Maya Makes a Mess

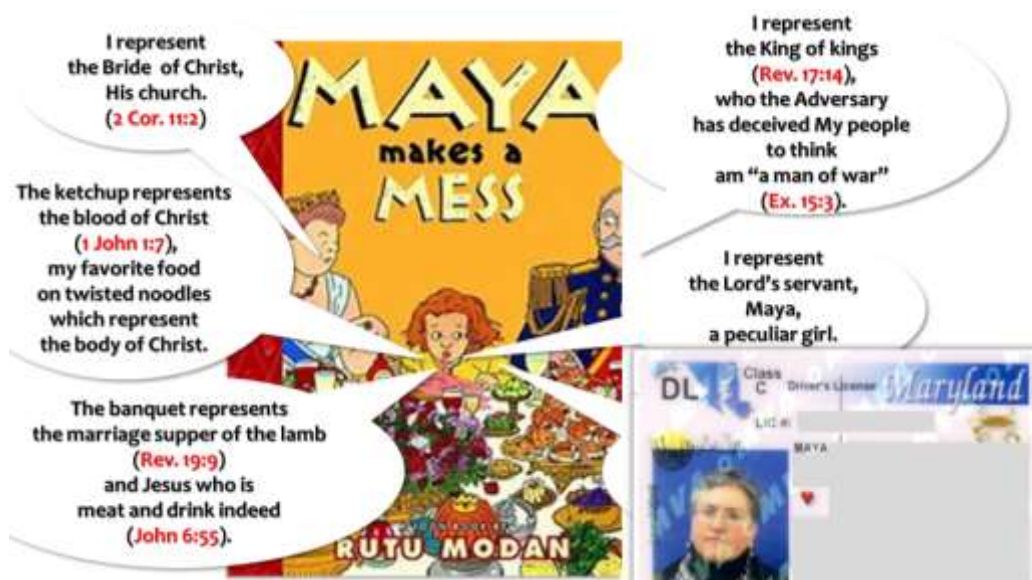
The Lord has me interpreting secular resources for the body of Christ in the same way that Joseph of the Old Testament interpreted dreams. The Lord is behind *everything* (Eph. 1:11 below), and “does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets” (Amos 3:7, ESV). So I’ll be going through this 32 page book, cover to cover, line by line, interpreting it for the body of Christ. Another key Scripture that ties in to these interpretations is Psalm 2:4, “He who is sitting in the heavens doth laugh, The Lord doth mock at them” (YLT). God is mocking THE BODY OF CHRIST for having been so extremely unfaithful, historically, which He’s had me sum up on this video: [On the Road to Rapture vol. 1](#). And everything I’m saying I’m backing up with Scripture and with links to resources where others are essentially saying the same thing on that particular point. God is *warning* the body of Christ through this ministry while, at the same time, helping us get “ready” for His very soon return (Rev. 19:7, ESV). So rather than take offense, as Christians have been doing for the last 27 years with me and the last 2000 years with the Lord, you should listen carefully and repent as needed. As Jesus says “Blessed is the one who is not offended by me” (Matt. 11:6, ESV & John 14:6 below). We are blessed when we *admit* the truth, rather than get offended by it.

The Cover

We see a queen, a king, and a girl named Maya sitting between them at a banquet table.



The King. He represents Jesus, “who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords” (1 Tim. 6:15, ESV). He’s wearing a military uniform because our deceitful hearts (Jer. 17:9) have had the body of Christ thinking that He’s a man of war when He’s the “Prince of Peace” (Isa. 9:6, ESV). This graphic also sums up the HUGE mistake born again Christians have historically made for *not* “rightly dividing the word of truth” (2 Tim. 2:15, YLT) as we were told to do. We have “call[ed] evil good and good evil” (Isa. 5:20, ESV), especially in the Old Testament, saying God did things or said things that were *obviously* done or said by Satan—obvious when “we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ” (2 Cor. 10:5, NIV) which only the born again were given the ability to do being that those without the Spirit within “cannot understand” (1 Cor. 2:14, ESV).



You can see that the king, who represents the Lord Jesus Christ, is eyeballing the girl, who represents me as you can tell by my driver's license. I am Maya. He's eyeballing me because "the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless" (2 Chron. 16:9, ESV). That's what He's doing with these interpretations, revealing His strong support of me for having "st[ood] firm in [the] faith" (Isa. 7:9, NIV) for decades while rebuked by born again Christians—along with the lost—who view me with contempt like you see the queen doing on the cover. And I discern by "blameless" God means to the best of our ability, which is what I've been doing for decades. I haven't done it perfectly since, like everyone else, my "heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (Jer. 17:9, KJV). But I *have* been working hard at doing my best as my testimony and material reveal. I've been doing what Jesus told us to do, which is "Bear fruit in keeping with repentance" (Matt. 3:8, ESV). I've been willing to let Him correct me when I've been wrong.

The Queen. She represents "the church, his body" (Eph. 5:23, ESV) who is His "Bride [who needs to] ma[k]e herself ready" (Rev. 19:7, ESV) because He's coming back soon. While someone from a YouTube video replied to my comment yesterday that "We will be made holy at the rapture," that response denies much of the teachings of Christ who says, for example, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching" (John 14:23, NIV). The body of Christ knows this so that the web/AI provides the correct answer: "In Christianity, a Christian becomes holy through a process of sanctification, which involves a transformation by the Holy Spirit, enabling them to live a life increasingly aligned with God's will and character." It's about how we live *this* life—before being raptured.

Maya. She's peculiar as revealed in the book, representing what I am and what *all* born again Christians should be and mostly aren't. Jesus "gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works" (Titus 2:14, KJV). But rather than being peculiar and zealous of good works, the majority of today's born again Christians look *just* like the lost with the only difference being that they *say* they believe in Jesus. It's a spectrum from less to more faithful. And—as a whole—the body of Christ has been in "rebellion" (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV) in increasing measure for these 2000 years, as God foretold we would be before "that day," the day of the Lord's return which I summed up with this apostasy graphic as well as with the graphic from Messiah 2030 which I tweaked. Inside Covers

There are two fat dogs.

Fat. They represent the body of Christ. God says “You have lived on the earth in luxury and in self-indulgence. You have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter” ([James 5:5, ESV](#)). And American Christians have done it worst of all having been granted the most. Every day of this age has been “a day of slaughter” because Satan, a “murderer” ([John 8:44, ESV](#)) is “the ruler of this world” ([John 12:31, YLT](#)), granted that “authority” by God ([Luke 4:6, ESV](#)) because He’s been “testing [us].” ([Deut. 13:3, ESV](#)).

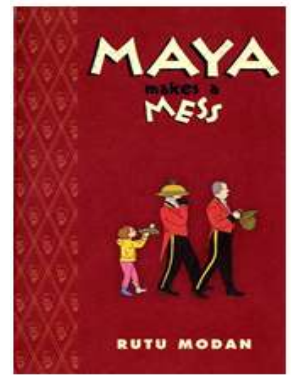
Dogs. I summed up why they’re dogs on this playlist: [Lies Christians Peddle - YouTube](#) along with this graphic below.

In short, we’ve been *behaving* like dogs. While told to “not give dogs what is holy” ([Matt. 7:6, ESV](#)), we can clearly see on this video someone else made that all so-called Protestant leaders bow down to the popes: [All Denominations Bow Before the Pope](#). The body of Christ has been giving what is holy to dogs. While told to “beware of dogs” ([Phil. 3:2, KJV](#)) and reminded that “the dog returns to its own vomit” ([2 Peter 2:22, ESV](#)), our historical rebellion reveals that we’ve not only NOT been wary of dogs, we’ve become just like them—as if having returned to our vomit.

We were also informed that “outside are the dogs and...everyone who loves and practices falsehood” ([Rev 22:15, ESV](#)). And these interpretations—along with the “new covenant” ([Luke 22:20, NIV](#))— reveal that the body of Christ might as well be standing on the outside since all mature born again Christians should be able to discern God’s voice in “all things” ([Eph. 1:11, ESV](#)). Instead, they call you nuts when you reveal their lack of discernment and expose their dog-like demeanor. And the new covenant reveals our dog-like manner since much of what the body of Christ is doing or saying doesn’t actually line up with the teachings of Christ. While the members of the body *are* born again, the Lord’s teachings reveal that we’ve historically been getting “saved, but only as through fire” ([1 Cor. 3:15, ESV](#)). And His will for us is to do a whole better than that!



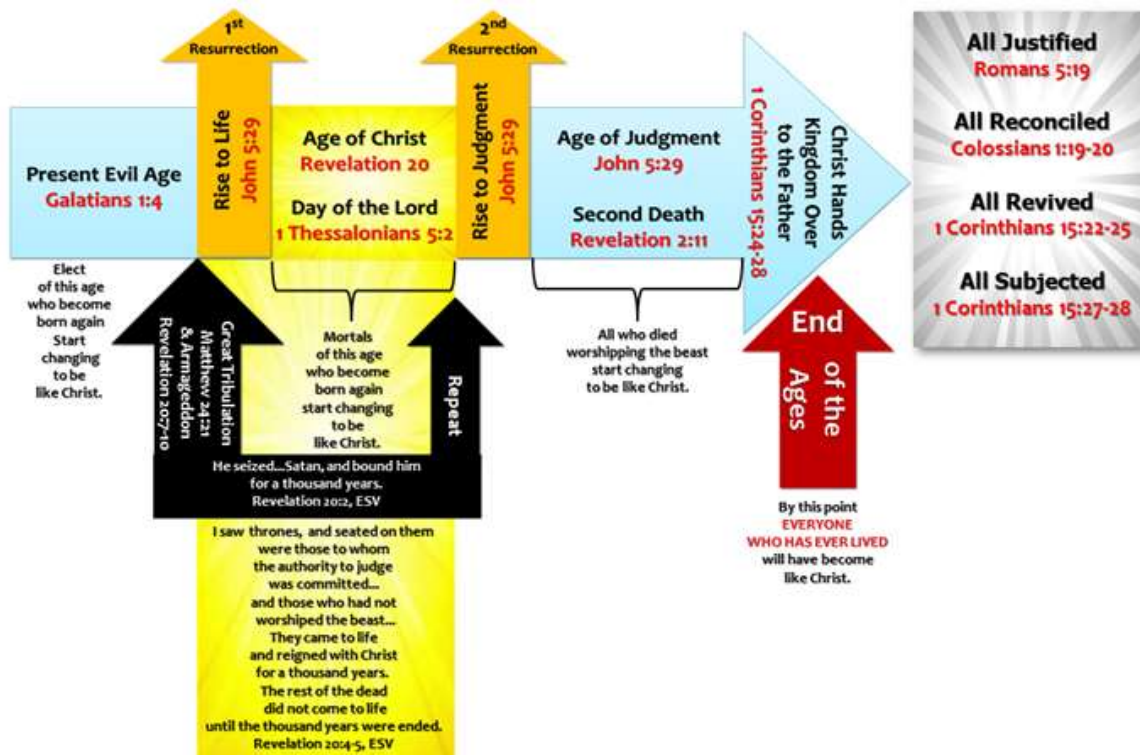
Servants. You see three servants, Maya being one of them. God said “Even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy” (**Acts 2:18, ESV**). That’s what He has me doing throughout this ministry which He has entrusted to me, which includes these interpretations of secular resources. As with Joseph’s interpretations of dreams (**which begin in Genesis chapter 37**), these are prophetic. But they also reveal the past and present of what the body of Christ has done and is doing—along with what God has done, is and will do, *and* what we will do since “the Lord GOD does nothing without revealing his secret to his servants the prophets” (**Amos 3:7, ESV**).



Maya’s Feet. She’s got funky feet because it’s as it is written, “How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who publishes peace, who brings good news of happiness, who publishes salvation” (**Isa. 52:7, ESV**). Except they *don’t* look beautiful to people since we “look on the outward appearance [when God]...looks at the heart” (**1 Sam. 16:7, ESV**). Christians have historically been calling “evil good, and good evil” (**Isa. 5:20, ESV**), as with the false doctrine of hell, for example, which I summed up with the graphic. How could it be good that God is, supposedly, sending most of the people He created and DIED FOR, to eternal hell or annihilation?! And this graphic sums up my understanding of God’s actual vision for humanity as revealed in the Bible.



Maya's Load. She's carrying a huge load for a child—a child of God—because there's “daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches” (2 Cor. 11:28, NIV) as we approach the very end of this age which involves “great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now...and never will be” (Matt. 24:21, ESV). It's a HUGE load! So while [Messiah 2030 - YouTube](#) clearly reveals the timing of the Lord's soon return, there are three main things that need to happen first concerning the body of Christ:



1. **The Bride Has to Get Ready:** The Lord is coming back for a Church, a Bride, who is holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:25-27 in the graphic) and we're currently not that! Right now we're a BRAT WHORE. He says “You have the brazen look of a prostitute [and] you refuse to blush with shame” (Jer. 3:3, NIV) which is my testimony of 27 years. And it's the body of Christ's testimony of the last 2000 years.
2. **The Body of Christ Needs to Repent:** In order to be ready for the Lord's return, born again Christians need to admit and repent of all revealed sins so as to get fully enlightened and empowered in order to bring in the harvest. Again, I've summed up the main lies—false doctrines—the body of Christ is walking in on this playlist: [Lies Christians Peddle - YouTube](#).
3. **The Latter Rain Has to Be Poured Out:** God has promised a great outpouring of His Spirit on the faithful—the “latter rain” “downpour” (Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT)—a greater outpouring than the one described in Acts, the first rain. But that won't happen *until* at least a decent number within the group repent because “God is not mocked” (Gal. 6:7, ESV). He's not going to bless us like crazy when we're sinning against Him like crazy. Again, unlike what the born again currently think, it's the body of Christ who needs to repent. *Then* the lost elect will get convicted to repent and also walk in the truth fulfilling the latter rain outpouring. 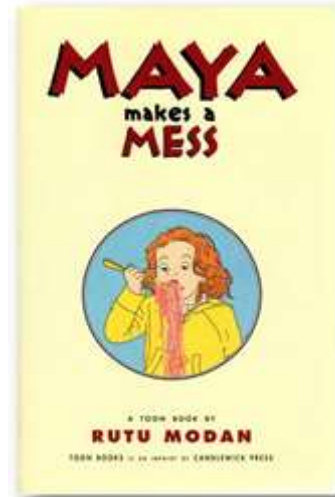

Maya Eyes Her Food. Maya is looking very closely at the food she’s eating because it represents the Lord Jesus Christ since He says “My flesh truly is food” ([John 6:55, YLT](#)). She looks at it closely because *not everything* we get fed by professing Christians is sound doctrine. In fact, **most** of what Christians have historically fed each other and, therefore, fed the rest of world is *false* doctrine, again as revealed throughout my ministry and summed up on [Lies Christians Peddle - YouTube](#). And God had Frank Viola and George Barna a hunk of it in 2001 with their book *Pagan Christianity: Exploring the Roots of Our Church Practices*, which He also had me sum up on this table before showing me that book: [Fake-vs-Real-Church.pdf](#).



Maya, who represents me, is doing what the Bereans did who “were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, **examining the Scriptures daily** to see if these things were so” ([Acts 17:11, ESV](#)). Rather than just blindly swallow what I’ve been fed by others, especially so-called Church leaders, I do what we were told to do and “not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world” ([1 John 4:1, ESV](#)). Eyeing her food as she’s doing is like “tak[ing] every thought captive to obey Christ” ([2 Cor. 10:5, ESV](#)) because “truth came through Jesus” ([John 1:17, ESV](#)) *not* through Moses, the so-called Church Fathers, or anyone else. Not even through those in the New Testament as I summed up with Peter’s rebellion when, above all others, Peter should have dealt *righteously* with Ananias and Sapphira because of what he had walked through himself.

- It was Peter who had asked about forgiveness and been told to forgive seventy times seven ([Matt. 18:21-22 below](#)), as in *always* forgive. Jesus had also put it to them this way, “If you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses” ([Matt. 6:15, ESV](#)).

Matthew. 18:21-22, ESV Then Peter came up and said to him, “Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?” Jesus said to him, “I do not say to you seven times, but seventy-seven times.

- It was Peter to whom Jesus said “I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven” ([Matt. 16:19, ESV](#)).
- It was Peter who betrayed the Lord three times so that “he went out and wept bitterly” ([Matt. 26:75, ESV](#)). In other words, Peter knew better than anyone that we can turn on Jesus even though we love Him.
- It was also Peter who had been *forgiven* by the Lord *and* given a great ministry ([John 21:17 & Gal. 2:8 below](#)) even when he’d betrayed Him as repeatedly and badly as he had.

John 21:17, ESV “Do you love me?” and...Jesus said to him, “Feed my sheep.

Galatians 2:8, ESV He...[gave] Peter...his apostolic ministry.

But rather than “do to others as [he] would have them do to [him]” ([Luke 6:31, NIV](#)), *forgiving* his brethren and *binding* demonic spirits as Jesus had done for him and told him he *could* do, lacking love while power tripping, Peter set demonic spirits loose and had Family members **KILLED**. Rather than honor Jesus he honored Satan “the one who has the power of death...the devil” ([Heb. 2:14, ESV](#)). Peter did it because, like everyone else, he had a heart that was “deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked” ([Jer. 17:9, KJV](#)).

