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# We Will Rock You, Queen

While people, including born again Christians, love to tell me that I'm delusional, Christians sing about God's hand being on everything as with the song *Reason* by Unspoken, part of which says "If we could pull back the curtain of heaven we would see God's hand in everything...He's always been in it." Called by God and given the Joseph Experience I'm interpreting songs, books, and movies on this playlist pulling back the curtain of heaven revealing that He *has* "work[ed] all things according to the counsel of his will" ([Eph. 1:11, ESV](#)). Part of the reason Christians can't discern God's voice to this level is because, as a group, we've fulfilled "the rebellion" ([2 Thess. 2:3 in the graphic](#)). Right now the body of Christ is in the worst shape we've ever been in, and ever will be in. We've hit the bottom of the barrel. So the key verse that ties in to these interpretations is [Psalm 2:4](#), "He who is sitting in the heavens doth laugh, The Lord doth mock at them" (YLT). He's mocking the body of Christ for having been so outrageously unfaithful historically. So, among other things which I'll be covering, it would help you to listen to the song first to get the feel of it fresh in your system. [Queen - We will rock you \(Lyrics\) - YouTube](#). I'll be walking through the whole lyrics "bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of the Christ" ([2 Cor. 10:5, YLT](#)) as all born again were instructed to do.



**The Rock.** The *Rock* is God's Christ, commonly called Jesus. Scripture says "that Rock was Christ" ([1 Cor. 10:4, KJV](#)).

**The Queen.** The queen refers to the "body of Christ" ([1 Cor. 1:27, KJV](#)) biblically called the Church since "Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her" ([Eph. 5:25, ESV](#)). Jesus is the "King of kings" ([Rev. 19:16, ESV](#)) and "Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" ([John 1:29, ESV](#)). Therefore, as "the wife of the Lamb" ([Rev. 21:9, ESV](#)) the body of Christ is the Queen, in fact, Queen of queens—the most important women of this world.

But, again, She/the Church has historically looked and behaved like a BRAT WHORE ([Jer. 3:3 below](#)) rather than the beauty queen Jesus died for us to be, having gotten worse with time so that we've fulfilled "the rebellion" ([2 Thess. 2:3, ESV](#)). But because He's faithful even when we're not ([2 Tim. 2:13](#)) and He died to make Her "holy and without blemish" ([Eph. 5:27, ESV](#)), He's giving Her a makeover like they did in the movies *My Fair Lady* (1964) and *Pretty Woman* (1990).




If you think there's nothing wrong with the Church, compare the words of the Lord to what Christians have been saying and doing and—being honest—you'll see that we don't even come close to measuring up, summed up with the graphic.

**We Will Rock You, Queen.** As a member of the body of Christ, *we* primarily refers to myself and the Lord Jesus Christ. We will be rocking you, the queen, the body of Christ—through the ministry which He has entrusted to me, IF you're going to be honest about it. The following is the key verse the Lord gave me about this ministry in the late 1990s when I asked Him about the “good works, which God prepared beforehand, that [I] should walk in” (Eph. 2:10, ESV).

The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry (Hab. 2:2-3, KJV).

The body of Christ has blinded Herself with hypocritical beams in her eyes, which the Lord has been holding in place as a judgment against us since “judgment must begin at the house of God” (1 Pet. 4:17, KJV) and we are “God's building” (1 Cor. 3:9, ESV). At His appointed time, He'll be removing the blinders and rocking the body of Christ, the Queen, through this ministry because as a group we've been believing and teaching a load of lies which *severely* dishonor Him. I summed it up on the playlist [Lies Christians Peddle - YouTube](#) where I go over around 30 of them, some of which I'll cover here.





**The Body of Christ as Buddy.** Jesus says to all born again Christians “I have called you friends” ([John 15:15, KJV](#)). Buddy is another word for friend. All born again Christians were supposed to behave like Buddy to Jesus, who is God, since we’re supposed to “love the Lord...our God” ([Mark 12:30, ESV](#)). We were also to behave like Buddy to every other human being having been called to “love...our neighbor as...ourselves” ([Mark 12:31, ESV](#)). And, we were supposed to behave like Buddy to those who hate and want to hurt us since we were also supposed to “love...our enemies” ([Matt. 5:44, ESV](#)). And we haven’t been doing any of it historically. That’s obvious for those who know even the slightest bit of history.


**Jesus as Buddy.** Jesus is our “Buddy” since He says “I have called you friends” ([John 15:15, KJV](#)) and He “lay down his life for his friends” ([John 15:13, ESV](#)). He *proved* to be the best Friend any of us could ever have.

## Being a Boy

This refers to being immature—a child.

**Satan is a Boy.** Satan’s really just a *boy* compared to God, both “Father, and...Son” ([1 John 1:3, KJV](#)), since he’s extremely immature. While he thinks he’s God’s gift to the world—which he *would* have been had he been faithful being that “angels [were created to be] ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation” ([Heb. 1:14, NIV](#))—but he rebelled against the Lord and *hardly* measures up to Him. The best Satan can do is be “**like** the most High” ([Isa. 14:14, KJV](#)). He’s like a little boy *pretending* to be a man. In fact, those who have “the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him” ([Acts 5:32, NIV](#)), are greater than Satan since “greater is he that is in you [born again Christians], than he that is in the world” ([1 John 4:4, KJV](#)), and Satan is “the ruler of this world” ([John 12:31, YLT](#)). He was given that authority by God, more specifically Jesus who said “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me” ([Matt. 28:18, ESV](#)). God, the Father, gave Jesus, His Son, all authority in heaven and on earth, and Jesus gave part of it to Satan, making him the ruler of this world because He’s been “testing” us “to know whether you love the LORD...our God with all your heart and with all your soul” ([Deut. 10:10, ESV](#)). Essentially He’s been proving to us that we do not love our Maker, doing it so that we all eventually see our need for Him and become *genuinely* grateful to Him for what He did for us—as I’m somewhat covering here.

**The Body of Christ is a Boy.** By not having taken Jesus seriously enough, the body of Christ is also like an immature boy. Living “as people of the flesh [the body of Christ as a whole has been functioning] as infants in Christ” ([1 Cor. 3:1, ESV](#)). The Lord *has* made the point since for the 27 years that He’s had me holding Christians accountable NOT ONE has been honest and admit the truth that we as a group need to repent. And until we repent we are behaving like an immature brat—a boy.




