created idolaters as well as lazy Christians. In contrast, being part of an assembly where we're expected to provide input on a regular basis would motivate every member of the body to live up to the calling we've received (Eph. 4:1), especially if the others are going to do the hard work of holding us accountable as we're told to do in the following passages, for example:

If anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness (Gal. 6:1, ESV).

Confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power (James 5:16, ESV).



The Problem with Idolatry. While the Lord has had me holding Christians accountable to the new covenant for 26 years, I haven't been able to get through to anyone even though it's obvious that I'm a born again Christian serving the Lord, revealing that most born again Christians are idolaters of these hired hands. Those who've been excited about what I've said have run to their pastor for his take on it and since it's just as Jesus warned us, that "the hired hand...cares nothing for the sheep" (John 10:13, ESV), those pastors turned those excited born again Christians AWAY from the truth. And those Christians are also at fault. It's this graphic for the parable of the sower. Because the body of Christ has historically been fulfilling "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV), we were all born again into—and brainwashed into—a Church loaded with thorns. Like the majority of those professing and born again Christians in that system, we've gone with the flow to one degree or another and let the cares of this world choke the work (Matt. 13:22 below) and that Word is Jesus whose "name is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, YLT). And it's especially true in the United States.

Matthew 13:22, ESV As for what was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.

I discern that part of the reason the Lord has had me reach out to so many people for two and a half decades, many of whom were clearly born again Christians, was to prove that the body of Christ has become idolatrous. In turn, God has given the body of Christ as a whole over to a strong delusion as a reward for not loving the truth! (2 Thess. 2:10-11 below) I discern most of the people attending those buildings, aren't actually born again as Jesus says "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 7:21, ESV), "many" will hear "depart" (Matt. 7:22-23, ESV). And those who are born again have blinded themselves with hypocritical beams (Matt. 7:5 below) which have then served to further harden their hearts. And that's problematic because there are really only two spiritual leaders, Christ and the leading antichrist, Satan. So I discern that the reason the Lord has had me reach out to so many born again Christians for these 26 years and not be able to get through to even one person is because we're under His judgment (1 Pet. 4:17 below) since we've been hypocrites historically so that we've blinded ourselves with beams, and as He's been holding those beams in place as a judgment against us. But out of His grace He's calling us out of fake religion, fake Christianity.

2 Thessalonians 2:10-11, ESV Because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. Therefore God sends them a strong delusion, so that they may believe what is false.

Matthew 7:5, KJV Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

1 Peter 4:17, ESV For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?

10 Protestants are Reformed

While most born again Christians think there was a great spiritual reformation during the Middle Ages, history combined with Scripture reveal that's a lie. While there was a reformation that took place it wasn't spiritual but carnally motivated. As already noted, they summed it up well enough on this series: The Plain Truth about the Protestant Reformation - Part 1 | Tomorrow's World (tomorrowsworld.org).) If you think there was a reformation and are part of the institutional system we've historically called church, you should definitely watch it.

For example, in part 3 of the series we read the following:

As late as March 3, 1519 [two years *after* nailing his these to the door of the church building so that he's referred to as The Father of the Reformation], Luther wrote the pope: "Now, Most Holy Father, I protest before God and his creatures that it has never been my purpose, nor is it now, to do ought that might weaken, or overthrow the authority of the Roman Church or that of your Holiness; nay, more, I confess that the power of this church is above all things; that nothing in heaven or on earth is to be set before it, Jesus alone, the Lord of all, excepted" (Alzog, Johannes. *Manual of Universal Church History*. 1878. p. 195).

Protestants have been saying Martin Luther was the Father of a reformation he didn't even want!

Besides that, as clearly exposed on the video All Denominations Bow Before the Pope (youtube.com) there was no reformation! All the denominations are part of the Catholic so-called church which does not represent God but Satan—since they honor men (the popes, people they call saints, and Mary) more than Jesus. Real saints are born again Christians as you can see in the New Testament letters addressed to the body of Christ which begin, for example, "to the assembly of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called saints" (1 Cor. 1:2, YLT). They're not people appointed by man as saints but people revealed by God to be saints. And there's LOADS of evidence that Catholic leadership is excruciatingly wicked and has been so historically. Here's one of probably thousands of links available: Shocking Confession of Sister Charlotte, Former Roman Catholic Nun (youtube.com). Honoring anything that's not taught in the Bible in relation to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) teachings of Christ, as with lent, Christmas, denominational worship, etc., you are honoring Satan, the leading antichrist rather than Christ—even if you're born again.

Christ is the head of the church. Ephesians 5:23

The Catholic Church teaches that the pastoral office, the office of shepherding the Church, that was held by the apostles, as a group or "college" with Saint Peter as their head, is now held by their successors, the bishops, with the bishop of Rome (the pope) as their head.

As revealed through the series of articles summing up the so-called Reformation, Luther and the other so-called reformers ignored the fact that we are under the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) "law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2, ESV) and were *not* taking their thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5) motivated by carnal desires. Their so-called reformation was motivated by greed, politics, and finances not spirituality. And today's Christians who have also not been in the habit of "tak[ing] every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV) believe and teach that there was a great reformation of the Church in the Middle Ages and that they themselves are reformed when most professing Christians are likely not Christian at all—not born again as Jesus says we "must be" (John 3:7, ESV). It's as He warned us:

Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness (Matt. 7:21-23, ESV).

People who aren't born again *can* prophesy in Jesus' name, cast out demons, and do many mighty works in His name because they're being used by Satan. Honoring Satan rather than Christ their "presence is according to the working of the Adversary, in all power, and signs, and lying wonders and in all deceitfulness" (2 Thess. 2:9-10, YLT). This is what Satan set out to do, "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) and "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV). And who better to use than professing Christians?! And God allowed it because He's been "testing [us], to know whether [we] love the LORD...our God with all...our heart and with all your soul" (Deut. 13:3, ESV). In other words, God has been *proving* to all of humanity that we've failed His test and failed it miserably, especially proving it with the born again body of Christ. While we should have been honoring Christ, we've mostly been honoring the leading antichrist, Satan!

And the problem runs deeper than with just the denominations as I cover in the next section and video. And the reason people can get saved and even grow spiritually—to some degree—in those denominational churches is because God "makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust" (Matt. 5:45, ESV). Elsewhere, the Bible says God "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV). He's taken all of Satan's garbage along with all of *our* sins and worked them ALL into His Master Plan. So while He'll use the people in those churches to minister to you and teach you etc., it will only go so far because Satan is "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) given "all authority" (Luke 4:6, ESV), by God, so that those denominations and churches—that whole institutional set up—is under his jurisdiction. And God has been saying "Come out of her, my people,' so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plague" (Rev. 18:4, NIV).


By not having taken Jesus seriously, historically, the body of Christ has allowed Satan to use us for his purposes rather than allowed Jesus to use us for His purposes, for the most part. But since He's God Almighty, and "God is love" (1 John 4:8, ESV) and "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV), people have been getting ministered to in that system. But it's not what God has called for as described in the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV). God has been using most born again *in spite* of us, historically, when we're supposed to be working with Him as His "ambassadors" (2 Cor. 5:20, ESV) "bear[ing], therefore, fruits worthy of the reformation" (Matt. 3:8, YLT).





11 Christians are Spiritually Awake

While every born again Christian thinks they're spiritually awake, it's more like we're in a coma as a group because for 2000 years the Lord has been telling us to "Wake up, and...repent" (Rev. 3:2-3, ESV) and we've refused. God views us not only as individuals but as a group He calls "the body of Christ" (1 Cor. 12:27, ESV). And just like it is with physical sleep, there are spiritual *levels* of sleep. So while the body of Christ as a whole is as if in a coma, within the body there are some who are more awake than others which I reference in my material. And that's exactly how it was when He was speaking to the church of Sardis. Having told them to wake up and repent, the Lord then said "Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments" (Rev. 3:4, ESV). Since we can be born again and yet backslidden (carnal, prodigal), and in 26 years no born again Christians has treated me in a manner that honors Christ when He's had me reach out to them, I discern every member of the body of Christ today has soiled garments. And it's what this text and playlist reveals, since the born again are believing and or practicing many if not most of these lies that contradict the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV).

Unlike those who came before us, for more than two decades, since the web, we should be much more enlightened than they were since we've had 2000 years worth of Bible study and have loads of Bible translations to work with, easily accessible to each of us. Yet when the Lord has had me reach out to those who are more enlightened, for 26 years, they've all refused to admit that some of their beliefs don't line up with the truth even when it's been clearly pointed out to them. In other words, they love their opinions more than the truth they profess to know and love. And the Lord is constantly correcting me so I'm not just pointing the finger at others. **We** are a mess, as a group. We are asleep as a group when we're supposed to be the most enlightened—most awake—of all the people on earth! And it's because we're dead asleep in a coma that the Woke LGBTQIA movement has flourished. The body of Christ is most at fault because we're the only ones who have been enlightened with the truth and the New Testament says "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7, ESV). Instead, as a group, we've submitted to "the ruler" and "god of this world" (John 12:31, YLT & 2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). That's pretty dead asleep since he's "a murderer" and "liar" (John 8:44, ESV) and we're the only ones who know and believe this truth!