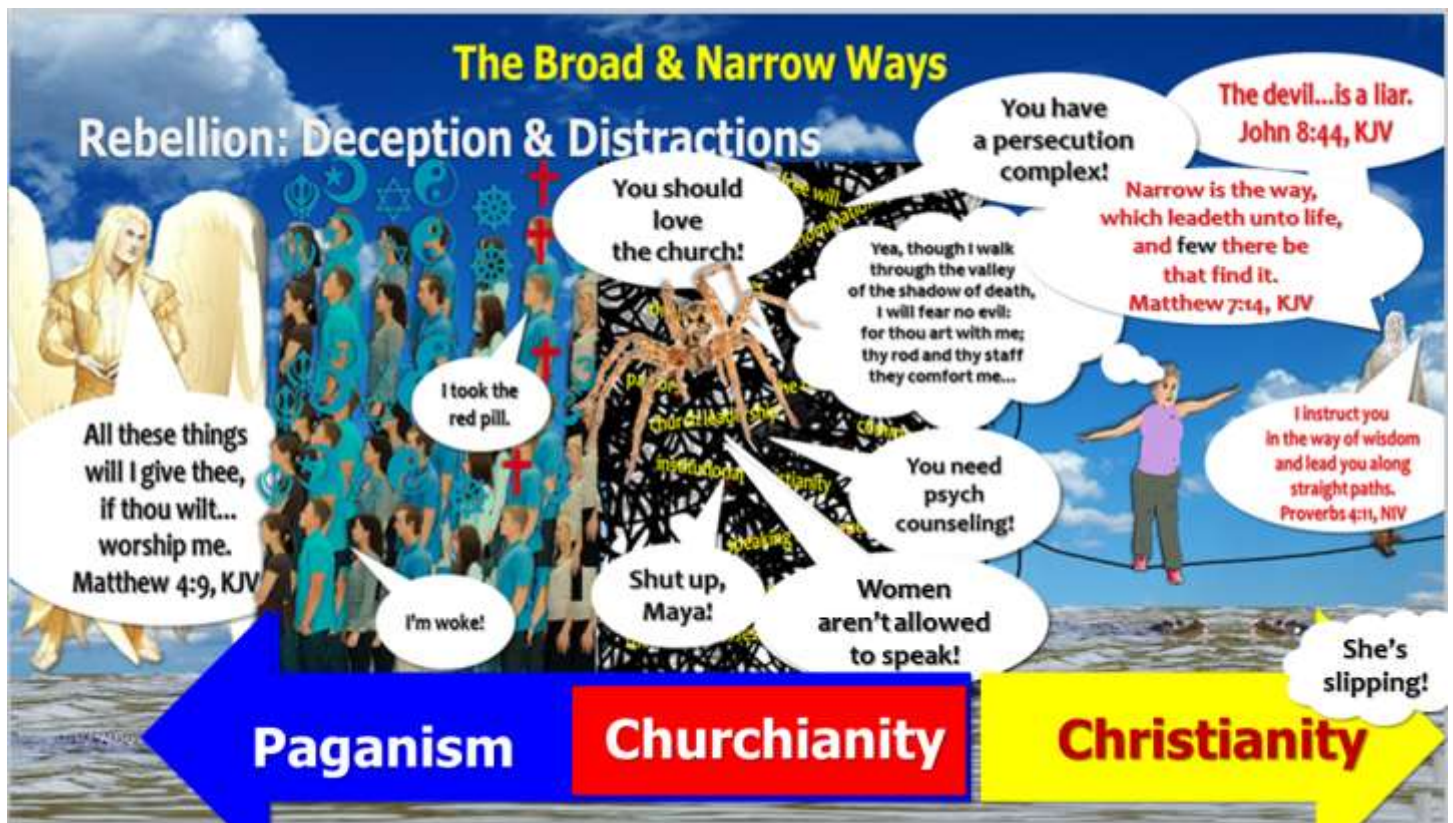
It's a very messy pot of noodles which represents four things: Christ, the body of Christ, the mess we've made of the truth, and a thread of truth.

1. **Christ—His Spirit:** As He says “My flesh is true food” (John 6:55, ESV). The pot represents the Lord who is food. And it's overflowing because “God gives the Spirit without limit” (John 3:34, NIV). We're the ones who limit Him by “quen[ching] the Spirit” (1 Thess. 5:19, ESV)—as we've been doing for these 2000 years.
2. **The Body of Christ:** Christians are also represented by the noodles. Since “we are ambassadors for Christ” (2 Cor. 5:20, ESV) we should be modeling the life of Christ who let us eat Him alive! He did it back then when He let them crucify Him, and He's been doing it ever since by letting us ignore Him and misrepresent Him for these 2000 years, picking and choosing what to believe and obey out of His teachings. That's what the denominations are all about. Called as His ambassadors, we should be letting others ‘eat us alive.’ For example, He says, “Love your enemies” (Matt. 5:44, ESV). He *didn't* tell us to kill them like we've been doing ever since Peter did it, like with our military, which we do for loving this world. While His “kingdom is not of this world” (John 18:36, ESV), we've been asking God to “Bless our troops,” deceived to think He loves us more than others when “God so loved THE WORLD” (John 3:16, ESV, my emphasis)—not just hypocritical Christians.



John 14:6, ESV Jesus said to him, “I am the...truth.

3. **The Body of Christ's Mess:** The pot of overflowing noodles also represents the mess the body of Christ has historically made of “the truth” who is Jesus (John 14:6, ESV), the food (John 6:55 above). As I summed up with this graphic, we've created Churchianity—a very *twisted* version of the truth.





4. **A Thread of Truth:** The noodles also represent the consistency found with the Lord, “the truth” (John 14:6, ESV). It’s the thread we see throughout the Bible which is full of prophecies pointing to Christ even though it was penned by 40 different people, from ten different countries, over a period of 1500 years. We also see this thread of consistency throughout this *Maya* book which also all points to Christ. And it also runs through every page until the last page where we see the fat queen eating it, genuinely *enjoying* her food, Christ (John 6:55) the truth (John 14:6). It’s what She’ll finally do before His soon return. And since the Lord has worked EVERYTHING out for His purposes (Eph. 1:11), that’s what the Queen does in the book, learns to love porking out on the food.

She’s Fat—So while the Queen, “the wife of the Lamb” (Rev. 2:19, ESV), will get fat on the Truth before the Lord returns, right now She’s just “fattened [He]r heart...in a day of slaughter” (James 5:5, ESV) by walking in false doctrines and worldly living. Many who think they represent the Queen—who think they’re Christian—aren’t actually born again as Jesus says we “must be” (John 3:7, ESV). They’re deceived, and if they don’t soon wake up to themselves they’ll be the ones to whom He’ll say “I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness” (Matt. 7:23, ESV). And the majority of those who are born again, are getting “saved, but only as through fire” (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV). So this graphic sums up what it means to be born again in right fellowship with God. Unlike what most teach, ‘Just believe’ or ‘Just say this prayer,’ you have to *prove* yourself to God for a season of time before He places His Spirit inside of you which is what makes you born again. You have to “keep” His Word (John 14:23 in the graphic). And, having become born again, you have to *continue* keeping it if you want to hear “Well done” (Matt. 25:21, ESV) and “receive a full reward” (2 John 1:8, KJV). You have to become a *follower* of Christ (Matt. 4:19 in the graphic), the closer the better.

Counting the Cost. The book *Maya Makes a Mess* was published in 2012 and retailed at \$12.95. Yet the Lord gave it to me for something like 26 cents because it's like salvation. (Asking Him if He had anything for me while at the used section of the library, it's what He showed me, giving me a brand new copy in 2012 when it came out.) Our salvation cost Him plenty ([Luke 22:40 below](#)) but to us it's a "gift" ([Rom. 6:23, YLT](#)) though it's not entirely free as some of the translations say ([Rom. 6:23 below](#)) since we have to "work out...our own salvation" ([Phil. 2:12, ESV](#)) and it could cost us as much as our mortal life, being "faithful unto death" ([Rev. 2:10, ESV](#)). At a minimum, it requires that we die to self like Paul who wrote "I am crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me" ([Gal. 2:12, ESV](#)). So, for example, I've had to kill off my own desires letting go of things like family and friends—ALL OF THEM—(since they reject Christ), paid work and so on. It's cost me everything but a roof over my head, just as He said it should. "Those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples" ([Luke 14:33, NIV](#)). But He's worth it!

It's ALL About Food

The story centers around food since Jesus is "food" ([John 6:55, ESV](#)) and His is "the name that is above every name" ([Phil. 2:9, ESV](#)) so that He "works all things according to the counsel of his will" ([Eph. 1:11, ESV](#)).

Eating. Christians are supposed to be holding "love feasts" ([John 1:12, ESV](#)) rather than what we've been doing, having made communion with the Lord a meaningless ritual as I summed up with the graphic. In fact, what Christians have been doing for centuries is very much like what they're doing in the story since there's an overriding air of hostility through it rather than overflowing joy and love. That's what's revealed in reality by the tens of thousands of denominational splits and constant scandals of church abuse. And the story reveals how everyone looks down on Maya (who represents me) and is hostile towards her. But they'll come to realize she's figured something out that they hadn't been aware of and which blesses them so much that most of them do a complete turnaround in how they view her. It's prophetic.



Fake Communion



Maya. The main character is a child because “unless [we] turn and become like children, [we] will never enter the kingdom of heaven” (Matt. 18:3, ESV). This storyline reveals what Jesus means which is also revealed by my life. It’s NOT about being a stuck up snob.

Her Elders. Maya’s parents represent the elders within the body of Christ, more mature Christians, people He’s had me addressing for 27 years—all to deaf ears and *very* hardened hearts. Not taking every thought captive to Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), they’ve been focused on the traditions of men which have the *opposite* effect of what God meant for the body of Christ.

Feeding the Dog. Dogs also represent needy souls as revealed with the saying “That poor dog.” Having fulfilled “the rebellion” (2 Thess. 2:3, ESV), the only reason *anyone* is getting saved and being used by God today is because “if we are faithless, he remains faithful” (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). We are all poor dogs who are getting fed by the Lord in spite of our historical rebellion. However, having promised to “send...prophets” (Matt 23:34, ESV), He’s using me to feed the other dogs, more specifically the body of Christ.



Condemning the Guiltless

No matter what Maya does, her elders find fault with her. And that’s how it is with me and the body of Christ so that I haven’t been able to get through to one born again Christian in 27 years. Like the lost, they’ve thought, even said, I’m out of my mind. It’s a re-run: “Because your sins are so many and your hostility so great, the prophet is considered a fool, the inspired person a maniac” (Hos. 9:7, NIV). I discern that because the body of Christ has been so unfaithful historically, we have blinded ourselves with beams in our eyes (Matt. 7:5 below) and God is *keeping* everyone in the dark concerning this ministry until His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV) as a judgment against all of us since “judgment must begin at the house of God” (1 Pet. 4:17, KJV) and born again Christians are that house. We are “God’s building” (1 Cor. 3:9, ESV). While it’s *obvious* that I’m a born again Christian serving the Lord and feeding the poor dogs, the born again have consistently blown me off when that’s not an option. “The eye **cannot** say to the hand, “I have no need of you,” nor again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.” On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable” (1 Cor. 12:21-22, ESV). I seem to be weaker since “man looks on the outward appearance” (1 Sam. 16:7, ESV), and I’m *indispensable* because of the ministry the Lord has entrusted to me exposing the lies the body of Christ is walking in, which will “ma[k]e [us]ready” for His soon return (Rev. 19:7, ESV) just as soon as we repent. It’s a judgment because instead of having had these 27 years to store treasure in heaven (Matt. 6:20), most will have barely stored anything. Historically, the members of the body of Christ has wasted their lives away instead of “store[d]...treasures in heaven” (Matt. 6:20, NIV).



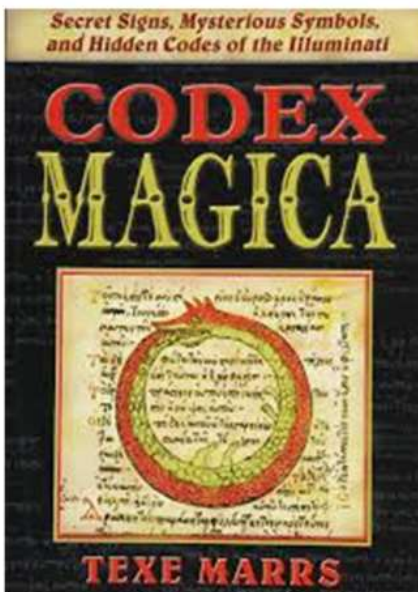

The Queen's Manners

Maya's father, her elder, represents "the eldership" (1 Tim. 4:14, YLT) within the body of Christ—those who've been born again the longest, the supposedly more mature Christians. He rebukes her just like they rebuke me. And he represents the Queen, the "the Bride, the wife of the Lamb" (Rev. 21:9, ESV)—they both do. In the story, they're both subjects of the same kingdom and in reality all born again Christians are the wife of the Lamb, Jesus Christ, subjects of the same kingdom. It parallels what's going on since this *elder* is telling Maya that *she* needs manners when *his* manners—the manners of the body of Christ, especially those in leadership roles—are outrageous as they eat dinner/have communion with the "King" (1 Tim. 6:15, ESV), Jesus Christ. Scandal upon scandal year after year, and the body of Christ just keeps on business as usual—for the most part—pressing on as if our sins aren't that big a deal.



For example, the only so-called home church the Lord ever gave our family was Eagle Alliance in Indianapolis in 1997. He led our family there because it represented what the body of Christ is doing *and* because it was mentored by Ravi Zacharias who was finally exposed in 2021 as the worst kind of false prophet, a wolf in sheep's clothing. This is super important because RZIM represented the brightest minds within the body of Christ and this is the level of discernment we've had—NONE! Ding Dong! Again, the Lord is mocking us (Ps. 2:4)

because He has been knocking on the door of the Church/the body of Christ for 2000 years trying to get us to wake up to ourselves and we've refused to wake up! And by ignoring the Lord, we've been ignoring the spiritual war we're in with "the forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (Eph. 6:12, NIV)—which is pretty dumb, *Ding Dong!*—so that we're facing chaos everywhere we turn as Chris Hedges summed up. Except it's the world, and it's much worse than what he summed up. The problem is that no one is doing what needs to be done which is to repent and walk closely with the Lord. It's what the Lord will finally get the body of Christ to do through this ministry. And when *we* repent the lost elect will follow suit since we are the light of the world (Matt. 5:14 in the graphic)—the ONLY light.

Rejecting God’s Interruptions

Someone comes with a message and Maya’s father, Church eldership, is so undiscerning and unloving that he gets annoyed and views it as an unwelcome intrusion. It’s exactly what’s been happening so that someone recorded it in 2015: [JOHN MACARTHUR CONFRONTED BY A FALSE PROPHET AT GRACE COMMUNITY CHURCH, CA 8-16-2015 / SO4J-TV](#). They viewed the true prophet as a false prophet and kicked him out while submitting to the false prophet, in fact, viewed the whole thing as a joke. And *all* of those so-called pastors and institutional leaders are false teachers if not false prophets since that whole system is pagan and all denominational leaders bow to the popes. Jesus also warned us saying “A hired hand...cares nothing for the sheep” ([John 10:13, ESV](#)). Paid professionals are hired hands who care more about their position and income than the Lord Jesus Christ and His people—for which there is much proof. They *refuse* to be held accountable. We were also told to “not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares” ([Heb. 13:2, ESV](#)). Yet, as my testimony of decades reveals, born again Christians don’t even welcome other born again Christians! They’re just like the lost who love their opinions more than the truth. The parable of the sower sums up what’s happened, which the Lord had me clarify with this graphic. Having historically fulfilled “the rebellion” ([2 Thess. 2:3, ESV](#)), for centuries every member of the body of Christ has been born again into a land covered with thorns so that we easily fell in step with the rest of the rebellious crowd and choked out “The Word” ([Rev. 19:13, ESV](#)) the Lord Jesus Christ.



Biblical Elders. Since “one is...our director—the Christ, and all [w]e are brethren” ([Matt. 23:8, YLT](#)), this graphic sums up what God’s elect have historically done. Many have wasted their whole lives by not becoming born again even though God has been calling them since as young as we can remember ([Rev. 3:20 & John 6:44 in the graphic](#)). And those who became born again have mostly become believers rather than *followers* of Christ even though He says “Follow me” ([Matt. 4:19, ESV](#)). They didn’t become *disciples* of Christ. In turn, they’ve *also* wasted their lives away since they’ll “suffer loss” when God tests their works by fire ([1 Cor. 3:15, ESV](#)).



[Matthew 16:18, YLT](#) I will build my assembly, and gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

The Lord showed me through my own life and through the lives of others, that even if we come from a home that is not Christian, He starts drawing us to Christ and knocking on the door of our heart when we're in preschool. And He never stops. It's like He's standing there knocking every single day of our lives because He uses EVERYTHING and EVERYONE to reach out to us having "work[ed] all things according to the counsel of his will" (Eph. 1:11, ESV), which He's proving through this ministry, especially with these interpretations. He ALWAYS has more to teach us.

Taken By Surprise. In the story they get taken by surprise when the messenger comes knocking. Likewise, the message God is giving His people through this ministry will take the body of Christ by surprise. While Jesus said "Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation" (Matt. 26:41, KJV), we've historically fallen into many temptations to the point that today's born again defend Satan's ways not even able to tell the difference between true and false prophets. And all it takes for a born again Christian to discern if someone is speaking for God is "take every thought captive to obey Christ" (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV). Having gotten proud, the Queen is going to wake up to Herself at the very last minute, practically, having wasted away most of Her life. And that includes those who are currently the most enlightened, because "whoever exalts himself will be humbled" (Matt. 23:12, ESV) and the entire body of Christ has gotten super proud proving God's point that our hearts are "deceitful above all" (Jer. 17:9). We're so deceitful many Christians talk about already having the new hearts when we don't that until the rapture (1 Cor. 15:52 below) IF we actually became born again.