## Making a Big Noise

Making a big noise is something like being obnoxious, as immature brats tend to be.

**Satan Making a Big Noise.** Satan makes a “big noise” by having exalted himself. It’s the reason, I discern, he was demoted to earth so that Jesus said “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” ([Luke 10:18, ESV](#)). The way I see it, God informed the angels of His plan and because Satan is so proud ([Ezek. 28:17 below](#)), he flipped out when informed that humans would be greater than him and “judge [the] angels” ([1 Cor. 6:3, ESV](#)). In turn, “war arose in heaven” ([Rev. 12:7, ESV](#)). But Jesus trumps Satan—and everyone else. He says “Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, so shall it stand” ([Isa. 14:24, KJV, my emphasis](#)). In other words, no matter what the fallen angels do, or what any of us do for that matter, God “works all things according to the counsel of his will” ([Eph. 1:11, ESV](#)) which He’s proving through this ministry, especially these biblical interpretations of secular resources.

[Ezekiel 28:17, ESV](#) Your heart was proud because of your beauty; you corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor. I cast you to the ground.

**The Body of Christ Making a Big Noise.** Born again Christians have been making a big noise by telling others that they need to repent if they don’t want to end up in hell, when there are some serious problems with that. First of all, it’s the body of Christ who needs to repent since “judgment must **begin** at the house of God” ([1 Pet. 4:17, KJV](#)) and the born again are “God’s building” ([1 Cor. 3:9, ESV](#)). Secondly, hell doesn’t even exist as revealed by the original languages of the Bible which I’ve walked through on different videos and free books and summed up on this graphic. And The Total Victory of Christ YouTube channel throughly covers it on this playlist: [Universal Restoration Christian Doctrine - YouTube](#). The verses in the graphic also reveal that hell is a false doctrine. The doctrine of hell totally contradicts God’s nature as revealed by Jesus who is “the exact representation” ([Heb. 1:3, NIV](#)) of God’s being since He “is the image of the invisible God” ([Col. 1:15, KJV](#)). And Jesus wouldn’t hurt a fly! So while called to be “the light of the world” ([Matt. 5:14, ESV](#)), the *only* light, the body of Christ has mostly been keeping the world in the dark and *just* making a big noise.

## The Body of Christ **Playing in the Street.**


Christians are only *playing* at Christianity since next to nothing we've been saying or doing as a group lines up with the teachings of Christ as God revealed outside of the Bible in 2002 by having Frank Viola and George Barna publish *Pagan Christianity: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices*. Since those roots are pagan, what we've been historically practicing is *Churchianity* rather than biblical Christianity, *playing* at Church rather than actually *being* the Church. In turn, today's Church is nothing like the Church of the first Christians, neither in manner or in power as summed up in the book of **Acts**. What it should be like was summed it up well on this short video: [Making Disciples](#). [Richard Jacobson - YouTube](#) also did a good job on his channel. And I summed it up with the two graphics of street preaching: what Christians—better Christians like Philip Blair—are doing and what we will be doing once the body of Christ repents. We'll still be out in the streets, and much more so, having an even stronger presence online, but we won't just be playing at Church and telling lies about God. 

# Gonna Be A Big Man Someday

Being a big man refers to being well respected.

**Satan Gonna Be A Big Man Someday.** Since “the Lord GOD does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets” (*Amos 3:7, ESV*), having called me to “write the vision and make it plain” (*Hab. 2:2, KJV*), He’s given me the vision of His plan for humanity—which is quite different from what rebellious Christians have historically taught, summed up with the graphic. Since God “declar[es] the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done” (*Isa. 46:10, ESV*), I discern He knew exactly what Satan and everyone else would do and moved forward with it anyhow since He knew He could work it all out to benefit everyone in the end *while* accomplishing His goal of revealing to us what we’re really like which is “deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked” (*Jer. 17:9, KJV*). Having been humbled, we will all eventually genuinely appreciate what He did for us through Christ. Unlike everyone else including the supernatural beings, God stands outside of time since He is the “Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending” (*Rev. 1:8, KJV*). And Jesus said, “Behold, I am making **all things** new” (*Rev. 21:5, ESV*). All things includes Satan. One day Satan will be a big man having repented of all his evil deeds. So, looking at the graphic, and considering how much damage Satan has done throughout history, I discern the last age will actually be a much longer period of time than the two ages before it. Satan will be *a big man someday*, someone highly respected—just as highly as everyone else. No one is going to hell. But, only those who become born again will rise to life for the next age.



**The Body of Christ Gonna Be A Big Man Someday.** While everyone who became born again will rise to life at the end of this age, Only those who obeyed the Lord, will actually be a big man, well respected, during the millennial reign as Jesus alluded to in the following parable:

When you are invited by someone to a wedding feast, do not sit down in a place of honor, lest someone more distinguished than you be invited by him, and he who invited you both will come and say to you, ‘Give your place to this person,’ and then you will begin with shame to take the lowest place. But when you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place, so that when your host comes he may say to you, ‘Friend, move up higher.’ Then you will be honored in the presence of all who sit at table with you. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted (Luke 14:8-11, ESV).

I summed it up on this graphic. Jesus warned us to “not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal, but [to] lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal” (Matt. 6:19-20, ESV). Connecting the dots, I discern that our treasure in heaven adds up to our *position* in the Lord’s kingdom during the next age, at least, possibly longer (Rev. 22:5 in the graphic), which would be until the end of the ages. So minimum 1000 years or up to however long it takes Satan to get right with God—which will be a good while. It’s as Jesus informed us, “If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all” (Mark 9:35, ESV). If we want a decent position in His kingdom come, we were supposed to humble ourselves during this life and do everything He called us to do, which could include cleaning toilets for people (as He did for me for a season)—or praying for decades for Him to bless people who are mean to you while working hard to communicate God’s will to them. More importantly, we’ll *honor* our Lord and Savior.


## You Got Mud on Your Face

Having mud on your face, according to Google in reference to this song means you're behaving foolishly or embarrassingly. It also means you're dirty. Spiritually, it means you are steeped in sin. It also means your face is covered.