12 The Best Christians are Popular

Today's Christians—both professing and actual born again Christians—behave like these graphics to one degree or another. That's my testimony of the past 26 years. And it's what I've read and seen they've done with others as with the prophet God sent to John McArthur during the service in 2015, Charismatic false prophet confronts Pastor John MacArthur at Grace Community Church (youtube.com). While the person who uploaded the video called that man a false prophet, a more careful study of Scripture and of John MacArthur reveals that John MacArthur is the false prophet. Another 'good' one is Ravi Zacharias, viewed even after being fully exposed as having had a "fruitful" ministry: Ravi Zacharias - His Great and Tragic Legacy (youtube.com). You could only say that if you're blind to the definition of fruitful, blind to the lies that are passing off as being Christian. According to Jesus the version of Christianity that's passing off as Christian is a "diseased tree" which can only produce "bad fruit." Jesus clearly made the point. "A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit" (Matt. 7:18, ESV). And if it doesn't line up with the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) teachings of Christ, it's not good fruit! The only reason there's any truth at all coming out of this pagan version of Christianity is because GOD IS FAITHFUL. Even "if we are faithless [as is clearly the case since hardly anything Christians are saying or doing lines up with sound doctrine], he remains faithful—for he cannot deny himself" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). Glory to God!

We have to always keep in mind that "our struggle is...against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV). We're at war with the devil and the rest of the fallen angels who use people, just like God uses people. But they do it to "devour" us (1 Pet. 5:8, ESV). And they do it with a high level of truth, twisted Scripture, and a sprinkling of flat out lies. That's how we get deceived, with the truth, so that we were warned to "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV) and it's NOT what Christians are doing or have historically done.

And because our hearts are so "deceitful" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) that we can be born again, profess to love the Lord who taught us to love, and yet be so hateful that we either have others killed or don't even care that our actions lead others to be killed or otherwise suffer. We clearly and desperately need a new heart which we have NOT yet received from God. We have not yet been fully transformed. In fact, most born again Christians have barely been transformed at all since they've focused on being believers rather than followers of Christ doing no better than "the devils [who] also believe" (James 2:19, KJV). That's how immature the body of Christ is today as a group!




We're calling evil good and good evil (Isa. 5:20), not exactly being "the light of the world" (Matt. 5:14, ESV), NOT "liv[ing] a life worthy of the calling [we] have received" (Eph. 4:1, NIV). True prophets, according to Jesus, are rejected like Jesus, and like the twelve apostles who died as martyrs with the exception of John who was imprisoned for being so unpopular. Today's "Christian" mentality is the opposite of what Jesus taught when He said "The way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few" (Matt. 7:13-14, ESV). It's that spiritually backwards mentality that allows wolves to get by in sheep's clothing. And then defend them even when they've been exposed! It's the ones who deceive the born again that are wolves, not the ones, like Joel Osteen, who deceive professing Christians who couldn't possibly be born again!

13 God is a Trinity

Christians teach that God is a trinity when that's not true according to Scripture. If anything He's *two* persons, Father and Son. But Jesus says "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30, ESV) and that's because they're of the same mind and Spirit so that the Old Testament says "the Lord our God is one" (Deut. 6:4, KJV). God is one person who revealed Himself to humanity in the embodiment of Jesus Christ so that John 1:18, in the Concordant literal translation says "God no one has ever seen. The only-begotten God [Jesus]...He unfolds Him" (John 1:18, CLT).

And when you look up the trinity online, this diagram comes up explaining how the so-called Church "fathers" came up with the concept—hundreds of years after Jesus walked the earth. This is one of the better links I've come across: The Trinity before Nicea - 7 Early Theologians - by Sean Finnegan (youtube.com). Taking my thoughts captive to Christ I have to disagree with their graphic and assessment since Jesus says "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30, ESV) and this doctrine teaches that the Father is not the Son and, therefore, that Jesus was wrong in saying what He said! And He also said it this way, "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father" (John 14:9, ESV). We can't have it both ways. Either we'll believe this man-made doctrine or what Jesus said. I choose Christ.



Oh my!

So here's what I discern the Lord did. By having me place my understanding in graphic format He further enlightens me when I find out I can't do it or realize I can't do it while keeping in step with sound doctrine. So while this graphic might make it seem as if I believe that God is two, it just reveals the limits of graphics on paper. I think this is the best explanation for what God did. I've never heard a better one. "God...is one" (Deut. 6:4 & John 10:30 in the graphic) who split like a cell so that He said to Jesus "You are my Son; today I have begotten you" (Ps. 2:7, ESV), and He's the "exact representation" of God (Heb. 1:3, in the graphic) both as a spirit being and when He walked the earth. So while there are two-Father and Son-they're one like those identical cells.

For example, when someone has cancer they have tons of cancer cells. But we don't says they have cancers, plural, because those multiple cells are one in essence just like the Father and Son are one—and it's how the body of Christ—billions of people—have been called to behave as Jesus prayed in His most important prayer, His "High Priestly Prayer, "that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you" (John 17:21, ESV). Except for 2000 years years the body of Christ has refused to obey Him.



And because the Father split before doing anything else Jesus spoke of the glory He had before He created the world (John 17:5 in the graphic). Jesus said "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me" (Matt. 28:18, ESV) so that the New Testament says "by him all things were created" (Col. 1:16, ESV). The Concordant and one of the NASB translations also speak of Him as "the only-begotten God" (John 1:18, CLT). Having split like a cell, I discern the Father then placed His Spirit, which is the Spirit of Jesus, in Mary, the virgin, in the same way that doctors do today through in vitro fertilization for surrogate parenting. God did it to Mary so that she carried a child that wasn't actually hers. While generations before us couldn't understand it, we should have zero problem with it!

Taking my thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5 below) I see that the trinity doctrine doesn't line up, and doesn't make sense. This is what I mean. Revelation 3:21 says "the one who conquers, I will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne" (ESV). We also read of "Satan's throne" (Rev. 2:13, ESV). So the Father has a throne; Jesus, His Son, has a throne; born again Christians will share Jesus' throne; the devil has a throne; but nowhere in the Bible are we told about the Spirit's throne. So we're supposed to believe that while God has used the so-called person of the Holy Spirit for all of human history, especially the last 2000 years, He's then going to completely ignore Him! I don't think so.


2 Corinthians 10:5, ESV We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ.

Since Jesus is "the exact representation of his being" (Heb. 1:3, NIV), and "his name is called The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, KJV), Jesus has been revealing God to humanity throughout history—doing it through a combination of His Word, the Bible, and His Spirit. The Spirit is God's essence since "God is spirit" (John 4:24, ESV). The Spirit isn't another person but *how* God has worked in the world—before, during, and after Jesus walked the earth. I think we're told to baptize "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" because it's the Spirit of God who's at work. Since we can't see either Father or Son, we're dealing with Him through His Spirit. It ties in to this passage, "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all" (2 Cor. 13:14, ESV). The New Testament speaks of all three since God has done for us—does for us—through all three, Father and Son by way of His Spirit. Flipping the order of 2 Corinthians 13:14, out of love God sent Jesus who had the grace to suffer brutally for us so that we could have fellowship with God through His Spirit.

14 God is One of Fire and Brimstone

It's doubtful to me that you could get through high school in the United States and not have heard about the "fire and brimstone God." That's the reputation Christians have given "God [who] is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV). Yet, we were informed in the Old Testament that Satan said in his heart "I will be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) and in the New Testament that he's been "deceiv[ing] the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV)—something the lost have not been enlightened to. So while Jesus is "the exact representation of [God's] being" (Heb. 1:3, NIV)—which Christians profess to believe—we've historically peddled Satan's lies that make God out to be NOTHING like Jesus who revealed God's true nature which is the exact opposite of brutal.


Not in the habit of taking our thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), most born again Christians have historically used the Old Testament to defend their beliefs and actions. Yet we are under the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) Jesus made for humanity, calling the old covenant "obsolete" (ref). And the new covenant reveals that it's like this graphic, and Christians were supposed to "rightly divid[e] the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15, YLT) separating what was said by God—Father or Son since they "are one" (John 10:30, ESV)—and what was said by Satan, "the ruler" (John 12:31, YLT) and "god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV), to whom Jesus gave "all authority" (Luke 4:6, ESV).




And Jesus *modeled* "rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15, YLT) for us in Matthew 5, summed up with the graphics.

While today's Christians mostly focus on the Old Testament law of Moses, fallen angels took God's truth and gave it to humanity as if it had come from God (Acts 7:53 in the graphic) since that's what Satan set out to do, "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV). It's part of the reason Jesus "fulfilled all the things that are written in the Law of Moses, and the Prophets, and the Psalms" (Luke 24:44, YLT). Jesus fulfilled Satan's requirements, not God's. And ever since the Cross-for the last 2000 years-humanity has been under "the Law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2, ESV) so that the new covenant says "the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Gal. 5:14, ESV). That's the law we're under, a law of love because "God is love" (1 John 4:8, ESV).

Since the New Testament says that God "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV), I discern He let Satan do his thing, which was to take the truth and add his murderous lies to it pretending to be God.






And God allowed it because He's been "testing" us (Deut. 13:3, ESV) to reveal to us what we're actually like—which is "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) as **the body of Christ** has historically proven when we were supposed to love the truth and be spiritually discerning. God has run this test—*allowing* Satan to deceive humanity—so that we could finally genuinely appreciate what He did for us through Christ. If the body of Christ had actually appreciated what He did for us, we would have obeyed Him! Instead, we've disobeyed Him on nearly every count! But, we *will* finally obey Him as we come to the end of this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) because of the work He's doing, waking up the dormant body of Christ.

The new covenant speaks of "the simplicity that is in Christ" (2 Cor. 11:3, KJV) so that if you're careful to fulfill His greatest commandment to "love the lord your God" (Mark 12:31, ESV) you're going to fulfill all of God's requirements and not lie, not steal, not commit adultery, etc. While none of us can do it perfectly all the time, "we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous" (1 John 2:1, ESV) so that "if we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9, ESV). A born again *follower* of Christ, a disciple of Christ, will do as Jesus said and "bear fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matt. 3:8, ESV) or "reformation" (YLT). We admit when we've been wrong and change our mind and our ways to line up with the Truth constantly, a repeated cycle of falling down and getting back up since we're constantly straying off course as the hymns goes, we're "prone to wander."