1 Corinthians 15:52, ESV In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.

God Feeds Dogs. The dog gets fed even though no one is actually feeding it. Likewise, "if we are faithless, he remains faithful" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). So while the whole system we've historically called Christianity is a lie, people have still been getting saved and fed spiritually. But the outcome has been *nothing* like the first disciples as described in the book of Acts. And we should have been even more empowered than they were because we've had 2000 years to study the Bible when they didn't even have it in print for themselves.



God's Messengers. The little guy represents both supernatural and human messengers. Angels in Young's literal translation are referred to as messengers, as in the following examples:

Then doth the Devil leave him, and lo, messengers came and were ministering to him (Matt. 4:11, YLT).

Then he shall send his messengers, and gather together his chosen from the four winds, from the end of the earth unto the end of heaven (Mark 13:27, YLT).

And the Lord uses His human followers as messengers so that Jesus said "I send you prophets and wise men and scribes, some of whom you will...persecute" (Matt. 23:34, ESV). I discern most in the U.S. have been persecuted from town to town by born again Christians unwilling to hear what God is saying to them. It's always those who *should* listen who are the worst persecutors, as lamented by the psalmist "Even my close friend in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has lifted his heel against me" (Ps. 41:9, ESV).



The Source of the Invitation. We see a *royal* messenger because, besides representing an angel, he represents the "royal priesthood" (1 Pet. 2:9, ESV) of believers. He's the king's servant. While the invitation is coming from the Queen, "the husband is the head of the wife" (Eph. 5:23, ESV). So this message is coming to you from Jesus, "the King" (1 Tim. 6:5, ESV).

Only Maya Gets Invited. Jesus says "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 19:14, ESV). Maya's parents represent proud supposedly mature Christian snobs. That was His point in having me reach out to the born again for nearly three decades, many in leadership, and not be able to get through to even one, most being quite cold even hostile, proving the body of Christ is made up of undiscerning snobs. So only Maya got invited, was given this ministry.

We're On God's Timetable. The book has "tonight" in bold because we're on God's schedule not ours. "Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son" (2 John 1:9, *ESV*). You can be born again and not have God in the sense that you aren't walking closely with Him. In turn, you can't hear or see what He's saying and doing. You might as well not be born again, not have God. And "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God" (Luke 9:62, *ESV*). Again, born again Christians have *turned* back to their worldly living just like a dog who returns to her vomit (Prov. 26:11, *ESV*). So while their lifestyles might be different than before, they're still living worldly lives as compared to what's described in the "new covenant" (Luke 22:20, *NIV*).



When We Eat. Maya's comment and the messenger's reply refer to how we're to feed on God continually. He says "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds...Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up" (Deut. 11:18-19, *NIV*). Because it's as He says, "It is your life" (Deut. 32:47, *KJV*). So it's just as the messenger says to her objections. "So what?" "Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the LORD that will stand" (Prov. 19:21, *ESV*).



Onward and Upward!

Maya's getting ready to go up into the clouds because the Lord's "kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36, *ESV*).

A Messenger Gets Things Going. God says "Behold, I send my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me" (Mal. 3:1 *ESV*). That's what He's doing with that little guy and with me. We're both His messengers preparing the way before the Lord's soon return.

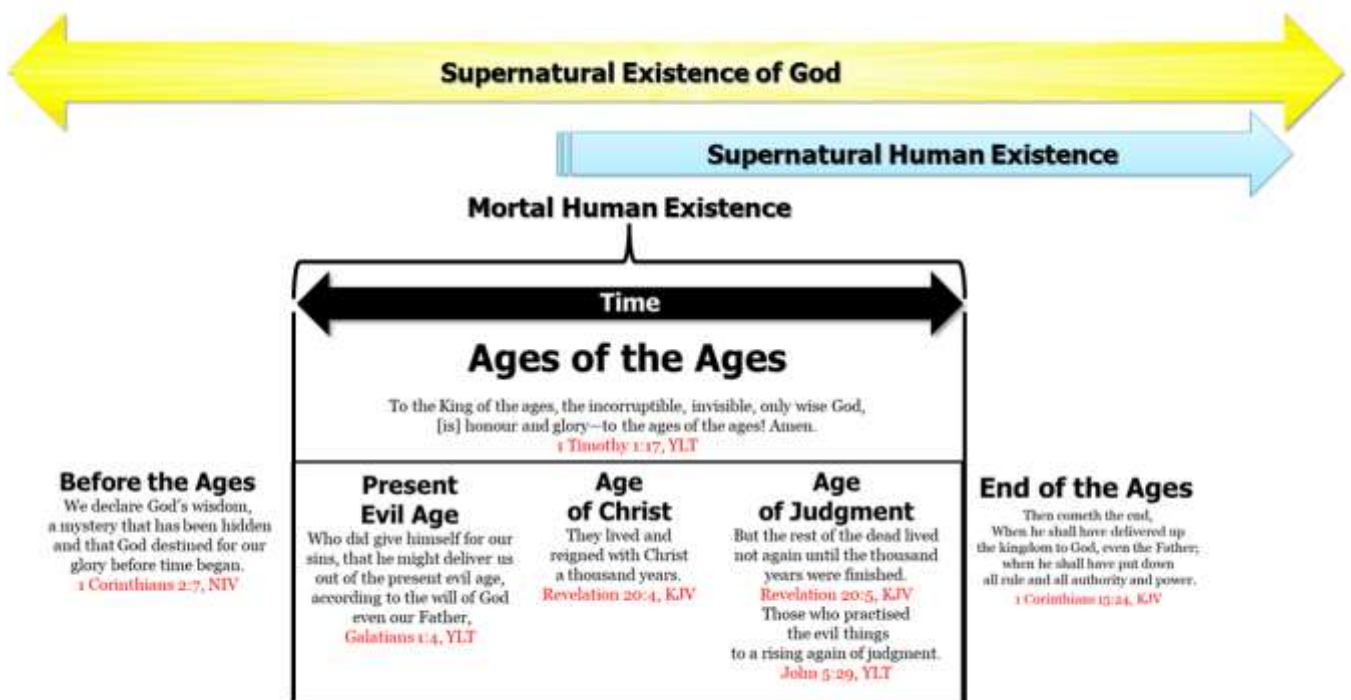


Set Apart. Maya says goodbye to her family because, even though they represent the born again, honoring the traditions of men, they have become antichrist. This video someone else made backs it up: [What is meant by "666" and "antichrist"?](#) In turn, God set me apart as He's done before, like when He said "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them" (**Acts 13:2, ESV**). Maya leaves them—the body of Christ—behind for the kingdom which "is not of this world" (**John 18:36, ESV**)—hence the plane. It's what I've done. Unlike those the Lord has been reaching out to through me, who have refused to even listen to what He was saying to them, I listened and left the rebellious body of Christ—for which born again Christians rebuke me! At the very least scoff, just like the lost.

Revving Things Up. The messenger gets things started because he represents a servant of God who says "New things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them" (**Isa. 42:9, KJV**). Again, "the Sovereign LORD does nothing without revealing his plan to his servants the prophets" (**Amos 3:7, KJV**). Before He returns He's helping His people get ready.



Nearly Out of Time. While the King, Jesus, is "the beginning and the end" (**Rev. 22:13, ESV**), and, therefore, has all the time in the world, being that He stands *outside* of time as I summed up in the graphic, His messenger says "No time, no time!" Because, we are on the Lord's schedule, not ours. And *everything* God does has an "appointed time" (**Hab. 2:3, KJV**) "for everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven" (**Eccl. 3:1, ESV**) so that Jesus came "proclaiming the gospel of God, and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand" (**John 1:14-15, ESV**). When He first came it was to bring the kingdom of God to earth where He would reign in men's hearts, all who let Him. Now with His second coming it's to bring the kingdom of heaven to earth where He will reign over both, in men's hearts and on earth through men as I summed up in the graphic. He's saying "I send an angel before you to guard you on the way and to bring you to the place that I have prepared" (**Ex. 23:20, YLT**). That place is His Kingdom, a place of *faith*. Before the Lord returns, "the righteous shall live by faith" (**Rom. 1:17, ESV**) "not ashamed of the gospel" (**Rom. 1:16, ESV**) as so many born again Christians are today so that they don't even evangelize to their closest friends—even though they profess to believe in hell!





Wrongly Focused. As Maya sets out to leave them behind, they hold out some things for her—a dress and toothbrush—ignoring the really important stuff, her shoes. They are “blind guides, which strain at a gnat, and swallow a camel” (Matt. 23:24, KJV). Since shoes are so important in both the material and spiritual realm, *that’s* what should have concerned them. God says to the body of Christ “Stand firm then...with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel” (Eph. 6:15, NIV). It’s ALL about the gospel, the “good news” we “bring” with our “feet” (Rom. 10:15, ESV).

God’s Ways are NOT Ours! Maya’s funky feet and manner sum up how God is having me bring this Good News because it’s as He says, “My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways” (Isa. 55:8, KJV). Our ways have been with big words and scholarly papers—and a ton of lies! In contrast, His are with the truth, and with children’s books and movies, for example.

Proper Dress. God walked me through something years before giving me this *Maya* book, making the point with another pretty little dress on another funky little “person.” Dust Bunny. He says, clearly speaking to the body of Christ, “Blessed is the one who stays awake, keeping his garments on, that he may not go about naked and be seen exposed!” (Rev. 16:15, ESV). The born again have clearly removed their garments! Not completely since we can’t become un born again, but we can get “saved, as through fire” (1 Cor. 3:15, ESV). “I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels” (Rev. 3:5, NIV). Those who get blotted out of the book of life won’t get to participate in the best of the ages, the next age. They didn’t become born again. Instead, they’ll rise to “the resurrection of judgment” (John 5:29, ESV). So while the born again will rise to life, getting there “by fire” (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV), is hardly ideal!



Led Like a Lamb to the Slaughter

On the plane, Maya has a moment of trepidation as she considers dining with the queen since she *knows* her manners and the queen's differ greatly. This is exactly what I was doing when God gave me this book since He had just asked me to begin "the routine" with the pastors at Riverdale Baptist in Largo, MD. Not wanting to, since by that point I'd experienced 14 *years* of the body of Christ's cold shoulder and hostility. But God says "Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (**Phil. 2:12, KJV**). It's with fear and trembling since *our* "heart is deceitful above all things" (**Jer. 17:9, KJV**). Sensitive to this fact, I obeyed, while again feeling "like a lamb or an ox that is brought to the slaughter" (**Jer. 11:19, KJV**). *Dreading* moving forward, I moved forward, like she's doing in the book.

Refreshing Comes from the Lord.

Considering her hesitation, Maya is surprised when the flight attendant brings her refreshments. It's how I felt when the Lord gave me this book, surprised considering how rebellious I was feeling. *If only I had never met the Queen before!* (And at the time He gave me at least one other very funny biblical interpretation, for the song Needing Getting by OK Go. VERY refreshing.) The flight attendant represents an angel because they're His servants as the angel told John when he bowed down to him saying "You must not do that! I am a fellow servant" (**Rev. 19:10, ESV**). In fact, angels are "ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation" (**Heb. 1:14, ESV**). Still, I was surprised since I'd been feeling like Elijah who said "It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers. [Every true prophet knows they're just as bad as the rest! It's the false prophets who think they're better than others. Yet] as he lay and slept under a juniper tree, behold, then an angel touched him, and said unto him, Arise and eat. And he looked, and, behold, there was a cake [cookies in this case] baked on the coals, and a cruse of water at his head [my guess is *Kool Aid* since the Lord is way cool and *aids* us being that He's our "Helper" (**Ps. 54:4, ESV**)]" (**1 Kings 19:4-6, KJV**). And since we were supposed to "bear fruit in keeping with repentance" (**Matt. 3:8, ESV**), He's telling the body of Christ to "mind your manners"—as in be *nice*. That's the Golden Rule, "Whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets" (**Matt. 7:12, ESV**). SO SIMPLE! And yet **not at all** how the body of Christ behaves!



Called to Live by Faith

On Captain's orders, the flight attendant/God's servant warns all to buckle their seatbelts—because, we're in for a Ride in these last of the last days. Jesus is "the captain of [our] salvation" (**Heb. 2:10, KJV**) and Christians were told to "Stand firm...with the belt of truth buckled around your waist" (**Eph. 6:14, KJV**). We need to be firmly buckled in because God says "I will shew [you] how great things [you] must suffer for my name's sake" (**Acts 9:16, KJV**). Christians get to experience most of the tribulation because our unfaithfulness is the *reason* the world is getting it (**Matt. 24:21, ESV**) since we could have put an end to Satan's schemes by "submit[ting]...to God [and] resist[ing] the devil, [so that] he w[ould have had to] flee" (**James 4:7, ESV**). Another reason is that trials are what make us mature spiritually (**James 1:4 below**). Still, "perfect love casts out fear" (**1 John 4:18, ESV**). And "God is love" (**1 John 4:8, ESV**) who is "perfect" (**Matt. 5:48, ESV**), And Jesus is God (**John 10:30 below**). It's part of the reason we want to know Him well. The better we know Him the more secure we are against Satan's schemes and get through the trials successfully having grown spiritually.

James 1:4, ESV Let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

John 10:30, ESV I and the Father are one.

Therefore, most professing Christians *should* be worried since they've barely gotten to know Him at all, and are *not* wearing "the belt of truth" (**Eph. 6:14, KJV**) as with thinking He is going to burn alive most of the people He created in a place called Hell—something only demented Satan would do.

Seeing God's Hand. You *should* be able to see God's hand on this ministry. It's right there in the middle since He's the "captain" of our salvation (**Heb. 2:10, KJV**).

Coming Soon. The plane is coming in for a landing reflecting the Lord's soon return (**Rev. 22:12 below**), having sent me (**Luke 3:4 below**)—along with all the people He has me referencing—to prepare the way because of how it is (**2 Cor. 12:20 below**). While Messiah 2030 reveals the timing of the Lord's soon return, the ministry the Lord has entrusted to me reveals that we're not at all ready, we the body of Christ. So it's not as if the rest are ready either so that "they [will] call...to the mountains and the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! (**Rev. 6:16, NIV**). And, again, God's wrath is expressed through Satan, the Lord's servant (**2 Cor. 5:5 below**).

Revelation 22:12, NIV Look, I am coming soon!

Luke 3:4, KJV The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.

2 Corinthians 12:20, NIV [Jesus says] I am afraid that when I come I may not find you as I want you to be, and you may not find me as you want me to be. I fear that there may be discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, slander, gossip, arrogance and disorder.

1 Corinthians 5:5, ESV Deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord.

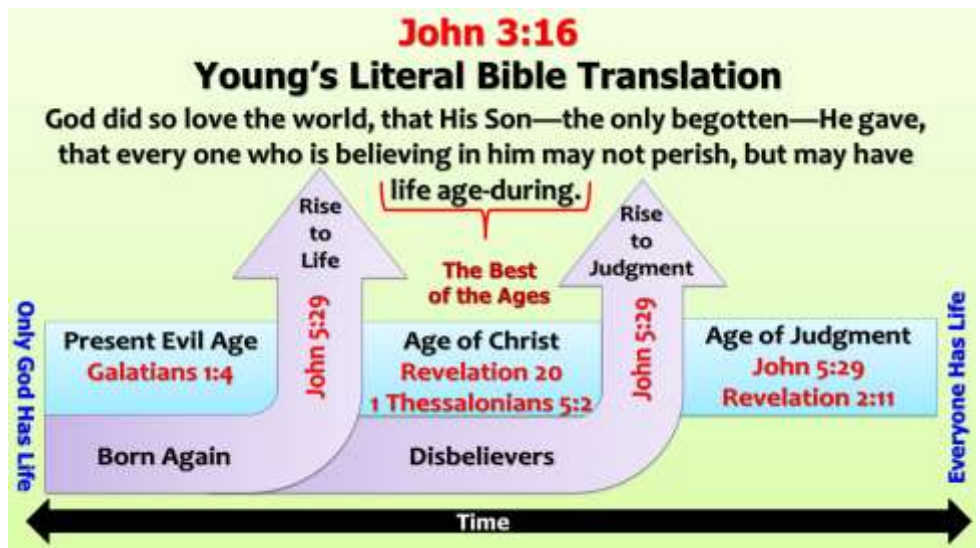




Kingdom Subjects are Proud and Blind

A red carpet has been laid out for Maya leading her to the queen while the band plays on and her children and fat dogs stand by. Then the queen begins the party as She leads the way.

The Red Carpet Treatment. Essentially, all elect have been given The Red Carpet Treatment compared to what the non-elect get during the “present evil age” (Gal. 1:4, YLT) since they don’t have the ability to chose Christ being that they were “fitted to destruction” (Rom. 9:22, KJV) for this present evil age so that it’s as Jesus says, “No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him” (John 6:44, ESV). During this age the Father is only drawing the vessels of mercy, the elect. I summed it up on this graphic. The literal translation says “and did believe—as many as were appointed to life age-during” (Acts 13:48, YLT). Not all were appointed for life during the age of Christ, the next age—only the elect “vessels of mercy, which he has prepared beforehand for glory” (Rom. 9:23, ESV).