**Me with Mud on My Face.** Like everyone else I have mud on my face—all over—since “there is none righteous, no, not one” (Rom. 3:10, KJV). And right after writing about being covered in mud all over to the leadership team the Lord wanted me to share this information with in 2012—I dreamt of our favorite getaway spot while we lived in Indianapolis, the dunes at Lake Michigan. Eyes opened, I literally jumped out of bed and rushed to a forgotten bookshelf to look at this picture. The Lord was reminding me and confirming to me that I was walking in the Spirit as we've been called to do. He says “walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh” (Gal. 5:16, ESV). He was also making me laugh as He often does. I *am* covered in mud! After years of seeing the *Tribe of Mud People* walking along the beach, the little women and I finally converted. And giving me that dream reminding me of this picture was one of the many ways He was fulfilling His promise to me that He had given me through the pastor at that so-called church. The day I'd handed them the first writing assignment the Lord had given me for them, the pastor then preached “Prophets have to wait, but they'll experience joy while waiting” so it's what I called the playlist—*Joy While Waiting*. When the Lord first called me to start reaching out to the body of Christ in 1998, He did it at a church whose signature Scripture was “They who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles” (Isa. 40:31, ESV). And having informed me that this vision/this ministry was “for an appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV) I'd already been waiting on Him for 14 years (that was 13 years ago). So I really appreciate Him giving me joy while waiting until His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV), because waiting is hard—especially when born again Christians are so cold-hearted and mean. And other than the lost, those are the only two groups which exist—so it's left me completely isolated minus chit chat with immediate family members. So it ties in to this verse, “The joy of the LORD is your strength” (Neh. 8:10, KJV). Without the joy the Lord continually gives me, there's NO WAY I'd be able to fulfill my calling!



**Jesus with Mud on His Face.** Since even the born again have taken Jesus for granted and NOT been in the habit of “destroy[ing] arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and tak[ing] every thought captive to obey Christ” (2 Cor. 10:5, KJV), we've been throwing mud on His face and “holding him up to contempt” (Heb. 6:6, ESV) when we're the ones who should have been honoring Him. The body of Christ has thrown so much mud on His face over the last 2000 years that He's hardly recognizable today. It's like this graphic, all those lines representing the mud of false doctrines and lies we've been historically throwing in His face. And Gordon Conwell theological seminary did the research and informed us that by 2012, so more than a decade ago, the body of Christ had already split by forty three THOUSAND denominations! God knows how bad it is today! And we're supposed to be united as one. That was His high priestly prayer, “That they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me” (John 17:21, ESV). If the Father was going to answer anyone's prayer, it would be that of the Lord's concerning His people. But in 2000 years He hasn't answered it, and it's because He gave us—the born again body of Christ, the responsibility of enabling Him to answer it. And, so far, we've been unwilling.



## You Got Mud On Your Face, You Big Disgrace

Being dirty is a disgrace—especially when seen from God’s eyes. Since God “make[s] known the end from the beginning” saying “I will do all that I please” (Isa. 46:10, NIV), having envisioned His plan, the Lord foresaw what everyone would do. In turn, He has allowed Satan and all the rest of fallen angels, along with all humans, to go about our sinful ways as He works it all out for His purposes (Eph. 1:11). In other words, “God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap” (Gal. 6:7, ESV). Just because God allows us to sin against Him like crazy—as we’ve been doing—doesn’t mean He’s OK with it. Again, I discern He’s allowed it to help us see what we’re really like so that we finally appreciate what He did for us and beg Jesus to give us the “new heart” He promised us (Ezek. 36:26, ESV).

**Satan’s Mud and Big Disgrace.** Satan is covered in mud/sin/filth and is a *huge* disgrace since he was “the anointed cherub” (Ezek. 28:14 KJV). As an angel, he was supposed to be helping God’s elect more than anyone—excluding the Lord—because “the angels...Are...all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation” (Heb. 1:13-14, KJV). Satan is a huge disgrace!




So while Satan was “perfect in [his] ways from the day that [he] wast created, till iniquity was found in [him]” (Ezek. 28:15, KJV), it’s not as if his rebellion came as a surprise to God since He knows the end from the beginning (Isa. 46:10 above). When Satan is finally put on time out and thinks about all he’s done, since he’ll be “bound...for a thousand years...so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years [a]re ended” (Rev. 20:2-3, ESV), he’ll start seeing the error of his ways just as kids often do when they’ve been put on time out. But, like most bad kids, he won’t repent until *after* the reign of Christ. I’m thinking way after. It’s like with people, especially teens who have to be punished repeatedly, sometimes for years, decades even, until they finally get right with their parents.

## The Body of Christ’s Big Disgrace.

Christians are a big disgrace since we’ve historically honored Satan, the leading antichrist, more than Jesus, God’s Christ—and as a group refuse to the repent. While told that “God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth” (John 4:24, KJV), that’s hardly what we’ve done historically—not even what Peter did as summed up on the graphic.

And it’s clearly not what we’re doing today summed up with these videos. Like the lost, most of the body of Christ today is honoring Satan since all denominations bow to the pope who rejects the lordship of Christ. And a born again Christian shouldn’t need to watch the videos to discern the truth. We just need to be honest.

The fact is that we, humans, are in a brutal spiritual war “wrest[ing]...against spiritual wickedness in high places” (Eph. 6:12, KJV). We’re at war against Satan and the rest of the fallen angels, the demons. Yet the body of Christ as a whole has historically *ignored* this war, for the most part, which is why we’re getting creamed. Just look around at what’s taking place all over the world today! Rather than submit to men we’ve historically called pastors, who submit to men who submit to the pope who is led by Satan “the ruler of this world” (John 12:31, YLT), all born again Christians were supposed to “submit...to God. Resist the devil, and he [would have had to flee]” (James 4:7, NIV). So simple!



Part of the problem is that Christians have bought the lie that when we believe in Jesus we're given a new heart. But "demons believe" ([James 2:19, ESV](#)). Those who became born again, which we do by obeying the Lord for at least a season of time ([John 14:23 below](#)), we receive God's Spirit, "the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him" ([Acts 5:32, ESV](#)). So while God said "I will give you a new heart" ([Ezek. 36:26, ESV](#)), we won't be getting that until the rapture *then* "we shall be changed" ([1 Cor. 15:52, ESV](#)). If the born again had a new heart already, we'd be like Jesus who NEVER sinned, NEVER lied, NEVER dishonored the Father etc., and that's clearly not any of us.

[John 14:23, ESV](#) If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. [Keeping God's Word implies a season of time.]