Another excellent example of how born again Christians have allowed ourselves to be deceived for not taking our every thought captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5) is in Deuteronomy 28 since Christians have been saying that God, who says "bless and do not curse" (Rom. 12:14, ESV)— which Jesus modeled as He prayed for those who were killing Him (Luke 23:34)—was the One threatening to bring all these curses on the **Israelites** disobeying Him! Christians have been teaching that God CHANGED when "Christ is the same...forever"



(Heb. 13:8, ESV). The Old Testament law was not given to the Israelites by God but by "angels" (Acts 7:53. KJV) who had to be *fallen* angels since "truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, NIV) and He *didn't* deliver us from Himself.

I discern Satan took God's truth and added his murderous lying ways to it in order to dishonor God and "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV). Because he was informed that humans would one day judge angels (1 Cor. 6:3 below) he rebelled against God (Rev. 12:7 below) before the earth was created and has been deceiving us the whole time. Not having been very good disciples of Christ, Christians have been believing and teaching that God was and will be brutal which doesn't draw people to Christ, which was Satan's goal. It obviously doesn't draw people to Christ since even those who initially obeyed Him enough to have become born again, have historically NOT continued to obey Him-as I've already covered. As is obvious by all those denominations. But if the born again had the actual vision of what God has done/is doing, we would have obeyed Him historically because it really is Good News for ALL of humanity. And not having had the vision of what God has actually done is exactly what we've historically revealed—we the body of Christ. He warned us saying "Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint" (Prov. 29:18, ESV). That's today's body of Christ, just as carnal as the lost for the most part, having become born again but NOT followers of Christ or not close followers of Christ. It's practically impossible to tell who's actually born again these days since even the most enlightened are walking in most of these lies. And when the truth is revealed to them, they defend the lies! Defend Satan! That's my testimony of 26 years. And they do it IMMEDIATELY without giving it a second's thought when the new covenant says "test the spirits to see whether they are from God" (1 John 4:1, ESV). And even if you did test what I'm saying against the teachings of Christ and discovered I'm wrong in everything I'm saying, out of love for Him and for your fellow man, you should communicate with me-just as Jesus did with those who disagreed with Him until it was clear that there was no point in trying to communicate any further. With every word and action we either represent Jesus, God's Christ, or Satan, the leading antichrist. And Jesus is not a God of fire and brimstone but of "love" (1 John 4:8, ESV). If you want to honor God, you'll love people. And that involves communication.

1 Corinthians 6:3, ESV Do you not know that we are to judge angels?

Revelation 12:7, ESV War arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back,

15 We Need to Obey the Ten Commandments

Many Christians teach that we need to obey the Ten Commandments when God didn't even give them to us, as I covered in the previous video. The new covenant says they were given "by angels" (Acts 7:53, ESV) who had to be fallen angels since God didn't deliver us from Himself. And those ten commandments sum up more than 600 commandments you'd have to obey since the new covenant says "Whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of all of it" (James 2:10, ESV). And it's impossible for any human being to obey all of those commandments all the time which is why Satan gave them to us and why Jesus had to fulfill his law. Satan took much of the truth and gave it to humanity—along with his murderous lying ways—to put us in bondage and draw us away from God. And, as already covered, God allowed it because He has been "testing [us]" (Deut. 13:3, ESV) to reveal to us what we're really like, "deceitful above all

things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). If we weren't deceitful above all things, the body of Christ would have obeyed Jesus. We would have submitted to God, resisted the devil, and he would have had to flee (James 4:7 below). Instead, we've fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV) and laid out the red carpet for Satan to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV).

Rather than focus on the Old Testament, old covenant, we were supposed to focus on the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) and love God and people (Mar 12:30-31 below). Expressing *genuine* love works like a domino effect so that Jesus said "On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets" (Matt. 22:40, ESV). Genuinely love Jesus and you *will* genuinely love people *and* fulfill all of God's requirements because He forgives us and cleanses us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9 below) and helps us td better every time we mess up. We're supposed to become born again Christians (John 3:7 below) and "produce fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matt. 3:8, NIV). There's a moral law God placed in all of our hearts (Rom. 2:14-15 below) which we're supposed to live by. We all know the difference between good and evil; we just don't walk in it. That's the point. *That's* why we all need Jesus.

James 4:7, ESV Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Mark 12:30-31, ESV You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

1 John 1:9, ESV If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


John 3:7, ESV You must be born again.

Romans 2:14-15, ESV For when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do what the law requires, they are a law to themselves, even though they do not have the law. They show that the work of the law is written on their hearts, while their conscience also bears witness, and their conflicting thoughts accuse or even excuse them.

16 Prophets Can't Make Spiritual Mistakes

The "hired hands" Christians call Pastors—who Jesus clearly warned us "care...nothing for the sheep" (John 10:13, ESV)—often shoot out the lie that a true prophet will NEVER make a spiritual mistake. Yet the best prophet, according to Jesus (Matt. 11:11 in the graphic) John the Baptist, didn't even know who He was spiritually, which was a pretty big spiritual

mistake! And He was Spirit-filled from birth! (Luke 1:15 in the graphic). The fact is that all prophets in the Bible and ever since have made mistakes-with the exception of Jesus who was more than a prophet. That's kind of the point, "There is none righteous, not even one" (Rom. 3:10, YLT). So I'm going through history quickly proving that everyone has made spiritual mistakes including those God called as prophets. Jesus said "I send you prophets...whom you will...persecute from town to town" (Matt. 23:34, ESV)—which is my testimony of the last 26 years. We're also told that "He gave some [as] apostles, and some [as] prophets" (Eph. 4:11, YLT) so that some people have said to me "Maya! You're a prophet!" because, it's pretty obvious.



During the Days of the Old Testament: Since God is "testing" humanity (Deut. 13:3, ESV) He made Satan the "ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) giving him "all...authority" (Luke 4:6, NIV). And Satan set out to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV) by being "like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) which he's done by "masquerad[ing] as an angel of light" (2 Cor. 11:14, NIV). However, the prophets of the Old Testament weren't "born again" as Jesus says we

"must be" (John 3:7, ESV). If you're not born again you do not have the Holy Spirit inside of you and "the person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit" (1 Cor. 2:14, NIV). The Old Testament prophets only had the Spirit for blips at a time so that sometimes they discerned correctly but not always, especially since Satan has been hard at work to "deceive the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV) from "the beginning" (John 8:44, ESV).

For example, the Old Testament says that God told the Israelites to make animal sacrifices to Him, as with the following passage, "You shall bring the bull before the tent of meeting...Then you shall kill the bull before the LORD...It is a sin offering" (Ex. 29:10-14, ESV). However, the Old Testament also says "Whoever sacrifices a bull is like one who kills a person" (Isa. 66:3, NIV). And Solomon, who was "wiser than all other men" (1 Kings 4:31, ESV) "offered as a sacrifice 22,000 oxen and 120,000 sheep" (2 Chron, 7:5, ESV). He had 142,000 animals killed as a sacrifice to God when God says killing one animal is like killing a person! Clearly, the people of the Old Testament, including the prophets, lacked spiritual discernment. Because, "truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, ESV) and "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Heb. 13:8, ESV) so that one of those speaking—who even modern day born again Christians have said was God Almighty—was actually "the ruler" (John 12:31, YLT) and "god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV). And I discern it was the one who called for the killing since "the devil...was a murderer from the beginning" and has a "lust" for murder (John 8:44, ESV) which Solomon clearly fed for having been deceived, just like all the Israelites of the Old Testament that it had been God who told them to sacrifice animals even though God also told them is was equivalent to murder. Not only were they not born gain, they also didn't have the Bible written down for them in the same way that we do so that we can even shove it in our back pocket. Besides that, as humans they each had a "heart [that] is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) so that they didn't have that big a problem killing all those animals kind of like how our generation doesn't have a problem murdering all those aborted babies or entertaining ourselves with brutality.

During the Day's of Christ: Because John the Baptist didn't have the whole teachings of Christ and also had a "heart" that was "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV), just like the rest of us, even though he was filled with the Spirit from birth (Luke 1:15 in the prior graphic), he still made mistakes. He was wrong about who he was in Christ. And while he had testified to the people saying "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me" (John 1:15, ESV) and had baptized the Lord and *heard* the Father say "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Matt. 17:5, ESV), he was still full of doubt about Christ so that "he sent word by his disciples [asking Him] "Are you the one who is to come, or shall we look for another?" (Matt. 11:2-3, ESV). This great prophet was pretty confused and made some mistakes! And since he was Spirit-filled from the womb and actually walked with the Lord in the flesh, it's not as if any of us would do any *better!*

Before the Printing Press: Since the Bible wasn't even printed until 1455, it really wasn't until more modern times that the average Christian has even had their *own* Bible to read. So the born again continued to make loads of mistakes since they were mostly looking to men for spiritual direction when Jesus warned us that a "hired hand...cares nothing for the sheep" (John 10:13, ESV) and also said "Ye may not be called Rabbi, for one is your director—the Christ, and all ye are brethren" (Matt. 23:8, YLT). He clearly meant that we are not to take money for teaching the Word of God and neither use titles. Yet the body of Christ has **completely** historically ignored Him, at least on these two points, *guaranteeing* a lack of spiritual discernment. And it certainly doesn't help that every human "heart is deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). It's the reason we've been picking and choosing what to believe and obey out of the new covenant teachings of Christ ever since Jesus ascended, as with Peter in his dealings with Ananias and Sapphira.