However, it’s *our* choice whether we (the elect vessels of mercy) walk on the red carpet or not (Luke 7:30 below). God says “He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life” (Rev. 3:5, KJV). Apparently, all elect were born with their names written in the book of life since “he chose us in him before the creation of the world” (Eph. 1:4, NIV). But God will “blot” out our name from His book if we don’t become born again. That doesn’t mean those people will go to hell since hell isn’t a real place other than what *we* have created here on earth. I discern it means that instead of rising to life for the next age, they’ll miss the glorious Age of Christ and rise to judgment at the end of it as we’ve been informed in the following passages, for instance:

I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended (Rev. 20:4-5, ESV).

An hour is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment (John 5:28-29, ESV).

Luke 7:30, NIV The Pharisees and the experts in the law rejected God’s purpose for themselves.

The Kingdom's People. The queen's children, the body of Christ, which includes those fat dogs since born again Christians are behaving like dogs, stand there looking down their noses at Maya because even the most enlightened born again Christians aren't open to being corrected. They "will not endure sound teaching...having itching ears" (2 Tim. 4:3, ESV), and "a scoffer does not listen to rebuke" (Prov. 13:1, ESV), which is my testimony concerning all professing Christians the Lord has had me reach out to for nearly three decades.

The Band. The band is playing because God's people "s[i]ng praises with gladness" (2 Chron. 29:30, KJV). The body of Christ does get this point, at least somewhat. Many do sing praises to God with gladness. But rather than being proud, we're supposed to be humble. Jesus says "Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven" (Luke 10:20, NIV) since we could just as easily *not* have been elect, *not* have had the ability to take God seriously during this life in the "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT). It's what **all** humans would do if God had not elected some of us since "there is none righteous, not even one" (Rom. 3:10, YLT) so that the Father has to *draw* us to Christ (John 6:44 below). Having done that, He then has to *convict* us to take Him seriously (John 16:8 & Eph. 2:8 below). As Jesus says, "Apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5, ESV). He meant nothing that will survive when "tested by fire" (1 Pet 1:17, ESV).

John 6:44, ESV No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him

John 16:8, ESV He will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment.

Ephesians 2:8, ESV By grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God.

We're All the Same. As Maya is greeted by the queen, we see that she's no different than anyone else just like "Elijah was a human being, even as we are" (James 5:17, NIV). So she gets momentarily mesmerized by the things of Satan's world when God says "If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world" (1 John 2:15-16, ESV). And "a friend of the world is the enemy of God" (James 4:4, KJV), because, Satan is "the ruler of this world" (John 12:31, YLT).



Maya's Coming is Good. The queen's children, who represent the body of Christ, the "royal priesthood" (1 Pet. 2:9, ESV), are snobs looking down on Maya—as you can tell by their stance and their rejection of me in the real world. But "if you had known what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice,' you would not have condemned the guiltless" (Matt. 12:7, KJV). At some point—at God's "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV)—the body of Christ will stop treating me with contempt and echo the queen's words admitting that it *was* good of me to come, good of me to obey the Lord because "to obey is better than sacrifice" (1 Sam. 15:22, ESV).

The Queen Leads the Way. The Queen is "the wife of the Lamb" (Rev. 21:9, ESV), the body of Christ, commonly called the Church. She starts the party leading everyone into the banquet hall because by admitting the lies we've believed and practiced, repenting of them, we'll lead the lost elect, to enter the *party*—the biggest revival in the history of the world, a period the Bible calls "the latter rain" (Joel 2:23, ESV) and "downpour" (CLT). It's a "party" because we'll be experiencing the greatest presence of the Lord in this world during this "present evil age" (Gal. 1:4, YLT).



Maya is Up Front. She's first after the queen because "God has appointed in the church...second prophets" (1 Cor. 12:28, ESV). And He informed me through many that I'm a prophet. It's obvious. Prophets are important because "the one who prophesies...builds up the church" (1 Cor. 14:3-4, ESV). That's what's important during this life, building up the church NOT our own estates as most born again Christians have done, especially in our day, having made their careers top priority and demoted Christ to about an hour, or at most a few hours, of their week.

Maya Stands Out. She's getting disparaging looks from everyone since she totally doesn't fit in "for so persecuted they the prophets which were before [me]" (**Matt. 5:12, KJV**). And Scripture says the following:

God chose **what is foolish** in the world to shame the wise; God chose **what is weak** in the world to shame the strong; God chose **what is low and despised** in the world, **even things that are not**, to bring to nothing things that are, so that no human being might boast in the presence of God (**1 Cor. 1:27-29, ESV**).

Through my material online, especially parts where I share my life testimony, God is making the point that all of those nothings highlighted represent my life. I am a *total nobody* in this world and fit it nowhere, not even in my own home just like Maya in the book. Compared to the rest, the girl is seriously odd.

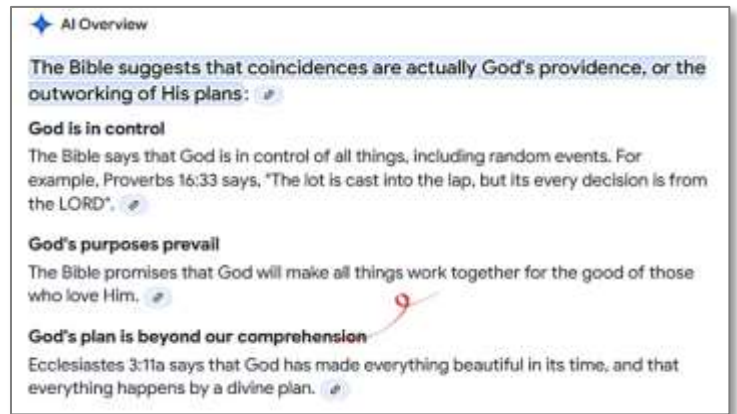
The Queen Starts the Party. Since I'm a child of God having "received the Spirit of adoption" (**Rom. 8:15, KJV**), and Jesus Christ is the "King" (**1 Tim. 6:15, KJV**) and all of His children make up "the church" whom "Christ loved" (**Eph. 5:25, ESV**) so that He laid down His life for Her on the Cross, and She's His "Bride" (**Rev. 19:7, ESV**), She's also the Queen and I am represented by her in the book (besides represented by Maya) making this announcement, that the party, the "latter rain" (**Joel 2:23, ESV**)—the period of greatest fellowship with the Lord by way of the Spirit—is about to begin since I'm actually starting it through this ministry. While there are some decent ministries out there, as with *Messiah 2030 the Total Victory of Christ*, and the *AOC Network*, they haven't motivated the body of Christ to repent since they're not addressing the many false doctrines we're walking in. And by the time of His return we *will* be "without blemish" (**Eph. 5:27, ESV**). "His bride [will have] made herself ready" (**Rev. 19:7, ESV**) by having listened, experienced godly sorry and finally repented of all exposed sins.

So while the Bible has foretold of "the latter rain" "downpour" (**Joel 2:23, ESV & YLT**), there's a fake version of the it, [The Last Reformation - YouTube](#), since Satan is copying EVERYTHING Jesus is doing being that he set out to "be like the most High" (**Isa. 14:14, KJV**) to "deceive the nations" (**Rev. 20:3, KJV**). There are many fakes but this is the biggest one as far as I'm aware.



- The First Christians were Highly Empowered by God because they Obeyed Him as Individuals and as a Group**
- They spoke in languages they hadn't studied (**Acts 2:4-6**);
 - They healed the sick (**Acts 3:2-7**);
 - They raised the dead (**Acts 9:37-41**);
 - They drove out demons (**Acts 16:16-18**);
 - They witnessed boldly (**Acts 4:4**);
 - They prayed for their attackers as they killed them (**Acts 7:58-60**);
 - They enlightened thousands at a time (**Acts 7:58-60**);
 - Their shadows provided healing (**Acts 5:14-16**);
 - Unbelievers admired them (**Acts 2:47**);
 - They beamed around like in *Star Trek* (**Acts 8:39-40**);
 - They were full of wisdom (**Acts 6:3**);
 - They were full of generosity (**Acts 4:34-35**); and,
 - They were full of joy (**Acts 2:46**).

Since Jesus, “the King” (1 Tim. 6:15, ESV), is my “Husband” (Isa 54:5, ESV), He’s backed up the ministry He’s entrusted to me having me *take my thoughts captive to obey Him* (2 Cor. 10:5), backing up just about every point with His Word in relation to the “new covenant” we’re under (Luke 22:20, ESV). He’s also backed me up by coordinating the the places where I grew up—La Reina/The Queen in Santiago, Chile and Queens, New York, for example, with His message being that He “works all things according to the counsel of his will” (Eph. 1:11, ESV). So He’s done the same thing for all of us. Scripture says “He marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands” (Acts 17:26, NIV). “My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure” (Isa. 46:10, KJV). According to Scripture there is no such thing as coincidence. Even AI knows this as you can see with the graphic. But since AI has been informed by humans, the last statement is wrong. If God’s plan was beyond our comprehension we’d have total chaos. He *has* “work[ed] all things [out] according to the counsel of his will” (Eph. 1:11, ESV). Those who take Jesus seriously, being honest about the lies the body of Christ has historically taught and practiced, repenting of them, will know that I’m serving Him. It’s as Jesus said about Himself, “The very works that I am doing, bear witness about me that the Father has sent me” (John 5:36, ESV). In my case, no false prophet would have sacrificed her entire adult life—career/money, family, friends, time and reputation—in order to honor the Lord by doing what He’s led me to do, praying His Word for them showing them how I’ve been doing it for nearly three decades, *while* being ignored or ridiculed by them. It’s a no-brainer, just like it’s a no-brainer that ONLY Jesus represents God (not Allah or any of the others). The only reason people don’t think it’s obvious is because they CHOOSE to deny the evidence, which is our main problem, and need for Jesus in the first place. Our hearts are “deceitful above all things” (Jer. 17:9, KJV).





Alone, Yet Not Alone. While everyone else is accompanied by someone, Maya walks alone enduring everyone’s contempt, as you can see by their faces. As a servant of Christ “I have come in my Father’s name, and you do not receive me. [But] if another comes in his own name, you will receive him” (**John 5:43, KJV**). For 2000 years Christians have been rejecting the Lord while opening their hearts to professing Christians who’ve been teaching false doctrines, just like we’ve accepted Peter’s actions against Annanias and Sapphira as if they lined up with the Lord’s teachings when they obviously didn’t. And I’m not really alone because the Lord is with me having said “I will never leave you nor forsake you” (**Heb. 13:5, ESV**). Just because no one else can see Him, doesn’t mean He’s not here with me—as all born again Christians know to be true.

The Feast

Maya sits at the head of the court between the King/Jesus and the Queen/the body of Christ because it’s where every prophet has sat. So plenty of others have recognized my calling as a prophet. It wasn’t until the Lord had me hold them accountable that they then decided I must be a false, since, again, our hearts *are* “deceitful above all” (**Jer. 17:9, KJV**).

The King’s Table. Prophets are stuck between God and His Bride because they are sent by Him (**Matt. 23:34 below**) to a people who are in “rebellion” (**2 Thess. 2:3, ESV**) as the teachings of Christ reveal. It’s like Paul said of them 2000 years ago, “It is hard to make [things] clear to you because you no longer try to understand” (**Heb. 5:11, NIV**). So it’s that much harder today, as my testimony reveals! God says “They have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching them, yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction” (**Jer. 32:33, KJV**). In turn, for 27 years NO ONE the Lord has had me reach out to—even among the most enlightened—has been humble enough to admit the truth. Not one. So we see that the queen has her back to Maya/God’s prophet/me—and, more importantly, to God/Jesus/Her King talking to some random guy as if he’s more important.



Matthew 23:34, ESV I send you prophets and wise men and scribes, some of whom you will kill and crucify, and some you will flog in your synagogues and persecute from town to town.

Followers Follow. The King/Jesus tells Maya/the prophet when to speak ([Rev. 22:10 below](#)) and when not to speak ([Rev. 10:4 below](#)), in the same way that He didn't act on His own initiative ([John 5:19-20 below](#)) because "a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him" ([John 13:16, ESV](#)). So while "Christians" have accused me of being nuts, super proud, even the Messiah(!), my writing has always revealed that I'm none of those things.

Revelation 22:10, ESV He said to me, "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near.

Revelation 10:4, ESV I was about to write, but I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Seal up what the seven thunders have said, and do not write it down."

John 5:19-20, ESV Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all that he himself is doing.



The Banquet. The banquet represents communion with God and His people before the Lord's return, which the literal and ESV call "love feasts" ([Jude 1:1, YLT](#)). It also represents the coming "marriage supper of the Lamb" ([Rev. 19:9, ESV](#)).

Turning a Blind Eye. Everyone at the table looks decent enough since "man looks on the outward appearance" ([1 Sam. 16:7, ESV](#)). So they lets dogs roam around freely and include Catholics. In turn, God says "Why do you make me look at injustice? Why do you tolerate wrongdoing?" ([Hab. 1:3, NIV](#)) "Whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord" ([1 Cor. 11:26-27, KJV](#)). "You cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils...cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils" ([1 Cor. 10:21, KJV](#)). Yet as already noted, today's so-called Protestants are led by Catholics. Therefore, God says "I have this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel [the Catholic so-called church], who calls herself a prophetess [a Christian] and is teaching and seducing my servants to practice sexual immorality" ([Rev. 2:20, KJV & Jude 1:12-13 below](#)). And this is just one grave sin the body of Christ is committing—one of many. This video is probably one of thousands, or more, online exposing Catholicism: [Shocking Confession of Sister Charlotte, Former Roman Catholic Nun](#). And turning a blind eye to sin within the body of Christ has landed the world in "great tribulation" ([Matt. 21:24, ESV](#)). No small problem. He warned us, "If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all ([Isa. 7:9, NIV](#)).

Jude 1:12-13, YLT These are in your love-feasts craggy rocks; feasting together with you, without fear shepherding themselves; clouds without water, by winds carried about; trees autumnal, without fruit, twice dead, rooted up; wild waves of a sea, foaming out their own shames; stars going astray, to whom the gloom of the darkness to the age hath been kept.





Servants Serve the Meal

God has been sending His prophets/the waiters/servants for 2000 years and the body of Christ hasn't listened to them, for the most part. "They hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse than their fathers ([Jer. 7:25-26, KJV](#)). What the body of Christ has done is much worse than those before us since we've had access to the completed Bible, along with access to the "Spirit whom God [gives] to those who obey him" ([Acts 5:32, NIV](#))—obeyed Him initially so that we became born again. On top of that, for the last two decades we've been able to carry our Bible in our back pocket and have had access to all of the most important books ever written on it. Besides that, we've got the truth (for the most part) presented in films as with the Visual Bible, and so much more! And that's God's point. There's a problem with the human heart in that it is "deceitful above all things" which is why He's giving us "a new heart" ([Ezek. 36:26, ESV](#)). But we have to *want* it. And for that we need to grasp the depth of our wicked nature. The fact is that we could have been the worst of the worst had He placed in a different setting, which the body of Christ has not understood since it would be revealed through humility.





The Food. Even though *dinner* (John 6:55 below) was served 2000 years ago (Mark 1:14-15 & Acts 2:1-4 below), Christians, as led by “hired hand [s]” (John 10:13, ESV) have made the Meal/Jesus, look *very* unappetizing—just like in the book. In contrast, two thousand years ago “breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved” (Acts 2:46-47, ESV). In contrast, people today can’t get far enough away from Christians fast enough. Like the Jews, the body of Christ has “nullif[ie]d the word of God for the sake of...our tradition” (Matt. 15:6, NIV)—our tradition of Churchianity, a fake version of God’s kingdom on earth.

John 6:55, NIV For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.

Mark 1:14-15, ESV Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel.”

Acts 2:1-4 ESV When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all...filled with the Holy Spirit.

No Gospel. Seeing the table before her, Maya is shocked and disappointed. While God “prepare[d] a table before [us] in the presence of [our] enemies” (Ps. 23:5, KJV), the body of Christ has “removed from...the grace of Christ unto another gospel” (Gal. 1:6, KJV) “which is really no gospel” (Gal. 1:7, NIV). Told to “grieve not the holy Spirit of God” (Eph. 4:30, KJV), grieving God is pretty much all the body of Christ is doing as even the most enlightened feed off a ton of false doctrines, which they eat with others who aren’t born again in that satanic so-called church system when told to “not be unequally yoked with unbelievers” (2 Cor. 6:14, ESV).



Expressing Good Manners

Knowing what tastes better (Ps. 34:8 below), Maya asks (1 John 5:14 below) and receives, having asked properly (Mark 11:24; James 4:3 below). We have to “build...ourselves up in...our most holy faith and pray...in the Holy Spirit” (Jude 1:20, NIV), which we do by reading, believing, and obeying God’s Word, in relation to the new covenant, again, more specifically, the words in red, words of the Lord. We “take every thought captive to obey Christ” (2 Cor. 10:5, ESV) which I’ve been doing to the best of my ability for the last 27 years.

Psalms 34:8, ESV Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good!

1 John 5:14, ESV This is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us.

Mark 11:24, ESV Whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.

James 4:3, ESV You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions.



Waiting is Required. Waiting is a big part of God’s “test” (**Deut. 13:3 below**). In turn, it was Eagle’s signature Scripture (**Isa. 40: 31 below**), the only so-called church the Lord ever had me call home. So it’s what I’ve been doing for the last 27 years getting ridiculed or ignored by everyone including born again Christians. While waiting is hard, boring, lonely, and annoying, God says “The testing of your faith produces perseverance. [Therefore] Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything” (**James 1:3-4, NIV**). Hard as it is, certain she’ll receive, the girl waits (**1 Pet. 5:6 below**)—as I’ve been doing. And in another song the Lord had me interpret, *King of the World*, a Broadway tune, He reveals His exasperation with us having made *Him* wait, part of which says “Let me out of here, Give me back all my dreams.”