But, thanks to the work Jesus did on the Cross, we can "confess our sins, [and] he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" ([1 John 1:9, ESV](#)). The body of Christ needs to repent so that we can finally become "holy and without blemish" ([Eph. 5:27, ESV](#)). *Then* "the marriage of the Lamb [will] come [because] his Bride [will have] made herself ready" ([Rev. 19:7, ESV](#)).


## Singin'

Singing refers to not worrying about it.

**Satan Singing.** Since Satan is the most self-centered and self-deceived of all, thinking that he can "be like the most High" ([Isa. 14:14, KJV](#)) and not suffer any consequences, it's like he's ruling this world hurting us all and singing about it. It's what all idiots do when they do something stupid blind to how much they're ultimately hurting *themselves*.

**Jesus Singing.** At the first and only so-called home church the Lord ever gave me, in the late 1990s, He connected me with the Worship Pastor, Bill Bean, who spoke this word to me: “The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing” (**Zeph. 3:17, NIV**). It was prophetic because it’s what the Lord often does for me, as He’s doing through this song, singing not just to me but to *us* through it. Even if no one else gets it yet. *I* get it. I hear His voice just as He says “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me” (**John 10:27, ESV**). And “walk[ing] in the Spirit” (**Gal. 5:16, KJV**) hearing from the Lord my God, “the most High” (**Isa. 14:14, ESV**), is pretty cool. It *doesn’t* get any better.

**Me Singing.** Rather than only crying my way through this difficult calling (**Ps. 126:5-6 in the graphic**), God has me ‘singing’ so to speak, “for the joy of the Lord is [my] strength” (**Neh. 8:10, KJV, my emphasis**). Meaning, He’s kept me going and not worrying about it since I know that in the end He *will* come through for me. By faith I know that at His “appointed time” (**Hab. 2:3, KJV**), He’ll remove the blinders and others will “run” with “the vision” (**Hab. 2:2-3, KJV**). What God has done for me is good for the whole body of Christ, because that’s how He works. He says “If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; [but] if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it” (**1 Cor. 12:26, NIV**). When members of the body of Christ—the real Christians—finally acknowledge that God is using me, and see *how* He’s using me—as revealed in the material He’s had me provide online of free books and videos—they’ll rejoice because the blessing is for all (all who take Him seriously). I’m singing in the same way they were 2000 years ago, “rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name” (**Acts 5:41, ESV**). What He’s doing through this ministry, which has me “singing,” is confirmation that this “present evil age” (**Gal. 1:4, YLT**) is just about over as most clearly revealed—not only by the signs of the times—but by [Messiah 2030 - YouTube](#).



## We Will, We Will Rock You, We Will, We Will Rock You

God made the point about repetition through Joseph of the Old Testament. And He prophesied to me through others beginning around 2001 that I’d be having a Joseph Experience—which I’m still having. Joseph was very blessed by God and suffered greatly for it. And he said “The dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice...because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass” (**Gen. 41:32, KJV**). Through these biblical interpretations God has given me He has doubled the message multiple times, stressing the point that He is coming back SOON. Many born again Christians know it but they fail to see that we need to prepare, or how to do it. By repeatedly repeating the message throughout this ministry God is nailing the point—for those who’ll have eyes that see, which is those who’ll take Him seriously. He’s also made clear how we need to prepare. We need to repent. And He’s exposing through this ministry—which is a combination of many ministries—what exactly we need to repent about.



## We Refers to Different Groups

The Father and the Son, Jesus and me, real Church leaders/servant leaders—as opposed to “hired hand[s]” (John 10:13, ESV)—and the awakened church.

**We = The Father and the Son.** God is One, yet plural since He manifested Himself through Jesus who “is the image of the invisible God” (Col. 1:15, KJV). Jesus also said “Whoever has seen me has seen the Father” (John 14:9, ESV). I summed it up with the graphics.



Mary was a *surrogate* mother to Christ, a carrier and not biologically related to Him which is why we shouldn't worship her like Catholics do. Like the rest of us her heart was “deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked” (Jer. 17:9, KJV) so that when Jesus was grown she went along with her children saying “He is out of his mind” (Mark 3:21, ESV) *lying* to herself about the Truth she knew better than anyone! An angel had come to her explaining things (Luke 1:35 in the graphic) and she *knew* she had been a virgin when she became pregnant with the Lord. “When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, but **knew her not** until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus” (Matt. 1:24-25, ESV). Mary and Joseph didn't have sex until after Jesus had been born. And I discern this is how God performed that miracle.

**We = Jesus & Me.** Again, the Lord and I will be rocking everyone's ground with this ministry—everyone paying attention. It's as He says, “Where I am, there shall also my servant be” (John 12:26, KJV). And you should be able to see His hand on this ministry. It's obvious!

**We = Real Church Leaders.** God has chosen certain ones among the “body of Christ” (1 Cor. 12:27, KJV) to step up to the plate and lead the way walking rightly before Him. I know that because that's the system He set in place as revealed in Ephesians 4, for example, which I summed up with God's Mission Statement. At some point—at His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV)—God will open up this ministry to those people, and they'll “run” with it (Hab. 2:2, KJV), encouraging others to “run with patience the race that is set before us” (Heb. 12:1, KJV). While lots of people are revealing Satan's hand “hidden in plain sight” there is no one I'm aware of doing what He has me doing, revealing His hand hidden in plain sight through biblical interpretations.



And I discern He's worked this way so that the body of Christ gets motivated to *mature* and also discern His hand hidden in plain sight in other resources, since that's the level of faith and discernment we'll need to get through the trials of the last of the last days which are nearly on top of us. You can't follow the Lord closely if you don't know His voice well. And to get to know Him well, you have to be honest since He is “the truth” (John 14:6, ESV). There is nothing more important to Him than the truth so that He says “I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth” (3 John 1:4, ESV).

## We = The Awakened Church.

Currently the body of Christ, the Lord's Girl, His Church, is as if in a coma "dead [asleep]" (Rev. 3:1, KJV). I know it's a coma and not RIP dead because He says "You are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die" (Rev. 3:1-2, NIV). The Lord's Girl, the Church, the body of Christ, is only dreaming about Jesus saying to Her "Well done good and faithful servant!" (Matt. 25:21, KJV) when He's actually saying "Wake up!" (Rev. 3:1, NIV).

And we know that She is going to wake up because God foretold of a great awakening, a greater outpouring of His Spirit than He did 2000 years ago, which I've summed up with the graphics.