Modern Day: It really hasn't been until the last 100 years, *especially* the last couple of decades with the web that we've had full and plenty of access to the Bible with the added benefit of 2000 years worth of Bible study. Even though much of their interpretation of the Bible had been wrong, much of it was right. And when we're honest about it all, willing to admit when we've been wrong, we can discern those mistakes as we "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV). Unlike those before us, we *should* have caught all their mistakes. But we haven't—different people *have* caught some, been enlightened to some—but because the body of Christ as a whole has been brainwashed with the lies that were historically passed down to us, and all of our hearts are deceitful above all things (Jer. 17:9), we still haven't "rightly divid[ed] the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15, YLT) so that we've also been "calling evil good and good evil" (Isa. 5:20, ESV) confusing Satan for God and vise versa!

While the born again have been given the Spirit of God since we obeyed Him, at least initially (Acts 5:32), we have not yet received a new heart as I covered in the section and video, the lie, that *Protestants are Reformed*. The point is that

we've all made loads of spiritual mistakes, including those who've been called and set apart by God as prophets. But this is the reason God admonished us to "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV) because when we don't, we seriously mess up. Rather than honor Christ, we end up honoring the antichrist. In fact, we end up *being* antichrist as clearly revealed by those on my path, and most clearly exposed in the book the Lord had me write for a professing Christian named Allen Barta which he had me made public. If you're seeing God's hand in this, if you're being honest, you should read that book. Much of this is in there, but that's much more thorough. <u>Dismissed-for-Allen-Barta-Final.pdf</u> (notmocked.com).

Use of Names: Having called me like Joseph, who interpreted dreams, the Lord has given me several biblical interpretation of secular resources, one of which uses my real name, the children's book *Maya Makes a Mess* by Rutu Modan. Before this point I'd used pseudonyms for everyone. But having exposed me the Lord exposed my lost relatives and it's not as if I should protect Christians while the lost are being exposed. If anything, Christian should be exposed since we're the ones who are supposed to be walking in the truth and in love. And I discern the Lord had me reach out to mostly Christians for 26 years to prove His point about our deceitful and wicked hearts, since EVERYONE has done the exact same thing with very little



variation so that in 26 years I've yet to be able to get through to even one person! That's how deceitful our hearts are, even when we're born again UNLESS we take every thought captive to Christ! And there's **NO WAY** you can be a born again Christian hypocrite and be able to see clearly, to clearly discern what God has said and done (Matt. 7:5 in the graphic)

Disclaimer: In the very beginning of having called me to reach out to Christians holding them accountable, the Lord let me know they would ignore me (Jer. 7:27 below) until His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:2-3 below).

Jeremiah 7:27, ESV You shall speak all these words to them, but they will not listen to you. You shall call to them, but they will not answer you.

Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

And when I wrote that book I erred on the side of grace thinking that Allen was likely born again. But working on this playlist seeing that he's also blown me off even though the Lord had me write a book for him, praying for him on videos, and giving him a section of my prayer journal in that book and he still didn't even acknowledge that I reached out to him, I'm now thinking he might not be born again, and worse. He came from a Catholic background, let his son go to the Jesuit Georgetown University while being an elder at a so-called reformed Presbyterian church, so I'm now thinking he might not be born again but a Jesuit purposely deceiving people and God had me write him the book as a set-up for when he stands before Him. Either way, the Lord went out of His way to get through to him and he still hardened his heart. In any case, the examples I provide in the book of others are clearly born again.



Excerpt from the Jesuit Oath: Be a spy...among other Protestants...obtaining their confidence, to seek even to preach from their pulpits, and to denounce with all the vehemence in your nature our Holy Religion and the Pope; and...plant the seeds of jealousy and hatred between communities, provinces, states that were at peace, and incite them to deeds of blood, involving them in war with each other...take sides with the combatants and to act secretly with your brother Jesuit, who might be engaged on the other side, but openly opposed to that with which you might be connected (my emphasis).

17 Born Again Christians Can't Be Demonic

The truth about the abusive nature within the body of Christ is revealed by Christian history, because at the very least many born again Christians have been OK with going off to war to kill our enemies rather than love them as Jesus called us to do (Matt. 5:44). The new covenant also says "him that had the power of death, that is, the devil" (Heb. 2:14, ESV). Going off to kill people is to serve the devil. It's demonic. And my 26 year testimony reveals how unbiblical, cold, and abusive today's Christians are, including the born again as shared throughout my YouTube channel and on free books. My testimony of very bright, highly educated so-called upright citizens who are clearly born again Christians reveals that they couldn't care less about dishonoring Christ even if it's led to children attempting suicide or singing "Our hearts are on fire with the feeling to kill." They don't care because it's as Jesus warned us in the teaching about the unclean spirit leaving a person and then coming back with seven spirits even more wicked so that the last state of that born again person is worse than the first! (Matt. 12:43-45 below). While you won't want to believe what I just said—that the born again can be demon possessed—I cover it thoroughly on my free book Dismissed-for-Allen-Barta-Final.pdf (notmocked.com), starting with page 83 with the section A Satanic Body of Christ! (And before that page I've revealed how it's clear that those people had to be born again. If they weren't born again no one is born again! Because, even those who are clearly producing good fruit in that they their work is exposing some of the lies and/or revealing greater truth that before, just scratching the surface of the rest of their beliefs reveals they're also walking in some of these lies so that they're also false teachers.)

Matthew 12:43-45, ESV When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person [that unclean spirit had to leave when that person became born again because the Holy Spirit of God booted that unclean spirit out], it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. Then it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. [That house is "empty" since that born again person who has been "swept and put in order" isn't a **follower** of Christ (Matt. 4:19), **not** fanning into flame the gift of God (2 Tim. 1:6) nor working out their own salvation as required (Phil. 2:12). It's like when I drove my motorcycle practically on fumes, saved by the reserve tank. Spiritually, we get "saved; yet so as by fire" (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV) "for our God is a consuming fire" (Heb. 12:29, ESV), like saved "by the skin of [your] teeth" (Job 19:20, NIV).] Then it [that unclean spirit] goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that [born again] person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation (Matt. 12:43-45, ESV).


Since we live in "the present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT) and God stands outside of time every generation has been an "evil generation." But He *especially* meant for the last 2000 years since He did what was necessary to set us "free" (John 8:36 below) from our bondage to sin (Rom. 6:6 below) and from OURSELVES (Jer. 17:9 below)—*knowing* we'd take what He did for us for granted since He "declar[es] the end from the beginning" (Isa. 46:10, ESV). Since we're so deceitful and wicked, the body of Christ blipped over what He warned us about in Matthew 12 just as we've blipped over most of what He warned us about so that we've made God out to be worse than Satan, covered next.

John 8:36, ESV If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

Romans 6:6, ESV We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

Jeremiah 17:9, KJV The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked.





18 Hell is a Real Place

This graphic sums up my understanding of what God has actually done which is revealed most clearly in the literal translations and in a decent interpretation of *any* translation. God is in the process of changing every human being He created to be like Christ. The Total Victory of Christ - YouTube channel produced by Michael Webber is by far the best I've come across having understood something other than hell for most of the people God created, what he and others refer to as universal salvation. But he hasn't yet been enlightened to the lies of pagan Christianity—a pretty big set of lies! Still, he has excellent content to go with a humble manner. Again, we have to take EVERY thought captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), "test [everything]; hold on to what is good [and] reject every kind of evil" (1 Thess. 5:21, NIV). We reject everything that doesn't line up with sound doctrine which is found in the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) teachings of Christ and as demonstrated by His life. (The following are the verses from the right column of the graphic.)

Romans 5:19, YLT For as through the disobedience of the one man, the many were constituted sinners: so also through the obedience of the one, shall the many be constituted righteous.

Colossians 1:20, YLT And through him to reconcile the all things to himself...whether the things upon the earth, whether the things in the heavens.


1 Corinthians 15:22-28, YLT Even as in Adam all die, so also in the Christ all shall be made alive, ²³ and each in his proper order...²⁸ and when the all things may be subjected to him, then the Son also himself shall be subject to Him...that God may be the all in all.

Considering that God knows the end from the beginning (Isa. 46:10) and that most born again Christians seldom evangelize, He would have to be intensely evil and hypocritical to have included the pagan notion of hell as part of His plan! But "God is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) so that hell is neither a real place nor part of His plan. You won't even find the word in the literal translations of the Bible. I think part of what God has done is something like this graphic. Having missed the best of the ages combined with the realization of what they've done against the backdrop of what God has done will be be a big part of their punishment. They'll be *overcome* with guilt because we were *all* made in the image of God who is love (Gen. 1:26 & 1 John 4:8). The shame and reality of their monstrous behavior *will* torment them. That could even be the whole punishment. They'll be tormented equivalent to the measure that they were evil.



However it actually plays out, the beauty of what God has done is that not only will those they hurt be able to forgive them since they'll be like Christ, *they* will be able to forgive themselves, eventually. "He will wipe away every tear from their eyes [the eyes every human being], and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away" (Rev. 21:4, YLT). When it's all been said and done, at the end of the ages, we'll *all* **fully** comprehend just how wicked we've all been and just how much Jesus did for all of us. While He didn't give us that much detail on the events after this age, and what He did give us we've seriously twisted, we do know that genuine love isn't brutal. It's "full of compassion" (Ps. 116:5, NIV) and "keeps no record of wrongs" (1 Cor. 13:5, NIV). In contrast, the doctrine of hell is seriously brutal and carried out because God supposedly keeps a record of wrongs.