Deuteronomy 1:3, ESV The LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Isaiah 40:31, ESV They who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

Hebrew 11:6, ESV And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

1 Peter 5:6, ESV Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you.

The Lord also tied the point about waiting and our unfaithfulness to another interpretation, *Fly Like an Eagle* by the Steve Miller Band. If you’re born again you should have no problem hearing God’s voice in it. While it has obvious Christian references, it wasn’t written as a song to prophesy of what’s been taking place. Rather, God is using it for His purposes (**Eph. 1:11**), rebuking the body of Christ for keeping Him as if locked up.

I want to fly like an eagle

They that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles (**Isa. 40:31, KJV**).

to the sea

You will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth (**Acts 1:8, KJV**)

Fly like an eagle, let my spirit carry me

You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you (**Acts 1:8, KJV**)

I want to fly like an eagle til I’m free

Christ loved the church and gave himself for her that he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish (**Eph. 5:27, KJV**)

Oh Lord, through the revolution

Be glad then, ye children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he hath given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain (**Joel 2:23, KJV**).

Feed the babies who don’t have enough to eat

Shoe the children with no shoes on their feet

House the people livin’ in the street

The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners... to comfort all who mourn, and...bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair (**Isa. 61:1-3, NIV**)

Oh Lord, there’s a solution

I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received (**Eph. 4:1, NIV**).



The song’s chorus includes the line “Flying like an eagle: to be carried in spirit”, which references Isaiah 40:31 in the King James Version of the Bible.

The song’s origins can be traced back to another song, “In The Ghetto”, which was a protest song about the US government’s treatment of Native Americans.

The Kitchen is Where You Find Food. Since Jesus is the “Master” ([John 13:13 below](#)) as well as “food” ([John 6:55, ESV](#)), He's “the head” ([Eph. 5:23 below](#)) Chef—which ties in to a culinary parable He had me write three years before giving me this *Maya* book. It was about the International Academy of Manna (IAM). In it I'd spoken of serving as His Sous Chef since He's called me to feed His sheep ([John 21:16 below](#)) with His vision ([Hab. 2:2-3 below](#)). In that parable I spoke of a great sauce I'd called 828 after [Romans 8:28](#) which says “we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose” (ESV). So in this *Maya* book the waiter, the servant, checks “in the kitchen” because that's where Chef's works, and brings the girl her food with this classic great sauce. It's like when Jesus “gave [the loaves and fish] to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people” ([Matt. 14:19, NIV](#)). Those disciples, His servants, got the food to distribute among the people from Jesus, the Head Chef, which is where I've been getting it.

[John 21:16, KJV](#) Feed my sheep.

[John 13:13, KJV](#) Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

[Ephesians 5:23, KJV](#) Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.



Expressing Genuine Gratitude. Receiving (Matt. 25:21 below), Maya is genuinely thankful (Rom. 7:25 below) if not entirely humble (Rom. 3:10 below).

Matthew 25:21, ESV [My] lord said unto [me], Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master. [That's essentially the word He gave me through the pastor the day He gave me this book, "Prophets have to wait but they'll experience joy while waiting.]

Romans 7:25, ESV Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! [My life testifies of my genuine gratitude.]

Romans 3:10, KJV There is none righteous, no, not one.

In contrast, Christians say they're thankful to God for what He did for us on the Cross, but have historically revealed by their actions that they *don't* really appreciate who He is and what He's done. So He continues to say "This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men" (Matt. 7:6, ESV). "They profess to know God, but they deny him by their works. They are detestable, disobedient, unfit for any good work" (Titus 1:16, ESV). The only good coming out of the body of Christ is because He is "faithful" even when "we are faithless" (2 Tim. 2:13, ESV). The state of the Church and world prove that the body of Christ has only produced proud spiritual hypocrites who keep themselves and others *from* knowing the Lord well or even at all. While the born again do know Him, it's more like they're just acquainted with Him. They *barely* know Him, as He's proven through these interpretations of secular resources since all born again should be able to hear His voice in them as they sing about in the song *Reason* by Unspoken. So the ONLY reason I'm doing any different is because GOD is faithful (2 Tim. 2:13). If not for His intervention, I would have kept on just like the rest of the body of Christ, *hypocritically* serving Him.

*Except from Reason by Unspoken
If we could pull back the curtain of Heaven
We would see His hand on everything
Every hour every minute every second
He's always been in it*

Prone to Wander. Again, you see that Maya is just like everyone else as she gives in to pride. It's the reason we were told to "work out...our own salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil. 2:12, ESV). Because, we all have a heart that "is deceitful above all things" (Jer. 17:9, KJV) since we won't get a new one until after this life is over. Again, God informed everyone through the Israelites saying "I will give you a new heart" (Ezek. 36:26, ESV). He obviously did not give it to them and neither has He yet given it to the born again. While Christians talk as if they've already received it, as the man does on this documentary at the 3:10 mark, [American Gospel - Movie \(youtube.com\)](http://American Gospel - Movie (youtube.com)), Christian history reveals we have not yet received it. If we had we would have obeyed the Lord.



And He's giving us **His** heart, One who "cannot be tempted with evil" (James 1:13, ESV). The born again know that "when he appears we shall be like him" (1 John 3:2, ESV). And according to Scripture, I discern He's giving *every* human being His heart because "God so loved THE WORLD" (John 3:16, ESV, my emphasis) not just hypocritical unfaithful Christians. So those who became born again during this life will get it first, at the rapture (1 Thess. 4:16-17 below) when Jesus returns. *Then* "we shall be changed" (1 Cor. 15:52, ESV). The mortals of the next age will get it either during or after that age. And those who didn't become born again will get it after the "judgment" (John 5:29, ESV) when they too have submitted to Christ (1 Cor. 15: below) so that "every knee will bow before [Him]" (Rom. 14:11, NIV).

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17, ESV The Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:22-25, ESV For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. But each in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power. [He's destroying ruler and authority, not people. The YLT says "He may have made useless all rule, and all authority and power."] For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.



The Million Dollar Question

Faced with this table setting, it's like Maya is asking *What is the meaning of life?* And Jesus says “The way is hard that leads to life, and [therefore] those who find it are few” (**Matt. 7:14, KJV**). So that when you compare His teaching to what Christians have historically taught, it totally doesn't line up at all!

For example, Christians teach that the Old Testament God was one of fire and brimstone while correctly teaching that *He doesn't change* (**Mal. 3:6**). They're being “double-minded” and God warned us that such people are “unstable in all they do” (**James 1:8, NIV**). So the body of Christ also teaches that Jesus is NOT going to forgive the majority of the people He created and either burn them alive forever or annihilate them, neither of which is loving or forgiving as He *revealed* Himself to be (**Luke 23:34 below**). If you're born again and are being honest, you should see a HUGE problem! And it's that the body of Christ has historically *not* “rightly divide[d] the word of truth” (**2 Tim. 2:15, KJV**).

Luke 23:34, ESV Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.

So the utensils represent so-called Christian denominations since we're divided by the tens of thousands as revealed to us in 2012 by Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. God knows how bad it is today! And the glasses represent other religions and philosophies people believe to make sense out life like the Athenians who wrote an “inscription [on a statue], TO THE UNKNOWN GOD” (**Acts 17:23, KJV**). The noodles represent all of humanity since “all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God” (**Rom. 3:23, KJV**). We're all wishy washy like wet noodles. And the ketchup bottle represents God's answer to our problem and to Maya's question. The blood of Jesus answers the meaning of life question because “there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved” (**Acts 4:12, NIV**). And God actually made it very clear for us to know this truth since Jesus fulfilled at least 351 Old Testament Messianic prophecies ([351 Old Testament Prophecies Fulfilled In Jesus Christ | New Testament Christians.Com](#)) and then had Peter Stoner do the math [What-are-the-Odds-of-1-Person-Fulfilling-only-8.pdf](#), which others verified [The Statistical Probability of Jesus Fulfilling the Messianic Prophecies – Theology for the People](#), revealing that it would be easier to win the lottery than to have one man fulfill just *eight* of those prophecies—and Jesus fulfilled over 300 of them! It's like God made it a no-brainer for us to know the truth. But we haven't believed Him because our hearts *are* “deceitful above all things” (**Jer. 17:9, KJV**) so that even when enlightened to the evidence most people still question it! And, according to God all religions—including Churchianity—come from Satan “the ruler of this world” (**John 12:31, YLT**). Jesus didn't come to give us a new religion. He came to make it possible for humanity to have a relationship with Him, even though we can't see Him. But eventually everyone will see Him—after the ages.

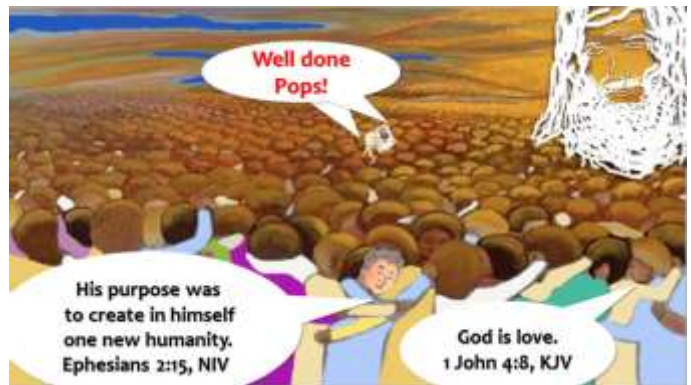
So, as we see in the story, Maya doesn't focus on the utensils but on the ketchup. Jesus shed His blood for all of humanity (**Rom 11:32 & Heb. 9:22 below**), explaining the color of the sauce. God crucified His own Son/crucified Himself, basically (**John 10:30 below**) since it was like cutting off His own right hand. "His own arm brought him salvation" (**Isa. 59:16, ESV**) because "His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity" (**Eph. 2:15, NIV**). So again, it involves everyone, not just rebellious born again Christian hypocrites. "For even as in Adam all die, so also in the Christ **all shall be made alive**" (**1 Cor. 15:22, YLT**)—just not at the same time. Some at the end of this age. Some by the end of the next age. And the rest by the end of the last age which I've called the Age of Judgment since they'll rise "to the resurrection of judgment" (**John 5:29, ESV**) not *damnation or condemnation* as most translations say.

Romans 11:32, NIV God has bound everyone over to disobedience so that he may have mercy on them all.

Hebrews 9:22, ESV Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.

John 10:30, KJV I and my Father are one

Unlike the norm, having been further enlightened by the Lord, my understanding of what God has done for humanity through Christ varies greatly from the typical Christian. Here it is in a nutshell. God came up with a plan to create a world, a kingdom, a Family, like Him, in other words like Christ, by our own free will. The only other option would have been to create robots, but He wanted something better than that. And because He informed the angels that humans would one day rule over them (**1 Cor. 6:3 below**), Satan along with some others rebelled so that God cast them down to earth (**Rev. 12:7-9 below**). He also allowed them to do everything they've been doing which includes "deceiv[ing] the nations" (**Rev. 20:3, KJV**) because He wants us to see our desperate need for Christ, for His heart rather than ours which is "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (**Jer. 17:9, KJV**). Because, not only did He make it a no-brainer for us to know that ONLY Jesus represents Him, all we had to do to have "in earth as it is in heaven" (**Matt. 6:10, ESV**) was "submit...to God. Resist the devil, and he [would have had to] flee" (**James 4:27, ESV**). As we were informed, "the LORD your God is testing you, to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul" (**Deut. 10:10, ESV**). And the body of Christ has PROVEN BEYOND A DOUBT that we haven't loved Him—not even close! Since He stands outside of time, He immediately saw everything everyone would do and worked it all into His plan/His Vision since He "works all things according to the counsel of his will" (**Eph. 1:11, ESV**). Having worked it all out for His purposes and our good, by the end of the ages everyone He created *will* admit the truth about themselves, that we *are* "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (**Jer. 17:9, KJV**). Everyone will also see and admit the truth about Jesus, that "there is salvation in no one else" (**Acts 4:12, ESV**). At some point every human being will appreciate what Jesus did for them so that it's as He says, "Every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God" (**Rom. 14:11, ESV**). They're not going to do it under compulsion but eagerly out of their own free will. So that in the end God will have His "new humanity" (**Eph. 2:15, NIV**) forming a loving kingdom since "God is love" (**1 John 4:8, ESV**), as someone summed up on this graphic which I tweaked.



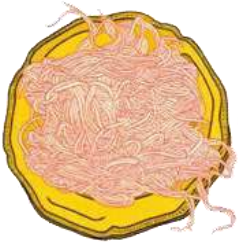
1 Corinthians 6:3, ESV Do you not know that we are to judge angels?

Revelation 12:7-9, ESV War arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, ⁸but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. ⁹And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

And only born again Christians could have discerned God's plan and Satan's lies in the Bible since "the person without the Spirit...cannot understand" (**1 Cor. 2:14, ESV**). But, as a whole, we didn't for not having taken Him as seriously as we should have, picking and choosing what to believe and obey out of the Lord's teaching, starting with Peter in his dealings with Ananias and Sapphira thereby *proving* God's point that our hearts *are* "deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked" (**Jer. 17:9, ESV**) even when we're born again.

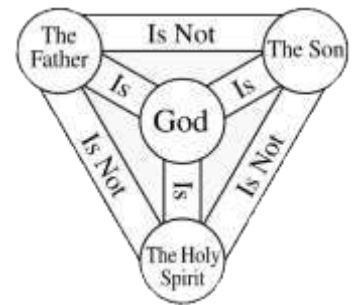
A Mess of Noodles.

While the noodles represent all of humanity since “God so loved the world” ([John 3:16, ESV](#)), focusing on “the present evil age” ([Gal. 1:4, ESV](#)) they only represent the elect, “vessels of mercy, which he has prepared beforehand for glory” ([Rom. 9:23, ESV](#)). And they’re already covered with sauce since in God’s eyes His plan has already been fulfilled as Jesus said, “It is finished” ([John 19:30, ESV](#)). But since we’re stuck in time, *we* haven’t walked through it all yet. So Maya dumps sauce on em. He says, “**You** must be born again” ([John 3:7, ESV, my emphasis](#)) and “work out **your own** salvation” ([Phil. 2:12, ESV, my emphasis](#)).



And the lost elect, don’t *know* the answer to the question—like Maya in the book—because it’s as the Eunuch told Philip, “How can I [understand], except some man should guide me?” ([Acts 8:30-31, KJV](#)). That’s the system God set up, that the enlightened ones would inform the unenlightened ones. That’s the Great Commission, God’s working orders for the body of Christ having said “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” ([Matt. 28:19-20, KJV](#)). Enlightened elect, the born again, should have been willing, like Paul, to “endure all things for the elect’s sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ” ([2 Tim. 2:10, KJV](#)). But instead, most have historically continued to live for themselves making it seem to the lost as if God’s not real or not represented by Jesus. Or, that He doesn’t really mean what He says, as if it’s OK to pick and choose what to believe and obey out of the Bible even though they say it isn’t. We’ve historically been outrageous hypocrites.

On top of that, we’ve *made up* all sorts of lies—traditions of men—treating them as if they represent the truth. As with the teaching that God is a trinity, which isn’t taught in the Bible. So when you look up the trinity online this diagram comes up. The so-called Church “fathers” came up with the concept *hundreds* of years after Jesus walked the earth. It’s a lie since Jesus says “I and my Father are one” ([John 10:30, ESV](#)), yet this doctrine teaches that the Father is *not* the Son and, therefore, that Jesus was wrong in saying what He said! And He also said it this way, “Whoever has seen me has seen the Father” ([John 14:9, ESV](#)). We can’t have it both ways. Either we’ll believe this man-made doctrine *or* what Jesus said. The Friend of Sinners

The King’s attitude in the book reflects what our King, Jesus, is doing: pretending that He doesn’t know what’s going on, what needs to be done, and that He doesn’t even care, even though He’s overseeing the whole thing. He says “When you did these things and I kept silent, you thought I was exactly like you. But I now arraign you and set my accusations before you” ([Ps. 50:21, NIV](#))—which He’s doing through this ministry. It’s like when Jesus asked “Philip, “Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?”...[when] he already had in mind what he was going to do” ([John 6:5-6, KJV](#)). He also says “For a brief moment I abandoned you, but with deep compassion I will bring you back” ([Isa. 54:7, NIV](#)). He’s been testing our faith to prove to us that we *are* “deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked” ([Jer. 17:9, KJV](#)). When the body of Christ finally admits it, He’ll draw us back with deep compassion giving us the “latter rain” “downpour” ([Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT](#)). And as you can see by His eyeball and the look on His face—and the fact that He gave His life for us!—the Lord is actually *eager* to see His subjects do what needs doing—slosh on that classic red sauce. He says “I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth” ([3 John 1:4, KJV](#)). “If [you] walk in the light...[you will] have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus [that classic sauce]...[will] cleanse...[you] from all sin” ([1 John 1:7, KJV](#)). So Maya sloshes it on. And you can see that it’s what I do with all the red references in my material as I take my thoughts captive to Christ ([2 Cor. 10:5](#)).