"Now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed" (Rom. 13:11, KJV). When the born again finally wake up to themselves, especially those of my generation, elders who are not yet elderly, "we will rock" the world as a group. And while it's not just those of my generation, the Bible is clear that those who are older, elders, have a greater responsibility. Even the lost know this; *children* know it. Older women, for instance, were supposed to "urge the younger women to love their husbands and children" (Titus 2:4, ESV), not to go off and work full-time dumping their children in daycares—what our doctor referred to as "a cesspool of germs." And the "younger [ones are supposed to], submit...to [their] elders" (1 Pet. 5:5, KJV). But that's not what we've historically done because the human "heart is deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV, my emphasis). We say we love Jesus but refuse to obey Him—and it's *especially* true these days as we near the end of the age, the worst we'll ever be as a group.



### The First Christians were Highly Empowered by God because they Obeyed Him as Individuals and as a Group

- They spoke in languages they hadn't studied (Acts 2:4-6);
- They healed the sick (Acts 3:2-7);
- They raised the dead (Acts 9:37-41);
- They drove out demons (Acts 16:16-18);
- They witnessed boldly (Acts 4:4);
- They prayed for their attackers as they killed them (Acts 7:58-60);
- They enlightened thousands at a time (Acts 7:58-60);
- Their shadows provided healing (Acts 5:14-16);
- Unbelievers admired them (Acts 2:47);
- They beamed around like in Star Trek (Acts 8:39-40);
- They were full of wisdom (Acts 6:3);
- They were full of generosity (Acts 4:34-35); and,
- They were full of joy (Acts 2:46).



## Rock You

To “rock” something would mean to stone it, which means to kill it, so to put an end to it. It also means to disturb the status quo like when you *rock the boat*. It also means to do a great job surpassing expectations as with “You rock!” And, it means to have a good time as in “This rocks!”

**To Rock/To Stone/To Kill.** All who get right with God will *stone* the BRAT’s abominations to death *something* like they did in the Old Testament when the prophet said “Why did you bring trouble on us? The LORD brings trouble on you today.” And all Israel stoned him with stones]” (Josh. 7:25, ESV). But since “grace and truth came through Jesus Christ” (John 1:17, ESV), and Jesus is “the Prince of Peace” (Isa. 9:6, ESV), when the Lord finally opens up this ministry at His appointed time (Hab. 2:2-3 below) we’ll be stoning the BRATs abominations with the Word, the Rock, since “that Rock [is] Christ” (1 Cor. 10:4, KJV). “His name is called The Word of God” (Rev. 19:13, KJV). It’s what He has me demonstrating through my material. Unlike what Christians have historically done by being hateful to different groups at different times—when it suits them—“the weapons of our warfare are NOT carnal” (2 Cor. 10:4, KJV, my emphasis). Christians will finally learn to actually be Christian, *genuine* “ambassadors for Christ” (2 Cor. 5:20, KJV) and Christ is God and “God is love” (1 John 4:8, ESV). Being ambassadors for Christ requires us to be *loving*. And yelling at people telling them that God hates them and/or is going to burn them alive forever in a place called hell, for example, isn’t loving—nor truthful.





**Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV** The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

**Rocking the Boat.** As the born again start getting right with Him, because of how God will be using this ministry combined with what’s going on in the world, those who are more faithful/more humble will be turning the Church right side up again, *seriously* rocking the boat. Christians talk about turning the world upside down when the world is upside down “call[ing] evil good, and good evil” (Isa. 5:20, KJV)—which is what the body of Christ has been doing historically, as with the doctrine of hell. We need to turn the Church right side up again which will impact the world. Paul said “What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside? God will judge those outside” (1 Cor. 5:12-13, KJV). Yet Christians have either not focused on the lost at all, or else they’re standing in judgment of them as in this graphic. God didn’t tell us to spread the Good News by protesting and condemning people but by preaching and teaching the Good News—which, again, does NOT involve hell. He says “Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction” (2 Tim. 4:2, KJV). “For God sent **not his Son into the world to condemn the world;** but that the world through him might be saved” (John 3:17, KJV). God says “Your turning of things upside down shall be esteemed as the potter’s clay” (Isa. 29:16, KJV). When we took pottery classes all of the messed up and old clay was recycled. That’s what God is doing starting with the more discerning members of the body of Christ—working us over—because we are also made of clay. Scripture says “the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground” (Gen. 2:7, KJV). Dust is dirt which is clay.






## ONE WORLD POWER SYSTEM



**To Rock Means to Surpass Expectations.** Having followed the Lord through some house cleaning detours for a couple of months where He had me praying for people in this important part of the world—the DC metro area—several said to me “Girl, you rock!” for having made their place so squeaky clean. They just had no idea how much I was actually *rocking* (stoning their abominations) as I prayed over them, their families, their jobs, their homosexual partners, their co-workers, their friends, and whatever else God brought to mind with Scriptures to pray as I cleaned their place. He prophesied that “on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord” (*Lev. 16:30, KJV*). And Jesus “hast made us [the born again] unto our God...priests” (*Rev. 5:10, KJV*). I am part of the “holy priesthood, [made so by God] to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ” (*1 Pet. 2:5, KJV*). And considering that He had me praying for people who work on Capitol Hill and throughout the federal government, some with strong international connections, the lowly job of housecleaner *wasn't* all that lowly—especially considering the “good works” (*Eph. 2:10, ESV*) He has given me to do with the rest of this ministry. And since the best way to rock—to stone abominations—is by being in right relationship with God and praying His Word and will to be done by His power, prayer has been a pretty big part of my calling and ministry. And, at His appointed time God will answer all biblical prayers. For example, the New Testament speaks of “golden vials full of perfumes, which are the prayers of the saints” (*Rev. 5:8, YLT*). Not one biblical prayer has ever gone unheard and neither will they be unanswered. Except EVERYTHING is done at God’s appointed time. “For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven” (*Eccl. 3:1, ESV*). So, for example, *Acts* speaks of “ordained times before appointed” (*Acts 17:26, YLT*) and heading to the Cross Jesus said “My time is at hand” (*Matt. 26:18, KJV*).

**Priestly Service**—No one is so great that there’s a task, no matter how lowly like cleaning toilets, that we cannot perform for Jesus. The example of foot washing from *John 13* (below) is *symbolic*. Jesus meant we should be willing to do **whatever** He asks of us. That’s pretty much what *love* means. And He says “love one another; as I have you” (*John 13:34, KJV*). So while everyone looks down on me for the work I’ve been doing, clearly, God does not!