This doctrine is one of the most damaging lies against God and humanity since it makes God out to be worse than Satan and keeps most elect from even *considering* the possibility that Jesus is God. Because of the condition of our hearts, that we are "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV), for centuries (at least) the body of Christ as a whole has been saying that "God [who] is love" (1 John 4:8, KJV) and who commands *us* to forgive "seventy-seven times" (Matt. 18:22, ESV), to the point that we "love...our enemies" (Matt. 5:44, ESV), and harshly rebuked hypocrites (Matt. 23:13), is the biggest hypocrite of all since He's (supposedly) **NOT**




going to forgive most of the people He created being that only a "few" find the way to life (Matt. 7:14) and is supposedly going to burn them alive FOREVER or ignore them forever leaving them in "outer darkness" (Matt. 8:12, KJV), or annihilate them with "everlasting destruction" (2 Thess. 1:9, NIV below). This doctrine makes God out to be extremely unforgiving and unloving. It also makes Him out to be extremely unrighteous since it's all for not believing in Jesus when "faith...is the gift of God" (Eph. 2:8, ESV) and no one can even come to Jesus unless the Father draws them (John 6:44 below). And the One burning or destroying everyone is supposedly Jesus because He's the One the Father gave "all authority in heaven and on earth" (Matt. 28:18, ESV) so that "all things were created through him and for him" (Col. 1:16, ESV). In sum, born again Christians have been saying that Jesus—the most loving and forgiving person who ever walked the face of the earth—is also the most brutal and unforgiving psychopath!

2 Thessalonians 1:9, ESV They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord. [Except the literal doesn't say *eternal* destruction but "destruction age-during" (YLT) or "eonian extermination from the face of the Lord" (CLT). Either way the literal translations speak of a time period, and age or an eon, not forever.]

John 6:44, ESV No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him.

And the notion that hell *has* to exist because God is holy—as so many Christians regurgitate without engaging their brains (2 Cor. 10:5 below)—is ridiculous since it **totally** ignores the *meaning* of holy (Jer. 17:9). It's also satanic because it honors Satan the "liar" (John 8:44, KJV). There is NO WAY the doctrine of hell—in any of its versions—is sound doctrine. That's clearly revealed when we take our thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5) and *work through* our cognitive dissonance.


2 Corinthians 10:5, ESV We destroy arguments and (a) every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ.



19 The Mark of the Beast

The combination of the truth about the so-called Great Reformation, my testimony of the past 26 years as the Lord has had me hold Christians accountable to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV)—to totally deaf ears and extremely hardened hearts—and the teaching on the following video, all confirm that the mark of the beast is *a way of life* summed up with these graphics from this video by thelivingword channel: What is meant by "666" and "antichrist"? It ties in to part of the picture that we were given in the Old Testament (Eze. 9:4 in the graphic). In other words, there are two 'marks' and most born again have the bad mark, the mark of the beast. While born again, they're honoring Satan and his lies and his ways.







The First Christians were Highly Empowered by God because they Obeyed Him as Individuals and as a Group

- They spoke in languages they hadn't studied (Acts 2:4-6);
- They healed the sick (Acts 3:2-7);
- . They raised the dead (Acts 9:37-41);
- They drove out demons (Acts 16:16-18);
- . They witnessed boldly (Acts 4:4);
- They prayed for their attackers as they killed them (Acts 7:58-60);
- They enlightened thousands at a time (Acts 7:58-60);
- . Their shadows provided healing (Acts 5:14-16);
- Unbelievers admired them (Acts 2:47);
- . They beamed around like in Star Trek (Acts 8:39-40);
- They were full of wisdom (Acts 6:3);
- . They were full of generosity (Acts 4:34-35); and,
- They were full of joy (Acts 2:46).

But since God has promised a "downpour" (Joel 2:23, CLT) referred to as the "latter rain" (Joel 2:23, ESV), an even greater outpouring of His Spirit in the faithful than He did for the "first rain" (Joel 2:23, KJV)—which was Pentecost and described in Acts, summed up in the yellow graphic—the born again who repent will rid themselves of the mark of the beast. It ties in to this ministry since He gave me the following passage summing it up:

The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry (Hab. 2:2-3, KJV).

I've walked mostly alone going against the grain for 26 years, suffering quiet a few consequences proving that I am a faithful servant of the Lord. At His "appointed time" the born again will run with the vision He gave me which is actually the vision He's given different people. He's just had me group their understanding, along with mine, all under one roof, so to speak. I discern it's the actual vision/message of the Bible. According to the new covenant, even the first disciples didn't have a full understanding of it. Maybe they did, but it seems to me that if they'd had it they would have presented it more clearly. "Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, ESV), the Father will finally answer the Lord's high priestly prayer of making us "one" with Him and one another (John 17:21, ESV). Since all things *are* possible with God (Matt. 19:26) who is "merciful" (Luke 6:36, ESV), many who currently have the beast's mark will swap it out for the Lord's mark through godly sorrow and repentance, changing both their mind and their ways—just like many lost elect will before His return, and *because* the born again did it first.

20 Spiritual Hypocrisy isn't That Big Big a Deal

While Christians would disagree and say that spiritual hypocrisy *is* a big deal, the actions of the body of Christ, historically, reveal that as group we think it's really no big deal since we've fulfilled the prophesied "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV). While even born again Christians have rebuked me for honoring Christ since the week I was born again in 1987, spiritual hypocrisy was a MAJOR point made by the Lord—as all born again Christians know. Spiritual hypocrisy is a huge problem for the following reasons:

- It blinds us from the truth (Matt. 7:5 below) and, therefore, keeps us from maturing in Christ;
- It leads unbelievers to think all religions are the same and that Jesus didn't mean what He said; and
- It's what Jesus said to the Jews "You hypocrites! You shut the door of the kingdom of heaven in people's faces" (Matt. 23:13, ESV). We keep people *from* the Truth when we're supposed to be leading them *to* the Truth.

Matthew 7:5, ESV You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

In short, with our hypocrisy, the body of Christ has laid out the red carpet for Satan to deceive and brutalize humanity when we were supposed to be "the light of the world" (Matt. 5:14, ESV). The body of Christ is responsible for the "great tribulation" coming on the whole world (Matt. 24:21, ESV) since we—not the lost—were informed (and profess to believe that it's true) that if we "submit...ourselves...to God [and] Resist the devil...he [would have had to] flee" (James 4:7 ESV). And only the born again body of Christ have the knowledge (Acts 4:12 below), the Spirit (Acts 5:32 below), and the power (Acts 1:8 below) to put an end to or, at the very least, severely hinder Satan's lordship over this world. In other words, there's nothing more damaging to humanity than spiritual hypocrisy in born again Christians. Rather than honor Christ, it honors the leading antichrist, "that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world" (Rev. 12:9, ESV) "a murderer" (John 8:44, ESV)—a mass murderer as reveal throughout the Bible.

Acts 4:12, ESV There is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Acts 5:32, ESV The Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him [obeyed Him initially long enough so that He gave us His Spirit].

Acts 1:8, ESV You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.

21 Prayer

Jesus says "Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it" (John 14:13-14, ESV). But praying in Jesus' name obviously doesn't just mean saying His name at the end of a prayer! It's praying in obedience to Him honoring His name—as revealed throughout the New Testament. Honor His name as a group, the body, at least a decent number of us, and the Father will answer the Lord's prayer to make us "one" (John 17:21, ESV), sending the latter rain to give us "on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10, ESV). It'll be as in heaven because the body of Christ will be walking in the power of the most High, who is in heaven. Because if the Father was going to answer anyone's prayers concerning the Church Jesus is building (Matt. 16:18 below), it would be the Lord's prayer for us to be "one" (John 17:21, ESV), His High Priestly Prayer, a prayer for maturity in Christ. Yet, while many have prayed for this during the course of the last 2000 years, the Father still hasn't answered it! In other words, we should have been on our faces asking Him why since the New Testament says "Let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity...And this we will do if God permits" (Heb. 6:1-3, ESV). As made abundantly clear through these lies—and as is abundantly clear by the state of the Church—God has not permitted this growth and the short answer as to why He hasn't is that "God does not listen to sinners" (John 9:31, ESV). In other words, the body of Christ is being called to repent. "Repent, then, and turn to God [or back to God], so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord" (Acts 3:19, NIV).

Matthew 16:18, YLT I will build my assembly, and gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

And since Jesus says "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him" (John 6:44, ESV), we should really only reach out to those He impresses us to reach out to. And if it wasn't at the spur of the moment but gave us time, we should cover that person or group in prayer so that they have a better chance at receiving the information. And no matter how much a person has been prayed for, we each person still have to CHOOSE to be honest. I discern prayer helps so that God knows just how bad it would be without it! Eventually, God will answer every biblical prayer that's come from a born again Christian, at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV) so that could be during this life or when they rise at the rapture or at the "judgment" (John 5:29, YLT).

For instance, God might call you to reach out to a co-worker so that He gave you plenty of time to cover them in prayer. And the way I would do it would be to pray through the New Testament for them with the exception of Revelation, and do it in writing downloading a chapter a day to my document then praying through the passages as I read them: as with this example since it's what He had me doing:

¹² For ⁽¹⁾ the word of God is living and ^(K) active, ^(L) sharper than any ^(M) two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and ^(N) discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Stab Allen to heart today with the Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God. Use all the work I've done to stab the body of Christ as well as the lost elect.

¹³ And ^(O) no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are ^(P) naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Michael knows this. Let him be willing to be held accountable to Your Word.