God Doesn't Change. The king telling Maya “There is no pasta fork” refers to the fact that God hasn't changed (**Mal. 3:6 below**). So He says “Eat it the way you're used to,” not the way Churchianity is doing, but the way we've been taught in the “new covenant” (**Luke 22:20, ESV**). We've been told to diligently study the Scriptures (**2 Tim. 2:15 below**) then interpret them according to the Lord's teachings since “truth came through Jesus Christ” (**John 1:17, ESV**). That's how we “rightly divide it” (**2 Tim 2:15 below**). So I study the Scriptures and I study the material of those who've studied the Scriptures “test[ing] everything; hold[ing] fast what is good” (**1 Thess. 5:21, ESV**). In other words, tak[ing] every thought captive to obey Christ” (**2 Cor. 10:5, ESV**). If it lines up with the things Jesus taught, then it's good. If not, it's not good. It's NOT coming from God. So in the book, rather than Maya becoming like them, they end up becoming like Maya—and that's prophetic because “the Bride [will have] made herself ready” (**Rev. 19:7, ESV**) before the Lord returns.



Malachi 3:6, ESV I the LORD do not change.

2 Timothy 2:15, YLT Be diligent to present thyself approved to God—a workman irreproachable, rightly dividing the word of the truth.

Loving God—Food—Offends Sinners

These pictures of Maya eating is what all born again Christians should be doing, “examining the Scriptures” like good Bereans (**Acts 17:11, ESV**), “delight[ing] in the Lord” (**Ps. 37:4, KJV**), “study[ing] them] to shew [ourselves] approved unto God...workm[e]n that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth” (**2 Tim. 2:15, KJV**), and “be[ing] filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding” (**Col. 1:9, ESV**), even though digging in and porking out offends people as Jesus warned us. He said “People [will] insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me” (**Matt. 5:11, NIV**). And the worst persecution—the one that's been keeping the body of Christ from maturing—has been coming from the body of Christ because born again Christians have gotten proud for knowing the truth that Jesus is God. So rather than welcome me as they should have been doing (**Rom. 16:2 below**), they've done like they initially do to Maya in the book, as He warned me they would when He informed me of this aspect of my calling in the late 1980s. “You shall speak all these words to them, but they will not listen to you. You shall call to them, but they will not answer you” (**Jer. 7:27, ESV**). At least not until His “appointed time” (**Hab. 2:3, KJV**).

Sinners Love Conformity

Deceived by their own wicked hearts ([Jer. 17:9](#)) and Satan's lies, the masses want everyone to be like them so that they feel good about themselves. Except "broad is the road that leads to destruction [so that] many enter through it" ([Matt. 7:13, NIV](#)). So when God finally opens up this ministry, the expression on that dog's face ([Mark 1:22 below](#)) will be on the face of the born again, people who've been behaving like dogs to one degree or another.

[Mark 1:22, KJV](#) They were astonished.

Condemning the Guiltless. The queen, who represents the body of Christ, "the Lamb's wife" ([Rev. 21:9, KJV](#)), rebukes Maya, me, saying no one has ever eaten that way, not even in the "wilds" of the kingdom, meaning, the wilderness. It's what the born again who have spoken to me, have done—rebuked me for porking out on the "food" ([John 6:55, ESV](#)). However, it's *exactly* what happens in the wilderness as Jesus modeled for us in the following account:

Jesus being full of the Holy [Spirit]...was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, Being forty days tempted of the devil...[and He defeated him with God's Word so that] when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season ([Luke 4:1-13, KJV](#)).

Jesus, along with the saints described in [Hebrews 11](#) (below) reveal that it's *all* about these so-called "bad manners" God's people have had in the wilderness, which also got them in trouble with unbelievers and those who *professed* to know Him. All who've honored God have known His Word well—as in pork out on the "food" ([John 6:55, ESV](#)).

In fact, these so-called "bad manners" are *needed* since Satan knows the Bible better than anyone (excluding Christ). And in these last of the last days, we should know the Bible better than those before us since we've had 2000 years of born again Christians studying it and helping us understand it through their writings, pod casts, and videos.

[Hebrews 11:29-35, KJV](#) By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry land...By faith the walls of Jericho fell down...By faith the harlot Rahab perished not...the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets: Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions...not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection.

NOTE: All of the people mentioned in [Hebrews 11](#) had faith in God. However, at times they were misled by Satan since they weren't born again and you need God's Spirit inside of you to have clear discernment since "the person without the Spirit...cannot understand" ([1 Cor. 2:14, NIV](#)). They understood as much as God enabled them to understand while *working it all out for His purposes* ([Eph. 1:11](#)).



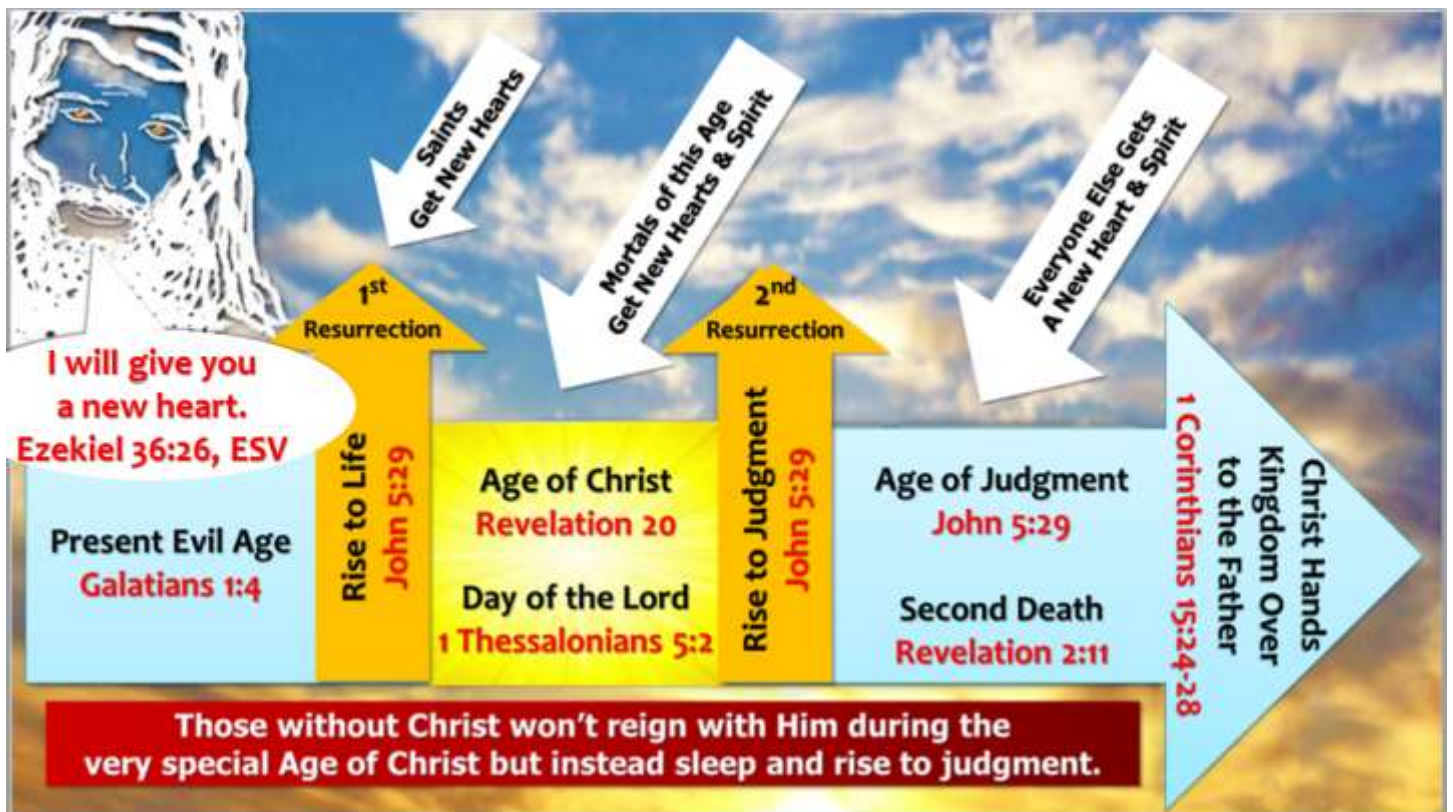
It's because the body of Christ hasn't porked out on the "food" ([John 6:55, ESV](#)) like Maya—which represents "the Word of God" ([Rev. 19:13, ESV](#)) and the Lord who is "the truth" ([John 14:6, ESV](#))—that the queen/the body of Christ condemns the guiltless. The body of Christ is walking in cognitive dissonance as someone summed up with this graphic which I tweaked. Like the lost, the born again love their opinions more than the Lord, who is the "food" ([John 6:55, ESV](#)) and "the truth" ([John 14:6, ESV](#))—for the most part. They've been eating tons of lies mixed in with the truth refusing to listen when He's approached them to further enlighten them—at least through me. In turn, they've swallowed an image of God that contradicts Who He *revealed* Himself to be.



So you see videos like this one ([Next time they say "God is evil", say THIS | John Lennox](#)) all over YouTube and the argument is echoed all around the world. The lost say that God is evil because He allows so much suffering and the Christian response to that has *not* been founded on sound doctrine—and is totally inadequate. It doesn't even make sense! While "God is love" ([1 John 4:8, ESV](#)), He's going to either torture or annihilate most of the people He created!? If that was the truth, then God would be extremely evil, even more evil than Satan who only has a short time to hurt humanity ([Rev. 12:12 below](#)). If the body of Christ had taken Jesus seriously most of us would be able to easily explain what God has done and why He's done it, as I already summed up. The doctrine of hell makes Jesus out to be very *unforgiving*, the exact opposite of what He revealed on the Cross! And part of the problem is that Christians have focused only mostly on this age, then comes hell. But there's the next age and then the judgment



[Revelation 12:12, ESV](#) Woe to you, O earth and sea, for the devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!



Jailed for Christ. When the Lord gave me this *Maya* book He'd had me working on a book which I thought was for publication, to sell at cost. So the night before God provided it I'd shown my daughter a huge binder with all the pictures I was using—mostly line drawings of other people's artwork, tracings I'd made since I'm no artist. She'd nodded, chuckled, and said, "You're going to jail!" (A publisher had told me this was legal, except my daughter didn't know that.)

And since unbelievers are antichrist and all professing Christians have rejected me, I might as well *be* in jail. It's like I'm under house arrest stuck here in my room working for the Lord, alone, unpaid, day after day, year after year, decade after decade. So the Lord backed me up with the interpretation for *Hotel California*. One day many born again souls will be *prisoners here of their own device*, choosing to take the heat for the Lord rather than live for Satan's world.



One Day Things WILL Change

The time is coming when the the body of Christ will do like the queen in the book and ask Maya/me questions, earnestly listening to what I'm saying as He informed me they would at His "appointed time" (**Hab. 2:2-3 below**). And those people will hear God's voice and "run" with it. Like John the Baptist, I have "gr[own], and waxed strong in spirit, and [have been] in the deserts [aka the wilderness/the wilds/alone] till the day of [my] shewing" (**Luke 1:80, KJV**) to the body of Christ. [Having informed me through others that He was giving me "a Joseph Experience" ties in. A Joseph Experience, speaking of Joseph of the Old Testament, is very much a Wilderness Experience, like a Twilight Zone experience as everyone turns against you when you've really done nothing wrong.] Taking God seriously the body of Christ will hear "a voice out of the cloud" (**Matt. 17:5, KJV**) through my videos, meaning, from heaven, the place through which data travels from one computer to another. Like many heard 2000 years ago, they'll hear "This is my [child], whom I love; with h[er] I am well pleased. Listen to h[er]!" (**Matt. 17:5, KJV**), except it's really still Listen to Him! since He's the Truth. They'll finally do what Paul told them to do concerning another woman in Christ, "Welcome her in the Lord in a way worthy of the saints, and help her in whatever she may need from you" (**Rom. 16:2, ESV**). We'll finally function how the Lord meant for us to function, "submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ" (**Eph. 5:21, ESV**).

Habakkuk 2:2-3, KJV The LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time.



Learning Manners. Maya explains to the queen that her parents taught her manners in the same way that my heavenly Father taught me my manners—the manner in which to follow the Lord, which is by porking out on Him since He’s “food” (John 6:55, ESV). And not porking out on Him leaves us wide open to Satan’s schemes since he’s “the ruler of this world” (John 12:31, YLT) as well as a “liar” and “a murderer” (John 8:44, ESV) who “deceives the nations” (Rev. 20:3, KJV), having set out to “be like the most High” (Isa. 14:14, KJV) by “masquerad[ing] as an angel of light” (2 Cor. 11:14, NIV).



For Heaven’s Sake. It’s “for heaven’s sake” that I eat like a pig since “there will be...joy in heaven over one sinner who repents” (Luke 15:7, ESV)—and that’s the goal of the ministry God has given all of us having called us to “make disciples” (Matt. 28:20, ESV). Repenting and just becoming a born again believer isn’t good enough because “the devils also believe” (James 2:19, KJV). God enlightened and empowered us to do better than devils! And many will repent and become disciples because of this ministry which is a combination of many ministries.

Food Tasting Better. “Food” (John 6:55, ESV), the Lord/Jesus, “the truth” (John 14:6, ESV) tastes better/is more appealing when you pork out on it/Him because that’s how you really get to know Him. If you don’t pork out on God’s Word—which is a combination of believing Him, living it out, and praying His word—you won’t be satisfied because it’s like the difference between having an acquaintance as compared to a good friend. Acquaintances hardly know you and you hardly know them. It’s mostly chit chat or awkward conversation which isn’t all that enjoyable. In fact, it’s more enjoyable to do without it. And that is how it is. Most born again Christians have barely gotten to know the Lord so that they’ve decided to live their lives without Him—until those moments when they’re in need of help. They use Him. And **no one** likes being used.

Paying Attention. Having actually *listened* to what the girl had to say, the queen, the body of Christ, engages Her brain (2 Cor. 10:5 below) and decides to take up the challenge (Mal. 3:10 below).

2 Corinthians 10:5, NIV We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Malachi 3:10, NIV “Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty.

The Overweight Love Food. The queen, the born again, will finally listen because, as you can tell from the looks of her, she really does love Food. You can tell that the queen has done more than just “taste [to] see that the LORD is good” (Ps. 34:8, ESV) which is true of the born again. They tasted enough that they became born again. But then they started eating all the junk food false doctrines we’ve historically been fed and got off track.



The King's Soul Mate. Everyone invited, the body of Christ, has to listen to the queen since She represents Her Husband, the King (Eph. 5:23; 2 Cor. 5:20 below)—especially when She walks in the truth (John 8:32 below).

Ephesians 5:23, KJV For the husband is the head of the wife.

2 Corinthians 5:20, NIV We [the body of Christ] are...Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. [If this is true concerning our address to the lost, it's all the more true as we address one another! We're supposed to "submit to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Eph. 5:21, NIV)—and it's *not* what we're doing!]

John 8:32, ESV The truth will set you free.



Making a Mess

We'll be making a mess because we've got a ton of changes to make to fix the mess we've made and nobody likes to admit they're wrong *and* they don't like change, so that even those who do change, start off against you, like it was for Jesus whose "own brothers did not believe in him" (John 7:5, NIV).

Getting the Boot. Making the necessary changes, those dogs will get booted from God's kingdom, which is represented by His table (Jude 1:12 & Ezek. 34:10 below), as will whoever feeds them (1 Cor. 5:5 & Rev. 2:5 below). Notice, the queen doesn't. Notice also that the Catholic/Nun isn't there.

Jude 1:12, NIV These people [the dogs] are blemishes at your love feasts, eating with you without the slightest qualm—shepherds who feed only themselves. They are clouds without rain, blown along by the wind; autumn trees, without fruit and uprooted—twice dead.

Ezekiel 34:10, ESV Thus says the Lord GOD, Behold, I am against the shepherds, and I will require my sheep at their hand and put a stop to their feeding the sheep. No longer shall the shepherds feed themselves. I will rescue my sheep from their mouths, that they may not be food for them.

1 Corinthians 5:5, NIV Hand this man over to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved on the day of the Lord.

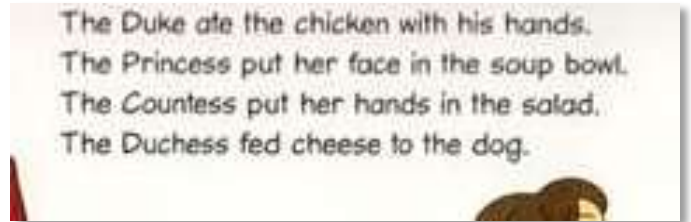
Revelation 2:5, NIV Consider how far you have fallen! [Born again Christians] Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.



Kingdom Subjects Suffer.

Everyone named is part of the court representing the body of Christ. The New Testament says “the Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him” (Rom. 8:16-17, ESV). Yet today’s version of Christianity—

Churchianity—has deleted suffering, especially in the U.S.—when it’s through the suffering that we build our fellowship with Christ (Phil. 3:8-11 below). On my walk with the Lord, He’s repeatedly shown me that today’s born again have no problem openly admitting that they won’t do something they know He wants them to do because it will cause some sort of friction with others. However, fellowship with Jesus is all about being willing to suffer, even to the point of death. He says “Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life” (Rev. 2:10, ESV). And “one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much” (Luke 16:10, ESV), which is the body of Christ, dishonest in much.



Philippians 3:8-11, ESV Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and **may share his sufferings**, becoming like him in his death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

Philippians 3:8-11, YLT Yes, indeed, and I count all things to be loss, because of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, because of whom of the all things I suffered loss, and do count them to be refuse, that Christ I may gain, and be found in him, not having my righteousness, which [is] of law, but that which [is] through faith of Christ—the righteousness that is of God by the faith, to know him, and the power of his rising again, and **the fellowship of his sufferings**, being conformed to his death, if anyhow I may attain to the rising again of the dead.