*John 13:5 & 14-15, ESV* he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel...If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you.



**To Rock Means to Have a Great Time.** Real Church would be like celebrating Thanksgiving, every week—only better since Jesus is the guest of honor—and He’s a load of fun. The best case scenario would have been of the body of Christ living in community like the group from Denmark in this documentary, *Happy (2011)*—only **much** better since they don’t even know the Lord. And yet, they’re all *super* happy! [Denmark Co housing - Happy Documentary Clip - YouTube](#).

But because Christians have been so rebellious for so long, we’ve been getting the exact opposite of what we could have had, and we’re coming into the worst period of all of human history “great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be” (**Matt. 24:21, KJV**). Still, when we get right with God as a group—as local assemblies—we’ll experience the “joy of the LORD” (**Neh. 8:10, KJV**). *Biblical* assemblies are the only way we’ll have some measure of protection from Satan’s schemes. And since Satan is “the prince of the power of the air” (**Eph. 2:2, KJV**) that “great” fellowship many have today online isn’t going to cut it.

In any case, the Lord gave an evangelist a vision of the end times ministry. It’s how it’s been playing out and how it will play out for those who take Him seriously—and for those people it will be a great time, rewarding as well as challenging: [Tommy Hicks Vision: The Body of Christ and End-Time Ministry - YouTube](#). Again, God has foretold of a “latter rain” “downpour” (**Joel 2:23, ESV & YLT**) greater than the outpouring of His Spirit following “Pentecost” (**Acts 2:1, ESV**). And those guys performed miracles and transported like they do in *Star Trek!*


As they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, “See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?”<sup>38</sup> And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him. <sup>39</sup> And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing. <sup>40</sup> But Philip found himself at Azotus, and as he passed through he preached the gospel to all the towns until he came to Caesarea (**Acts 8:36-40, ESV**).



## Buddy, You’re a Young Man Hard Man

Young, as in boy, refers to being immature. And hard speaks of having a hardened heart.

**Being Young and Hard.** Buddy again is Satan, but in this case I’m focusing on the immature WHORE BRAT (**Jer. 3:3**), the “body of Christ” (**1 Cor. 12:27, KJV**), who lacks faith in God. Two thousand years into it He is still saying “Though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God’s word all over again. You need milk, not solid food!” (**Heb. 5:12, NIV**). I discern that many born again Christians have a lot of head knowledge of the Word of God (much of which they’ve understood wrongly), but very few have a close *relationship* with Him—next to none! Meaning, very few are actually born again as Jesus said would be the case (**Matt. 7:22-23 below**) and those who are don’t have a very close relationship with Him. If they had, they would have discerned His hand on this ministry. And the response all have given me for 27 years reveals that not only is the Church super immature/young, She’s *super* hard hearted. She’s extremely carnal. The body of Christ has historically behaved just like they did in the Old Testament when “no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done?” (**Jer. 8:6, KJV**). And it’s what Jesus foretold when He said “Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold” (**Matt. 24:12, NIV**). So it has. I’ve even heard “hired hand[s]” (**John 10:13, ESV**) preach that there’s no one colder than a born again Christian. Having been enlightened, the born again have gotten super proud. Yet we’re supposed to be representing love, truth, and humility. We’re supposed to be the most loving, most honest, and most humble people on earth! But we’re not.



**Matthew 7:22-23, ESV** On that day many will say to me, ‘Lord, Lord...And then will I declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from me.




## Shouting in the Street

Shouting speaks of excess, like boasting/bragging. And being in the street is like being Home *less*. That’s what most professing Christians are because most are extremely proud spiritually and NOT actually born again. Even those who are born again are super proud. That’s my life testimony. I can tell some of them have been born again because there are some things only a born again Christians will say and do and have discernment about. Again, God is proving the point that our hearts are “deceitful above all things” ([Jer. 17:9, KJV](#)) even when we’re born again. He’s saying “Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?” ([2 Cor. 13:5 NIV](#)). If your life doesn’t line up with the teachings of Christ—reflecting, truth, love, and humility—you are either not born again, not a real Christian, or you’re born again but in rebellion. It’s normal to be born again and wrong about many things, but it’s proud and rebellious to be unwilling to get corrected by God’s Word in relation to the “new covenant” ([Luke 22:20, ESV](#)) which, again, is my testimony of decades as summed up with the graphics—revealing the body of Christ is a big disgrace.

## Gonna Take On the World Someday

Taking on the world speaks of confidence, power, and victory. And Christians are confidently cocky. They’re arrogant. For instance, Christians go on an on about having accepted Jesus when He chose us ([John 15:16 below](#))—and that’s IF He actually did. Both the born again along with professing Christians who only think they’re born again, seem to think they’ve already won the victory because they believe in Jesus when “even the demons believe” ([James 2:19, ESV](#)), and God expects more of us than the demons! The entire New Testament is packed with admonitions which enable us to take on the world, as with “work out your own salvation” ([Phil. 2:12, ESV](#)) and “fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you” ([2 Tim. 1:6, ESV](#)), for example. Not walking in the Lord’s teachings—as we’ve historically been doing—has kept the body of Christ ineffective, as the state of the Church reveals. As a group we’re exactly like the world with the exception of *claiming* to believe in Jesus and going to church which isn’t even biblical, so that He continues to say “This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me” ([Matt. 15:8, ESV](#)).



## You Got Blood on Your Face, You Big Disgrace

Having blood on ones face is clearly negative, therefore a disgrace.

**Christians Have Blood on their Faces—We’re a Big Disgrace.** Christianity’s abominations are mixed with the blood of Jesus along with the blood of others for having a brutal history of killing our enemies rather than loving them. I’m not speaking of Catholics, who also have this brutal history, but of the body of Christ who, for the most part, have historically gone off to war to fight for our country, forgetting that Jesus’ “kingdom is not of this world” (**John 18:36, ESV**) and that He says “Love your enemies” (**Matt. 5:44, ESV**). Therefore, Jesus is saying “When you did these things and I kept silent you thought I was exactly like you. But I now arraign you and set my accusations before you” (**Ps. 50:21, KJV**). That’s what He’s doing through this ministry and also through the trials the world is facing. He has “deliver[ed us all]...to Satan for the destruction of the flesh” (**1 Cor. 5:5, ESV**). The 9/11 attacks should have given us a clue. But Christians refused to acknowledge the truth and even laughed at those of us who said God was giving us a wake up call telling us to repent. So again He’s saying the following:

Your hands are full of blood. Wash yourselves; make yourselves clean; remove the evil of your deeds from before my eyes; cease to do evil, learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow’s cause (**Isa. 1:15-17, KJV**).