Having heard the Lord impress you through His Word to reach out to your co-worker and having prayed for them, then having reached out to them, they might *still* not have ears to hear you, but instead scoff—which is more than likely how it'll go. However, since God says "So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it" (Isa. 55:11, ESV) sooner or later that person *will* get enlightened. All we have to do is make sure that *we* are being faithful to what the Lord has called us to do, trusting Him to do His thing at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV). That's what I've been doing for 26 years having been called by Him to speak to the body of Christ to deaf ears and VERY hardened hearts! For all I know I'll die before anyone is honest about it! I don't think so, but—at this point—that'd be great! Not only because I'm sick of trying to get through to such hypocritical cold-hearted people, the born again, but because "for to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain" (Phil. 1:21, ESV) which ties in to another lie Christians have been peddling.

22 Satan is God's Enemy

Since the New Testament says "Jesus...was...tempted by the Devil" (Luke 4:1-2, YLT), many Christians say that Satan is God's enemy. But "by him [speaking of Jesus] all things were created, in heaven and on earth" (Col. 1:16, ESV). Jesus created Satan not as His enemy but as His tool. Sure, when He walked the earth Satan played the role of His enemy; but even then it was to teach us how to deal with him, which was by using our only weapon, "the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God" (Eph. 6:17, ESV) as Jesus demonstrated when led into the wilderness (Luke 4 & Matt. 6). He fought Satan's misuse of God's Word with proper use of it. And the Old Testament says "the Lord your God is testing you" (Deut. 13:3, ESV), so that I discern Satan is the Lord's tool by which He's testing us. The New Testament also says "Your enemy the devil" (1 Pet. 5:8, NIV, my emphasis) and "Deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord" (1 Cor. 5:5, ESV), again confirming the Lord's use of Satan as His tool. To say that Satan is God's enemy would mean that Jesus was powerless against him when he used the Romans and Jews to crucify Him. But anyone who even remotely understands the Bible knows that Jesus went to the Cross by His own choice so that He says, for instance, "For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life" (John 10:17, ESV) revealing the great love that He has for the Father and for humanity since "greater love has no one than [to]...lay down his life for his friends" (John 15:13, ESV). Since Jesus is "the carpenter" (Mark 6:3, ESV), and all carpenters have great tools, Satan is like the Lord's intense Swiss Army knife that He's using on us—what's commonly called the Refiner's Fire. Like going to the dentist, it hurts less when we work with the Lord rather than fight the dentist.

23 It's Hard to Tell Jesus is God

Christians don't say this outright—the lost do—but most Christians reveal by other words along with their actions that they think it's hard to communicate to the lost that Jesus is the One true God. And yet, God made it obvious, especially for our generation to know this truth. It's obvious because Jesus fulfilled 351 Old Testament Messianic prophecies and He had Peter Stoner calculate the odds of one person fulfilling just 8 of them. Stoner's findings, published in *Science Speaks* and verified by others, discussed in this article, <u>The Statistical Probability of Jesus Fulfilling the Messianic Prophecies — Theology for the People (nickcady.org)</u>, reveal it would be easier to win the lottery than for one person to fulfill eight of those prophecies! And since Jesus didn't just fulfill eight of them, but 351 of them! In other words, God made it a **NO-BRAINER** for us to know that Jesus is the only One who actually represents God.

This information should be the body of Christ's first line of evangelism and defense. If a lost soul is unwilling to admit that God made it obvious with those 351 Messianic prophecies (351 Old Testament Prophecies Fulfilled In Jesus Christ | New Testament Christians.Com there's no point in further discussion since they're not willing to be honest. What they're doing is proving God's main point that "the heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). Because, the Bible was written by 40 people in 3 different continents, of different walks of life, at different times in history over a period of 1500 years, in three different languages, and it's **loaded** with cross references! It's *obviously* a supernatural work of God! And He confirms it to us when we become born again because we can then "hear [His] voice" (John 10:27, ESV) through the Scriptures combined with His Spirit inside of us.

But, because the body of Christ is so far from God today—as a whole, as represented by all of these lies we're peddling which I'm covering on this playlist—today's born again Christians call you nuts if you hear God's voice clearly and what you hear contradicts the lies we've historically believed! That's how far from God we are today. Even the born again are immersed in Satan's lies—to one degree or another—and deaf to the voice of God for loving their opinions more than the truth, just like the lost they're supposed to be reaching for Christ!




24 Christians are in Heaven Right Now


Comparing Scripture with Scripture and everything we've been told about death and the Lord's return, I discern that Christians honor Satan, the "liar" (John 8:44, ESV), by saying that those who've died in the faith are with the Lord right now. I discern it's a lie because the New Testament says "the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first" (1 Thess. 4:16, ESV). In other words, those who died in Christ are currently asleep, like Lazarus was before Jesus came and said to him "Come out!" (John 11:43, NIV).

While Jesus told the repentant sinner on the Cross next to Him "Today you will be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43, ESV), I think He said it knowing that's how it would *feel* to the man. Since God "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV), and God stands outside of time, I discern it's playing out like we see in time travel movies. You could be dead, in Christ, for 2000 years, like all the apostles, and yet when they hear the sound of the trumpet and rise to meet the Lord in the air, those who had been dead in Christ and rise first will feel like they *just* died. It'll feel like when we were super tired, slept for hours, and woke up feeling like we just put our head on the pillow!

We have to remember that "we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against...the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places" (Eph. 6:12, ESV) out to "devour" us (1 Pet. 5:8, ESV). We're in a brutal war with Satan and the rest of the fallen angels. So when I hear testimonies of people having died and who went to heaven, or having died and gone to hell, all of which are spoken by Christians and pagans, I discern it's Satan at work "deceiv[ing] the nations" (Rev 20:3, KJV) even if what they're saying about the dead is positive since that's how good lies work, they're loaded with truth. These lies give people a false sense of security which is exactly what Satan wants us to have. If all these testimonies of professing Christians who say they died and went to heaven or hell were true, these people would be on fire for God and 100% devoted to Christ. But that's not the case. Instead of focusing on encouraging others to walk in the truth, they're typically focused on sharing that testimony. And the message that's being cemented is that it's OK to be a carnal unfaithful Christian—just believe in Jesus. And the problem with that—the main problem—is that "the devils also believe" (James 2:19, KJV). In short, these lies about heaven and hell and what happens after we die strengthen Satan's grip on humanity. Even if all the lost who heard those testimonies were drawn to Christ enough to become born again, they're still not growing in Christ but, instead, joining the mass of carnal Christians of today's version of Christianity.





More than anything, Satan wants to hurt Jesus since He kicked him out of heaven (Rev. 12:4-9 in the graphic). By deceiving and hurting the people Jesus loves, he hurts Him. Imagine being the Lord and having died that brutal and humiliating death, hanging there naked in excruciating pain for people who He knew wouldn't even appreciate it for 2000 years! That's gotta hurt. And while humanity hasn't appreciated it, what's gotta hurt the most is that born again Christians haven't really appreciated it since we've been picking and choosing what to believe and obey out of the Lord's



teachings for the past 2000 years—and when held accountable *refuse* to repent! The body of Christ "hav[ing] fallen away[,]...[keeps] crucifying...the Son of God to [ou]r own harm and holding him up to contempt [before the lost]" (Heb. 6:6, ESV). Then we top it off by blaming *them* for not honoring God and the mess the world is in! And we've been doing it because our hearts *are* "deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). But the logs in our eyes are much more of a problem than the specks of dust in theirs (Matt. 7:5 in the graphic). And my ministry and life testimony reveal that today's body of Christ is made up of the worst spiritual hypocrites of *all* time!

Again, according to Scripture and being that "truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, ESV)—so that we can't base our beliefs on the Old Testament alone—I discern that all who've died are asleep right now, as Jesus demonstrated with Lazarus, for example, are not in heaven. All those supposedly dead relatives those with near death experiences saw were Satan deceiving them since he can perform "signs and lying wonders" (1 Thess. 2:8, KJV).





25 What Took Place in the Garden of Eden

The body of Christ teaches that God—in other words Jesus since "all things were created through him and for him" (Col. 1:16, ESV)—tempted and cursed humanity in the Garden of Eden. We've been teaching that Jesus tempted humanity by placing the forbidden tree in the Garden. Then He, supposedly, cursed the serpent (Gen. 3:14 below), cursed Eve (Gen. 3:16 below), cursed the earth (Gen. 3:17 below), and cursed Adam (Gen. 3:19 below). Yet all born again know that God hates hypocrisy because of how Jesus dealt with the Jews (Matt. 23:13 below) and commands us to "bless and...not curse" (Rom. 12:14, ESV). The body of Christ also knows that God hasn't changed (Mal. 3:6) so that "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Heb. 13:8, ESV). So while we have historically, intensely lied about the Lord's character, held accountable the born again get offended by the truth that we've been this wrong in our interpretation of Scripture and honor Satan when Jesus says "Blessed is the one who is not offended by me" (Matt. 11:6, ESV), and He is "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV). In other words, blessed is the one who doesn't get offended by the truth. Jesus didn't set us up like how Christians have been teaching, though I do discern He set us up. This is what I mean. According to Scripture, He set us up by allowing Satan to be "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) giving him "all authority" (Luke 4:6, ESV) because He has been "testing" us" (Deut. 13:3, ESV). And as I've been explaining, this test was to reveal to us that even when we're born again our hearts are still "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV), which is why we were given all the warnings on how to work out our salvation in the New Testament.

Genesis 3:14, ESV The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you.


Genesis 3:16, ESV To the woman he said, "I will surely multiply your pain in childbearing.

Genesis 3:17, ESV To Adam he said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife...cursed is the ground because of you.