According to the new covenant, if you’re not regularly suffering because of your obedience to Christ, it’s highly questionable that you’re actually a child of God. Just because we *claim* to be a Christian doesn’t make us one. And even if you have the foundation of Christ, not building on it biblically, you’ll suffer loss and end up getting “saved; yet so as by fire” (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV).



¹¹ For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
¹² Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;
¹³ Every man’s work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man’s work of what sort it is.
¹⁴ If any man’s work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.
¹⁵ If any man’s work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.
1 Corinthians 3:11-15, KJV

This passage, in verses 11-12, makes it clear that it’s speaking of the born again, people who had the foundation of Christ.

Kingdom Subjects Differ. While they all eat off the King’s table since “salvation is found in no one else” ([Acts 4:12, NIV](#)), they each eat different things for being a different part of the body, “created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in” ([Eph. 2:10, KJV](#)). Yet most born again today have no clue as to what the good works are which God ordained for them to do! And it’s not as if we can *assume* what those are. God has to tell us, which He does when we’re paying attention as an obedient follower of Christ. He speaks to us about it through His Word and through other people, anything in the world around us. So this graphic sums up how the Lord has been pointing me in the same direction since I was a child starting a few months after I was told that God had created everything and everyone and that you could work for Him, so that I’d had the thought that I wanted to do that when I was grown up—which is what I’ve been doing.

The Duke ate the chicken with his hands.
 The Princess put her face in the soup bowl.
 The Countess put her hands in the salad.
 The Duchess fed cheese to the dog.

Some of the Times God Spoke About My Calling and Confirmed It

- 1969 When I was five God gave me a series of nightmares of the **Joseph Experience**.
- 1976 God had my mom (an unbeliever) plant a seed of it being a spiritual thing going on.
- 1988 God had a homeless man grab my arm and prophesy about this calling.
- 1988 God gave me a vision about this calling—of communicating to a sea of people.
- 1992 At a lecture I attended God had Alex Haley speak of being called as the writer in the Family.
- 1998 God had Ed Rice prophesy over me concerning the extensive growth that would take place, while he and the “pastors” lay hands on me and prayed.
- 1998 God had Kerry Bowman preach about getting pruned extensively like a bonsai.
- 1998 God had Stuart McAllister prophesy about how it would feel—as if He hates my guts.
- 1998 God had Delana Bradbury prophesy over me about plugging the hole in the cup (of salvation).
- 1998 God had a man named Jared prophesy over me singing with his harp.
- 1998 God had Angela Marshall tell me I’m a prophet.
- 2000 God had Matt Miller prophesy over me about it being a **Joseph Experience**.
- 2000 God had a sermon on **Joseph’s experience** the next day confirming that prophecy.
- 2010 God gives me my first full interpretation of a secular resource tying in to the **Joseph Experience**.
- 2011 God had a talk show speak of decades passing between the time of prophecy and fulfillment.
- 2012 God had a pastor in Largo Maryland prophesy that there would be joy while waiting, then God gave me a book a few hours later revealing what He meant, tying in to the **Joseph Experience**.
- 2012 onward God has provided many resources backing up the calling tied to **Joseph’s Experience** and joy while waiting since Joseph experienced extreme isolation and estrangement for many years.

In the same way that there’s a Duke, Princess, Countess, and Duchess in the story, the body of Christ is made up of royalty since we are “children” ([John 13:33, ESV](#)) of the “king” ([Rev. 19:16, ESV](#)) and a “royal priesthood” ([1 Pet. 2:9, NIV](#)). “And God has appointed in the church first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, helping, administrating, and various kinds of tongues...[and He says] earnestly desire the higher gifts” ([1 Cor. 12:27-31, ESV](#)). The highest gift is prophecy because “the one who prophesies edifies the church” ([1 Cor. 14:4, KJV](#)). The more faithful we are to Him, the more God enlightens and empowers us, part of which includes giving us a prophetic edge.

Queen of the King’s Table. The queen is the biggest pig of all because that’s what it means to be queen at something. The porky lady is Queen of “the Word...made flesh” ([John 1:14, KJV](#)) though she hasn’t been acting like it. So She *learns* to love that red sauce ([Rom. 8:28 below](#)) finally willing to take the bad with the good ([Job 2:10 & Phil 4:11 below](#)).

[Romans 8:28, ESV](#) We know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

[Job 2:10, KJV](#) What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil?

[Philippians 4:11, NIV](#) I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances.



A Servant Like Christ. “Out[doing] them all” also speaks of out serving everyone. The porky lady is the Queen of queens since—in God’s eyes—She’s already married to the “King of kings” (1 Tim. 6:15, ESV), and has therefore, been called to serve the people just like Jesus “did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many” (Mark 10:45, NIV). God says “He that is greatest among you shall be your servant” (Matt. 23:11, KJV). And the queen, the body of Christ, is the greatest among humanity because She’s the only One who has been enlightened to the truth that Jesus is God. “To you [the queen] it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of heaven, but to them [the lost] it has not been given” (Matt. 13:11, ESV). She should, therefore, *reflect* the love and service of Christ. Rather than promoting *Herself* with buildings, banners, platforms, power, titles, and money—as the body of Christ has been doing in increasing measure over the last 2000 years. She’ll draw attention to Jesus, “the truth” (John 14:6, ESV) by Her *service*. Her willingness to give Her all, like Her husband, the King, who also porked out “continu[ing] all night in prayer to God [the Father]” (Luke 6:12, KJV), for instance, besides being willing to die for His friends. But today’s born again rebuke us when we give Him our all. That’s my testimony.

Good Food Satisfies

Eating as God meant for the body of Christ, the Queen will finally *feel* satisfied and stop living off junk food. Jesus says “Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for *they* shall be filled” (Matt. 5:6, KJV, my emphasis). And when She finally porks out She’ll get enlightened to the lies She’s been believing, as with the false doctrine of hell. Understanding that God is “hav[ing] mercy on all” (Rom. 11:32, ESV) tastes a WHOLE LOT BETTER than thinking He’s going to be burning most people alive forever or annihilating them!

The Kingdom. The Queen’s kingdom is the King’s kingdom, commonly called Christianity. Having found satisfaction, the Queen declares that from now on—when God opens up this ministry at His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV)—everyone in His court (the born again) will start porking out on His Word like I do, “but only on holidays,” which means holy days which actually refers to *every* day because “this is the day that the LORD has made” (Ps. 118:24, ESV). “This” day is *every* day. While Christians argue whether the Sabbath is Saturday or Sunday, it’s clearly Saturday. But we’re *not* under the Old Testament Law of Moses since “truth came through Jesus Christ” (John 1:17, ESV). Every day is holy so that we are to “exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none...may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin” (Heb. 3:13, ESV). Not having paid attention, the body of Christ *has* been hardened with sin (to the point of being cold as ice!). He also says “Do not let anyone judge you by...a Sabbath day” (Col. 2:16, NIV). “Whoever has entered God’s rest has also rested from his works as God did from his” (Heb. 4:10, ESV). No born again Christian is a Christian only on one day of the week but every day. Yet we’re so “deceitful, and...wicked” (Jer. 17:9, KJV) that we reduced it to about one *hour* a week! When “the Jews were persecuting Jesus, because he was doing these things on the Sabbath...Jesus answered them, “My Father is working until now, and I am working” (Matt. 5:16-17, ESV). Likewise, we are to be doing God’s work *every* day because our Sabbath rest is not until Day 7 of God’s prophetic timeline. It’s not Saturday or Sunday under the “new covenant” (Luke 22:20, ESV). It’s the next *age*, the millennial reign of Christ as clearly visible on this graphic which I adapted from the Messiah 2030 YouTube channel.



A Great Meal Ends with Dessert

Grateful to Maya for having showed her how to really enjoy her food, the queen asks her what she can do for her, and the girl wants dessert. And having lived where they made *Land O' Lakes* ice cream—a city named after a VIP, St. Paul—I developed a taste for it. And in the first draft of the book the Lord had me write which I thought was for publication, in the culinary section, amazed at all God was showing me, I'd written, "Wow! I wonder what we get for dessert!" Then, a bit later while at Chincoteague, the name of the ice cream shop, *The Creamery*, struck a chord since I'd been *getting creamed* for the Lord at the time ([John 15:20](#) below). The Spirit then also reminded me how Jesus had "made a whip out of cords, and drove all from the temple courts" ([John 2:15](#), NIV). Knowing the Scriptures and how much the Lord loves to play with words being that He's the "one who understands riddles" ([Dan. 8:23](#), ESV) and speaks "in parables" ([Matt. 13:13](#), ESV)—I made some connections. In the late 1990s God used two songs—along with a bunch of other stuff—to tell me that He would be using my testimony and this ministry to finally melt His people's hearts which have been super "hardened by the deceitfulness of sin" ([Heb. 3:13](#), ESV) so that the typical response from born again Christians when another professing Christian says something that contradicts their opinion is hostile, just like the lost. The first song that came to mind was by Timothy James Meaney, something about bringing us to our knees, and the other one was by Chris Rice, *Live by Faith*, which says:

*Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe
And blessed are the hands that keep givin'
but never receive
Blessed is the heart that gets broken
but keeps holdin' on...
that's what it means to live by faith...*

It's what I've been doing these 27 years since He says, for instance, "Anyone who loves their son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me" ([Matt. 10:37](#), NIV). As all born again know, but ignore, the Lord expects us to love Him **above all**. That's the greatest commandment ([Mark 12:30](#)). It's not because He's proud. It's because it makes sense since He's our "Maker" ([Isa. 54:5](#), ESV) and the *only* One who can protect us from "the ruler of this world" ([John 12:31](#), YLT), Satan, who is "a liar" and "a [mass] murderer" ([John 8:44](#), ESV).

[John 15:20](#), ESV Remember the word that I said to you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they keep my word, they will also keep yours.



Connecting all the dots “walk[ing] in the Spirit” (Gal. 5:16, KJV), I realized that our dessert would be ice cream, meaning, that God will be melting/softening the born again’s stone cold hearts and whipping them into shape. Since we’re under the new covenant of grace, that whip is of a different sort. But it will make those who get convicted ‘scream’ in their inner being as they realize how cold they’ve been to Lord they profess to know and love. They’ll finally experience “godly sorrow” (2 Cor. 7:10, ESV). While the born again already have salvation, what that passage is speaking about, we were supposed to be “produc[ing] fruit in keeping with repentance” (Matt. 3:8, NIV). So that’s God’s purpose with this ministry at His “appointed time” (Hab. 2:3, KJV), to convict the body of Christ in the same manner Peter was convicted when he heard the rooster crow and “wept bitterly” (Matt. 26:75, ESV).



So three years after the Creamery vision, giving me the *Maya* book, the Lord confirmed what I’d discerned about our desert by having the culinary guys dressed in white bring in three monstrous platters of ice cream. They’re dressed in white representing the two groups who honor/will honor the Lord: angels (Acts 1:10 & Mark 16:5 below) and the resurrected saints (Rev. 19:7-8 below), people who’ve been called to “feed [His] sheep” (John 20:17, ESV).



Acts 1:10, ESV While they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes.

Mark 16:5, ESV And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed.

Revelation 19:7-8, ESV for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure.”

God’s Sense of Humor.

One of the things God revealed through Jesus 2000 years ago was that He was not at all as the Jews had pictured Him. And it’s the same today with the body of Christ having ignored Him that the hired hands don’t care for the sheep (John 10:13). We’ve been brainwashed to envision Him as someone who sends people to eternal hell. Yet He revealed Himself to be the most down to earth person we would ever want to know. And down to earth people

have a sense of humor—not getting offended easily. And through this ministry the Lord is helping us see Him as He really is: *very* down to earth. So in the late 1990s He gave me a food timeline. I don’t remember how exactly but I must have been thinking about Food since that’s what I do spiritually and literally. However, as I was editing this book (years after my last edit), I see the first half of it slightly differently having since been enlightened to Satan’s hand in the Bible.

His Story—It’s ALL About FOOD (John 6:55)



The Law: Since “truth came through Jesus Christ” (John 1:17, ESV), God didn’t give us the Law of Moses. The Israelites “received the law as delivered by angels” (Acts 7:53, ESV) who *had* to be fallen angels, which is why the Old Testament law is like broccoli rather than “the law of Christ” (Gal. 6:2, ESV) who is represented by ice cream. Unlike the Old Testament law, “the law of Christ” (Gal. 6:2, ESV) is smooth and cool like ice cream since it’s a law of love, “love the Lord...love your neighbor” (Mark 12:30-31, ESV). And when you understand what He did for all of us, it’s NOT so hard to do! It goes down super smooth! And that’s part of the problem, the born again *haven’t* understood it. So the preach broccoli.

The Prophets: The second part of my timeline is mashed potatoes representing the prophets since they get creamed for the Lord (**Matt. 5:12 below**). Jesus said “I send you prophets” (**Matt. 23:34, ESV**). The Concordant literal translation puts it like this, “I am dispatching to you prophets.” It’s like He meant starting now and moving into the future since it was Satan who sent the Old Testament prophets since Jesus made him “the ruler of this world” (**John 12:31, YLT**) giving him “all authority” which he could “give...to anyone” he’s wanted to give it to (**Luke 4:6, NIV below**). So while those men were appointed and sent by Satan, the Lord has been “work[ing] out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will” (**Eph. 1:11, ESV**). In other words, He let Satan run the show for these 6000 years while He’s been taking it all—Satan’s garbage along with all of our garbage—and worked it all out for His purposes which is also for our good—in the end (after the ages). Glory to God! And He was also present in the days of the Old Testament speaking to the prophets too. They just couldn’t tell the difference between His voice and Satan’s voice since you have to have God’s Spirit inside of you at all times to do it (**1 Cor. 2::14 below**) and “truth came through Jesus Christ” (**John 1:17, ESV**).

Matthew 5:12, ESV Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Luke 4:6, NIV [Satan said to Jesus for our hearing] “I will give you all their authority and splendor; it has been given to me, and I can give it to anyone I want to. [Unless you are doing the work specifically given to you by Jesus Christ, you are more than likely doing the work Satan gave you to do. Even if it’s good works, Satan’s using it to deceive and distract.]

1 Corinthians 2:14, NIV The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because they are discerned only through the Spirit.

The Temple Building: The third item on my timeline is steak because of all of the sacrifices which are foundational in the Old Testament law of Moses/of Satan. The temple building is highly associated with death since “the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil” (**Heb. 2:14, ESV**). This graphic with Solomon should get the point across since God is not double-minded and He gave the born again the job of “rightly dividing the word of truth” (**2 Tim. 2:14, YLT**) as in *separating* the voice of Satan from the voice of the Lord. Except we didn’t. So rather than being set free, we’ve remained enslaved to Satan’s lies. Not all, but most. We were also told to “take every thought captive to make it obedient to Christ” (**2 Cor. 10:5, ESV**). Had we done that, we would have questioned what was being taught by those so-called pastors and been delivered centuries ago! But God knew this is how it would play out. And He let it play out this way to help us see what we’re really like, how much we desperately need Him and, therefore, *finally* GENUINELY appreciate what He did for us.

Ephesians 1:11, ESV In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will,



Prophetic Waiters.

The color of the waiter and ice cream fades the further we move back so that the meaning of our dessert is that God’s presence will be increasingly magnified as we move forward, both individually and as a group. He says “Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded” (James 4:8, ESV). It’s time the body of Christ paid attention. God also says “[I] will give the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the later rain, that you may gather in your grain and your wine and your oil” (Deut. 11:14, KJV), talking about a harvest of souls. He says “They waited for me as for the rain, and they opened their mouths as for the spring rain” (Job 29:23, KJV). Christians haven’t done that because the way you open wide for the Lord is by obeying Him. But, since He’s faithful even when we’re not (2 Tim. 2:13), and has foretold of a “latter rain” “outpouring” (Joel 2:23, ESV & CLT) and of *His Bride having made Herself ready* (Rev. 19:7) by becoming “holy and without blemish” (Eph. 5:27, ESV), we know this is a prophetic message.



And going back to the timeline I’d made years before, I had Jesus as a combination of ice cream, whip cream, and the cherry on top, which speaks of the icing on the cake—the best saved for last. So, as we see in the picture, the piles of ice cream get bigger and there are more and more cherries; more of Jesus’ presence and power moving forward until we are literally standing before Him.



The Culinary Guys’ Shoes.

In 1998, the first time God had me make prayer crafts (helping me be faithful in praying for His mean and unfaithful people), I made hundreds of pasta angel crafts praying for everyone for months as I made them. And instead of painting them gold like the ones I’d received (which gave me the idea), I painted them different skin tones with different colored robes—like the different colored shoes on the culinary guys. The point is that “in every nation anyone who fears [God] and does what is right is acceptable to him” (Acts 10:35, ESV). And for many reasons—covered throughout my material—I appreciate God’s view of our racist attitudes. Instead of getting better and becoming more loving, we keep getting worse! But if we want to be part of God’s Family and “receive a full reward” (2 John 1:8, KJV) we need to start doing as He told us to do: become “born again” (John 3:7, ESV) and “Love one another deeply, from the heart” (1 Pet. 1:22, NIV). (While angels are typically pictured as white blonds, my father worked at the United Nations in New York so that my dolls represented different skin tones, which naturally came out in my angel decorations.)