While Christians think they’re innocent, we are *covered* in blood. For example, having watched the towers disintegrate before our eyes and thousands die in 9/11 of 2001, as a group we have *refused* to take God seriously and repent so that much blood has since been shed, “running into the millions” according to Brown University’s Costs of War Project—and that’s a figure from 2018). Called to love and peace, the body of Christ as a whole has a history of war and brutality—*just* like the lost.



However, if the body of Christ had repented as a group—like the PAGAN king of Nineveh led his people to do, for example (**Jonah 3:6-10 below**)—God would have “healed the land” (**2 Chron. 7:14, KJV**). He says:

If my people, which are called by my name [as in **Christian**] shall **humble** themselves, and **pray**, and **seek** my face, and **turn** from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land (**2 Chron. 7:14, KJV**).

**Jonah 3:6-10, NIV** When Jonah’s warning reached the king of Nineveh, he rose from his throne, took off his royal robes, covered himself with sackcloth and sat down in the dust. This is the proclamation he issued in Nineveh... Let everyone call urgently on God. Let them give up their evil ways and their violence. Who knows? God may yet relent and with compassion turn from his fierce anger so that we will not perish. When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he relented and did not bring on them the destruction he had threatened.

This *pagan* had more discernment and conviction than today’s born again Christians!



## Waving Your Banner All Over the Place


Waving a banner all over the place clearly speaks of arrogant pride.

**Christianity’s Banner Waving.** Christianity is a huge disgrace yet still waves the so-called Christian banner all over the place, wrongly, rudely, and hypocritically protesting in the streets—so cocky! God says “What right have you to recite my laws or take my covenant on your lips? [Since] You hate my instruction and cast my words behind you” (Ps. 50:16-17, NIV). Again, God has used this ministry to reveal that’s what the body of Christ is doing since I haven’t been able to get through to even one person in over *two decades!* And hating His instruction while casting His words behind us is what we’ve been doing for the last 2000 years. While the lost are doing it too, we profess to LOVE Him!

**Pagan Banner Waving.** Everyone who rejects Christ and flaunts their point of view all over the place is guilty. “For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low” (Isa. 2:12, KJV). Those gay pride parades are prophetic, like a self fulfilling prophecy.

## We Will We Will Rock You (Sing It) We Will We Will Rock You

Again, certain passages are repeated to express God’s passion “because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass” (Gen. 41:32, KJV). It is “the great and dreadful day of the LORD” (Mal. 4:5, KJV). Again, my understanding differs from the norm. I don’t see a seven year gap or a three year gap between the rapture and the Lord’s return. I see half an hour (Rev. 11:11-13 & 8:1 in the graphic). However, I think time in heaven and on earth aren’t exactly the same, like in time travel movies. I see a half hour passing on earth which I’m discerning will feel like much longer in heaven. God knows how it will actually play out. In any case, it will be a “great” day because it’s the day Jesus returns to earth to begin His kingdom reign when all who “had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands...[will] reign...with Christ a thousand years” (Rev. 20:4, KJV). But it’s also a “dreadful day” because all who did not become born again will “die in [thei]r sins” (John 8:21, KJV) and “be hurt of the second death” (Rev. 2:11, KJV). So, ultimately, “we” in We will rock you refers to the Father and, Jesus, His Son.



And the body of Christ is called to “sing it” as in let everyone know what’s going to happen. “Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching” (2 Tim. 4:2, ESV).


## Buddy, You're An Old Man, Poor Man

Old people have been alive a long time and poor people are lacking somehow.

**Satan is Old and Poor.** Satan was created before humans so that he's *really* old. We know he was created before Adam because Scripture says the following speaking to Job:

Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation? Tell me, if you understand. Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know! Who stretched a measuring line across it? On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy? ([Job 38:4-7, NIV](#)).

Only the morning stars—and “stars are the angels” ([Rev. 1:20, ESV](#)), a group Satan is a part of—were around when God created the earth. And even though he's the “anointed cherub” ([Ezek. 28:14, KJV](#)), yet another word for angel, Satan's actually *poor* since he was kicked out of heaven so that Jesus said “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven” ([Luke 10:18, ESV](#)). And he'll be further demoted at the end of this age, “cast down to the lake of fire” ([Rev. 19:20, CLT](#))—which, again, is not hell but the process of refinement as clearly revealed on this playlist: [Refined in the Lake of Fire | The Meaning of Hell Fire](#). Right now many people—like Freemasons, the Illuminati, and some politicians—actually worship Satan, thinking he's greater than Jesus. Finding themselves in the same situation they'll be shocked and say to Satan “You too have become as weak as we! You have become like us!” ([Isa. 14:10, ESV](#)).



**The Body of Christ is Old and Poor.** While we've had 2000 years to mature in Christ and make Satan flee since we were told to “submit...to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you” ([James 4:7, ESV](#)), we've done neither making us both old—2000 years old—and poor since we've GIVEN Satan everything he wants, practically: our marriages by getting divorced contrary to God's Word ([Matt. 5:32-33 & 19:6 below](#)); our happiness since we've enslaved ourselves to Satan's government in a load of difference ways, wrapped up in red tape in every which way (needing a license to get married, to have a business, to work a trade on and on). Being carnal, the body of Christ has sold Herself to sin. “we know that the law is spiritual, but [we are] of the flesh, sold under sin” ([Rom. 7:14, ESV](#)). Christians talk about Satan having taken stuff from us as if he stole it when we actually *gave* it to him—not entirely, but for the most part.

[Matthew 5:32, ESV](#) [Jesus says] everyone who divorces his wife, except on the ground of sexual immorality, makes her commit adultery, and whoever marries a divorced woman commits adultery.

[Matthew 19:6, ESV](#) They are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.”