Genesis 3:19, ESV By the sweat of your face you shall eat.

Matthew 23:13, ESV Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!

Since Satan has been "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT) from the very beginning and has been a "liar" and "murderer" (John 8:44, ESV) *all* of that time, who set out to "be like the most High" (Isa. 14:14, KJV) "deceiv[ing] the nations" (Rev. 20:3, KJV) by "masquerad[ing] as an angel of light" (2 Cor. 11:14, NIV), I discern he was the one—in cahoots with the rest of the fallen angels—who tempted and deceived the first humans by placing the forbidden tree right smack in the middle of their front yard commanding them not to eat of it. As already covered, technically, the term "Lord God" can refer to either, God, the Father; God, the Son, or Satan "the ruler" and "god of this world" (2 Cor. 4:4, KJV).



Since "truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, ESV), and God has been testing us (Deut. 13:3 below), it's only been the born again who could have—and should have—passed this test because no one can interpret Scripture correctly without His Spirit within (1 Cor. 2:14 below) and not being a hypocrite about what Jesus taught since that blinds us (Matt. 7:5 below). Therefore, Jesus modeled what we needed to do (in Matt. 5 in the graphic) and spelled it out through Paul who wrote "Be diligent to present thyself approved to God—a workman irreproachable, rightly dividing the word of the truth" (2 Tim. 2:15, ESV).

Deuteronomy 13:3, ESV The LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

1 Corinthians 2:14, NIV The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

Matthew 7:5, ESV Hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

Before Pentecost, there was no way for anyone to be able to *tell* when fallen angels or God Almighty was talking to them since those who don't have the holy Spirit within "cannot understand" the things of the Spirit (1 Cor. 2:14, NIV). But "truth came through Jesus" (John 1:17, ESV) so that born again Christians *should* have been able to discern this first deception. And we would have been enlightened to it had we taken Jesus more seriously than we've historically done.

And by not discerning Satan's presence in the Garden, the born again have *easily* fallen for his lies throughout the Old Testament so that we've repeatedly and consistently historically "call[ed] evil good and good evil...put[ting] darkness for light and light for darkness, [and]...bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter!" And God says "Woe" to such people (Isa. 5:20,

ESV). There is woe involved because we've not only been deceived by Satan who has a "lust" for "murder" (John 8:44, ESV), we've *helped* him deceive and murder, as clearly revealed by the so-called reformers of the Middle Ages, again summed up well enough on this series of articles: The Plain Truth about the Protestant Reformation - Part 1 | Tomorrow's World (tomorrowsworld.org). The born again who were called, chosen, enlightened, and empowered to be the "light of the world" (Matt. 5:14, ESV) have historically as a group—to one degree or another as individuals—helped Satan carry out his wicked "schemes" (Eph. 6:11, ESV). Like God, Satan uses people so that by not "tak[ing our] every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV), the born again have historically allowed ourselves to get both deceived and used by Satan.

The fact is that every minute of every day, every human being is either being used by God or by Satan since our "struggle is...against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV). The good part about it—God's grace in it—is that He's always using us *even* when we're being used by Satan since God "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV). What that means is that in the end—by the end of the ages—it will all have been turned around by God for His glory, our good, even Satan's good.


Therefore, when we start paying more careful attention now, we can work *with* God and make the most of Satan's schemes for God's purposes, which is also for our good. God has let Satan have his wicked way knowing how He's going to turn it ll around and use it for His glory by the end of the ages. And that glory is that in the end EVERYONE will finally fully understand and admit that we are "deceitful above all things and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). We'll finally *genuinely* be grateful for what Jesus did for us—so unlike how the body of Christ has historically been.

26 Christmas Honors God

Jesus didn't tell us to celebrate His birthday and scholars differ on whether it was the Spring or Fall; but they agree that it was definitely NOT December. It's as if He purposely prevented us from knowing so that we *wouldn't* celebrate it. Because, to celebrate it, a born again Christian is joining light with darkness when Jesus says "He who is following me shall not walk in the darkness" (John 8:12, YLT). In fact, the new covenant says "What fellowship has light with darkness?" (2 Cor. 6:14, ESV), the rhetorical answer being none. And since Jesus is "the light" (John 8:12, ESV), celebrating this pagan holiday keeps you *from* having fellowship with the Lord since you're walking in darkness. It's like having a close friend that we've decided to NOT spend time with for being more interested in something else. By celebrating this pagan un holy day, the body of Christ has also not been helping the lost—because they know it's a pagan holiday. And we've been called to "take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them" (Eph. 5:11, NIV). What we've been doing instead is sending out the message that the truth is subjective, based on opinions, helping Satan peddle his lies when we were supposed to be supporting the Lord who is "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV). We've been honoring Satan, the leading antichrist, rather than honoring Jesus, God's Christ—deceiving ourselves above all—and doing it for centuries, at least. And, again, that's God's main point, without taking our thoughts captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5) and lining up our lives with His teaching, our "heart is deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). We deceive ourselves. And as this text and playlist reveals, the born again have historically outrageously deceived ourselves!

The Old Testament also says "Learn not the way of the nations...for the customs of the peoples are vanity. A tree from the forest is cut down and worked with an axe by the hands of a craftsman. They decorate it with silver and gold; they fasten it with hammer and nails so that it cannot move" (Jer. 10:2-4, ESV). There are loads of documentaries on it online, as with this one: Christians Should NOT Celebrate Christmas / Saturnalia The Pagan Holiday (youtube.com). Apparently most or much of it is another documentary, The Unwrapping of Christmas: Its History, Myths, and Traditions. And God says "If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all" (Isa. 7:9, NIV) which is exactly the state of the Church today, not standing at all. It's totally ineffective because, at best, all we've been doing is creating more born again hypocrites who—as my testimony reveals—REFUSE to be held accountable and honor Jesus, when that's the main thing every Christian should be doing.


This pagan celebration also sucks up time, money, and resources which should be spent on building the Lord's kingdom which is "not of this world" (John 18:36, ESV). It's a HUGE **DISTRACTION** handed to us by Satan. And it causes more unhappiness than happiness for loads of people! "Christmas can be the most stressful time of the year, given the financial pressure and expectations to keep up with Christmas traditions. It can also trigger feelings of loss, grief, and trauma" (www.hopementalhealth.com). Yet Christians GET UP IN ARMS about it because they love Satan's trinkets and



the traditions of men (Mark 7:13 in the graphic) so that all Satan had to do to get us hooked on it was move one little letter around! Christians love watering down the truth so that as a group we are steeped in "rebellion" just as God said we would be before the "day" of the Lord's return (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV). But, thanks be to God, He also said there would be a "latter rain" "downpour" (Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT)—which will begin just as soon as we repent and start humbly working together—being honest. That's pretty important to God who says "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth" (3 John 1:4, ESV).

27 There are No Lone Ranger Christians

My experience of the past 26 years as the Lord has had me holding Christians accountable to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, NIV) "law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2, ESV), is that today's Christians are in the habit of mindlessly parroting what those hired hands preach from their pulpits, that "There are no lone ranger Christians!" So they dismiss me as if I haven't got a clue as to what I'm talking about and as if I'm not a part of the body of Christ when it's obvious that I am. And the thing is that most of them sing about what they say no one can be. I would think most professing Christians have sung the hymn—at least once—I Have Decided to Follow Jesus which says "Though none go with me, I still will follow." What they're singing is that they'll be a Lone Ranger Christian if that's what's needed. In other words, they've being double minded when we were warned that "a double minded man is unstable in all his ways" (James 1:8, ESV). And that is obviously the body of Christ today. Hardly anything we're saying and doing lines up with the teachings of Christ!




And the reason the Lord has enlightened me as much as He has is *because* I've been willing to follow Him though literally NONE go with me. I've walked alone with the Lord for more than a decade and in many ways more than two decades. It's also NOT as if I love doing EVERYTHING alone! I'd love nothing more than to have fellowship in Christ with others, but it's impossible with people who only honor Him with their lips yet keep their hearts far from Him, refusing to admit the truth of what Scripture actually says even when it's clearly pointed out to them. Or who refuse to even discuss anything concerning the new covenant that disagrees with their *opinions*. According to the Lord's teaching, I'm doing exactly what I'm supposed to be doing. But because we're living at the very end of the age, having fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV), I'm on my own, with Christ. He's not asking me to water down the truth in order to have so-called fellowship with others, He wants the body of Christ to stop being rebellious and repent so that we can all actually have fellowship with Him and one another—and finally *be* "the light of the world" (Matt. 5:14, ESV) He called us to be!

28 We Need Christians to Hold Us Accountable

The truth is that we need to be willing to be held accountable, whether that's when spoken to by another Christian or directly by the Spirit. But, having been unwilling to submit to God for these 2000 years, there are loads of testimonies online about supposedly mature Christians sinning like crazy crazy when—unlike EVERYONE else—we all know exactly what we should and shouldn't be doing. And God says "whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin" (James 4:17, ESV) So I give you this example of College Park church in Indianapolis.