Home is Where the Heart Is

Maya insists on getting home. Likewise, I'm dying to get Home since Jesus is so much fun! And "to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain" (Phil. 1:21, KJV). But it's also because I'm sick of working alone, day after day, years on end, unpaid, for a bunch of ingrates who *refuse* to acknowledge the obvious truth or even behave decently while so much hell is breaking loose around the world and all they care about is that Jesus is coming back soon for *them*, blind to the fact that most of them aren't even born again and we've barely even begun to "make disciples" (Matt. 28:19, ESV). It's like Jesus said, "O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you?" (Matt. 17:17, KJV). Answer: Until His "appointed time" (Hab. 2:3, KJV) and we have fulfilled our Duty, the "works, which God prepared in advance for us to do" (Eph. 2:10, NIV). And my Duty isn't done because, for one thing, He's now having me update all of these biblical interpretations yet again. Since He is "the truth" (John 14:6, ESV), He wants a great level of truth represented in these, calling for another edit.

Child Like Faith. While many happily wave goodbye to Maya having been blessed by her presence, the youngest child won't even face her for being so upset she's leaving. It's what kids do. And Jesus says "Unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 18:3-4, NIV). If we genuinely appreciate what Jesus did for us, we'll be filled with "godly sorrow" (2 Cor. 7:10, NIV) for how unfaithful we've been to Him and make a total turnaround as they did in the book, *feasting* on the Truth.

Not All will Change. You can tell that some people don't care one hoot that Maya's leaving. And it's because they're "vessels of wrath fitted to destruction" (Rom. 9:22, KJV) or elect like "the experts in the law [who] rejected God's purpose for themselves" (Luke 7:30, NIV).

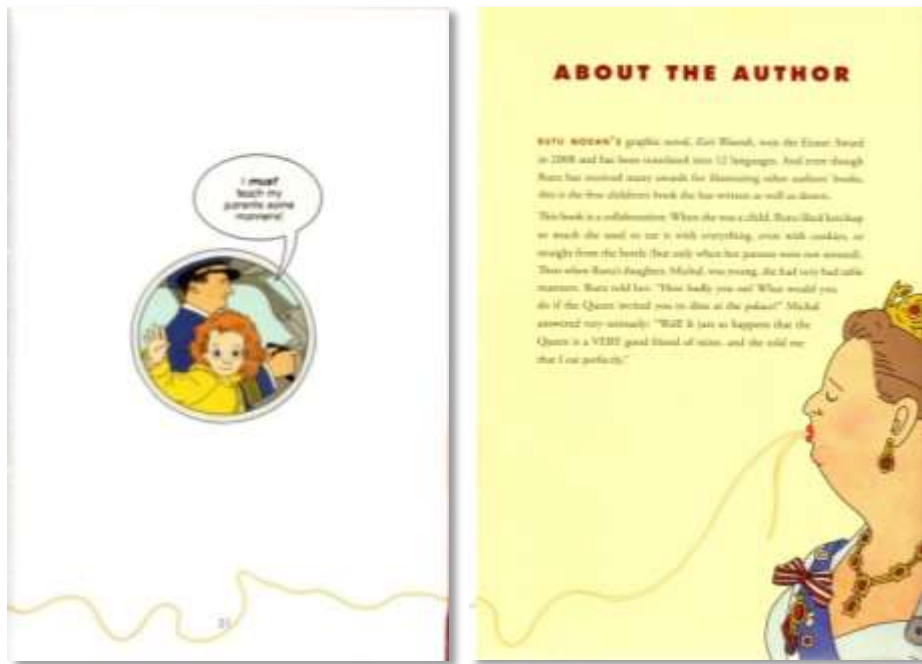
But because of all the horrendous trials coming on the earth during the very last of the last days, I discern all elect *will* take Jesus seriously as we've been informed in the following passage:

Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word [His words, the words in red] so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, **without spot or wrinkle or any such thing** (Eph. 5:25-27, ESV).

So far, it's been playing out like [Tommy Hicks Vision for the Church in the Last Days](#). And, as revealed in Brother Hicks' vision, not all born again will be *empowered* to the highest level because it's a spectrum dependent on how well we know His Word, which is Him since "the name by which he is called is The Word of God" (Rev. 19:13, ESV), and how willing we are to let Him use us. It depends on our level of faith. If we have great faith, we'll have made it a priority to get to know Him well, which, again, starts by getting to know His Word well. And we'll apply it as a FOLLOWER of Christ. Not doing things we think are good but doing what He *leads* us to do, *when* He leads us to do it, and *how* He leads us to do it, and *not* doing stuff He doesn't want us to do or be involved with people He doesn't want us involved with. Again, faith in Christ isn't about being a believer, as Christians are currently focused on being, since "devils also believe" (James 2:19, KJV). It's about trusting what He says, that He'll bless our obedience with His *presence* (John 14:21 below)—caring more about knowing Him than stuff He can give us.

John 14:21, ESV Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.

On the last page of the actual story, you see Maya sitting as “the captain[’s]” ([Heb. 2:10, KJV](#)) co-pilot, at his right hand, which is where a prophet would sit just as He sits at the right hand of the Father ([Mark 16:19 below](#)). Maya waves goodbye and makes a statement about her elders’ manners—you haven’t got any as my life testimony reveals. And Jesus says “To sit on my right hand and on my left hand is not mine to give; but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared” ([Mark 10:40, KJV](#)). Any born again Christian willing to be honest can tell that I’m sitting at His right hand, as revealed by my life and ministry. It’s obvious.

[Mark 16:19, ESV](#) Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.

Learning Good Manners. When God finally opens up this ministry, you’ll be saying to yourselves “How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof; And have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me!” ([Prov. 5:12-13, KJV](#)), and that’s especially true for elect men and women in institutional church leadership. For 2000 years Jesus has “suffered...their manners” ([Acts 13:18, KJV](#))—which is why the girl/Maya “must teach [her] parents some manners.” While everyone had been mad at Maya or offended by her until the very end, the fact is that the Captain invited her to the banquet and to sit next to Him. Jesus says “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit” ([John 15:16, ESV](#)) so that “no one takes this honor for himself, but only when called by God” ([Heb. 5:4, ESV](#)). He’s made it obvious that I’ve been chosen and called. And *He* doesn’t look like He’s mad at me. In fact, He’s got His eye on YOU! He says “The one who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet’s reward” ([Matt. 10:41, KJV](#)). And He told me the following two decades ago, “I will make those of the synagogue of Satan...come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you” ([Rev. 3:9, KJV](#)). They’ll finally humble themselves and acknowledge His calling on my life. In other words, they’ll finally honor Him. Because it’s as He said, “You will not see me again, until you say, ‘Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord’” ([Matt. 23:39, KJV](#)).

About the Author

The Queen, those who know “the author and finisher of our faith” ([Heb. 12:2, KJV](#)), or are getting to know Him, will recognize that I, Maya, “eat perfectly” since I *take my thoughts captive to obey Christ* ([2 Cor. 10:5](#)). While God has given me a ministry where He has me writing in a manner that is not what you’d call scholarly, He says “Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment” ([John 7:24, ESV](#)), which we do by taking our thoughts captive to Christ ([2 Cor. 10:5](#)). And having told us to come to Him as little children, it’s *not* as if scholarly papers with big words would *ever* draw God’s elect and motivate their socks off. They haven’t—at all. They’re super boring compared to what God has done through these biblical interpretations. They’re also *loaded down* with false doctrines.



It's All Connected. There's a twisted noodle running through the entire book just as there is through the Bible—prophesy about God's Messiah, a noodle the Queen is *eating*. God says "My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways" (*Isa. 55:8, KJV*). Our ways of supposedly "mak[ing] disciples" (*Matt. 28:19, ESV*) has been highly ineffective! Because, Churchianity is a bad tree and "a bad tree cannot bear good fruit" (*Matt. 7:18, ESV*). The **ONLY** reason ANYONE has or is having any positive spiritual impact is because even when "we are faithless, he remains faithful—for he cannot deny himself" (*2 Tim. 2:13, ESV*) and "God is love" (*1 John 4:8, ESV*). Love is helpful even when it's not deserved. In turn, God will be revealing that His way, of truth and speaking between the lines, revealing His secrets to His servants (*Amos 3:7 below*), will be *very* effective. Because, it's FUN! And He says "The joy of the LORD is your strength" (*Neh. 8:10, KJV*). It's also "the truth" that "set[s us] free" (*John 8:32, ESV*).

Back Matter

Some Christians like to say "God is in the details." It's one of the few things they've had right!

Guide to Young Readers. It speaks of the importance of facial expressions. And somewhere I wrote about how I use whatever's available to me—like Jesus did (*Luke 12:27 & 13:4 below*)—including my face, when explaining God's Word to people.

Luke 12:27, ESV Consider the lilies, how they grow...

Luke 13:4, ESV Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell...

Ham it Up! My ministry reveals that I haven't been afraid to go with God's flow even though it's meant going against just about every grain there is and letting people think I'm seriously wacked out, so that they've been quite insulting.

Talk about the Pictures. I just did.

Above All, Enjoy! Amen. While "in the world [w]e shall have tribulation [Jesus says—and enables us—to] be of good cheer; [since He] ha[s] overcome the world" (*John 10:10, KJV*). Hallelujah!

TIPS FOR PARENTS AND TEACHERS:
HOW TO READ COMICS WITH KIDS

Kids *love* comics! They are naturally drawn to the details in the pictures, which make them want to read the words. Comics beg for repeated readings and let both emerging and reluctant readers enjoy complex stories with a rich vocabulary. But since comics have their own grammar, here are a few tips for reading them with kids:

GUIDE YOUNG READERS: Use your finger to show your place in the text, but keep it at the bottom of the speaking character so it doesn't hide the very important facial expressions.

HAM IT UP! Think of the comic book story as a play and don't hesitate to read with expression and intonation. Assign parts or get kids to supply the sound effects, a great way to reinforce phonics skills.

LET THEM GUESS. Comics provide lots of context for the words, so emerging readers can make informed guesses. Like jigsaw puzzles, comics ask readers to make connections, so check a young audience's understanding by asking, "What's this character thinking?" (But don't be surprised if a kid finds some of the comics' subtle details faster than you.)

TALK ABOUT THE PICTURES. Point out how the artist paces the story with pauses (silent panels) or speeded-up action (a burst of short panels). Discuss how the size and shape of the panels carry meaning.

ABOVE ALL, ENJOY! There is of course never one right way to read, so go for the shared pleasure. Once children make the story happen in their imagination, they have discovered the thrill of reading, and you won't be able to stop them. At that point, just go get them more books, and more comics.

Toon Into Reading

Level 1. The little mouse is putting on really large hiking boots like I did when I was four when an earthquake hit in Chile. I'd been playing in my father's closet with his army boots and had to make my way down the spiral staircase with them on—which I've never forgotten since those stairs were scary (to me) no matter what. And hiking boots are what I live in since I'm prone to twisting my ankles. And a year before He gave me the Maya book, so in 2011, there had been an earthquake here in Maryland so that I was reminded of that time when I was four ([John 14:26 below](#)). Then, receiving this book from the Lord, He reminded me of how my father would make fun of me because I did the same thing with my tongue like the little mouse is doing. God, through His Spirit, will remind us of things we've experienced even as far back as preschool days—if needed for His purposes.

[John 14:26, NIV](#) [Jesus said] The Holy Spirit...will remind you of everything I have said to you. [In a way, it's He who has said everything to us since He is the One who has allowed it all being that no one has breath without His help.]

Level 2. A cute little critter is cracking up with a monkey peeking behind her who's not laughing. I've always been accused of either being too quiet or of laughing too much. It's because I'm not *into* what everybody else is into—and never have been—and not afraid to laugh when it's funny. (And idiots can be funny.) So what if it's not politically correct?! Politics are seriously screwed up because that's Satan's game being that he's the "ruler of this world" ([John 12:31, YLT](#)) who is using all those people as his puppets since he would NEVER allow anyone who genuinely honors Jesus to serve in his kingdom. And there's a saying, "Monkey See, Monkey Do." That's exactly how Satan is since he's been copying *everything* Jesus does ([Isa. 14:14 and 2 Cor. 11:14 below](#)). And he doesn't like it (doesn't laugh) when someone isn't intimidated by him and obeys Jesus instead. In fact, he looks mad and is hiding since "demons...tremble" at Jesus ([James 2:19, KJV](#)) and "he knows that his time is short" ([Rev. 12:12, ESV](#)) and the consequences for his behavior await him: "an angel...[will] seize...Satan, and b[i]nd him for a thousand years" ([Rev. 20:1-2, ESV](#)). He also knows that the one that's in the born again is greater than him ([1 John 4:4 below](#)).

[Isaiah 14:12-14, ESV](#) How you are fallen from heaven...you who laid the nations low! You said in your heart...'I will make myself like the Most High.'

[2 Corinthians 11:14, ESV](#) Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.

[1 John 4:4, ESV](#) Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for he who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Level 3. The little devil naturally represents Satan, and his little geeky friend represents those he's used to abuse people, who think they're so smart with their secret knowledge—Illuminati, Freemasons, and shadow government ([Ps. 2:1-3 below](#))—or those who peddle so-called science ([1 Tim. 6:20 below](#)). While they do have a great deal of power during the "present evil age" ([Gal. 1:4, YLT](#)), they're very little in God's eyes, as is Satan ([Isa. 14:13-19 below](#)). They've only been as powerful as the body of Christ has allowed them to be ([1 John 4:4 below](#)) as allowed by God who "works all things according to the counsel of his will" ([Eph. 1:11, ESV](#)).

[Psalm 2:1-3, ESV](#) Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against his Anointed, saying, "Let us burst their bonds apart and cast away their cords from us."

[1 Timothy 6:20, NIV](#) Turn away from godless chatter and the opposing ideas of what is falsely called knowledge.

[Isaiah 14:13-10, ESV](#) You said...I will make myself like the Most High.' But you are brought down to Sheol,.

[1 John 4:4, KJV](#) Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you [speaking to those who have His Spirit within], than he that is in the world.



A bullet says the “reader needs to make connections and speculate.” That’s a big part of the message of the Bible. And we are talking 2nd grade reading level because the new covenant is *not* hard to understand. Jesus said “Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven” (Matt. 19:14, KJV). Preschoolers can understand the Message and would continue to walk in the truth if the adults around them actually walked in it instead of being royal hypocrites. But if mature born again Christian adults won’t stand firm in their faith, it’s impossible for children to do it. So that’s also reflected in my testimony as shared elsewhere and summed up with the graphic.

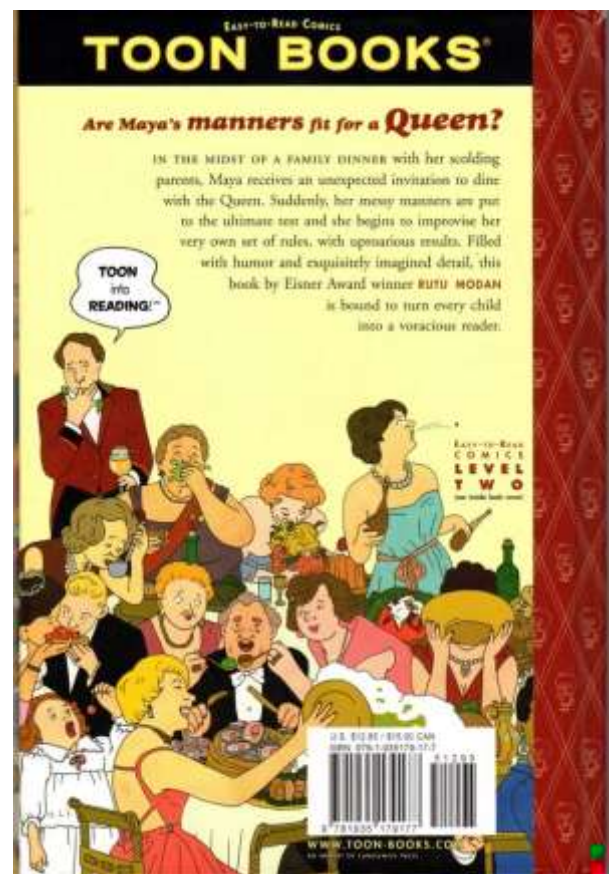


Back Cover

It says “Are Maya’s Manners fit for a Queen?” And the standard answer from the body of Christ has been NO! So that like Jesus “they [have] hated me without a cause” (John 15:25, KJV). Except the standard born again Christian isn’t walking in the truth having barely taken Jesus seriously. And He warned us what would happen in the following passage:

When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person [that unclean spirit *had* to leave when that person became born again because the Holy Spirit of God booted that unclean spirit out], it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. [It’s like all the warm bodies are already taken since we all have hearts that are desperately wicked (Jer. 17:9).] Then it says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. [That house is “empty” since that born again person who has been “swept and put in order” isn’t a follower of Christ (Matt. 4:19), not *fanning into flame the gift of God* (2 Tim. 1:6) nor *working out their own salvation as required* (Phil. 2:12 below). It’s like when I drove my motorcycle practically on fumes, saved by the reserve tank. Spiritually, we get “saved; yet so as by fire” (1 Cor. 3:15, KJV) “for our God is a consuming fire” (Heb. 12:29, ESV), like saved “by the skin of [our] teeth” (Job 19:20, NIV).] Then it [that unclean spirit] goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and **the last state of that [born again] person is worse than the first** [worse than before they were born again]. So also will it be with this evil generation (Matt. 12:43-45, ESV).

Elsewhere I provide plenty of examples of how this has played out in specific individuals who had to be born again since only the born again will do certain things.