**Humans are Old and Poor.** The lost cry that Christians are unloving while *they're* super unloving. And Christians cry how loving they are while they're even more unloving than the lost. It's an old poor/sad story that goes way back to the Garden of Eden. But I see it a bit different than your typical Christian. While Christians teach that it's all because “sin came into the world” ([Rom. 5:12, KJV](#)). I discern the problem goes further back. God says “The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked” ([Jer. 17:9, KJV](#)). Adam and Eve had that deceitful wicked heart BEFORE they sinned. It's the reason they disobeyed and “ate” ([Gen. 3:6, ESV](#)) the forbidden fruit. If their hearts had been better, they wouldn't have done that. I discern that while “God created man in his own image” ([Gen. 1:27, ESV](#)), in order to get humanity to genuinely appreciate Him for Who He is and what He's done for us—what the body of Christ *hasn't*

done—He created us with a heart that is less than perfect, knowing He'd be giving us all “a new heart” (**Ezek. 36:26, ESV**). In turn, “we [who became born again] ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another” (**Titus 3:3, KJV**). And most born again Christians are still living that way to one degree or another. Through Christ we have to learn to do what God said through Paul “our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin” (**Rom. 6:6, ESV**). Like everything else that we learn and master, it requires effort. The more we *rely* on Jesus, daily reading, believing, and *applying* His Word to our lives, the more successful we are spiritually—meaning, the more that old and poor man disappears. So Jesus says “You must be born again” (**John 3:7, ESV**). That’s the first step—summed up on the graphics.



**Unbelievers will be Old and Poor.** All who die having rejected Jesus or who gave Him nothing more than lip-service will become old and poor because everyone lives forever since “God is love” (**1 John 4:8, ESV**), and for that same reason their poverty won’t last forever. My understanding is that this graphic made by someone else which I tweaked reflects the end of the ages. Eventually, it will be just like a family: God, our Father, and everyone else His children. But unlike parents in this life, since His ways are not like our ways (**Isa. 55:8 below**), He doesn’t play favorites. We’ll all be on equal ground loving God and one another. While Jesus lowered Himself to become like us, He is elevating all of us to become like Him as revealed between the time of His resurrection and ascension, like when He walked through walls while being able to eat (**John 20:19-20 & Luke 24:41-43 below**).

**Isaiah 55:8, ESV** For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the LORD.


**John 20:19-20, ESV** On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, “Peace be with you.” When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.

**Luke 24:41-43, ESV** And while they still disbelieved for joy and were marveling, he said to them, “Have you anything here to eat?” They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate before them.



## Pleadin' With Your Eyes

Pleading with the eyes while having self-centered motives is the same as giving lip-service, lying to ourselves that we can get one over on God. He says “You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions” (James 4:3, ESV). Rather than being focused on the things that concern Jesus, most born again are focused on this world, Satan’s world, so much so that we’ve Christianized his world to justify ourselves, as with Christmas, when we’re supposed to “be separate...and touch no unclean thing” (2 Cor. 6:17, ESV). He also says “Whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God” (James 4:4, ESV). So while He sees right through it, He overlooks it, in part, since “He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities” (Ps. 103:10, KJV). But even though “the Lord is slow to anger...[He] will not leave the guilty unpunished” (Nah. 1:3, NIV). In other words, today’s body of Christ—especially the paid professionals—are like “the Pharisee [who]...prayed: ‘God, I thank you that I am not like other people...I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get’” (Luke 18:11, NIV). The majority of the born again are pleading God with their eyes while keeping their hearts far from Him, justifying themselves. “They measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves [so that God says] they are not wise” (2 Cor. 10:12, NIV). It’s the whole group to one degree or another.



## Gonna Make You Some Peace Some Day

This is prophetic. Everyone *will* make themselves peace some day because of the work Jesus did on the Cross, being the “Prince of Peace” (Isa. 9:6, ESV). So it’s as He said, “If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.” (John 8:36, KJV). He has set all of us free not only from Satan but primarily from ourselves by swapping out our deceitful and wicked heart (Jer. 17:9) for His heart (Ezek. 36:26).

## You Got Mud On Your Face, Big Disgrace

Again, God revealed that repetition points to the fact that “that the thing is fixed by God, and God will shortly bring it about” (Gen. 41:32, ESV). He’s definitely bringing to pass this revelation on the body of Christ when He finally opens up this ministry at His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV). I know it because He’s faithful, unlike us.

## Somebody Better Put You Back Into Your Place

Somebody can be anybody. In this case, it’s Jesus, then me, and finally the body of Christ.

**Somebody is Jesus.** Jesus is going to put everyone back in their place because “God opposes the proud” (James 4:6, ESV).

**Somebody is Me.** I’m *somebody* even though I’m a *total* nobody: no friends since they all only loved Jesus to a point, the point that it became inconvenient for them; no one in my family to talk to beyond chit chat because, like the

typical born again Christian they also walked away from the Lord; no paid job and no peers since I work for the Lord without pay and have done so for two decades, alone; no extended family since they're not interested in Jesus just like the rest of the lost. "God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong" (1 Cor. 1:27, NIV). What I do have is a decent relationship with Jesus, My "Maker" (Isa. 54:5, ESV) which is all that really matters since "apart from [Him we] can do nothing" (John 15:5, ESV) which will survive His fiery test of 1 Corinthians 3:11-15. It's the reason Paul spoke of the things he'd left behind for Jesus as being "dung" (Phil. 3:8, KJV) or "refuse" in the YLT. That's *all* most Christians have to show for themselves which they're currently so proud of. But they'll soon get humbled.

**Somebody is the Body of Christ.** *Behaving* like the Queen She was created to be, the body of Christ will finally conquer evil and put Satan in his place. Because, "greater is he that is in [the born again], than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4, KJV). And God informed us that this was His purpose:

To bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created all things, so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord (Eph. 3:9-11, ESV).

**We will, we will rock you, Sing it**  
**We will, we will rock you, Everybody**  
**We will, we will rock you, hmm**  
**We will, we will rock you, Alright**

Again we have the repetition "because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass" (Gen. 41:32, KJV). Jesus and I will be rocking the body of Christ with this ministry and He will be fulfilling everything He revealed to us as it ties in to the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, ESV).

**The Ending.** There's a long instrumental ending, which is a transition since they often play this song immediately followed by *We are the Champions*, which the Lord has also had me interpret. It's all about how long it's taken God's Church to get to this point—and we're not even there yet! But He has proven His point that "the heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) even when we're born again UNLESS we "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV). He's also proven that He "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV).