When an elder sexually abused his own preschool granddaughter at church, the leadership persuaded the congregation to honor the sexual predator rather than the poor little victim! This is the current state of the body of Christ since most born again Christians are still in those buildings viewing that pagan system as if that's the Church Jesus is building. So, as it is, there can only be disunity. The born again Christians the Lord has led me to, so far, have all been "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof [about whom He says] from such turn away" (2 Tim. 3:4-5, ESV). While Christians argue



that we need other Christians to hold us accountable *they* refuse to be held accountable *or* to hold others accountable—for the most part. Moreover, it's ultimately the job of the Holy Spirit to hold us accountable, "He will convict the world concerning sin, and concerning righteousness, and concerning judgment" (John 16:8, YLT). And it's each of our job to submit to Him—no matter who or what He uses to speak to us. We'll know it's Him if whatever is being said lines up with the teachings of Christ. So it's NOT hard to figure out if God is using someone to hold us accountable. It was the New Testament says "Do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God" (1 John 1:4, ESV). The way to unity in Christ is not by watering down the faith as Christian have historically done to suit themselves, but by "submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, ESV). If we actually have reverence for Christ, we'll value His teaching more than our own opinions. But I've yet to meet such a person. And I'm 60 years old!

Having fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV), most of today's born again Christians are walking very far from the Lord so it's not as if we can look to them to hold us accountable. And we shouldn't be looking to people in the first place since "there is none righteous, not even one" (Rom. 3:10, YLT) and all of our hearts are "deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). There's only One to whom we should look, that's Jesus Christ because "No one is good except God alone" (Mark 10:18, ESV). Look to anyone else and you'll become like those people at College Park, antichrist, as I covered throughout this playlist, cover throughout my material, and which Jesus warned us about in Matthew 12:43-45—telling us that we've become "worse" than before we'd been born again! I provide plenty of examples in the book the Lord had me wrote for Allen Barta which He also had me make public Dismissed-for-Allen-Barta-Final.pdf (notmocked.com). By not honoring Christ, members of the body of Christ, the born again, have allowed seven more evil spirits to enter into them—historically which is why even born again Christians have had no problem sinning like. College Park is just one example of God knows how many! As I've thoroughly covered, most born again Christians today are merely born again believers who are babies in Christ so that "though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God. You need milk, not solid food" (Heb. 5:12, ESV). And, being babies, rather than acting like mature adults, you get offended being informed of this truth. It's the reason the Lord will have to step in so that someone can finally run with the vision He's had me write (Hab. 2:2-3).

29 Elect Means Born Again

The following passage is the key one in the New Testament about the doctrine of election (Rom. 9:22-23 in the graphic). I discern the vessels of wrath are non-elect whereas the vessels of mercy are elect, those the Father has been drawing to Jesus during this age, specifically the last 2000 years since the "truth came through Jesus Christ" (John 1:17, ESV) and He says "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him" (John 6:44, ESV).

However, most of today's Christians talk about the term *elect* as if it means *born again*. But that can't possibly be the case since Paul said "I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Christ" (2 Tim. 2:10, ESV, my emphases). The born again have already obtained salvation. The fact is that I've never heard a definition of election by someone who hasn't bought the lie about hell. I think that's where a big part of the problem lies. Believing this lie, Christians twist Scripture to fit their incorrect understanding.

But having been enlightened to the lie about hell and to the ages, I discern that God broke up humanity for the present evil age—my guess is the next age as well but I'm just focusing on this age—I discern He broke us up into two groups in order to prove His point to us about the deceitful and wicked nature of our hearts (Jer. 17:9). And since the New Testament is primarily focused on "the present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT), that's what I discern this passage is focused on as well. And when I plug in my understanding of what God has actually done through the ages—that hell is a man-made false doctrine—and that Jesus died for all of humanity, as I've covered, that He has been "testing" us (Deut. 13:3, ESV), and that He's proving to us our desperate need for Christ because of the intensely deceitful nature of the human heart (Jer. 17:9) as the born again body of Christ has historically proven beyond a doubt, I discern that God broke us up into these two groups of elect and non-elect in order to use the non-elect like the control group.

While Christians talk about having been transformed—as I already covered towards the beginning—Christian history and the state of the body of Christ reveal that it's more like we've hardly been transformed at all so that it's practically impossible to tell who's born again today since even the born again sin like crazy and refuse to be held accountable to the new covenant. But, having proven over these 2000 years how deceitful we are even when born again, finally further enlightened to our sins by the Lord at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV), the born again will finally admit the truth about *ourselves*. Repenting, the lost elect—the current vessels of mercy who are not born again—will finally come to Christ as a group—a time the Bible calls "the latter rain" "downpour" (Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT)—so that we'll see the fulfillment of

Romans 9:22-23, God making known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy. It'll be fulfilled in stages, during the latter rain, then more so at the rapture, and even more so over the next 1000 years.

And since Jesus died for all of humanity, eventually everyone will see that "destruction" (Rom. 9:22, ESV) actually speaks of the vessels of wrath of this age who will experience "the resurrection of judgment" (John 5:29, ESV) also called "the second death" (Rev. 2:11, ESV), which I've already walked through. It being the same that the born again have walked through during this life having died to self. For us that spiritual death came first, before physical death. For them it'll come second, after their physical death.


Again, I discern God split us up into these two groups to reveal to us the depth of our depravity since the only thing making the elect come to Christ is God (John 6:44, ESV) since "there is none righteous, not even one" (Rom. 3:10, YLT). So while the Father drew the elect vessels of mercy to Christ, most have not become born again—they've rejected Jesus just like the vessels of wrath/non elect—and those who have become born again, have mostly become worse than before they were born again as Jesus warned us would happen if we didn't become His follower (Matt. 4:19 & 12:43-45 below) as opposed to mere "believers" like demons (James 2:19 below). Right now nearly everyone thinks they're a good person including born again Christians. Yet, admit it or not, we've all proven how desperately deceitful and wicked we all are. The only thing keeping the born again from being any worse is the Holy Spirit of God in us. And when God removes the blinders, we'll admit, as a group, that we really are capable of being just as bad as the worst humans have ever been, so that we'll finally express genuine gratitude to Christ for the work He did for us and is doing in us. And eventually EVERYONE will discern this truth about themselves and about Christ. Without the non elect vessels of wrath prepared for destruction, we wouldn't be able to see just how bad we can be. In other words, we wouldn't be able to appreciate what exactly Jesus did for us by being willing to go to the Cross so that He could eventually give us a "new heart" (Ezek. 36:26, ESV), His heart. And by the end of the ages everyone will have admitted that this is exactly what we all need because until we get that new heart we are all prone to being "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV)—as the body of Christ has been for these 2000 years.

Matthew 4:19, ESV Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

Matthew 12:43-45, ESV When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. Then it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation

James 2:19, ESV You believe that God is one; you do well. Even the demons believe—and shudder!

So while we currently have to *work out our salvation* (Phil. 2:12)—which the body of Christ and, I discern, all elect *will* finally do as this age comes to an end—fully transformed by God finally given the heart of Christ, we'll no longer have to work at it since being good, honest, and loving at all times will have become our nature. Glory of God! And, in the end, all of humanity, **EVERYONE** Jesus created will be like Him, all the time. We'll be a completely "new humanity" (Eph. 2:15, NIV).



30 Christians are Faithful

There are many more lies Christians peddle and practice, but I've covered 29 of them all of which prove that the body of Christ is the furthest thing from being faithful. As a group we've historically been outrageously unfaithful, and gotten worse with time so that we've fulfilled "the rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV). Today's body of Christ is in the worst shape we've ever been in so that the body is made up of mostly the worst hypocrites the world has ever known! If I was delusional as I get accused by everyone including the body of Christ then hypocrisy is the best thing ever and Jesus was insane in thinking otherwise. But He wasn't. And EVERYONE knows that there's nothing positive about hypocrisy. And the New Testament makes it clear that we have to "rightly divid[e] the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15, YLT), which we can't do if we have hypocritical beams in our eyes (Matt. 7:5). And I've proven that the body of Christ has *loads* of beams in Her eyes. And as a member of the body I've also had them in mine.

However, over the past several decades I've done my best to remove them from my eyes as I've gotten convicted by the Lord. And the reason He convicted me, was so that I'd be able to "write the vision, and make it plain...that h∫is people may] run [with it at His]...appointed time" (Hab. 2:2-3, KJV). In other words, God has given me a walk over the last 6 decades, especially the last three, to be able to see the vision of His Plan for humanity while providing good examples of what's currently going on—for those who are willing to be honest. It's what He says in Ephesians, that He "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV). And the only reason I've been convicted and not remained with the carnal body of Christ is because "if we are faithless, he remains faithful" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). If not for Him there would be no "latter rain" "downpour" (Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT). Either "the way" is so "narrow" (Matt. 7:14, ESV) that only one in a million people are actually born again—since not one person has responded biblically or honorably to me in 26 years—or the born again are as I've covered on this text and playlist, steeped in "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV)—as all born again admit! But Jesus didn't call us to just admit the truth. He's called us to line up our lives with it, with Him, and walk in the truth. I've had this passage on my mind for days about what Samuel said to his disgusting sons, "If someone sins against a man, God will mediate for him, but if someone sins against the LORD, who can intercede for him?" (1 Sam. 2:25, ESV), the obvious answer being no one. By giving Jesus lip-service as the body of Christ has historically done to one degree or another, we've left ourselves wide open for Satan to have his way with us—and his way is as evil as it gets. In turn, the world will soon be facing "great tribulation" (Matt. 24:21, ESV). But, because "He remains faithful" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV), He gave me this ministry, pleading for His children to walk in the truth and foretold that at His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV) His people will "run" with it (Hab. 2:2-3, KJV). Glory to God!

Many born again Christians today do discern the Lord's soon return. However, it's NOT as if Jesus is going to rapture us outta here without having had us fulfill our purpose! In other words, He *will* make His Church "holy and without blemish" (Eph. 5:25-27 below). And for that to happen, the born again HAVE TO ADMIT every instance that we're in the wrong **AND** CHANGE OUR WAYS. Because Jesus isn't the fool the body of Christ has made Him out to be! Shame on us!

Ephesians 4:25-27, ESV Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.
